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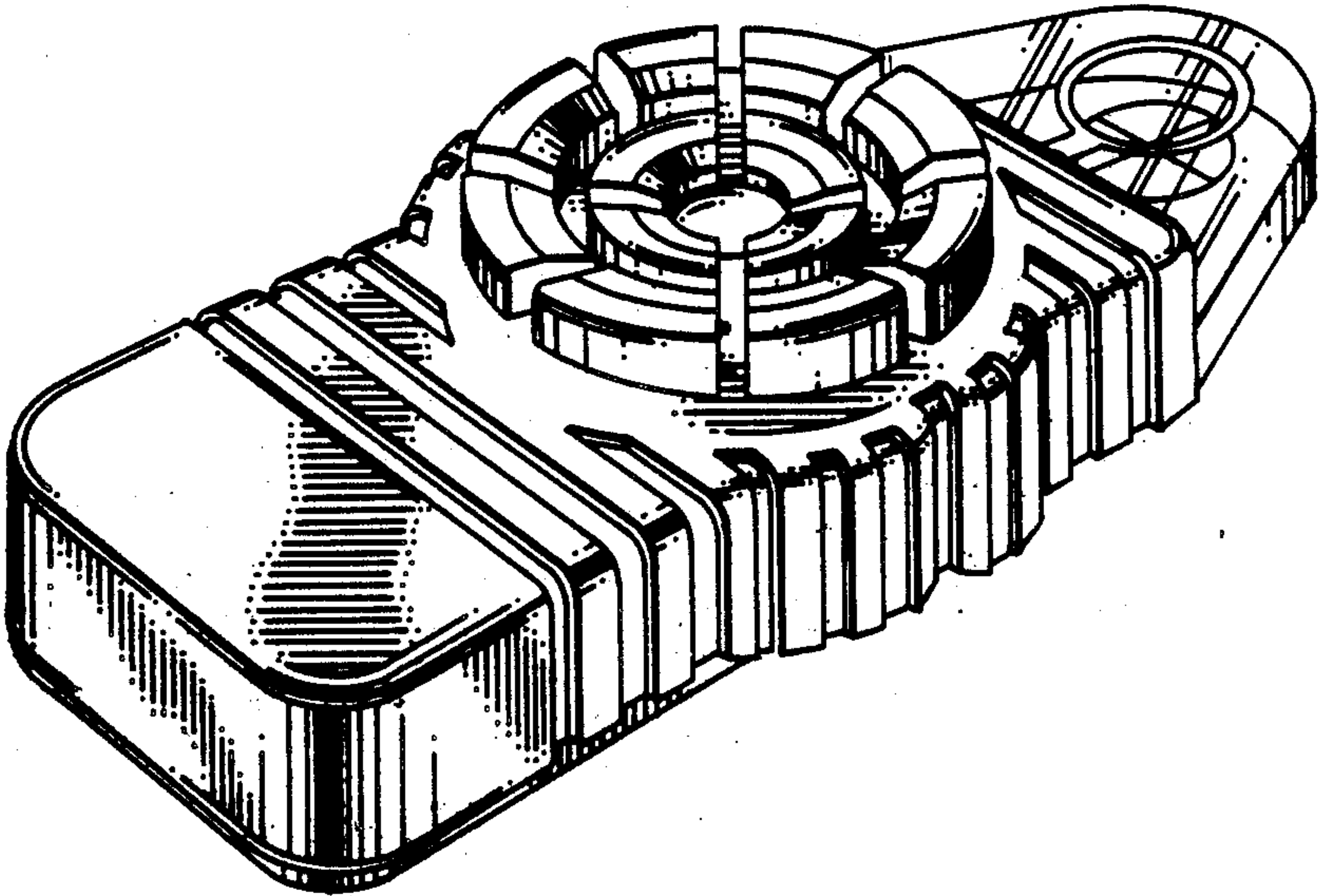
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[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right, rear, top perspective view of a cursor on an enlarged scale showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left elevational view thereof, the right elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a right, rear, top perspective view of a second embodiment of our new design on an enlarged scale;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a left elevational view thereof, the right elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 9 is a front elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view thereof.



