[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a construction toy link, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a construction toy link showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; the side opposite being identical;

FIG. 3 is a left end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right end elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

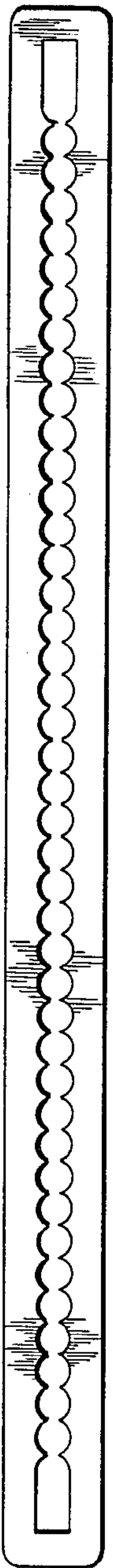
