The ornamental design for a golf course marker, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a golf course marker showing our new design with the anchor past omitted for convenience of illustration;

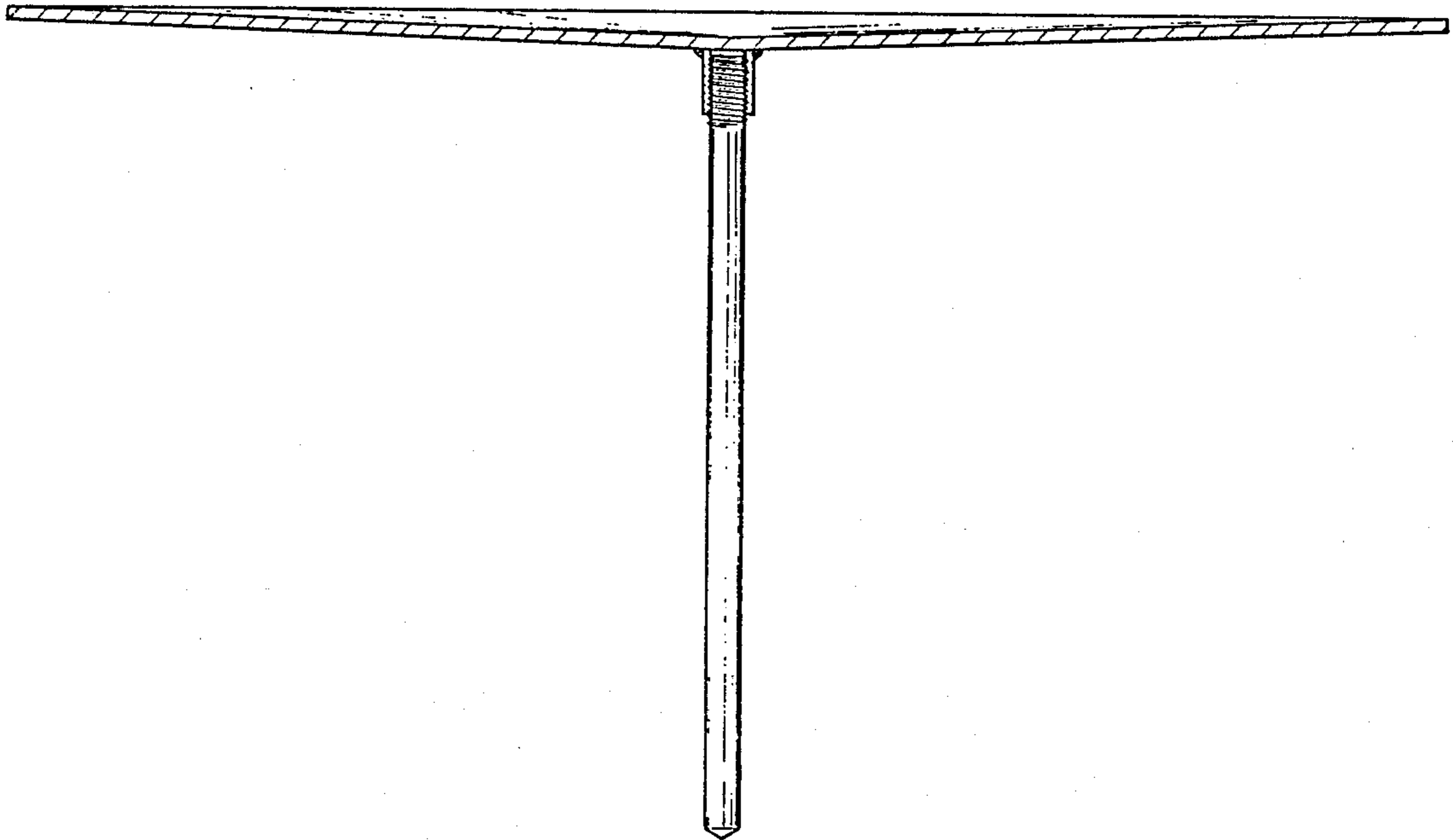
FIG. 3 is a reduced top plan view;

FIG. 2 is a sectional view taken along the lines 2-2 in FIG. 3 showing the entire marker;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of an alternate embodiment with the anchor past omitted for convenience of illustration;

FIG. 6 is a sectional view of FIG. 5 taken along the lines 6-6 in FIG. 7 showing the entire alternate embodiment marker;

FIG. 7 is a reduced top plan view of FIGS. 5 and 6; and FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.