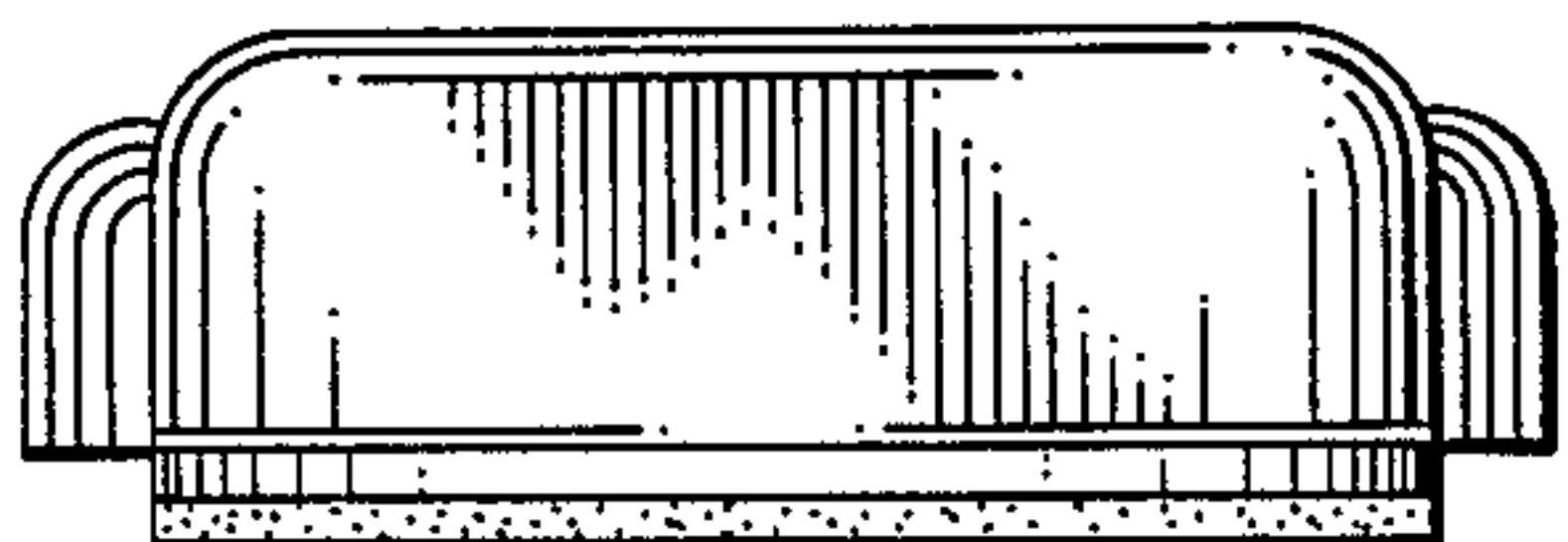
