The ornamental design for a paper dispenser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a paper dispenser showing my new design, the broken-line showing of the paper roll being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

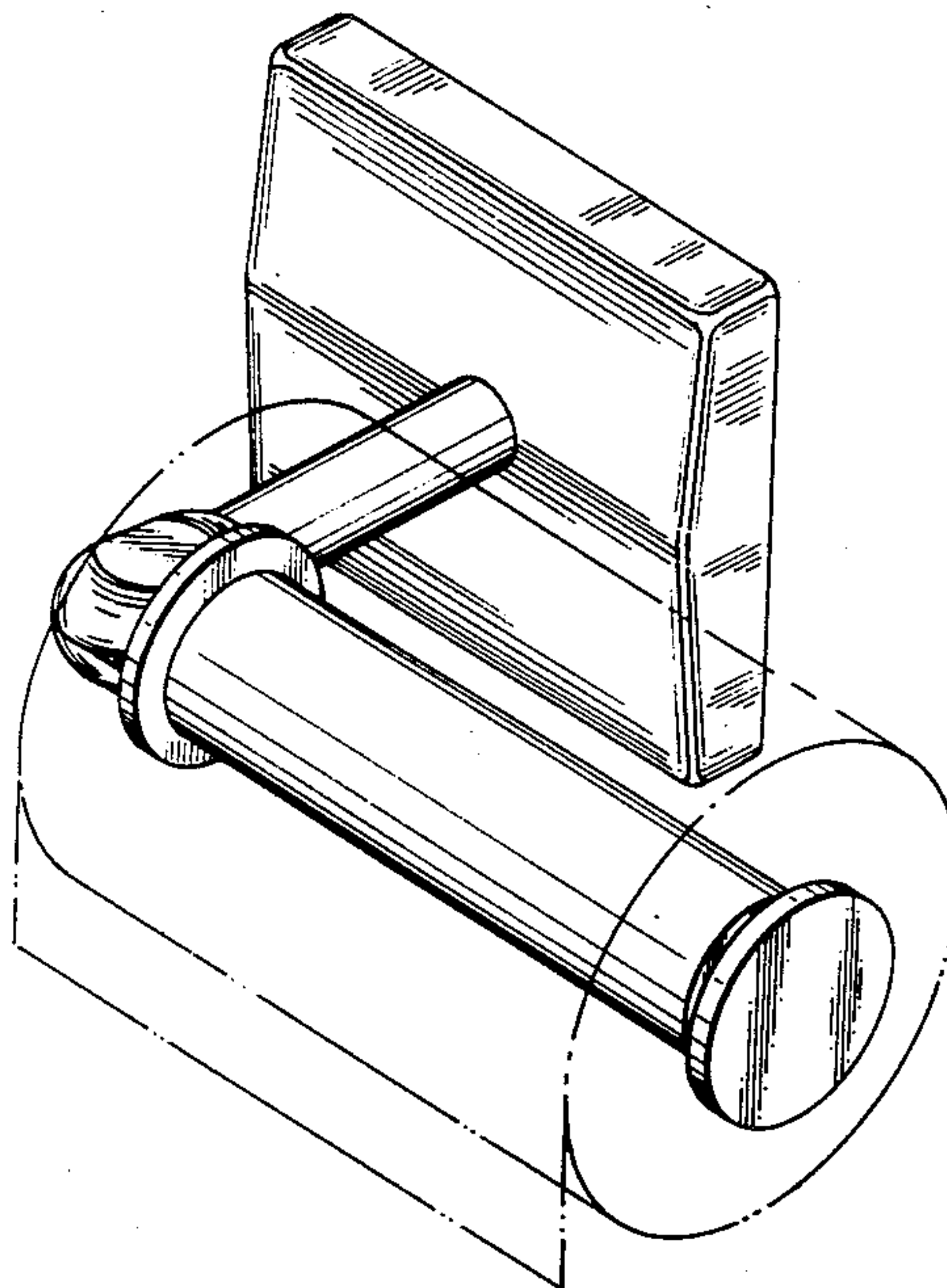
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second embodiment thereof, the only difference residing in the rotation of the arm member; and

FIG. 9 is a reduced perspective view of a third embodiment thereof, the only difference residing in the lengthening of the arm member.



