DESCRIPTION

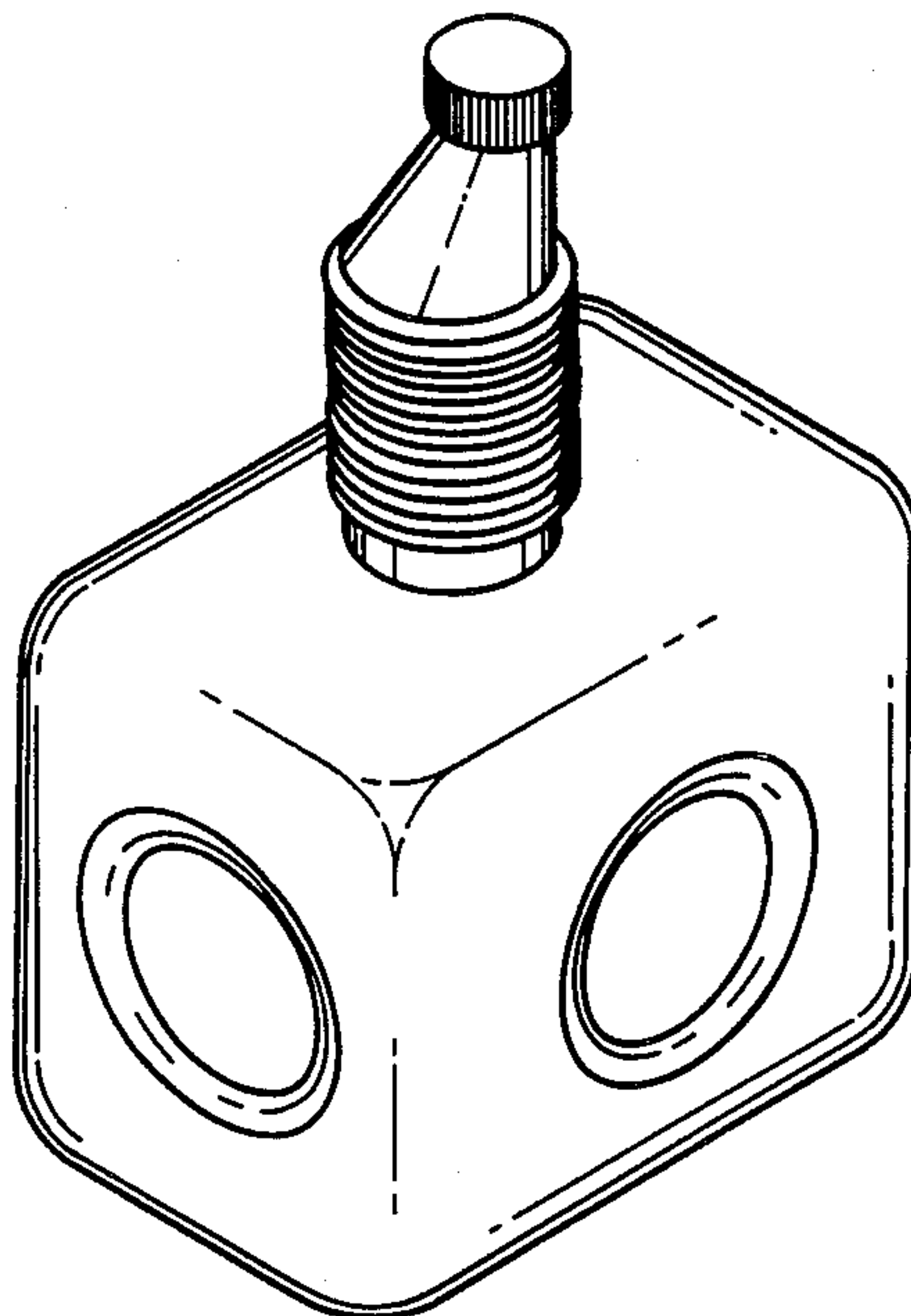
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined container and integral flexible funnel showing my new design.

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image.



