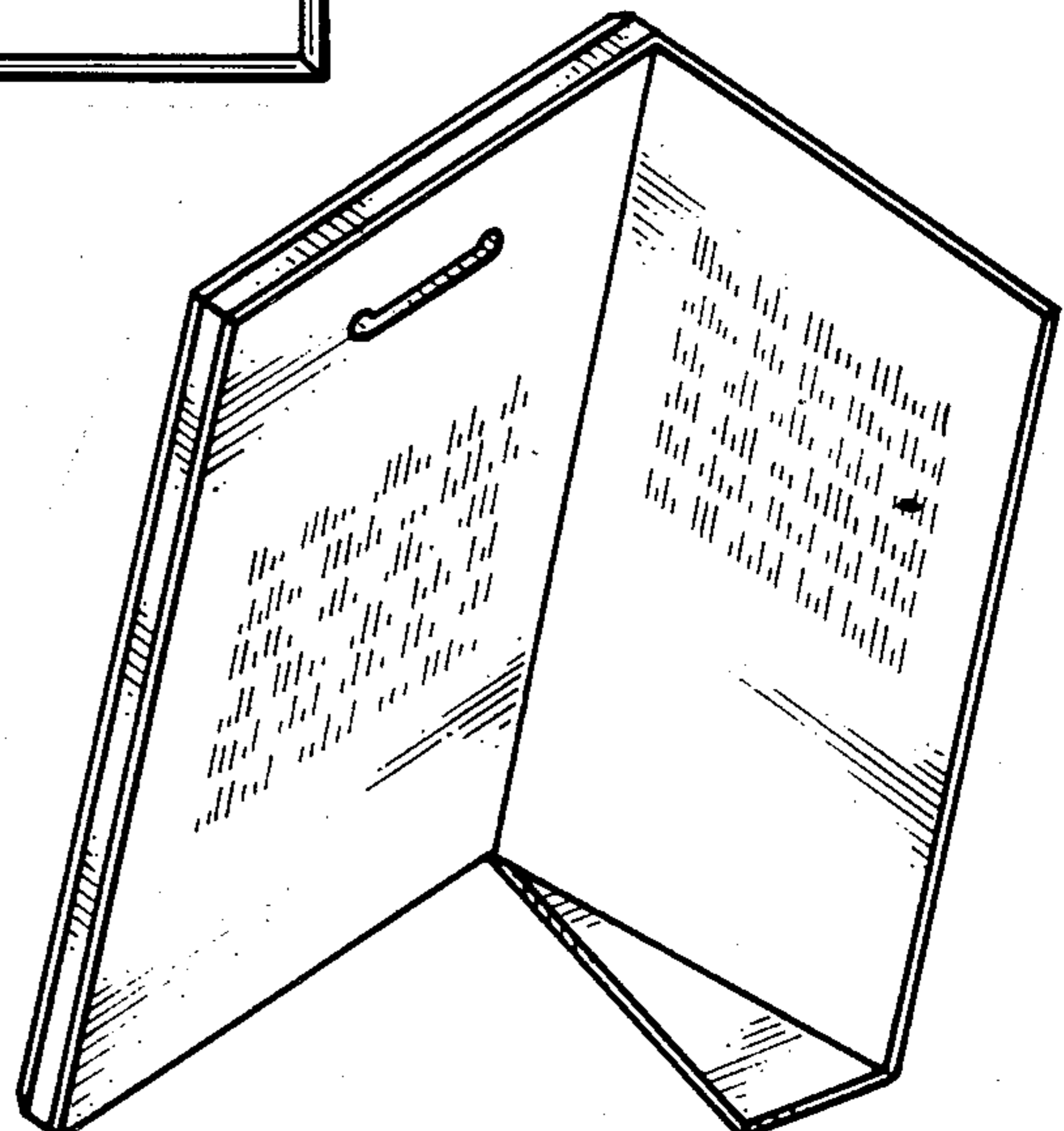
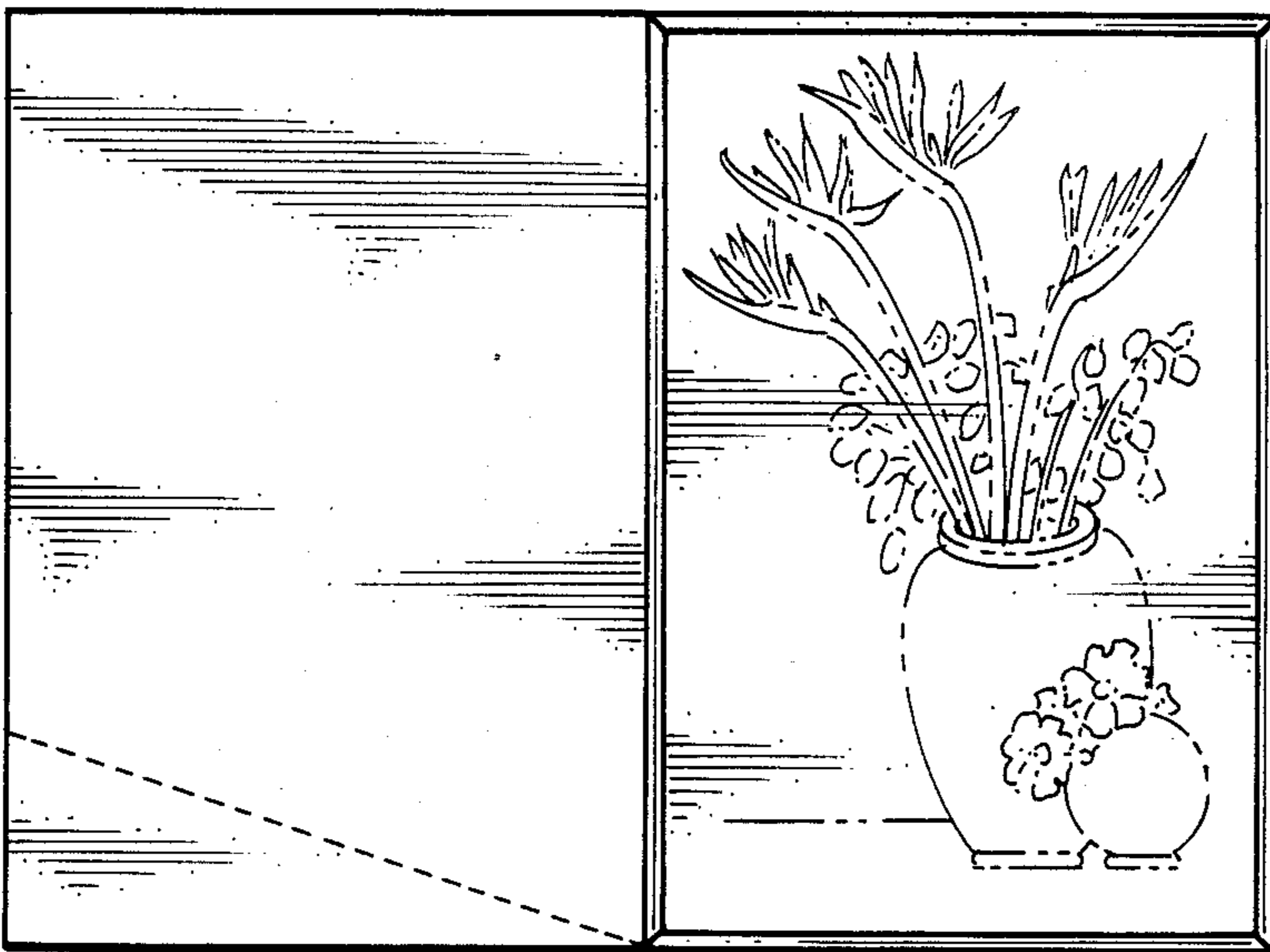
The ornamental design for a combined picture greeting card and display means, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined greeting card and display means showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view; FIG. 5 is a top plan view; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view; and FIG. 7 is an interior perspective view of my design in a partially opened condition.

The indicia and floral design depicted in broken lines in FIGS. 1, 3 and 7 are shown for illustrative purposes only.

The broken lines in FIGS. 1 and 3 have been employed to depict scored fold lines.