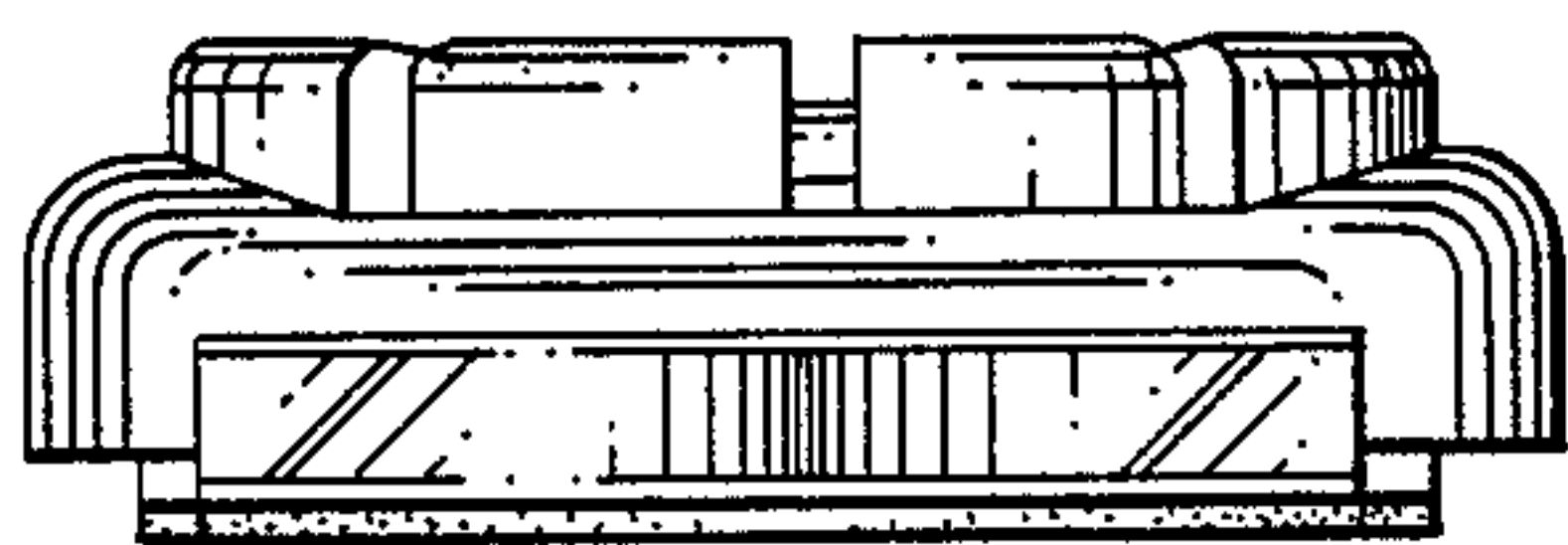
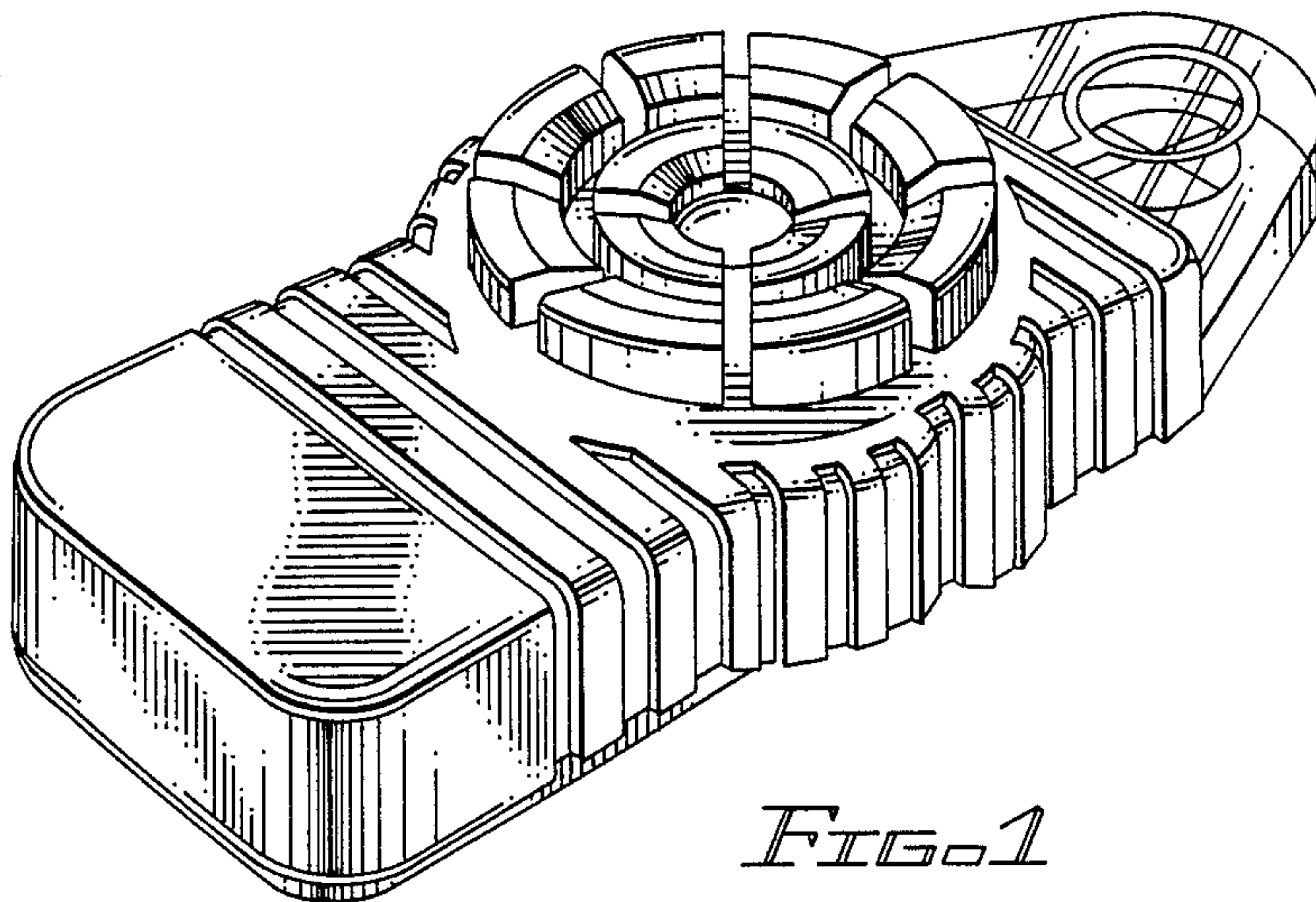