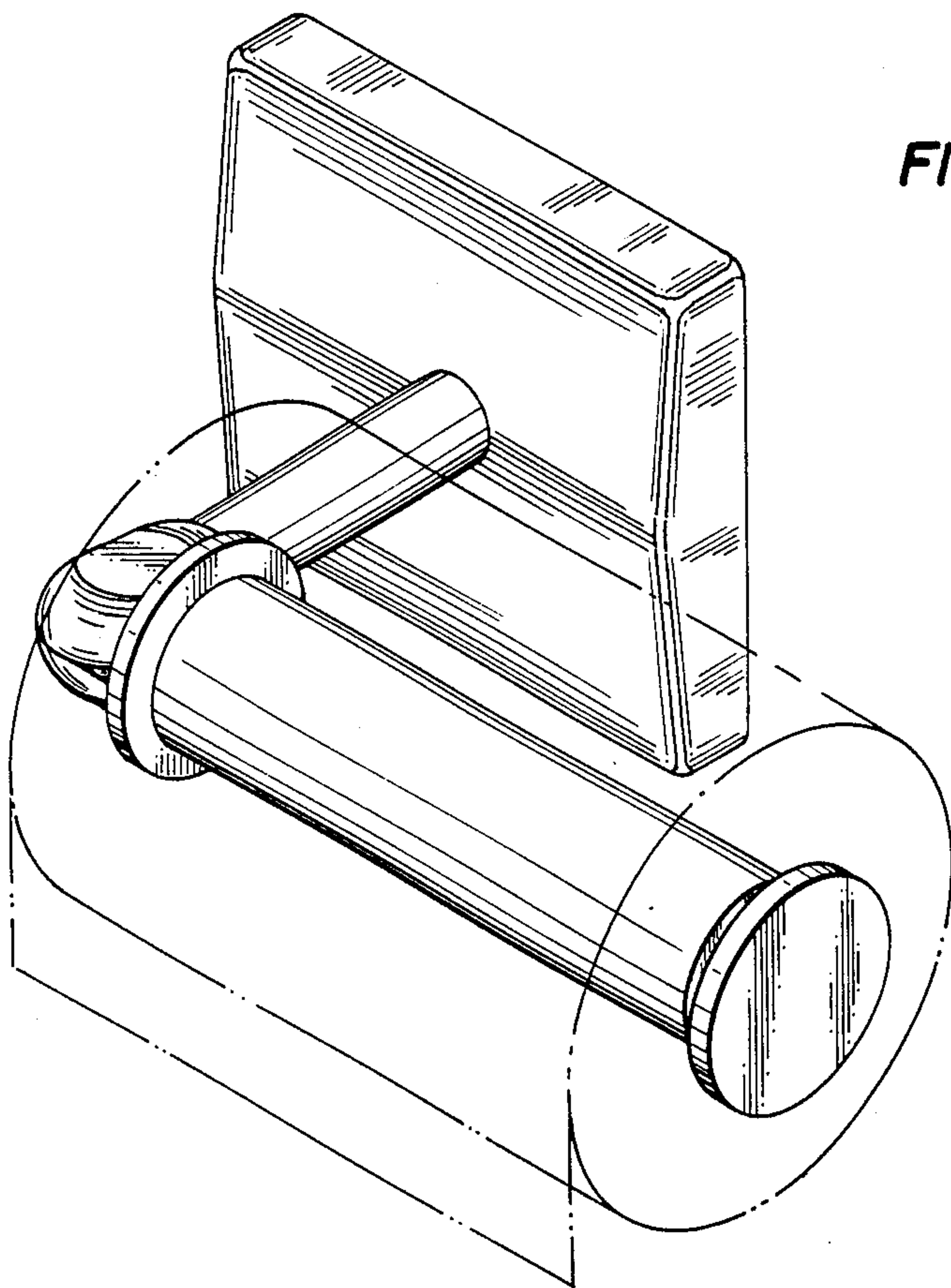