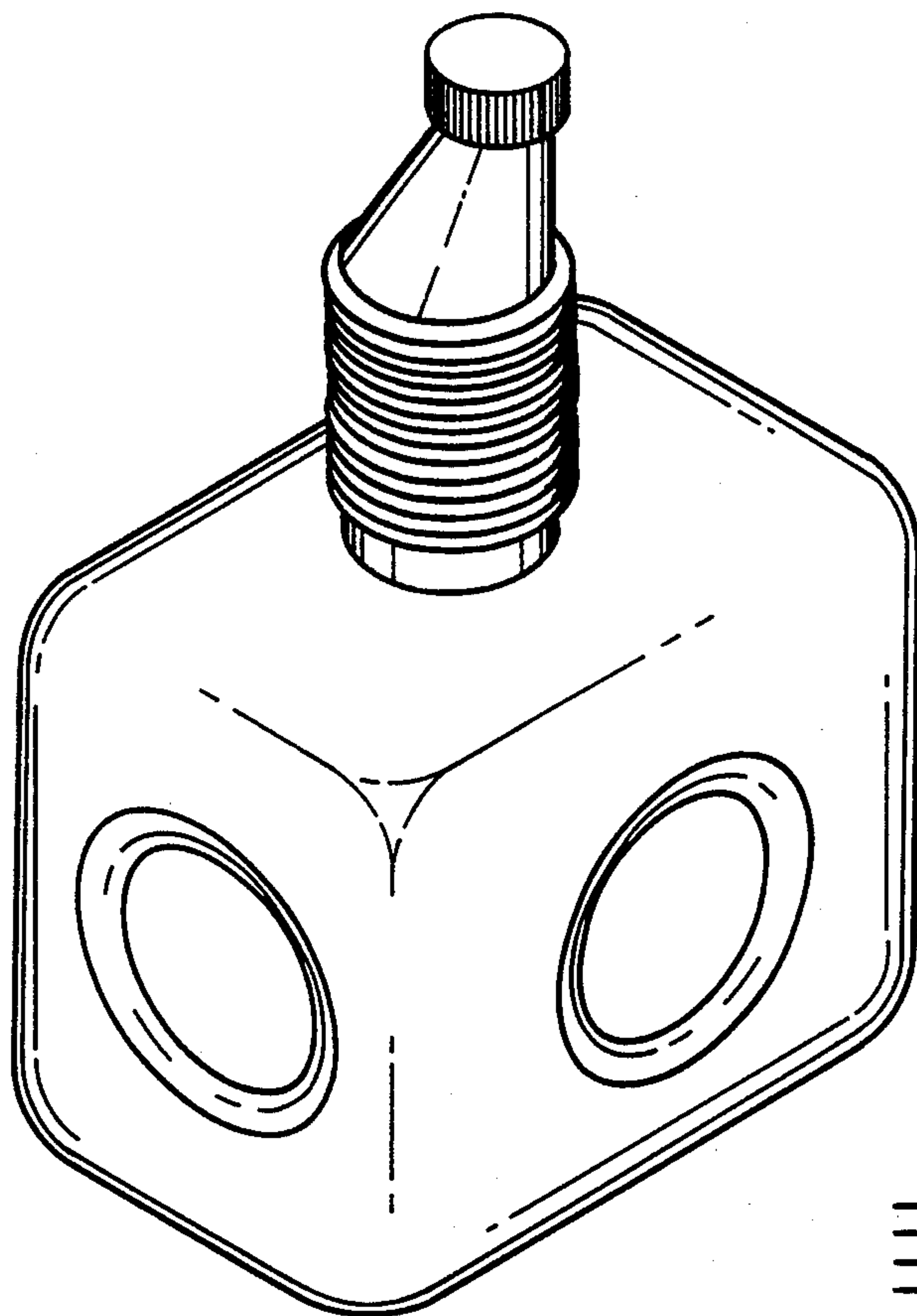

