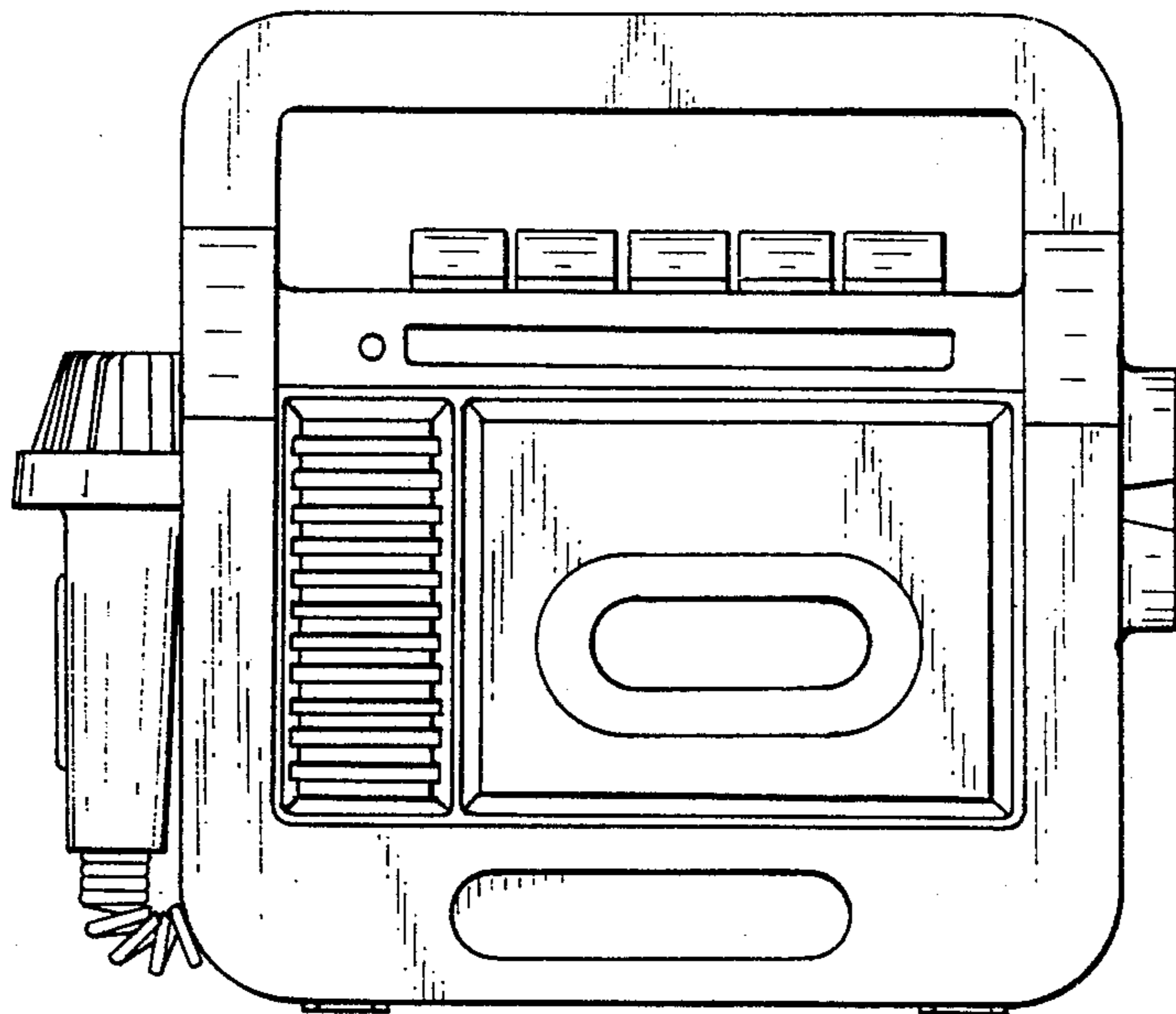

FIG. 6 is a right-side elevational view.