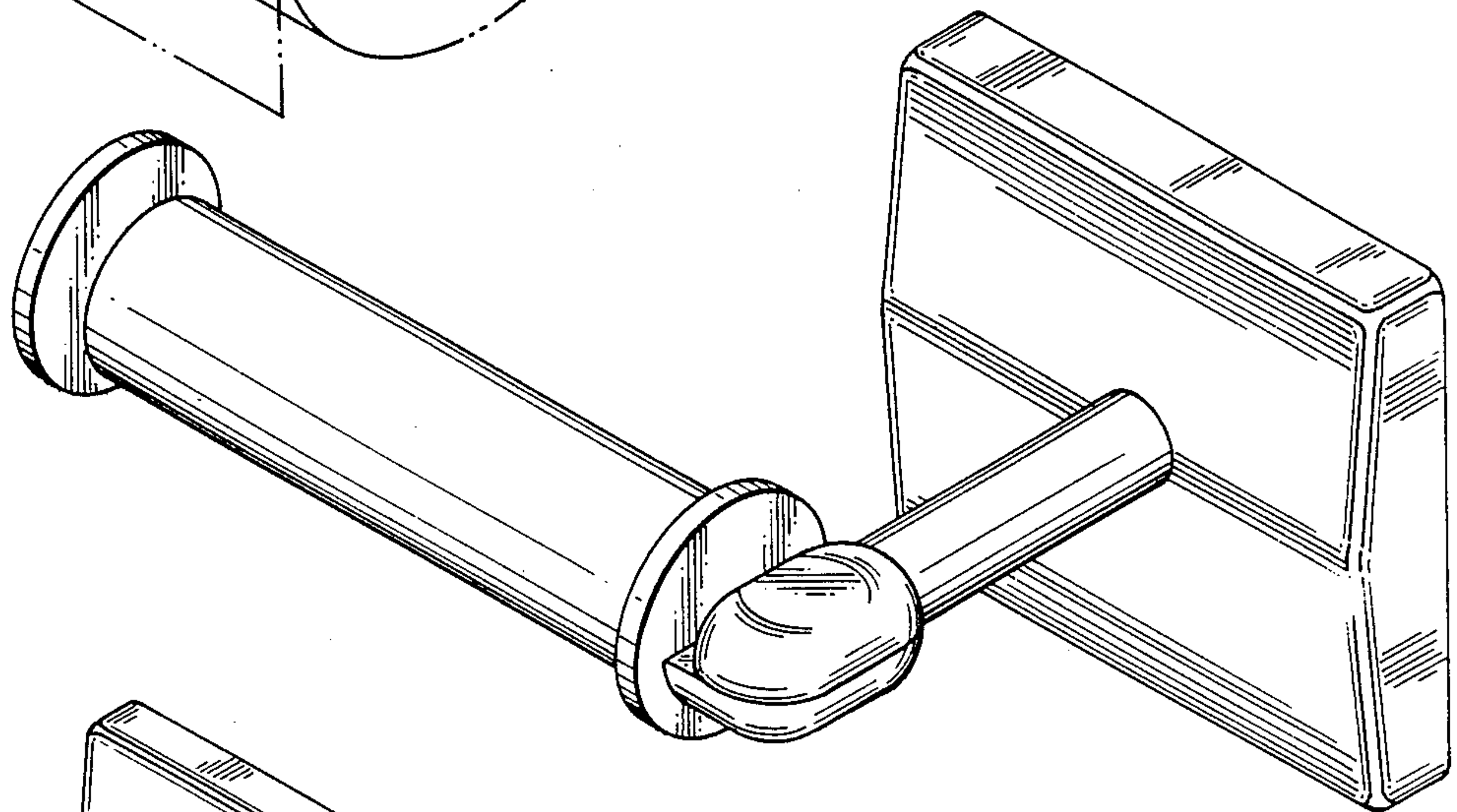

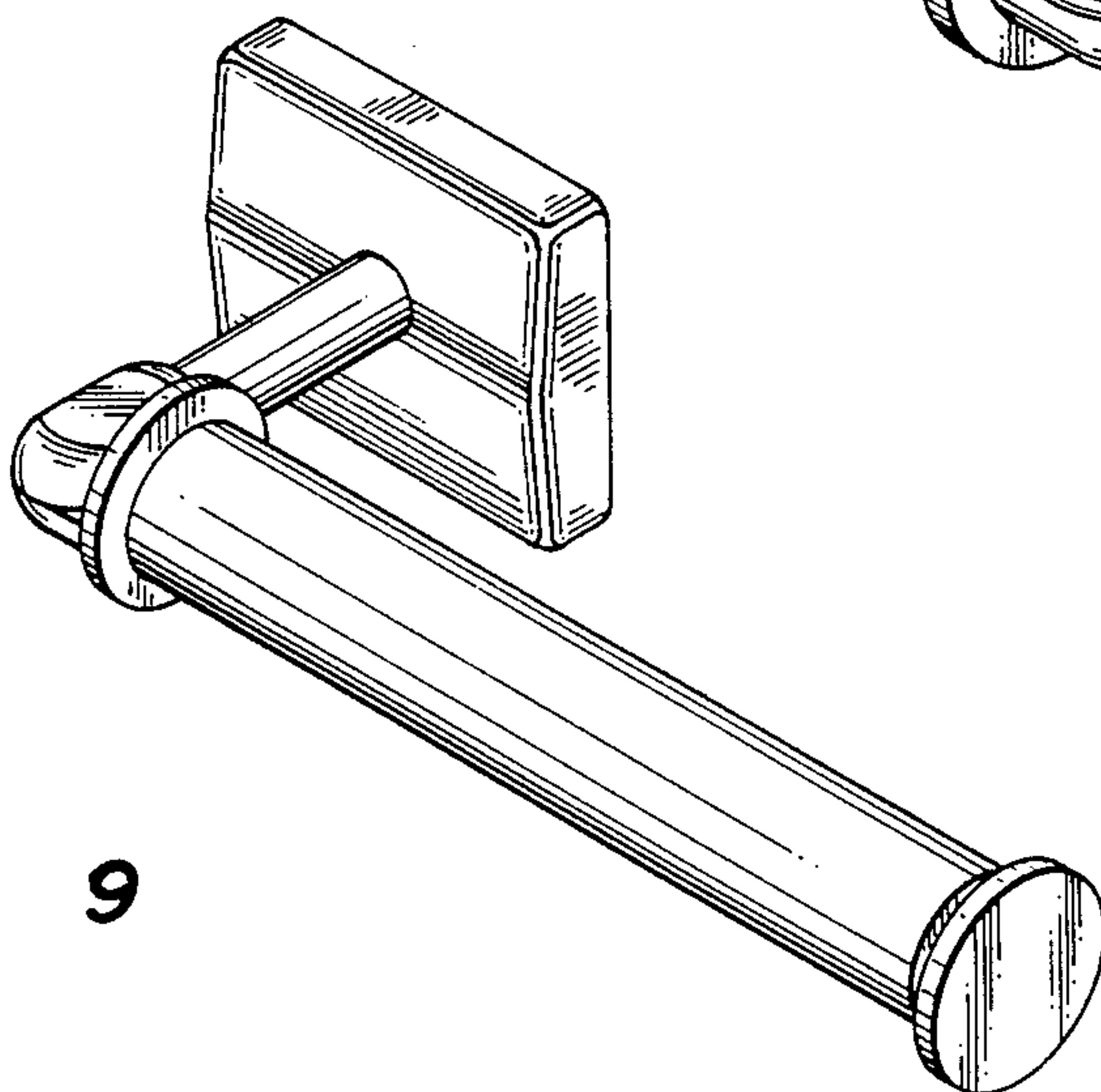

