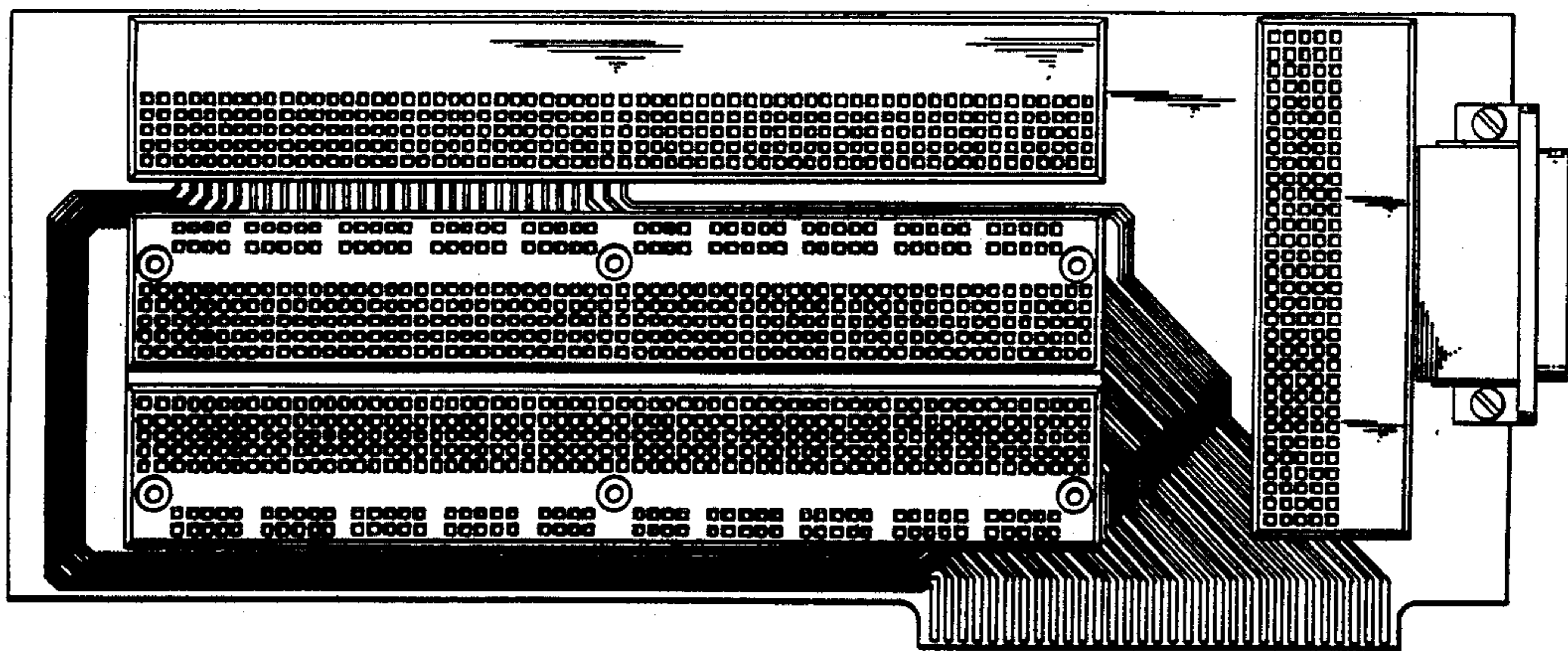

The ornamental design for a breadboarding card for a personal computer, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a breadboarding card for a personal computer showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof.