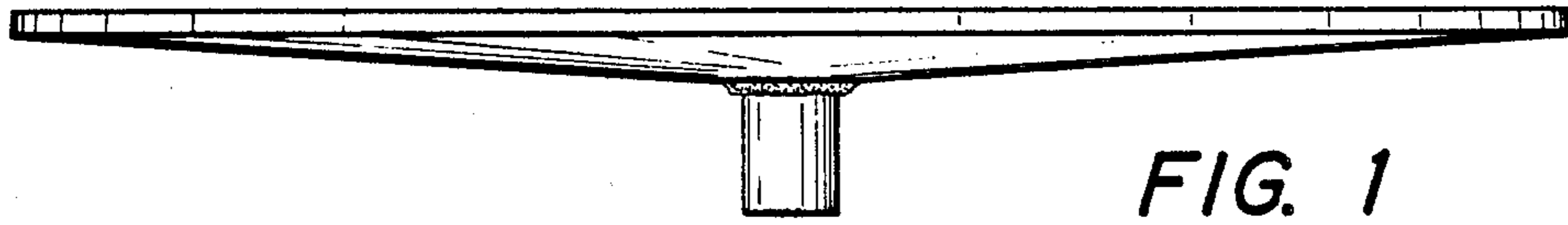

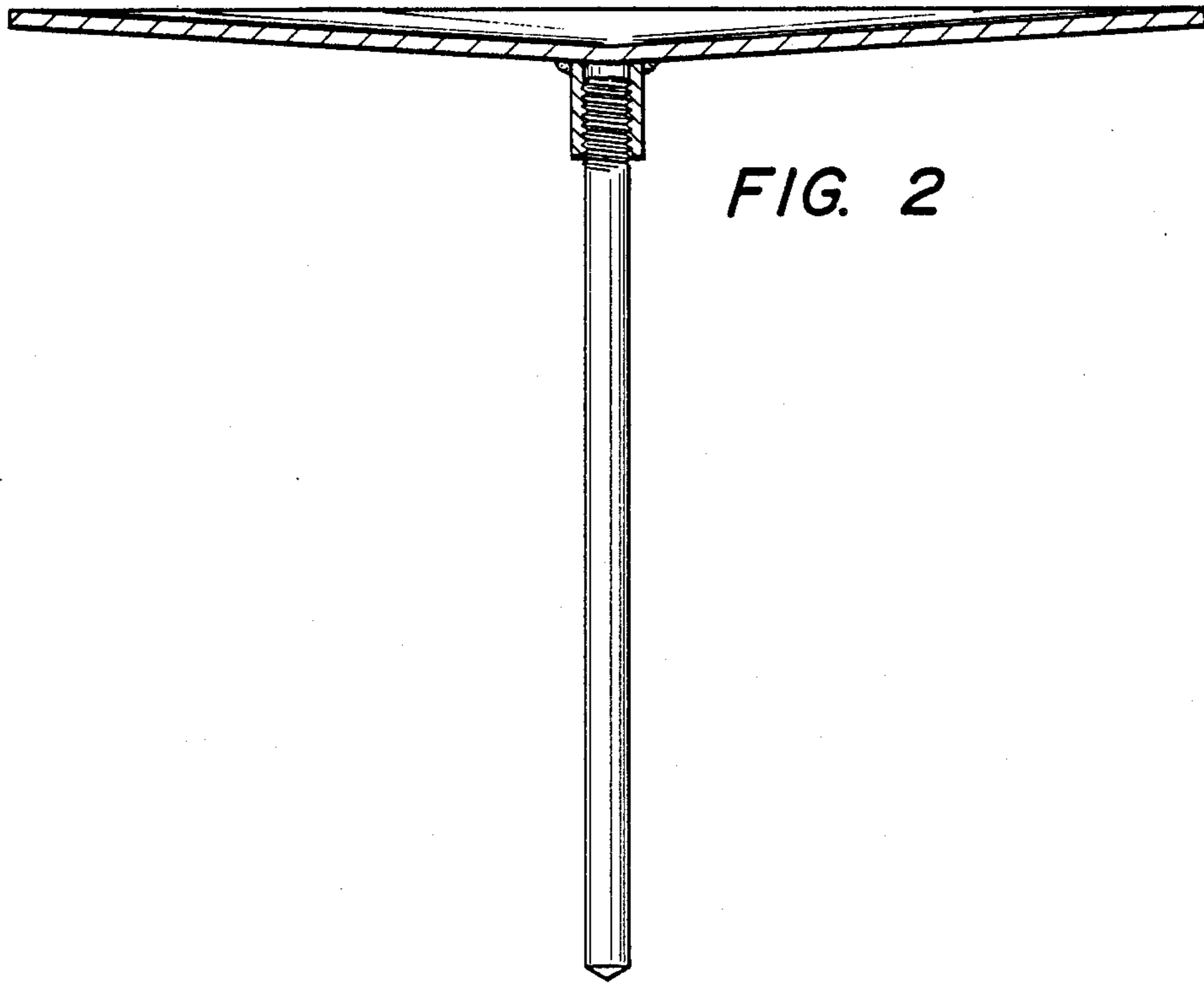

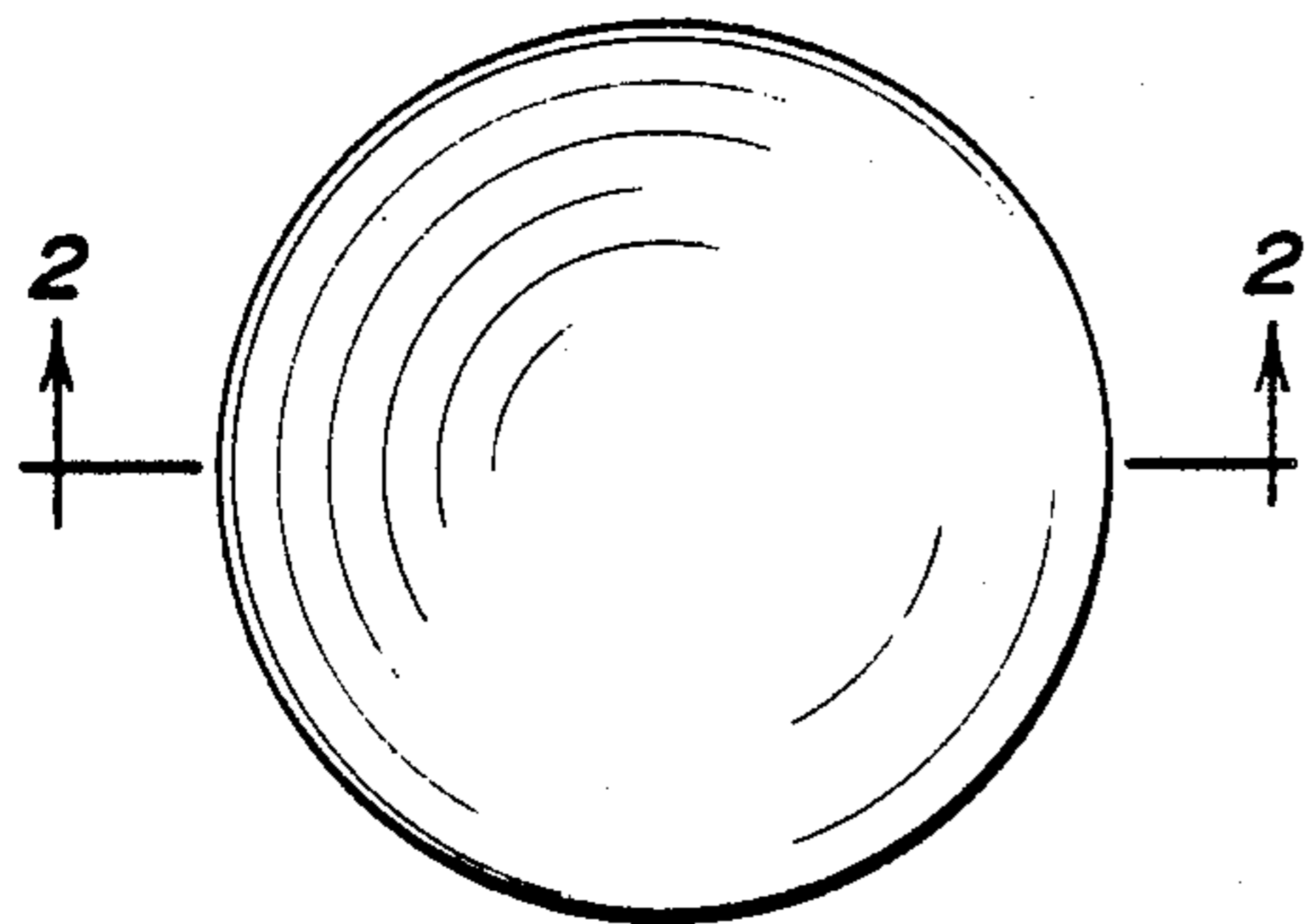