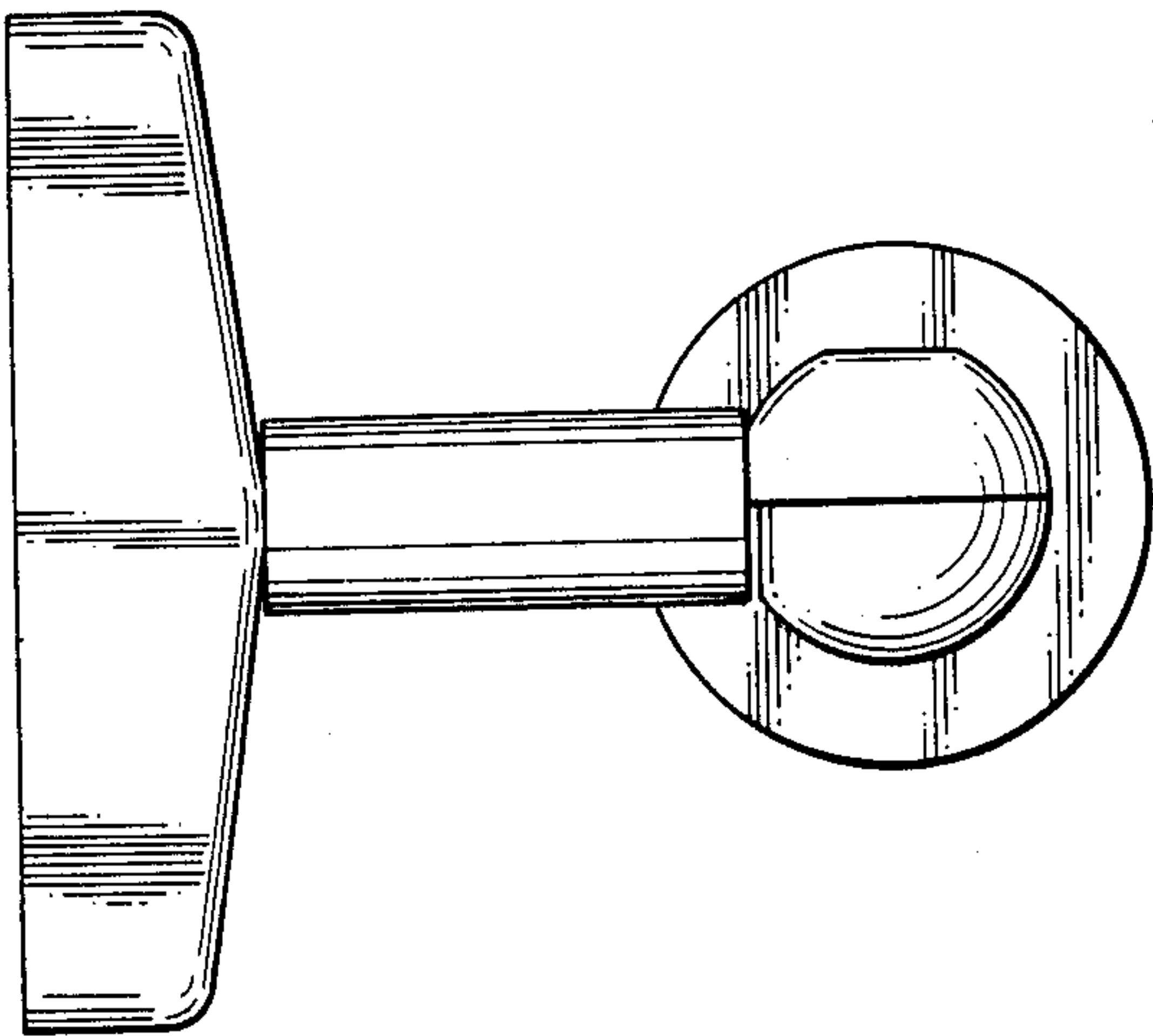

