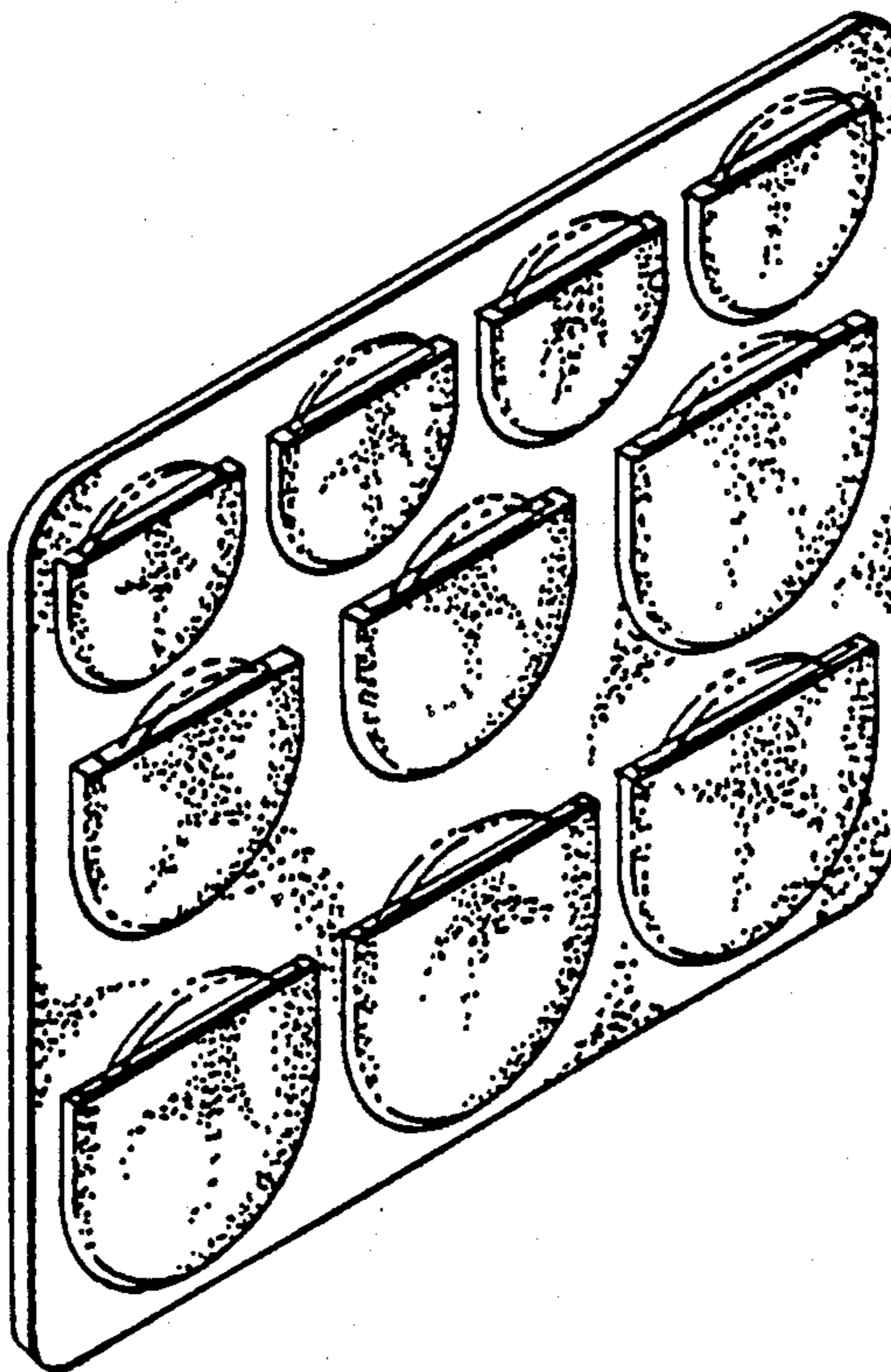
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a coin organizer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a coin organizer showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof.

