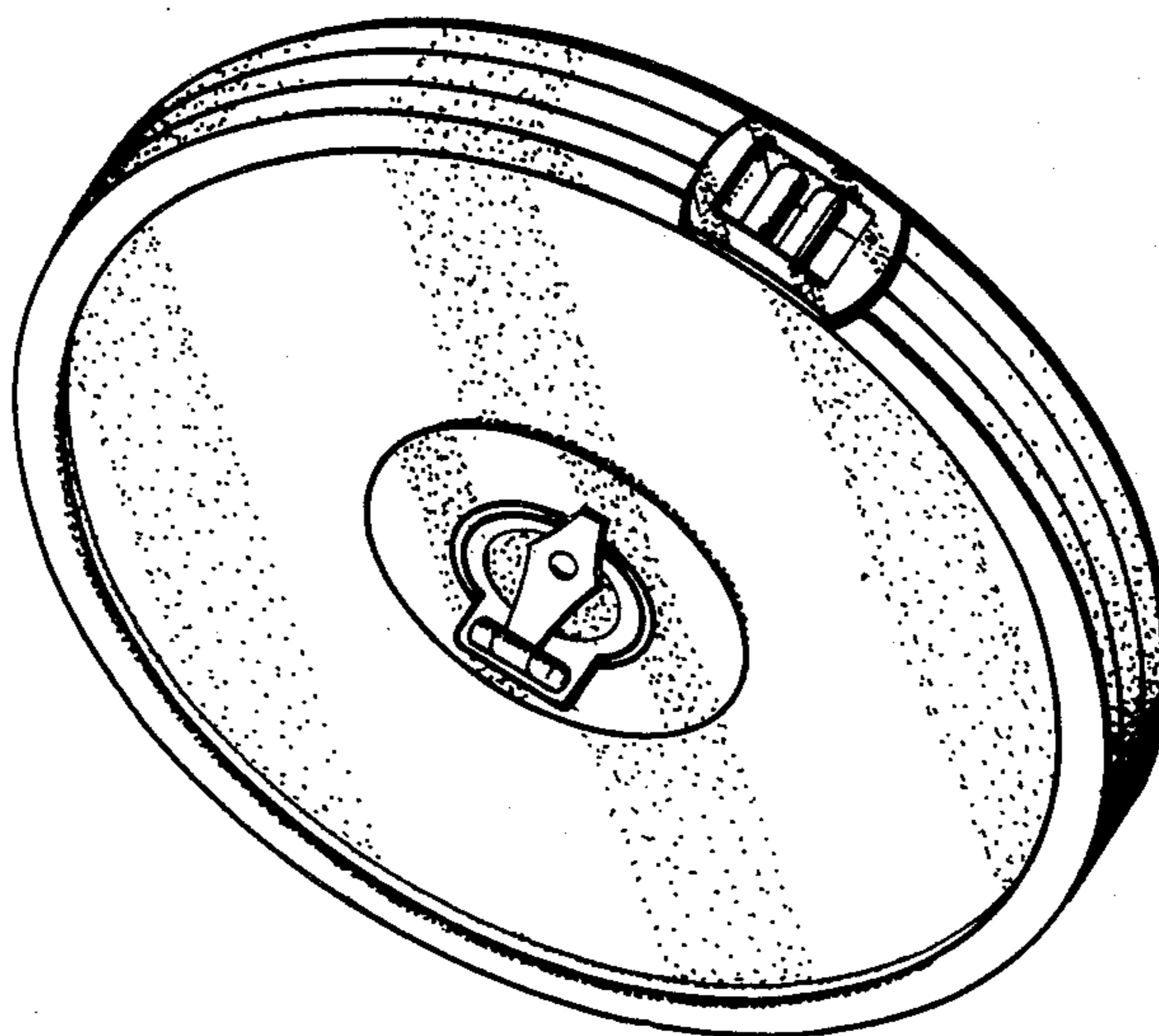

FIG. 4 is a top and front perspective view thereof.