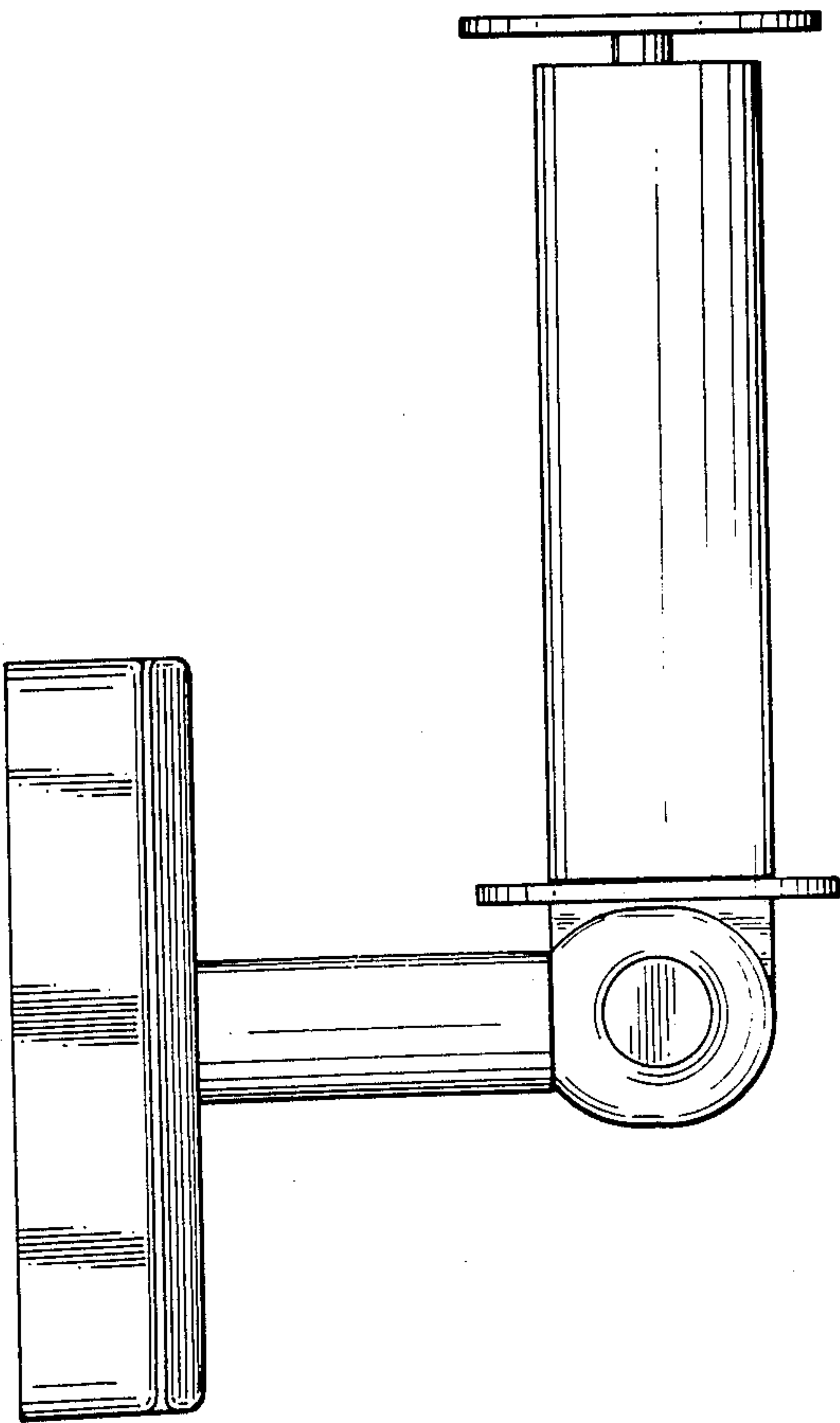