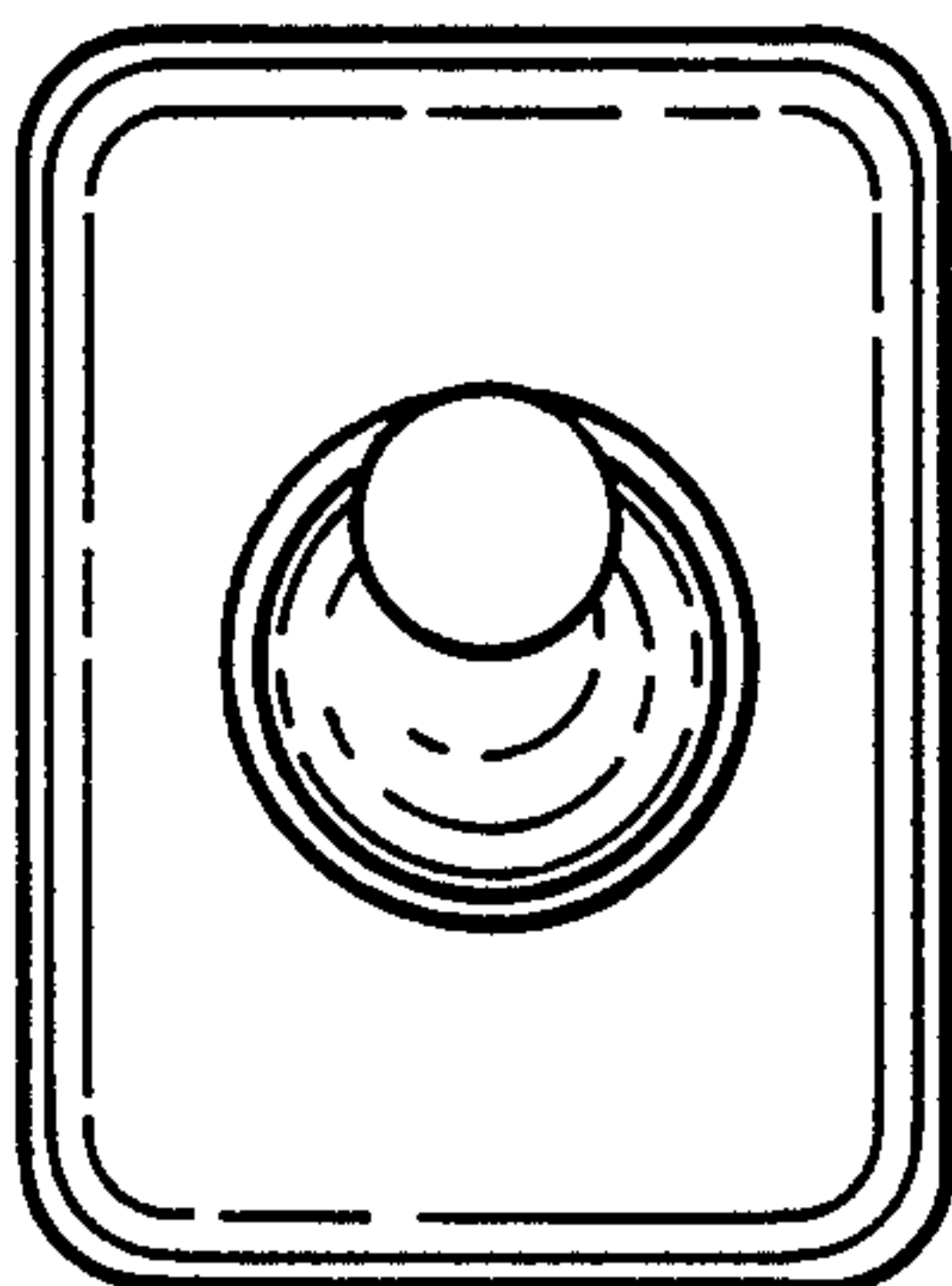

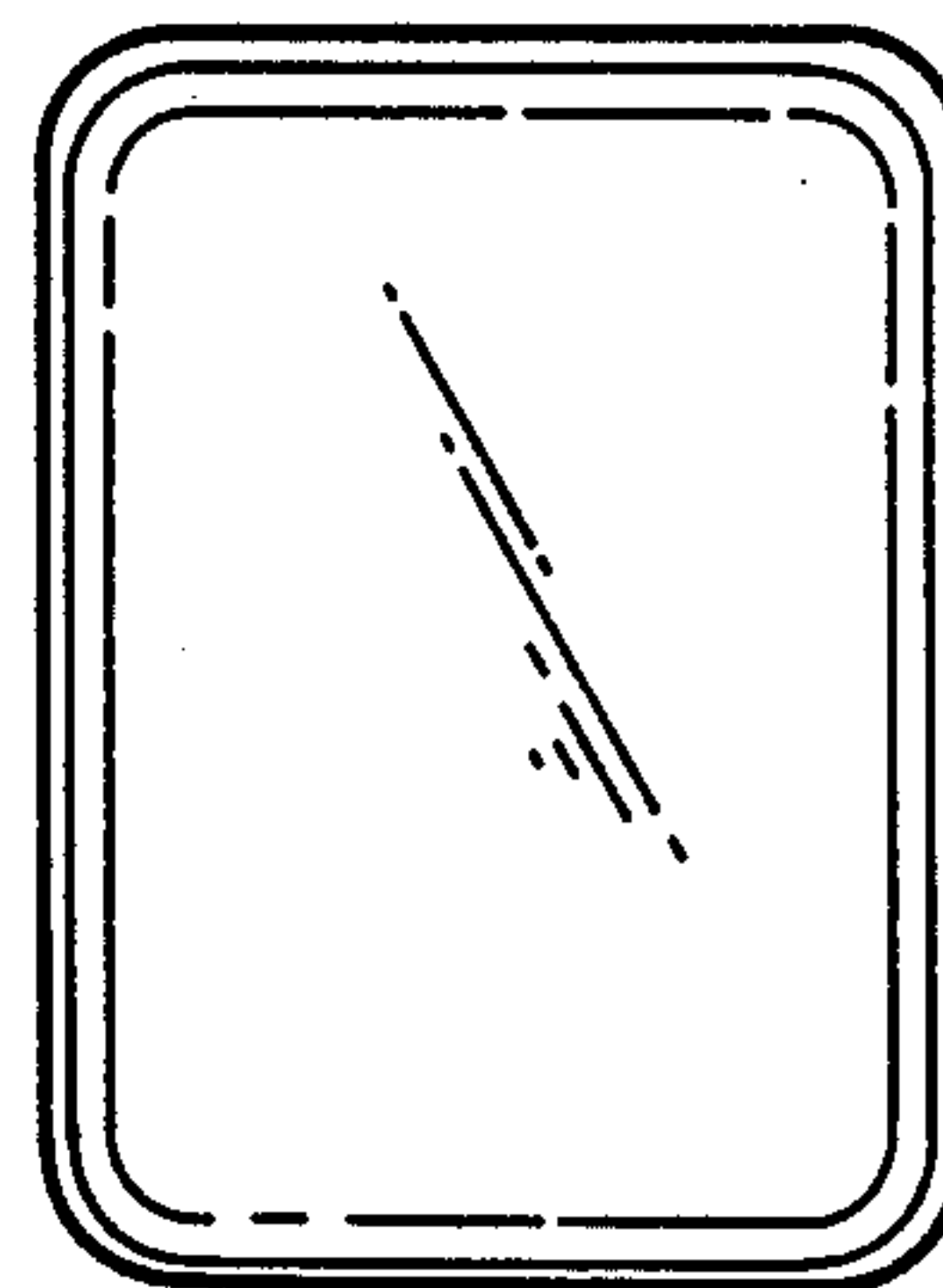

