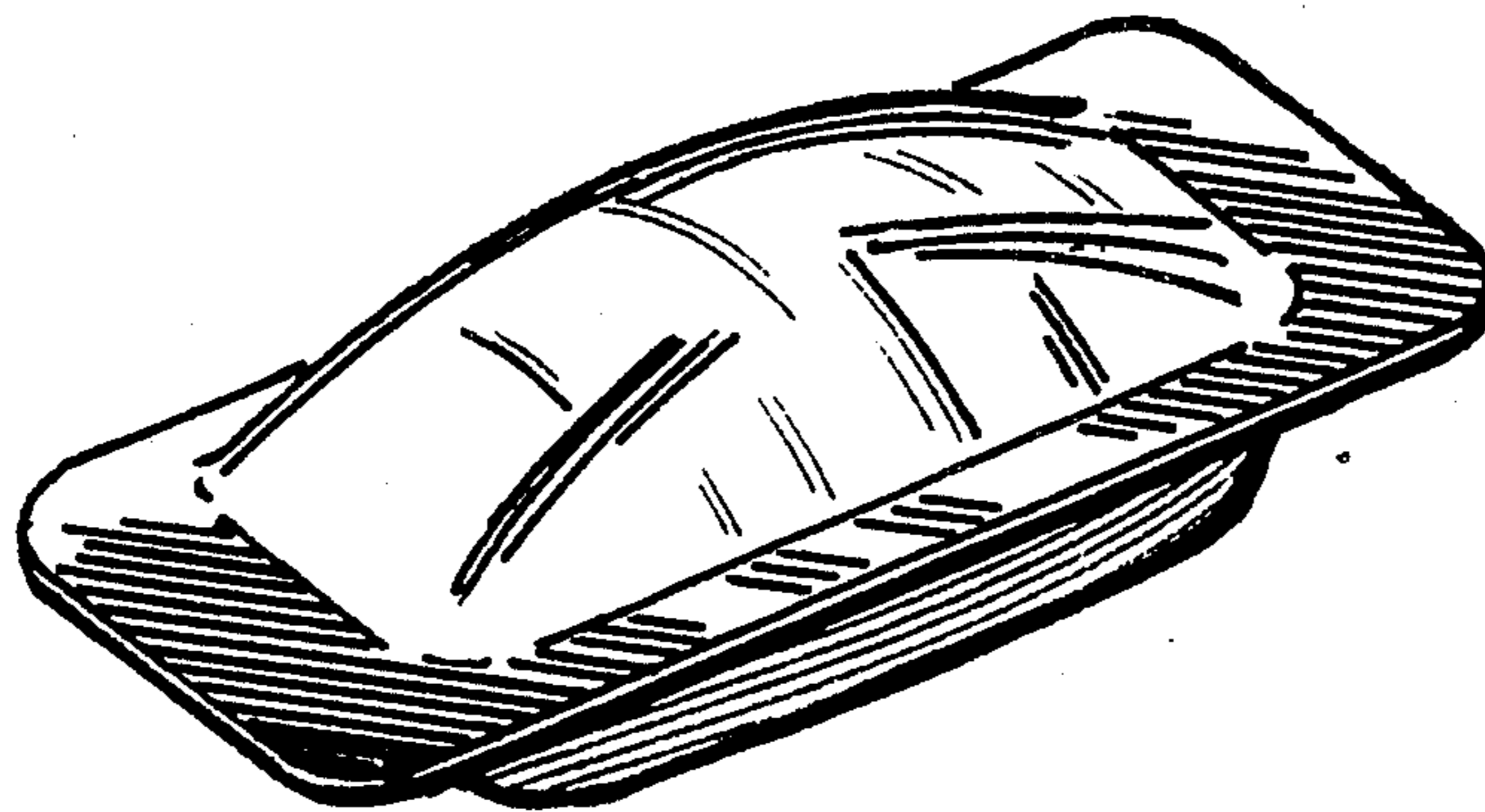

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a puncturable transparent container, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a puncturable transparent container showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof, the rear elevation is similar to the front elevation shown;
 FIG. 3 is a left side elevation thereof, the right hand side elevation is similar to the left side elevation;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
 FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof, with tooth brush attached.