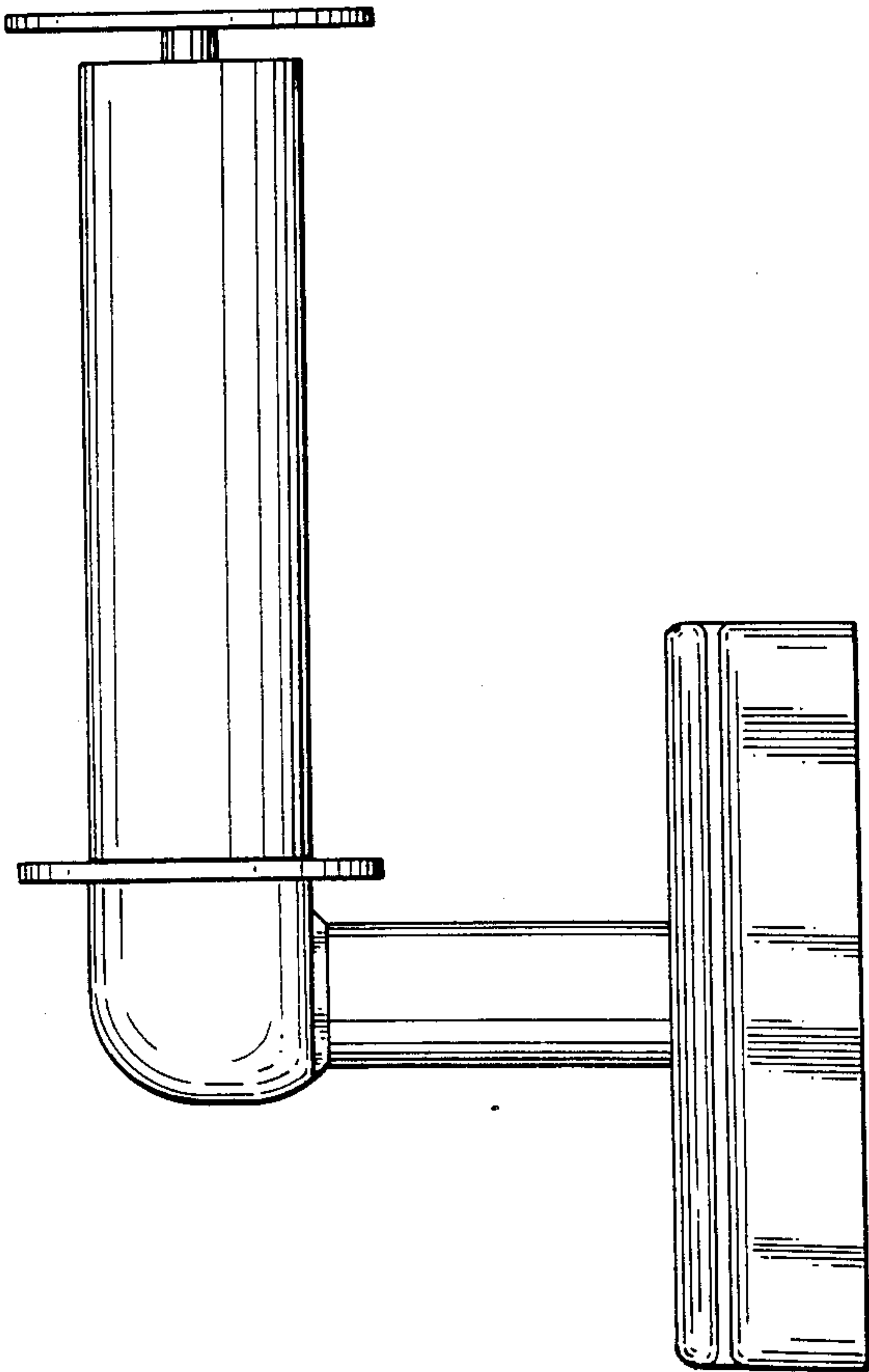