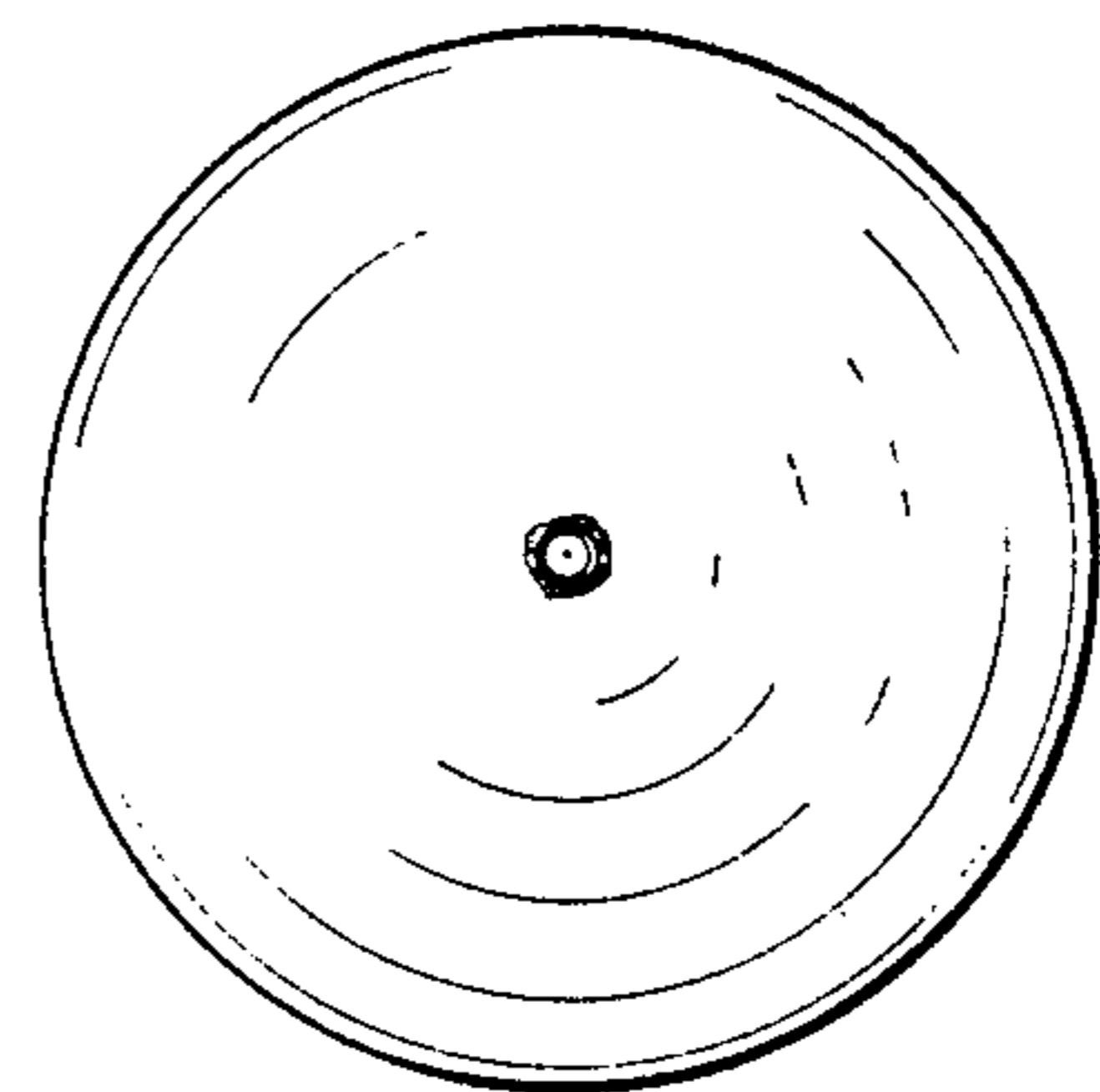