 The broken lines shown in FIG. 6 of a toothbrush are for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



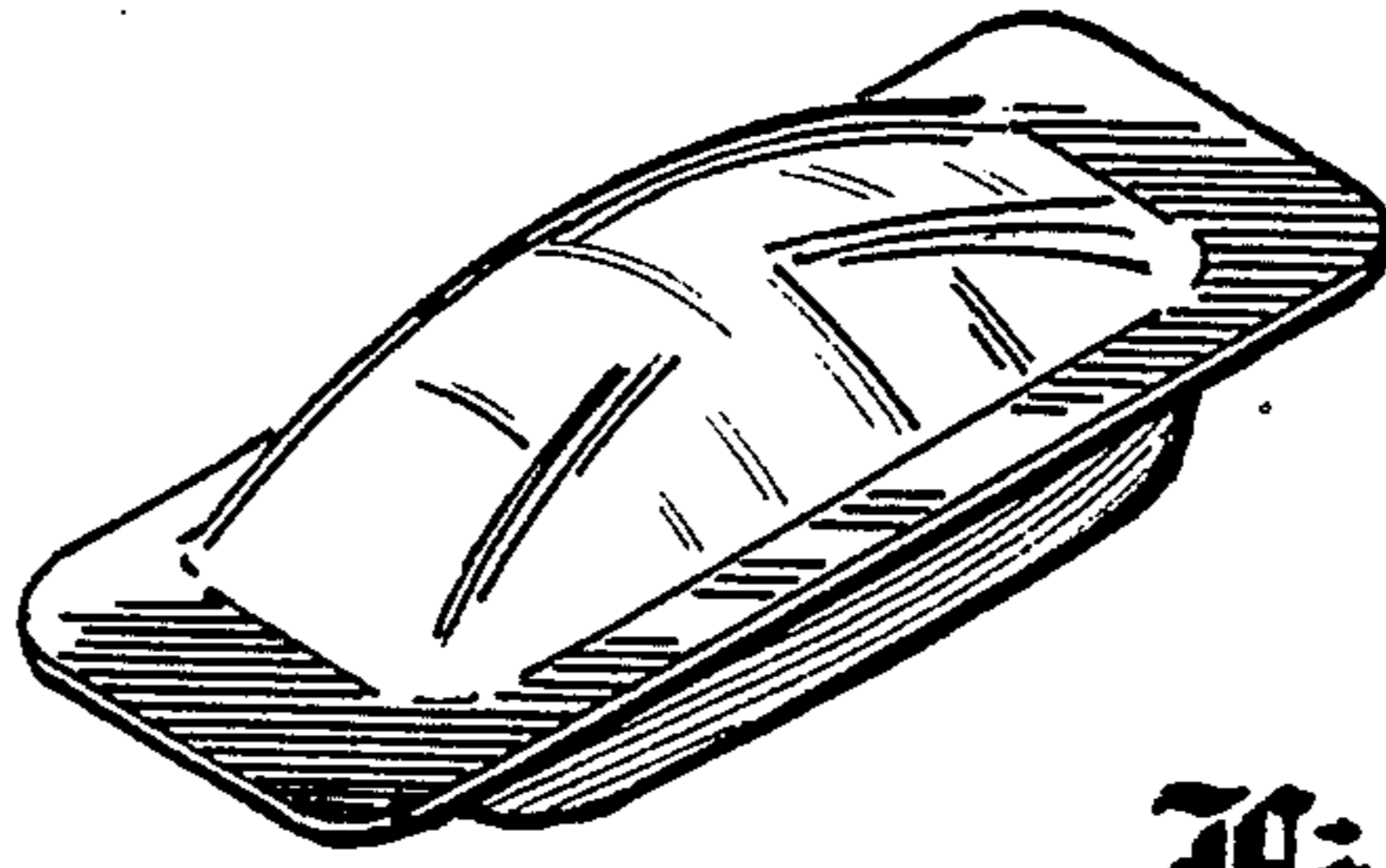

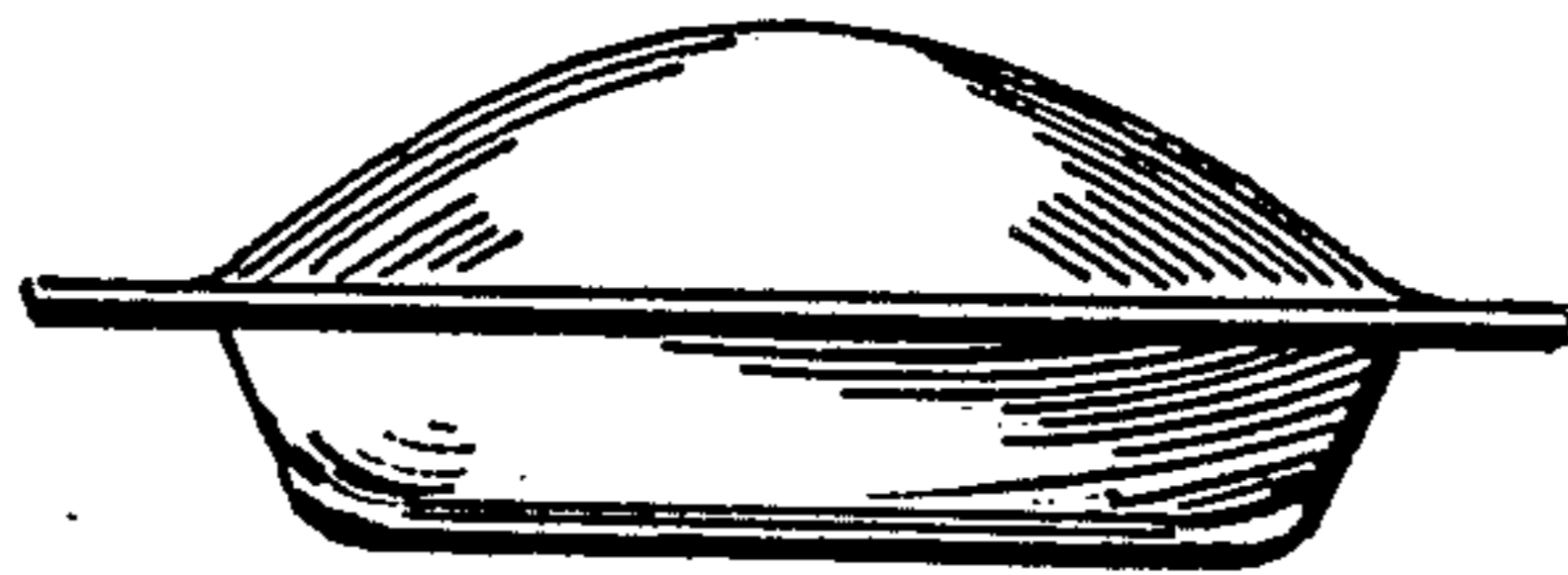