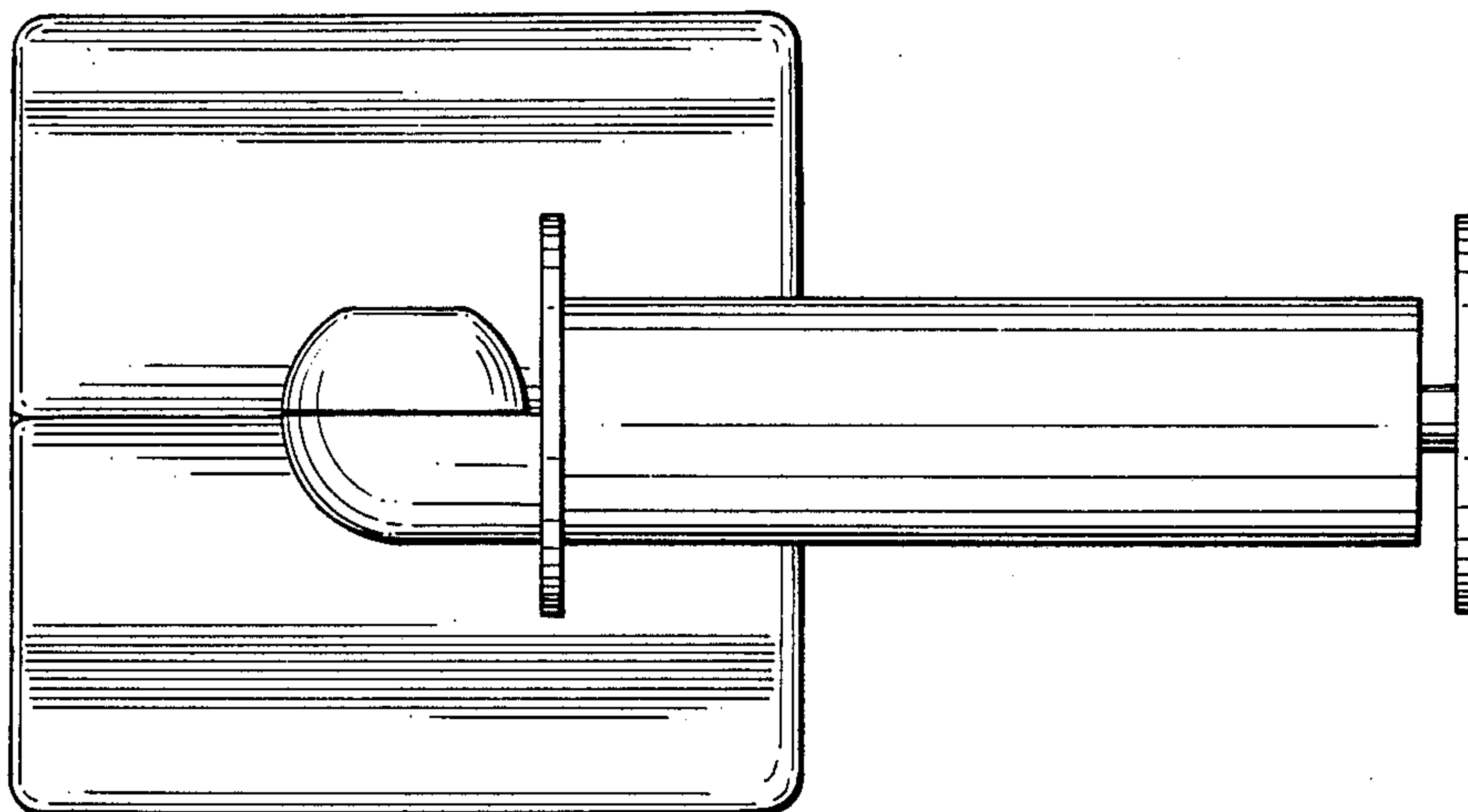

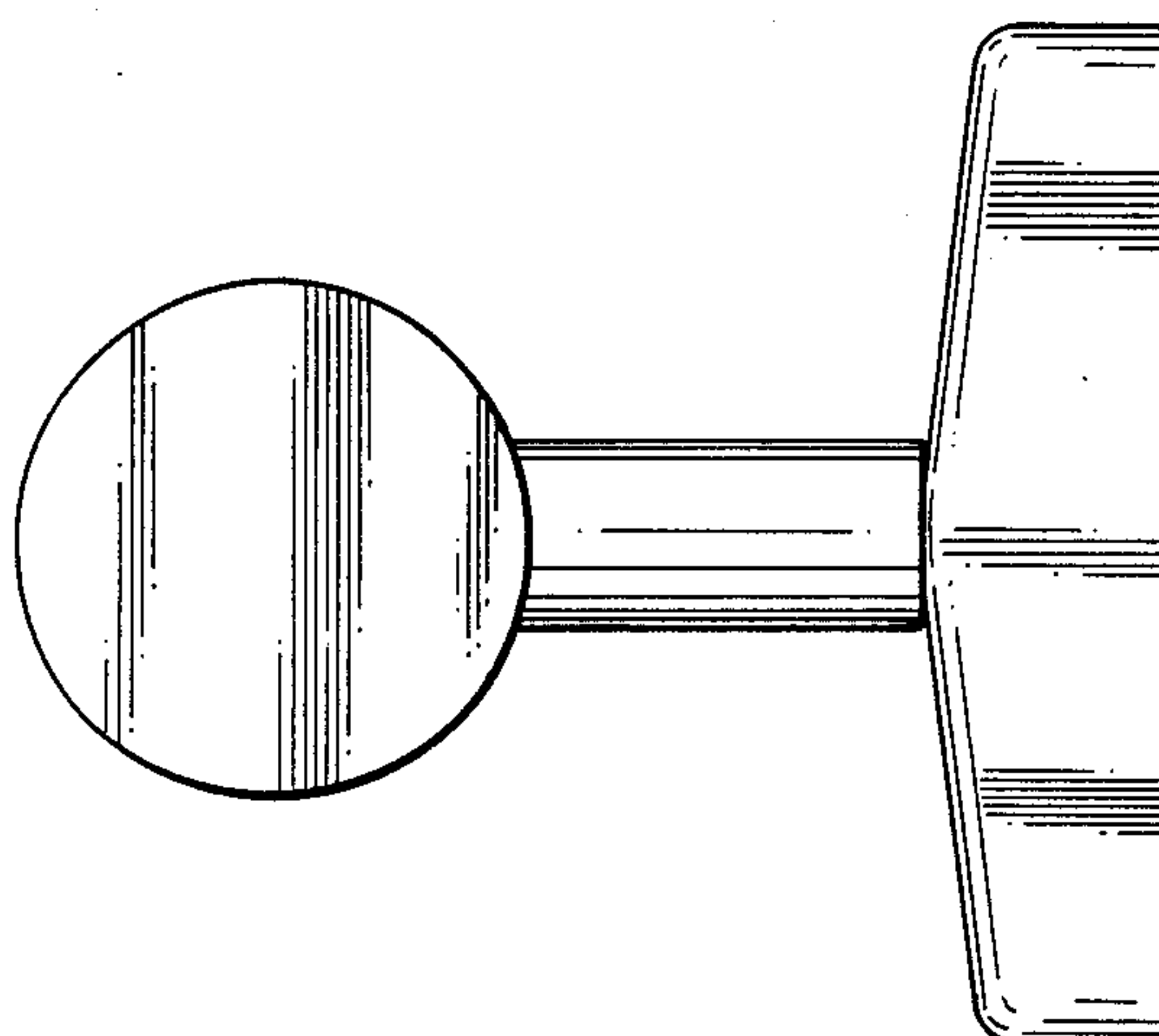