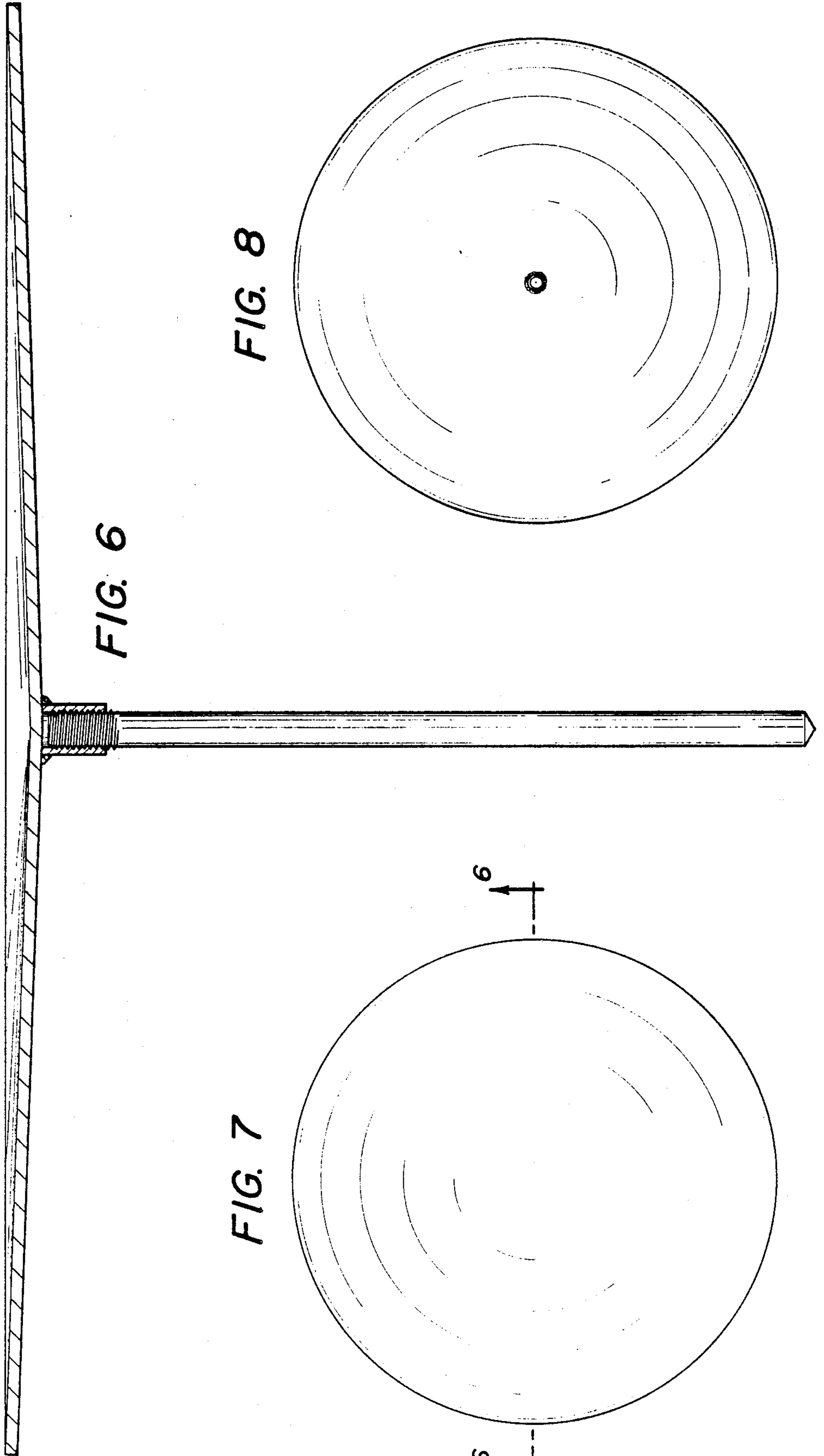
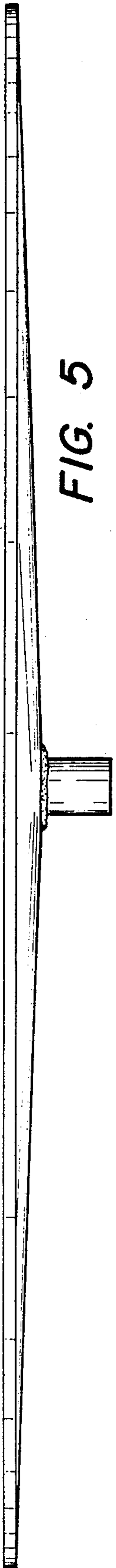