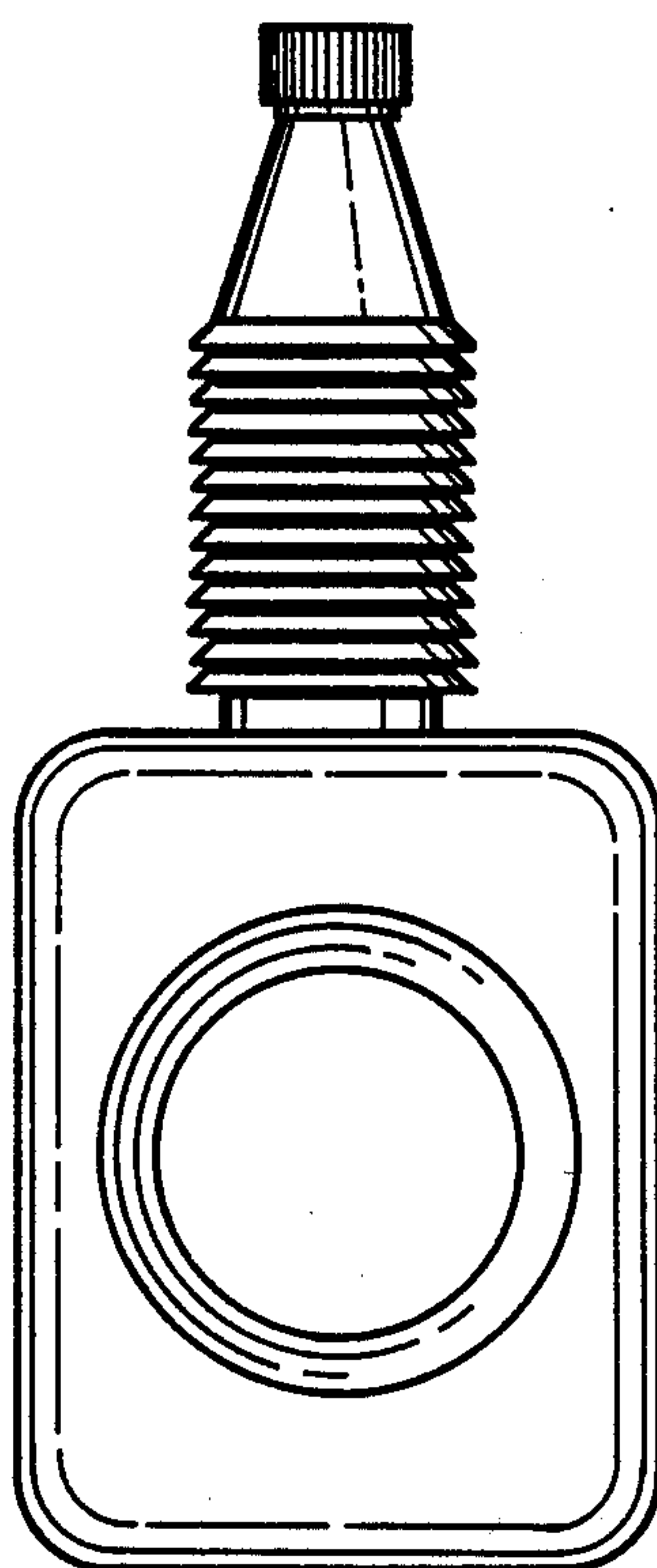