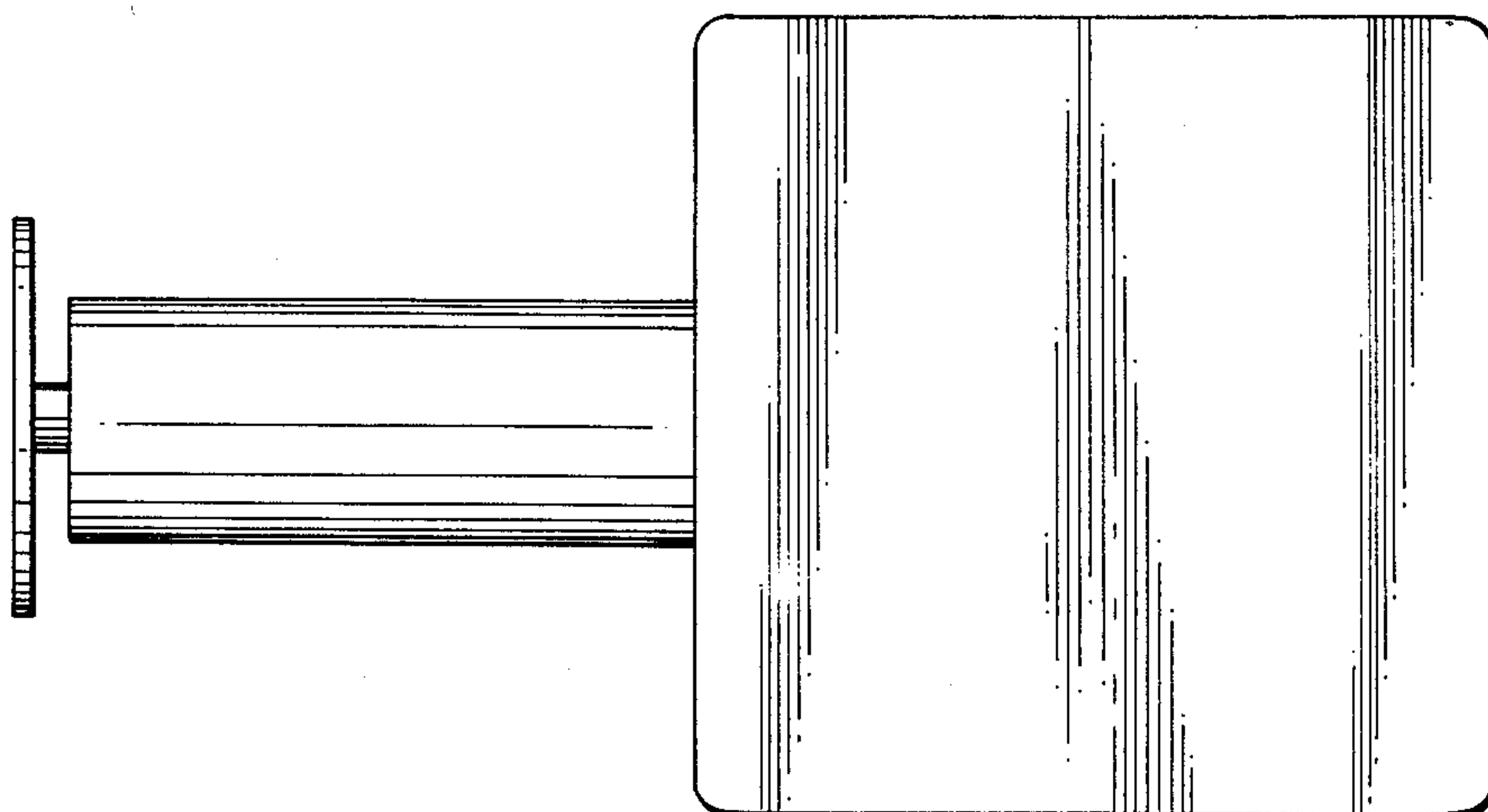