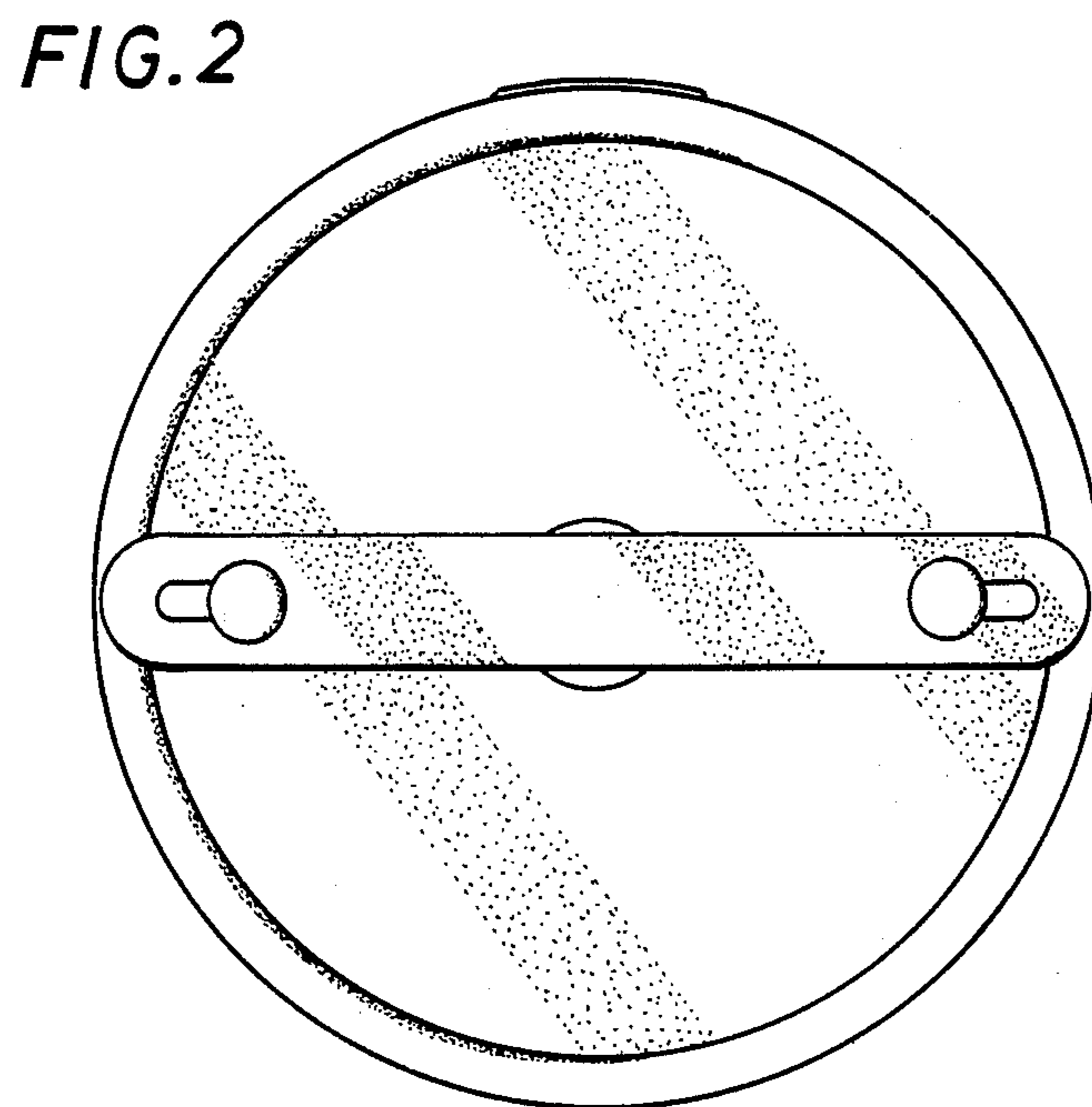