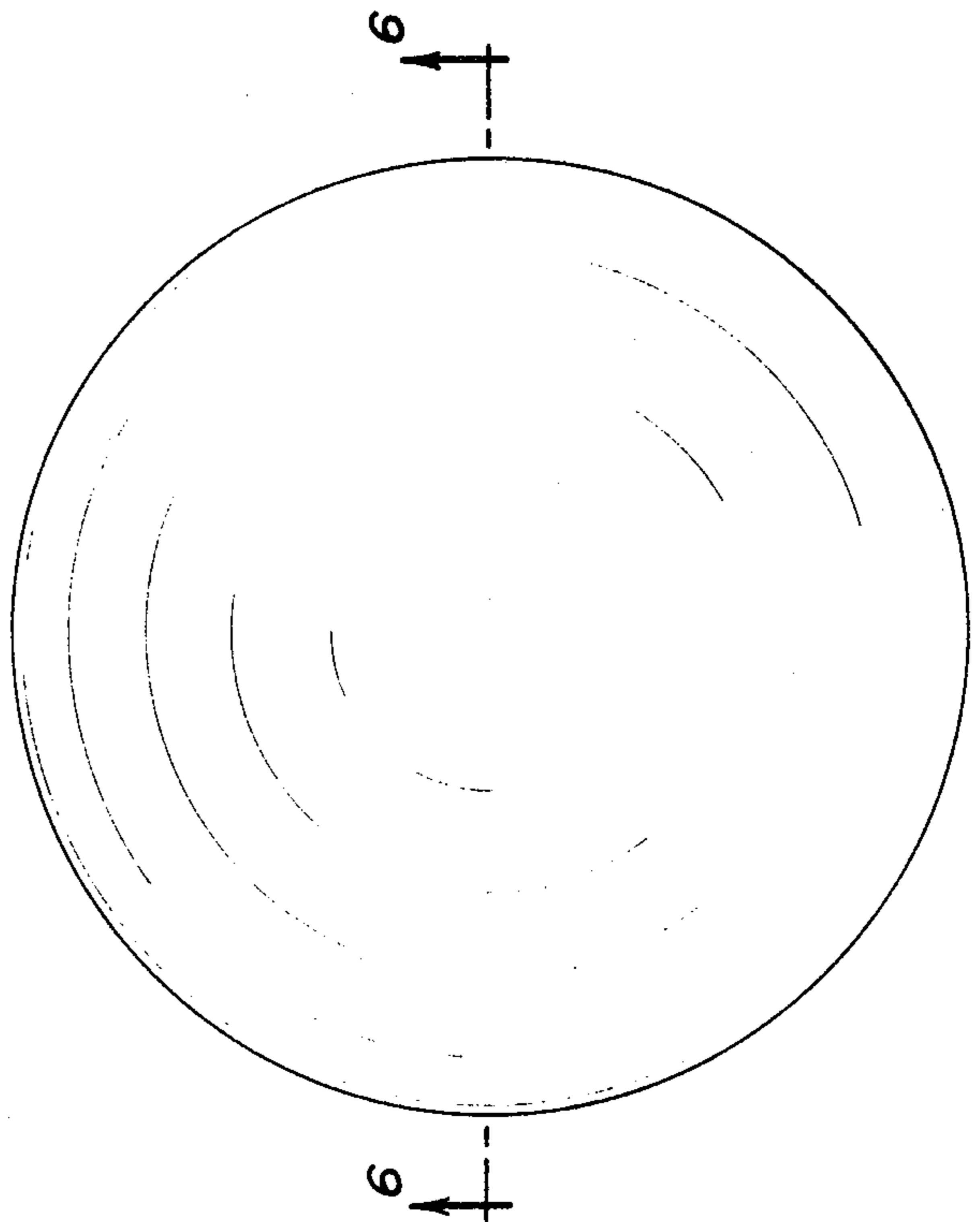