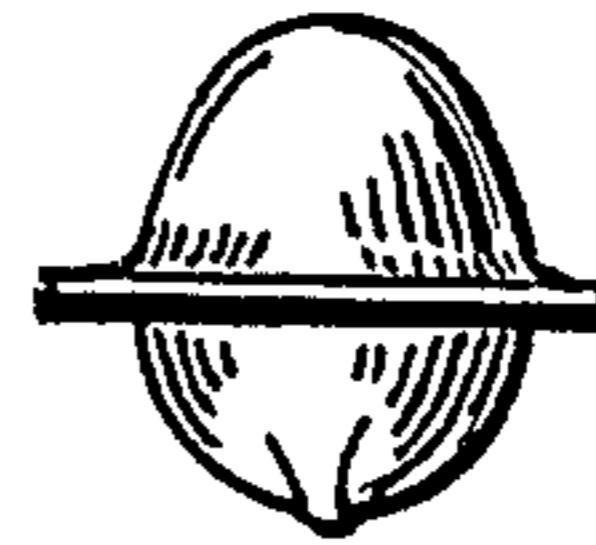

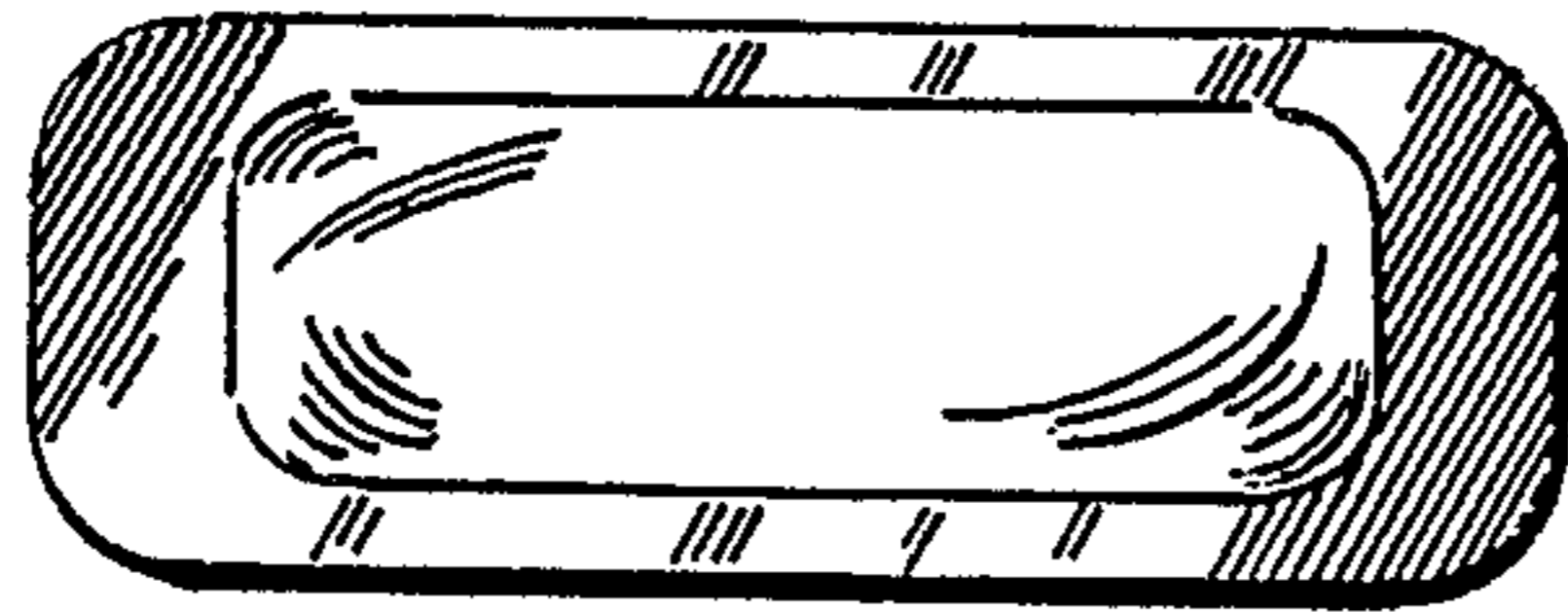