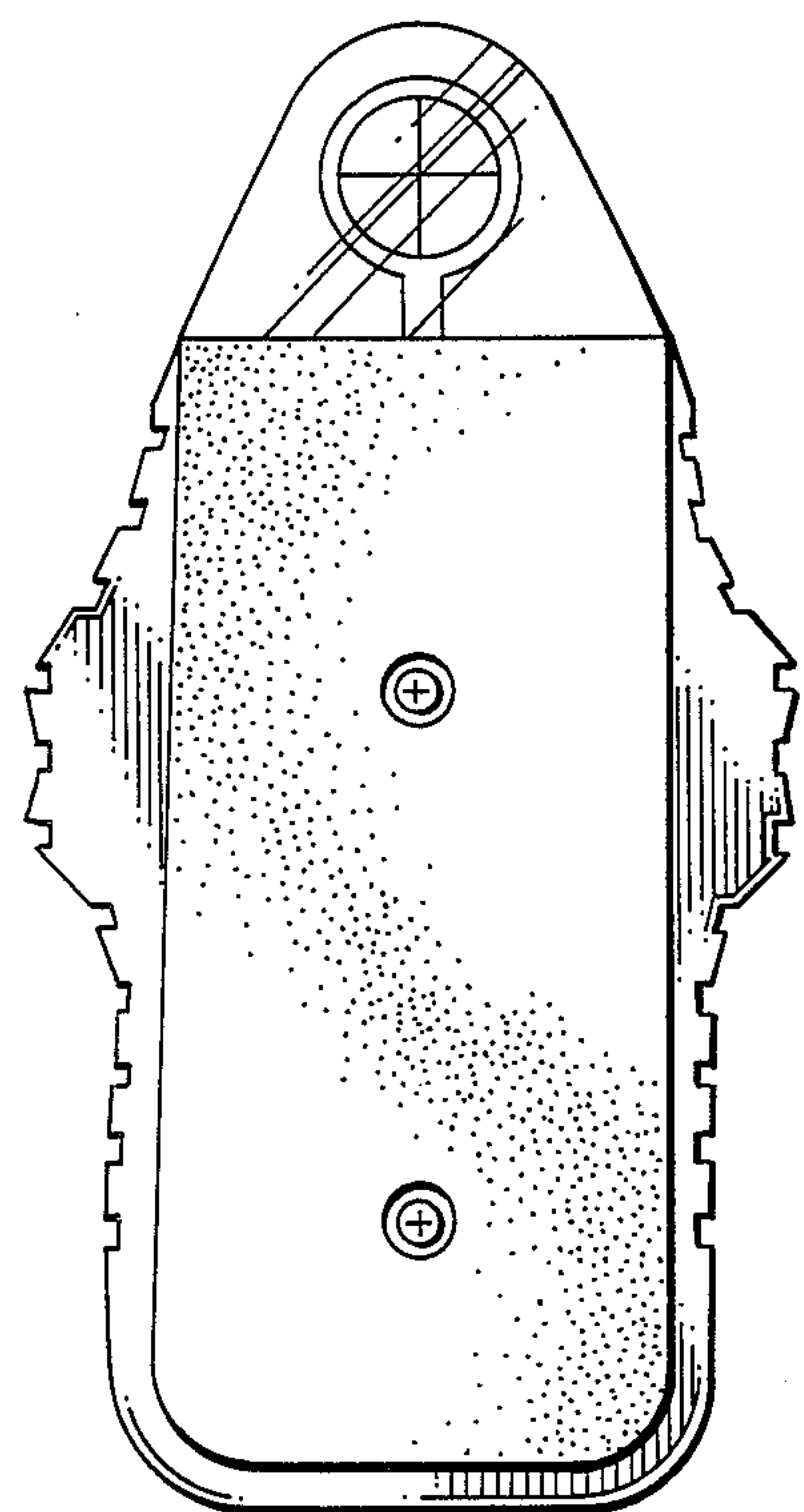