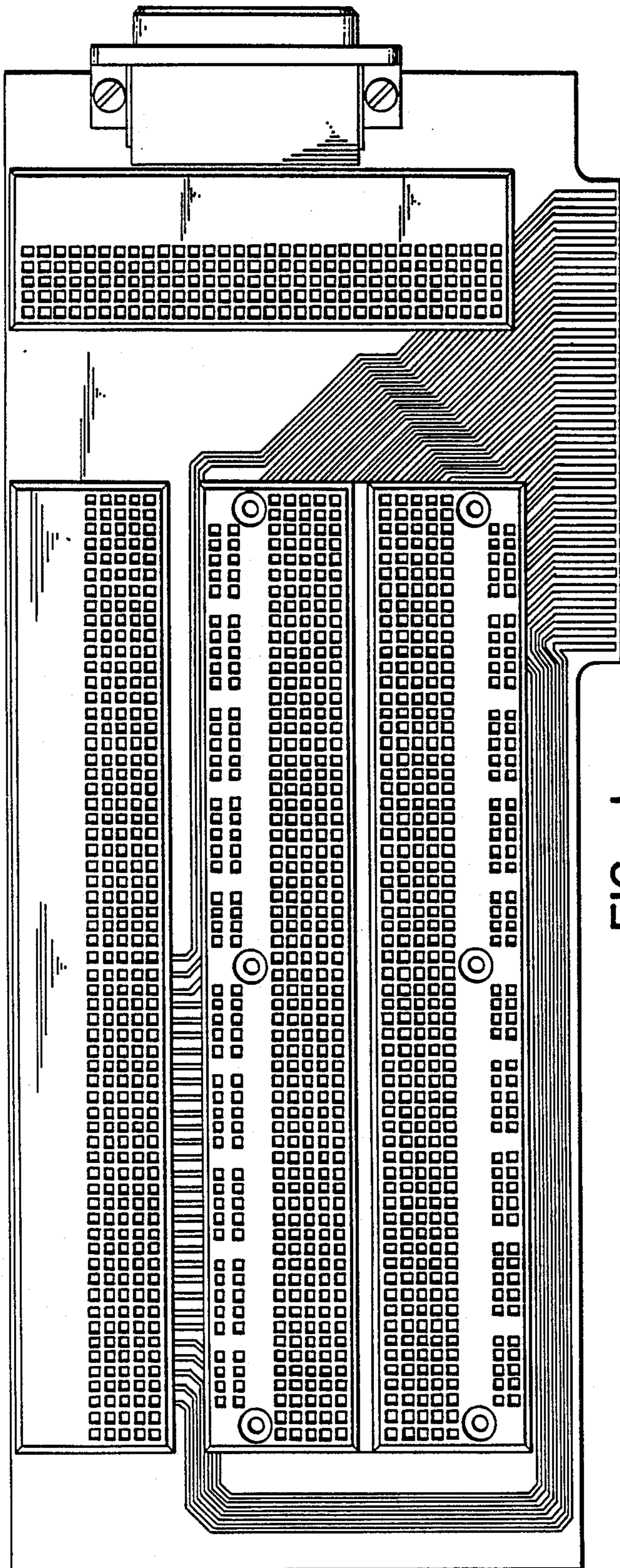

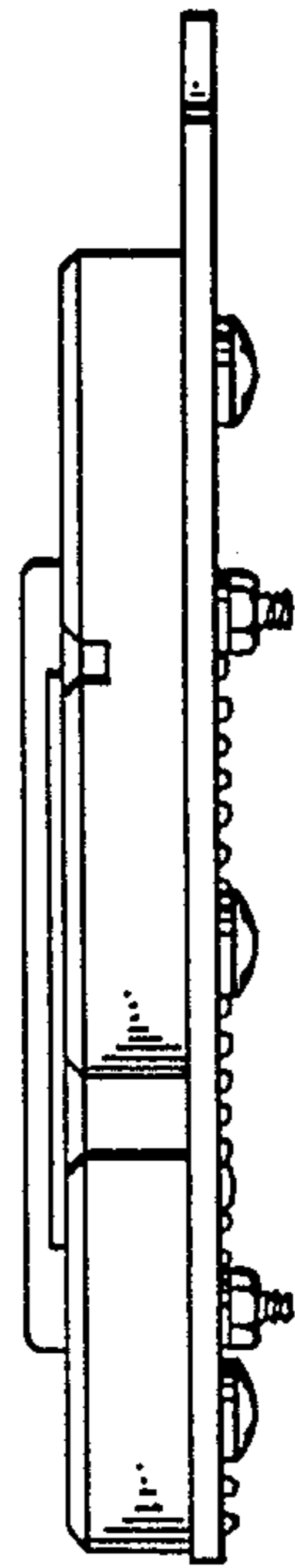