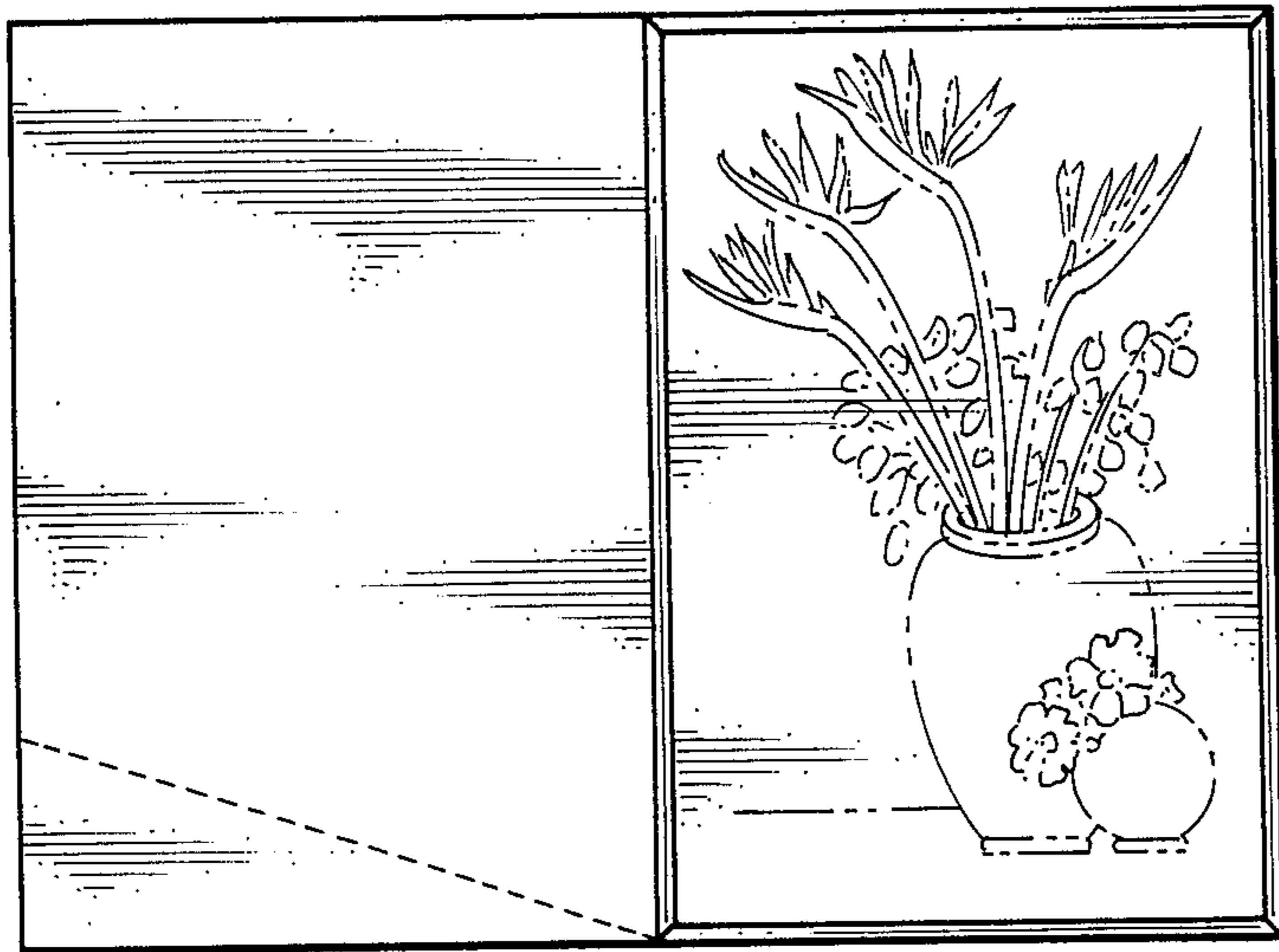