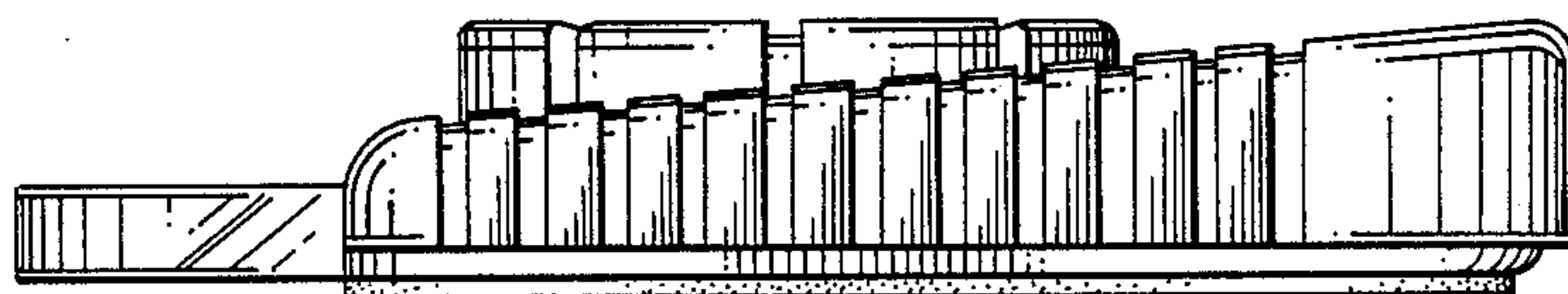