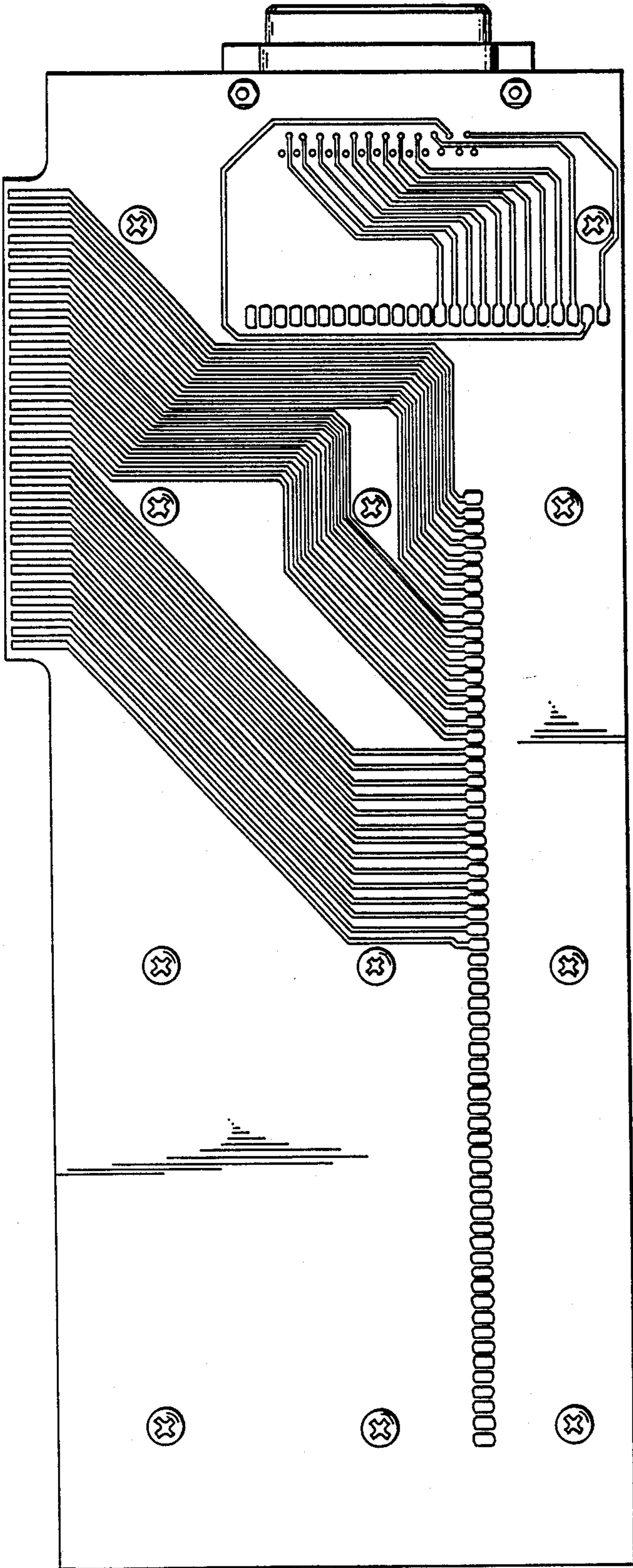

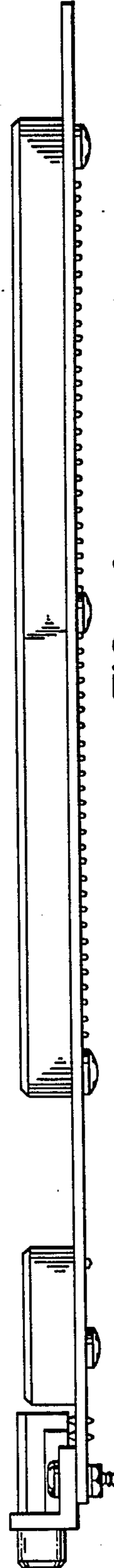

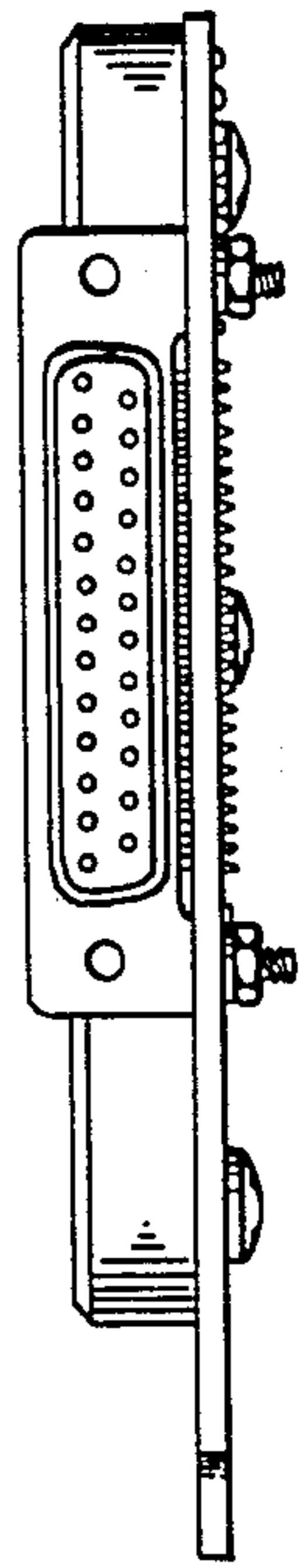