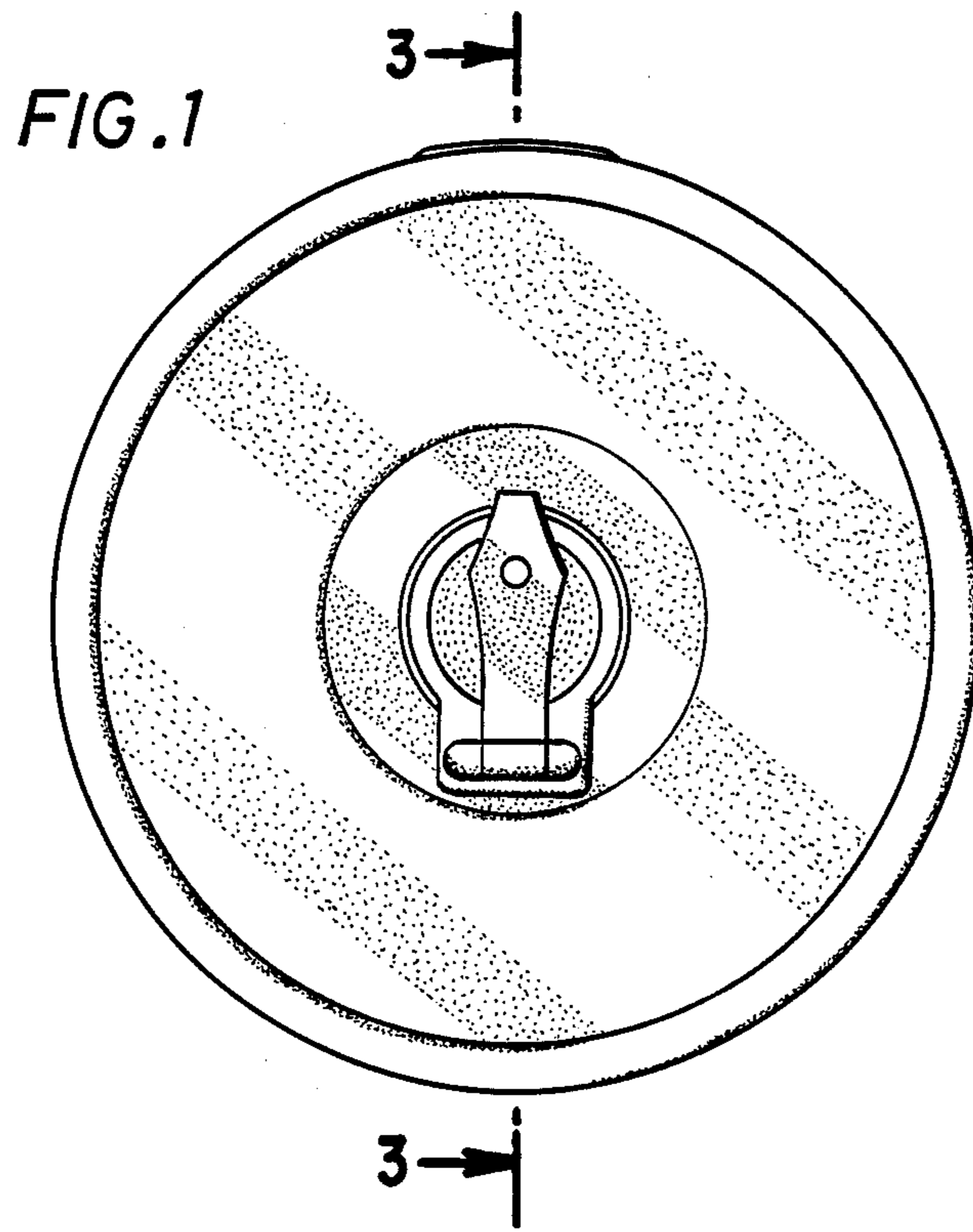

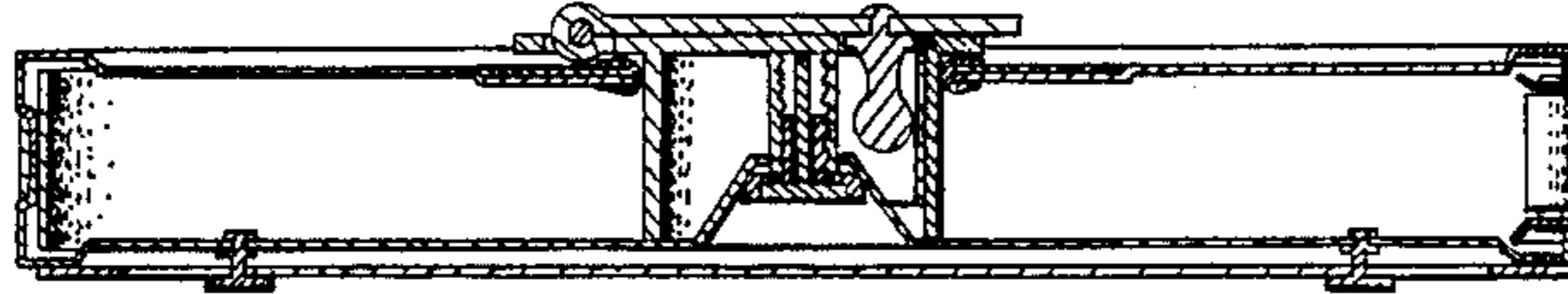
