[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a foldable footpeg for bicycles, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a foldable footpeg for bicycles showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The broken line showing of a bicycle yoke in FIGS. 2 and 3 together with fastening means in FIG. 3 is for illustrative purposes and forms no part of the claimed design.

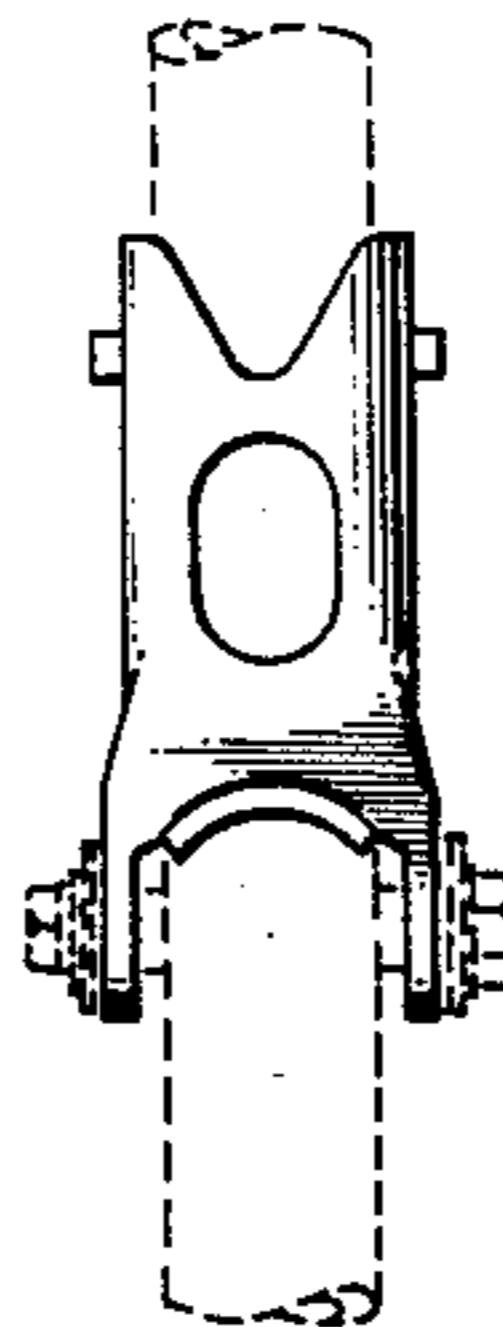

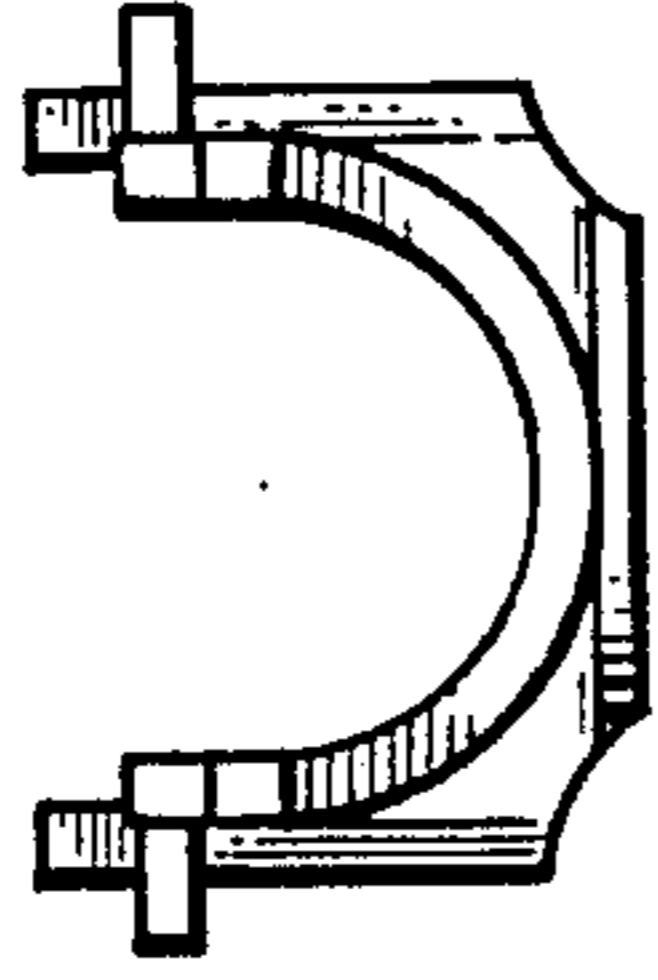

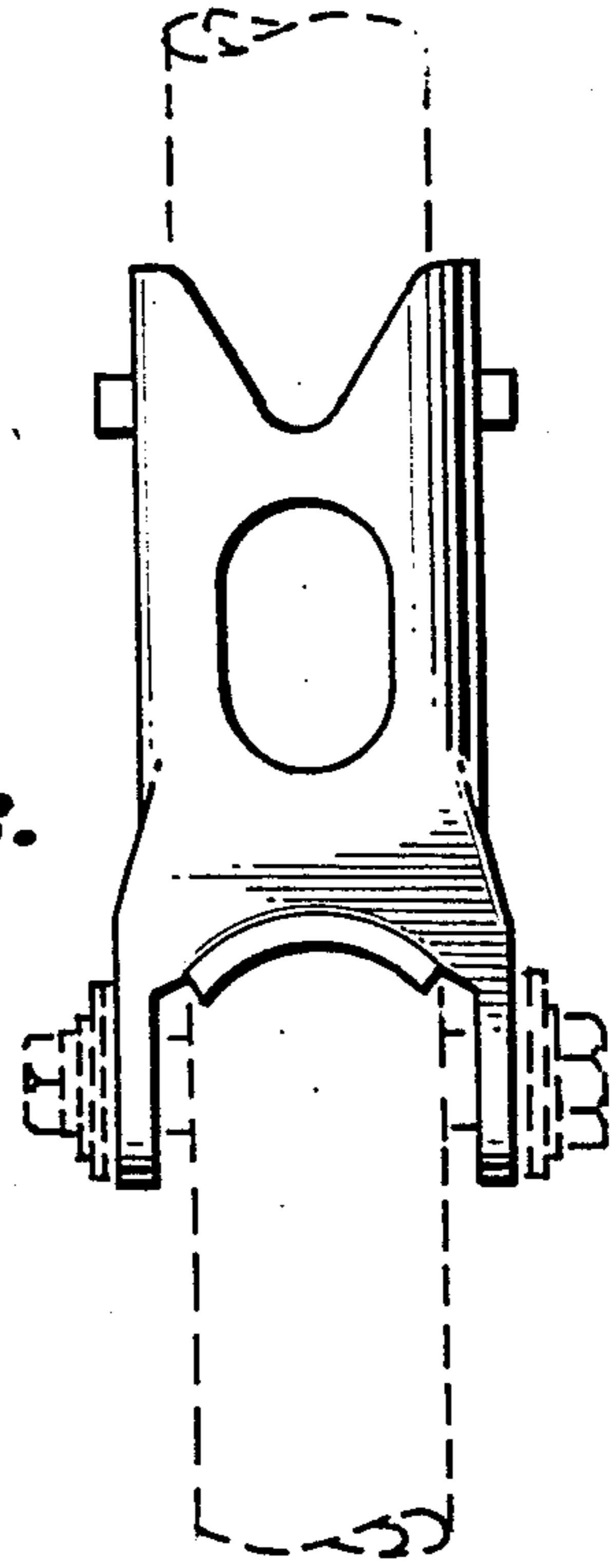

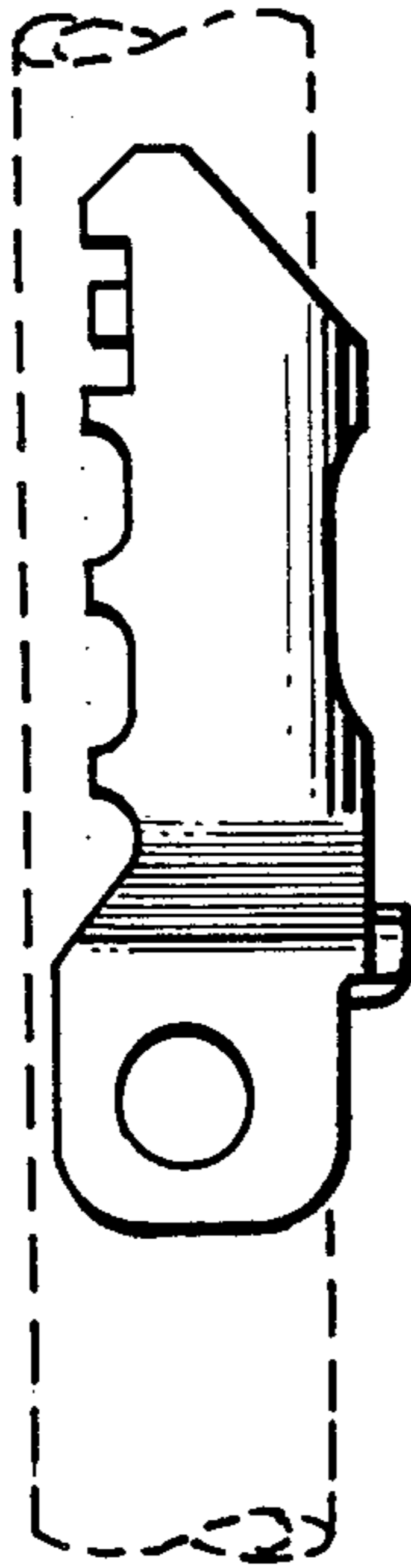

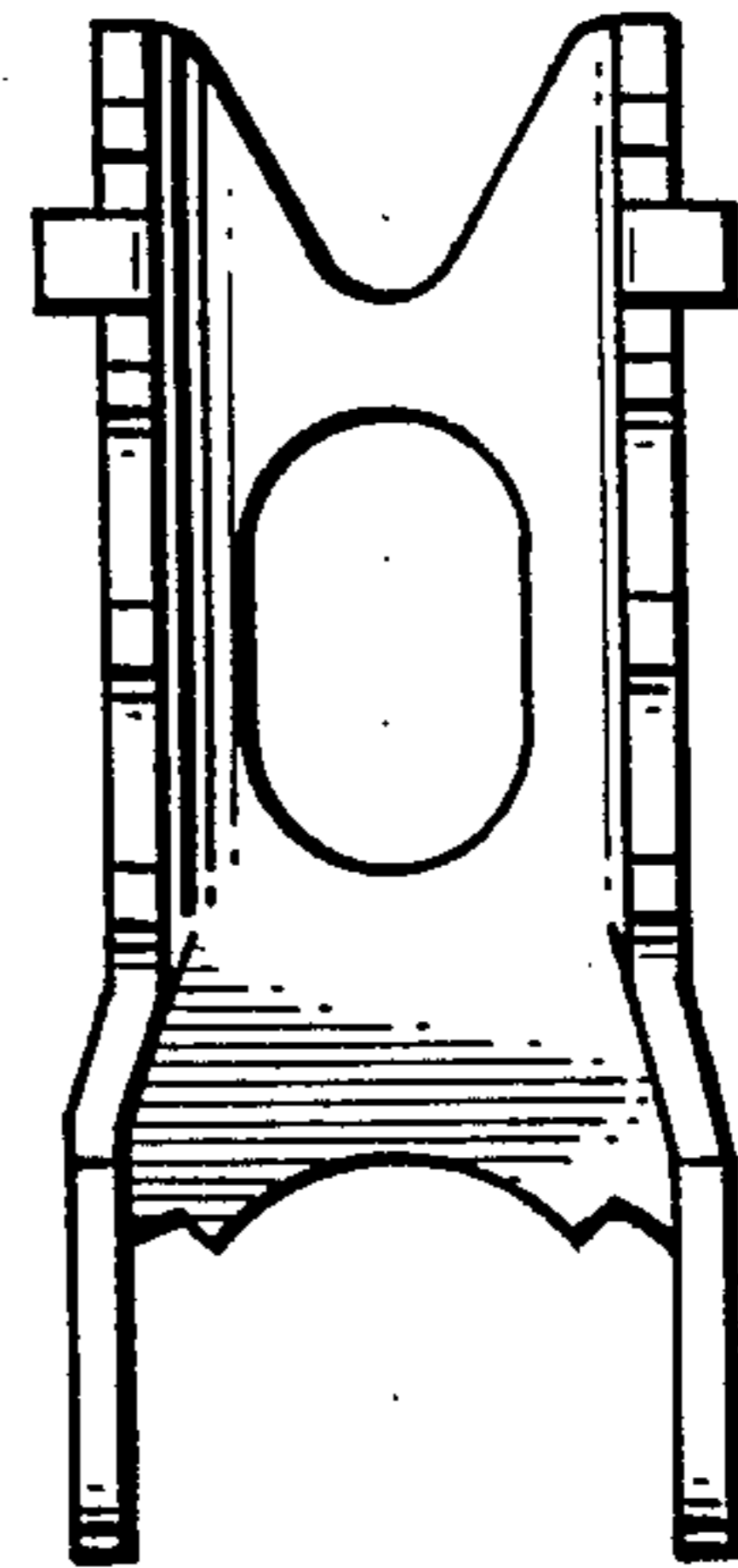