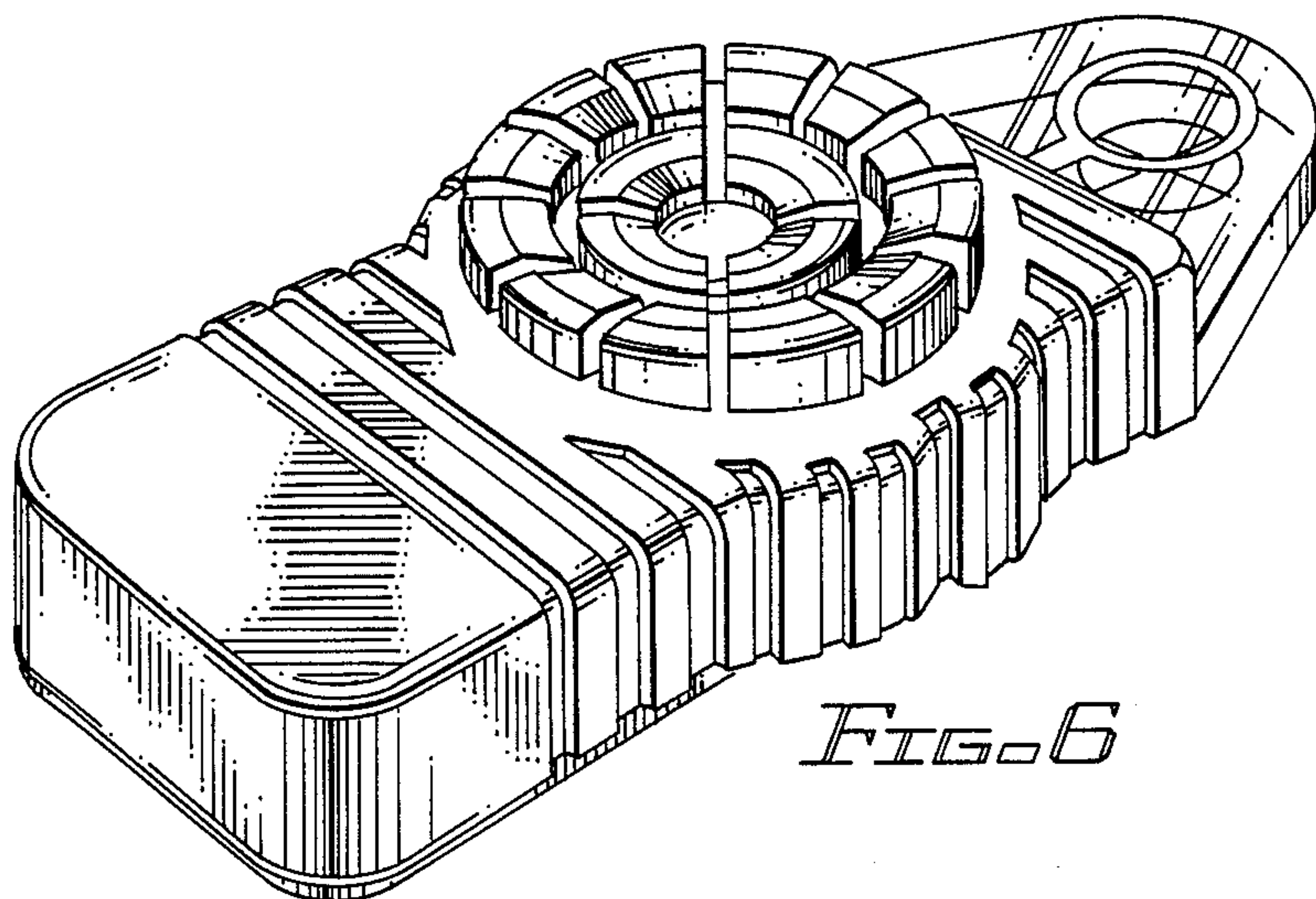