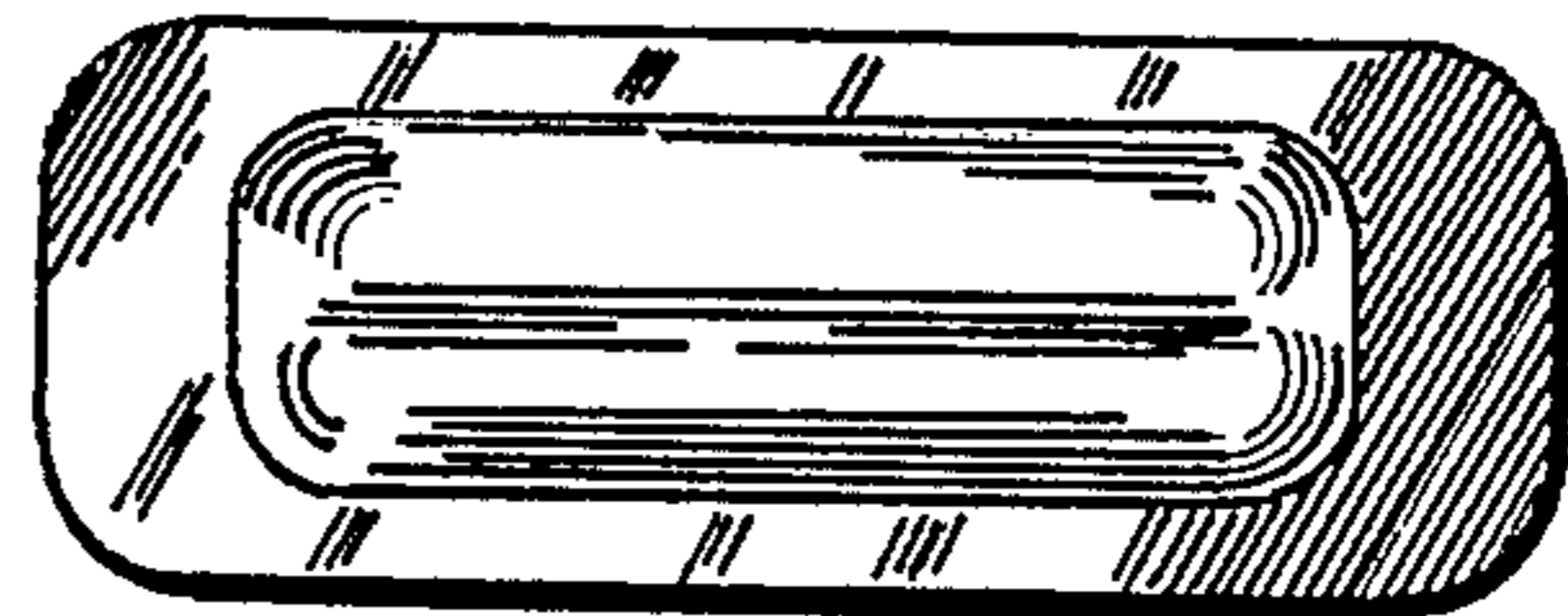

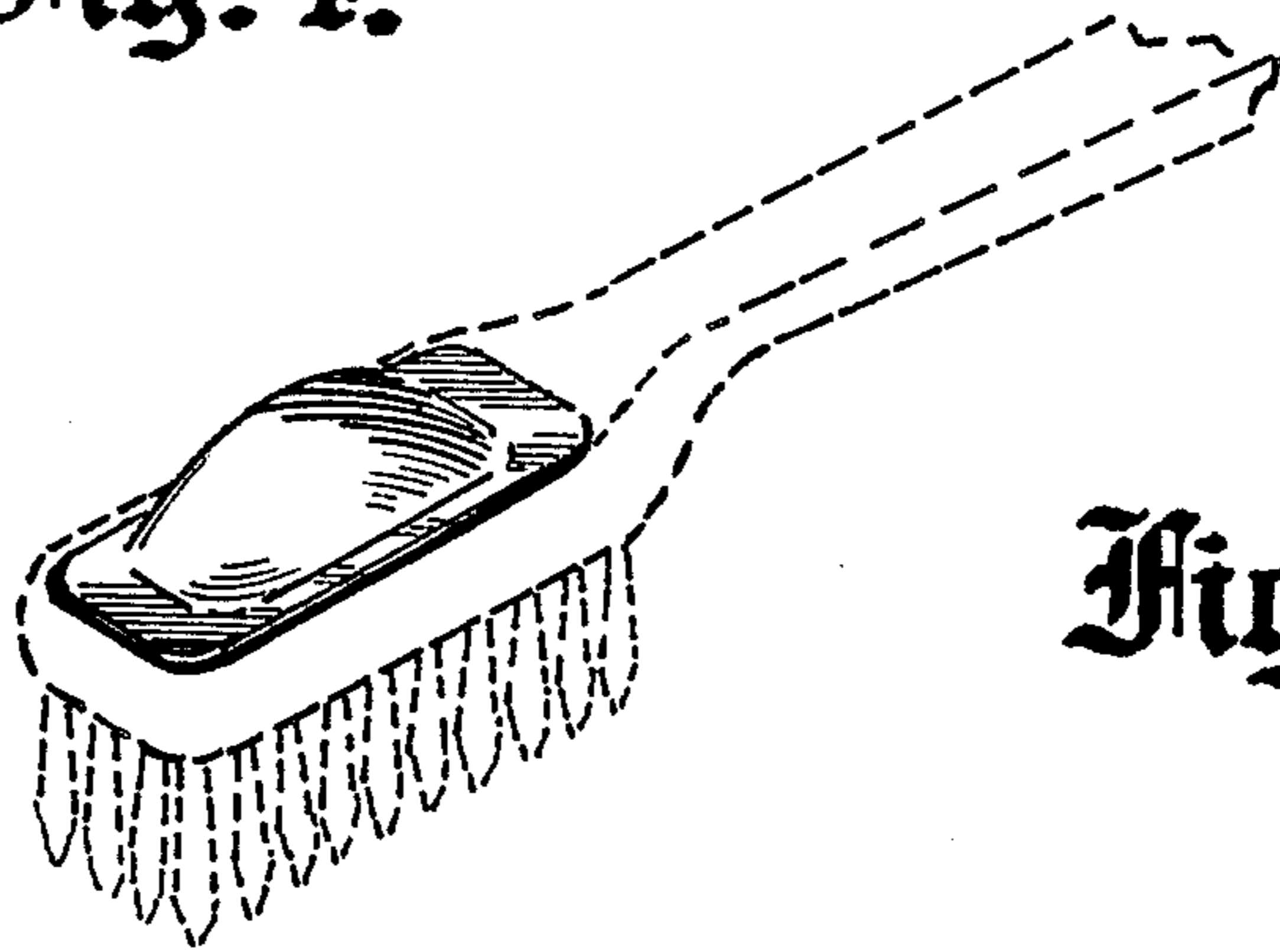