The broken line showing of the coins in FIGS. 1 and 2 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



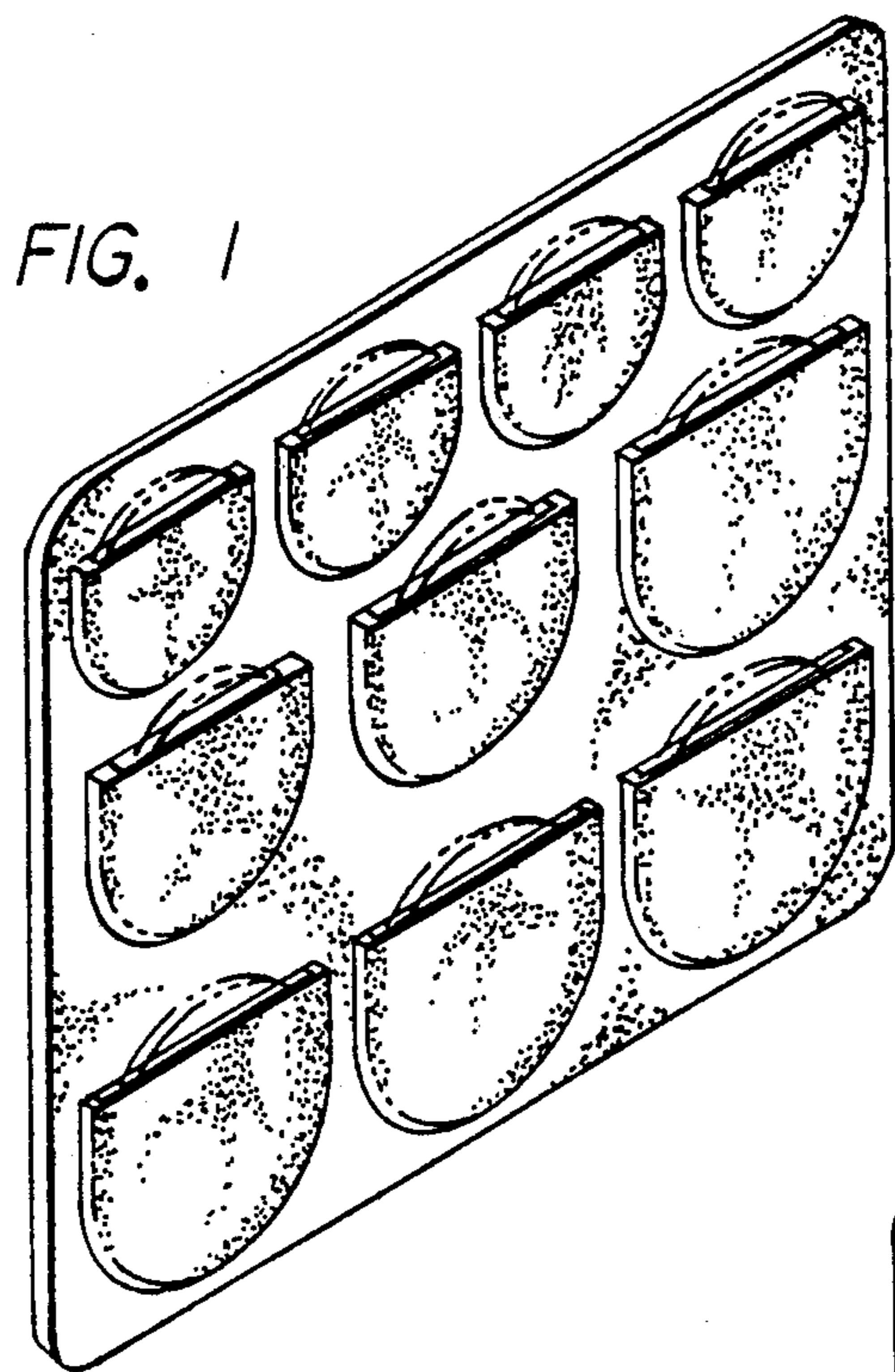

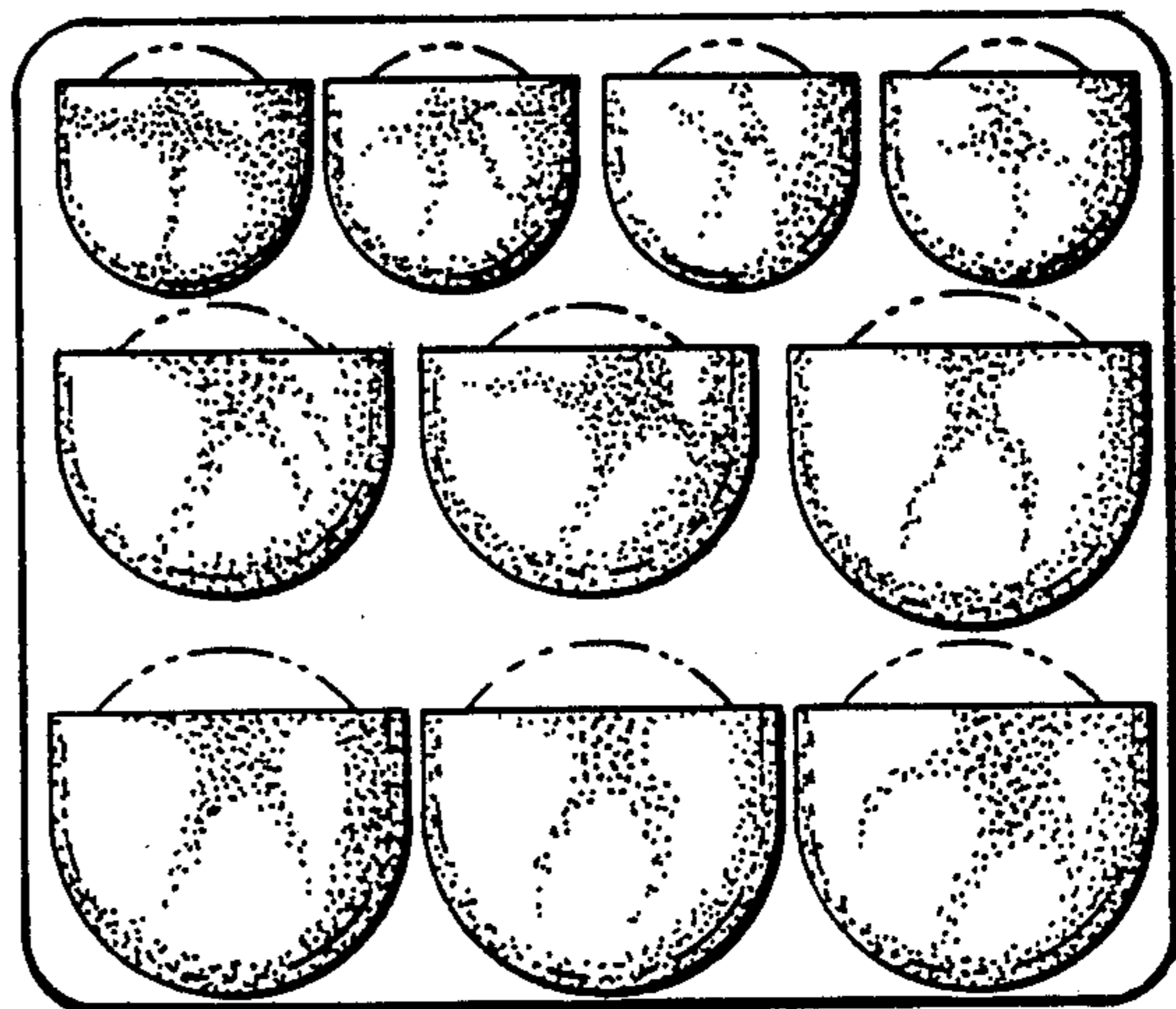