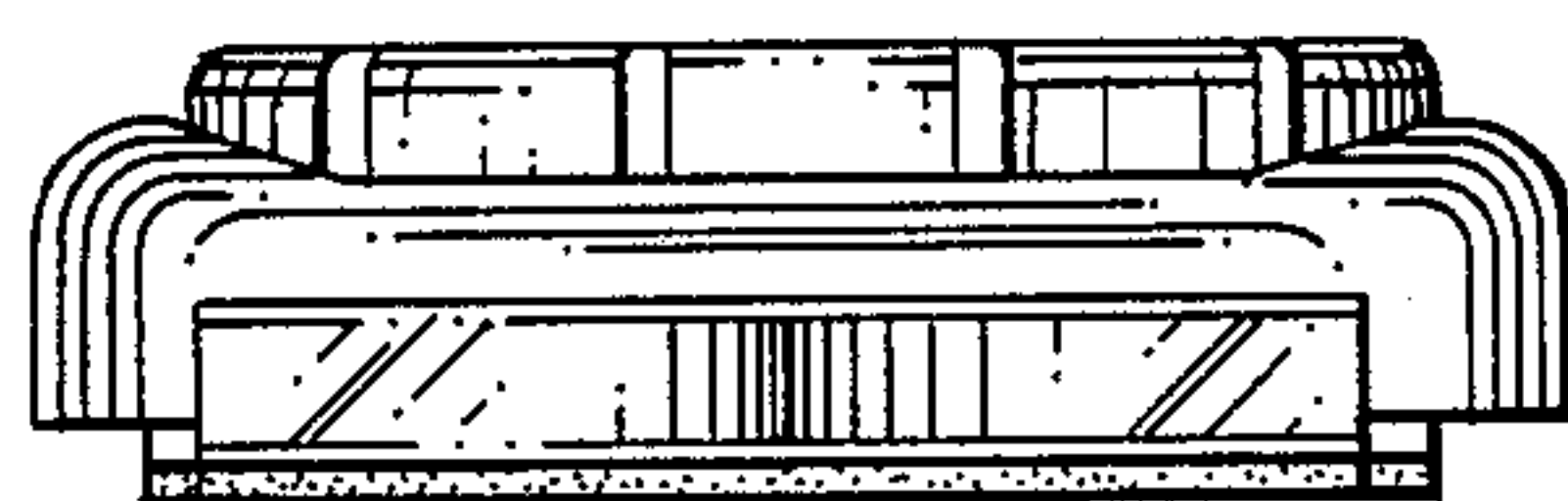

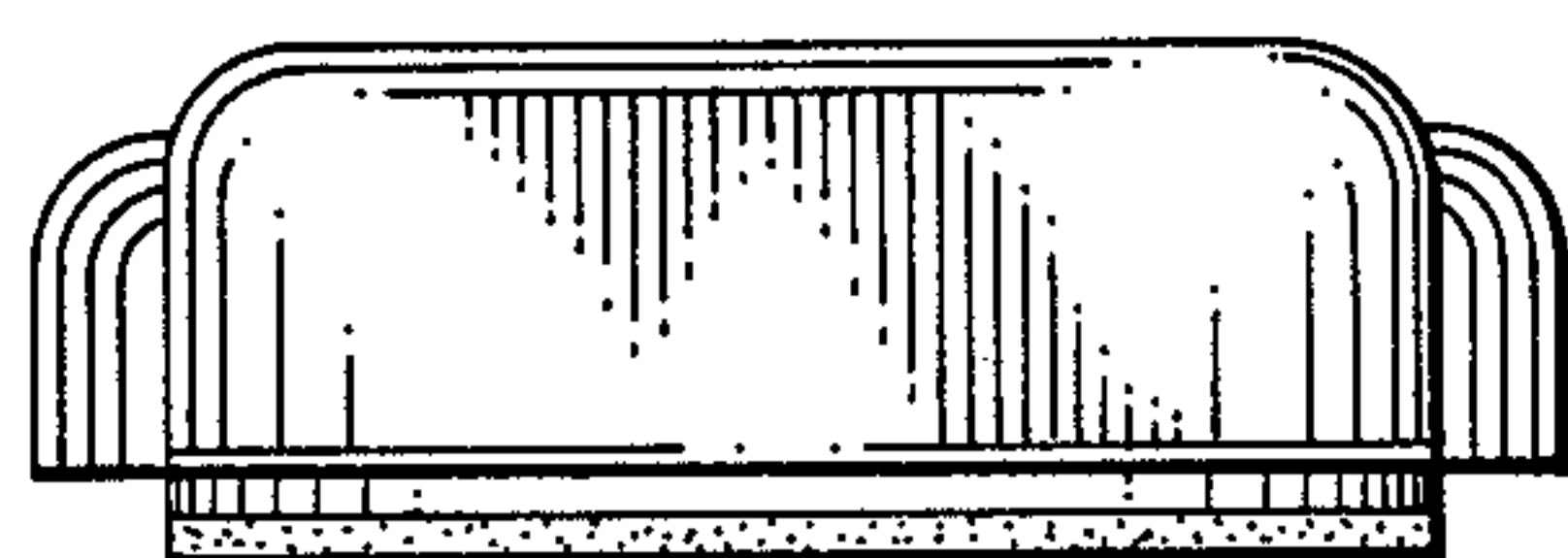