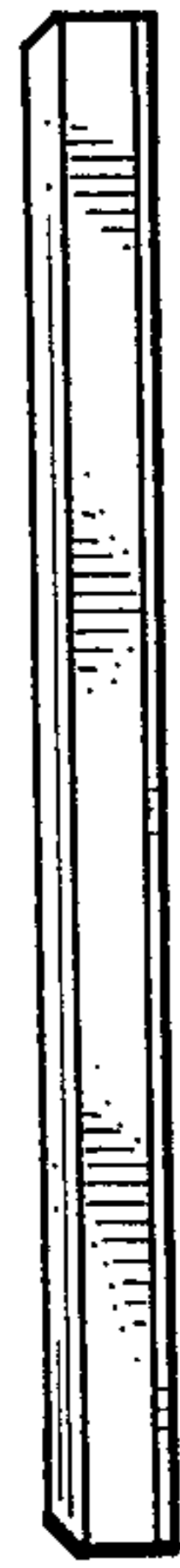

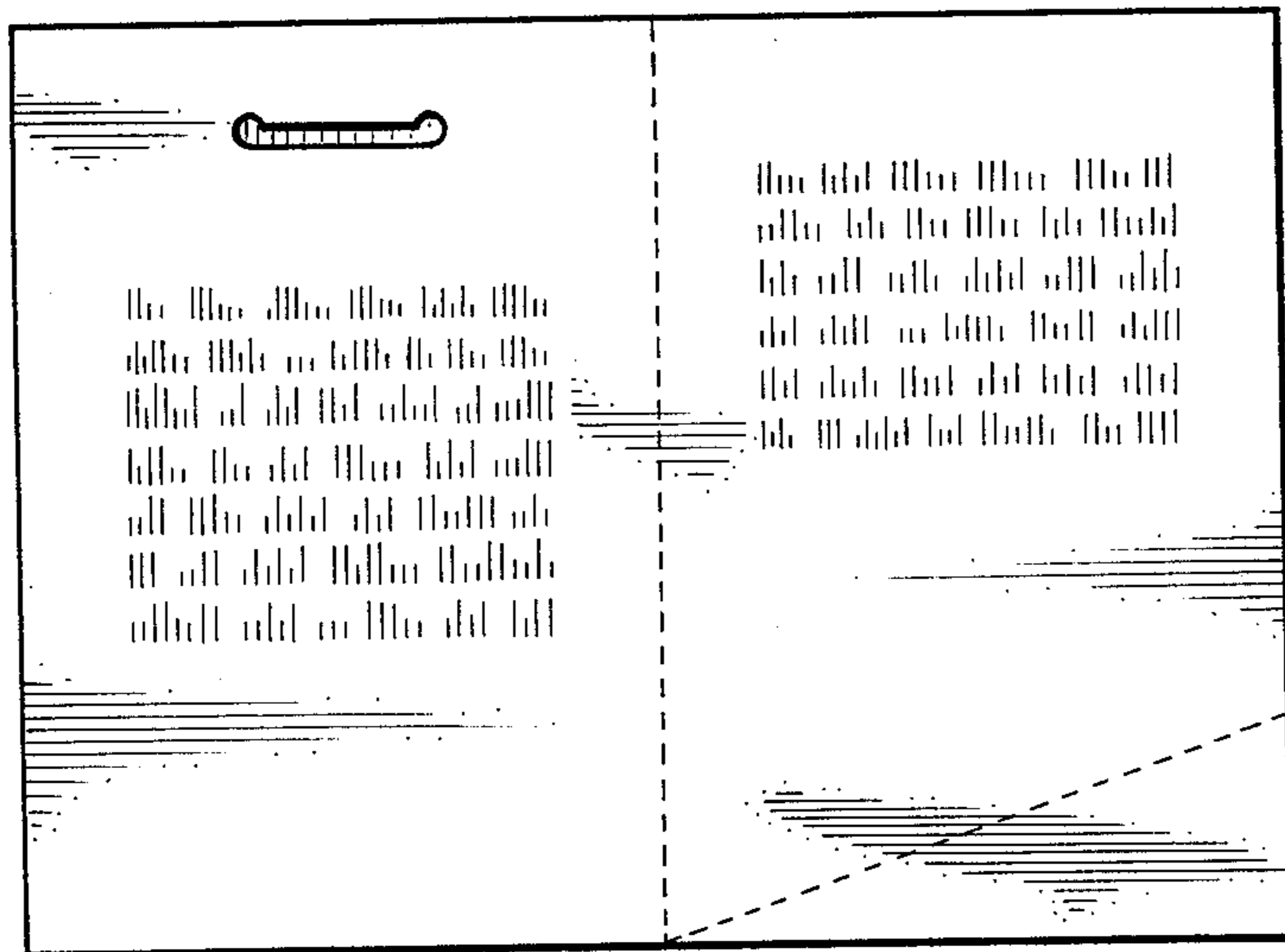