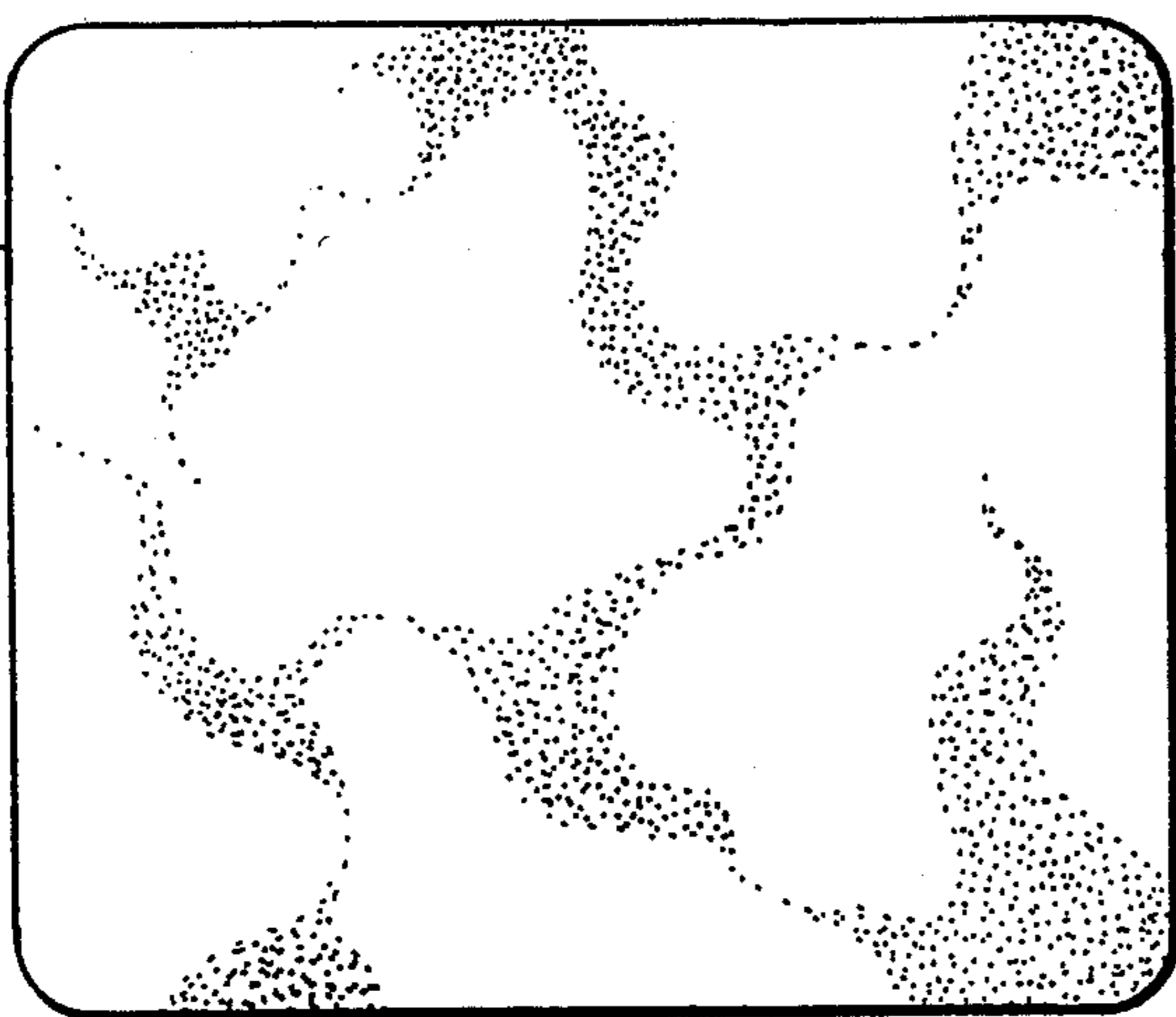

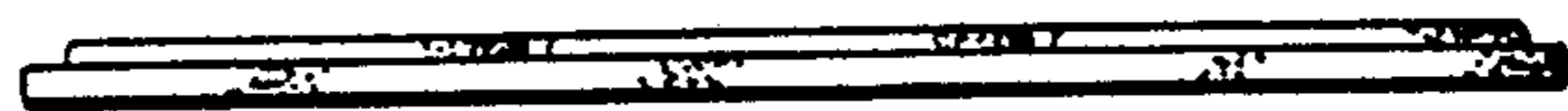