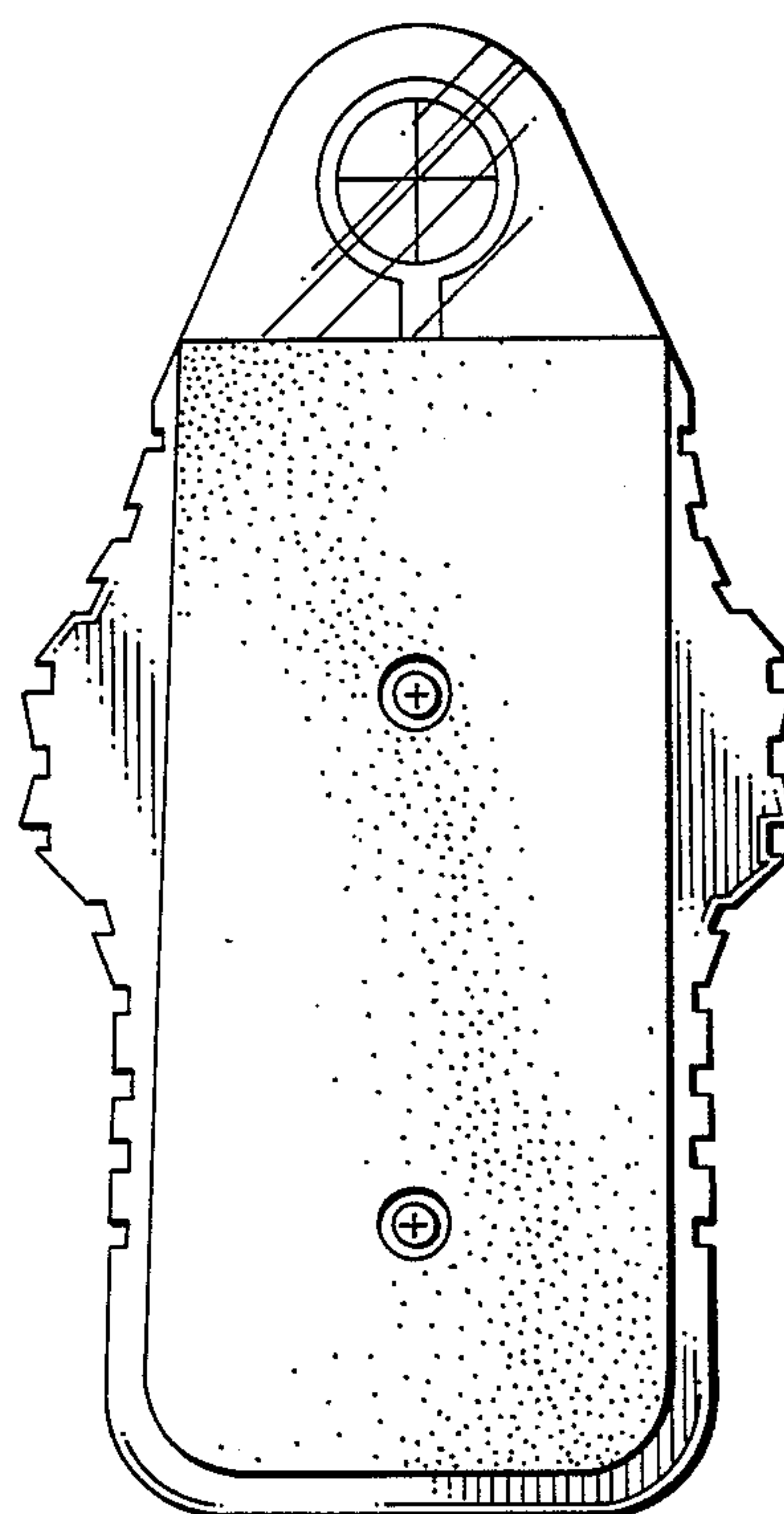