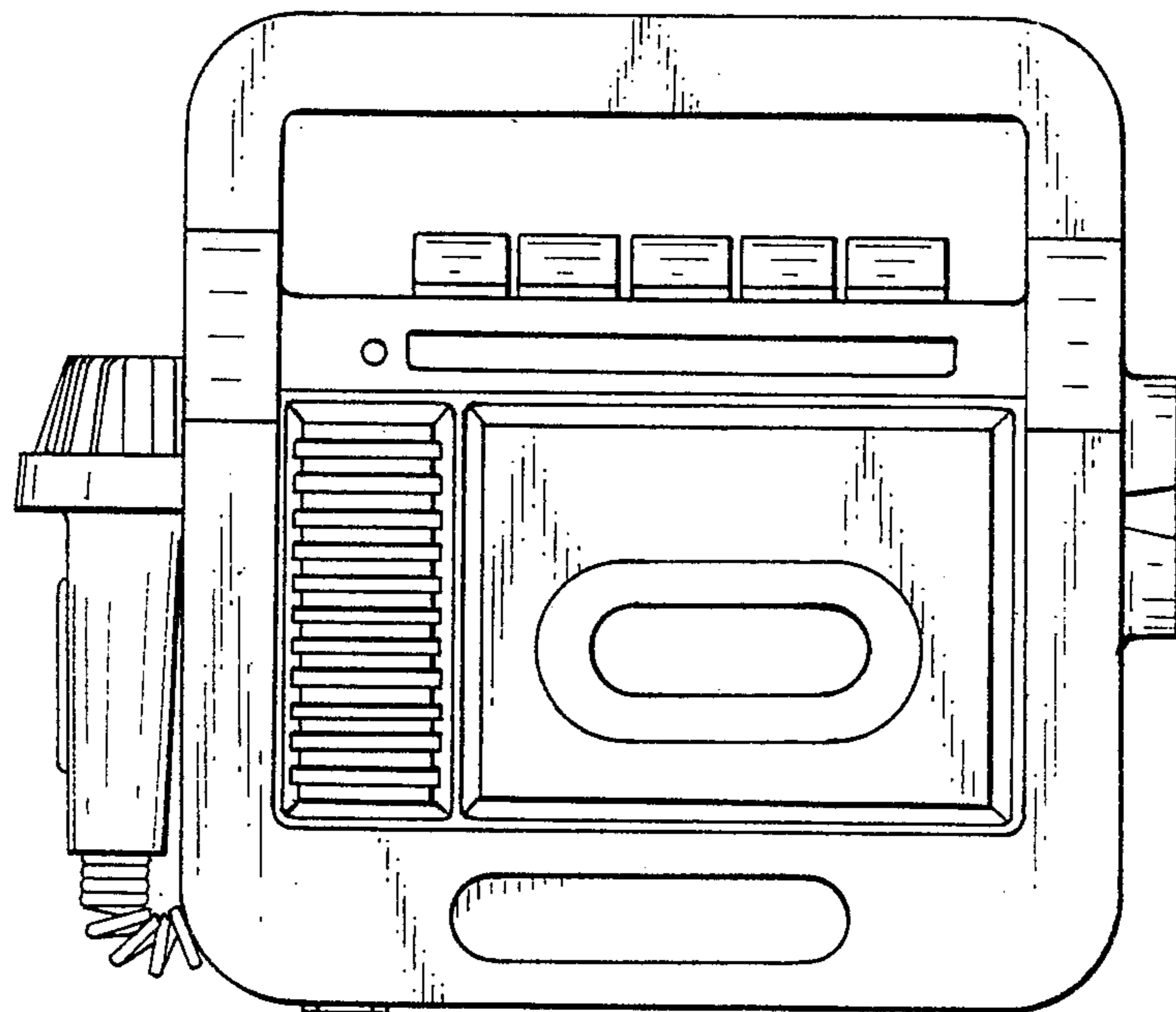

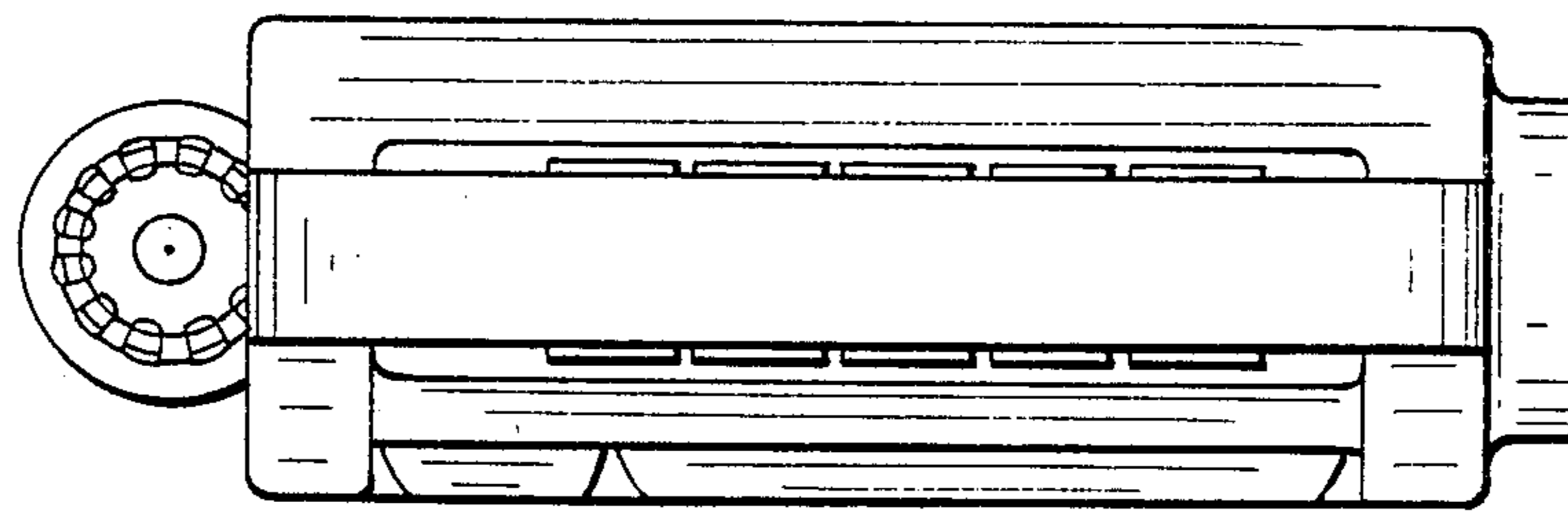

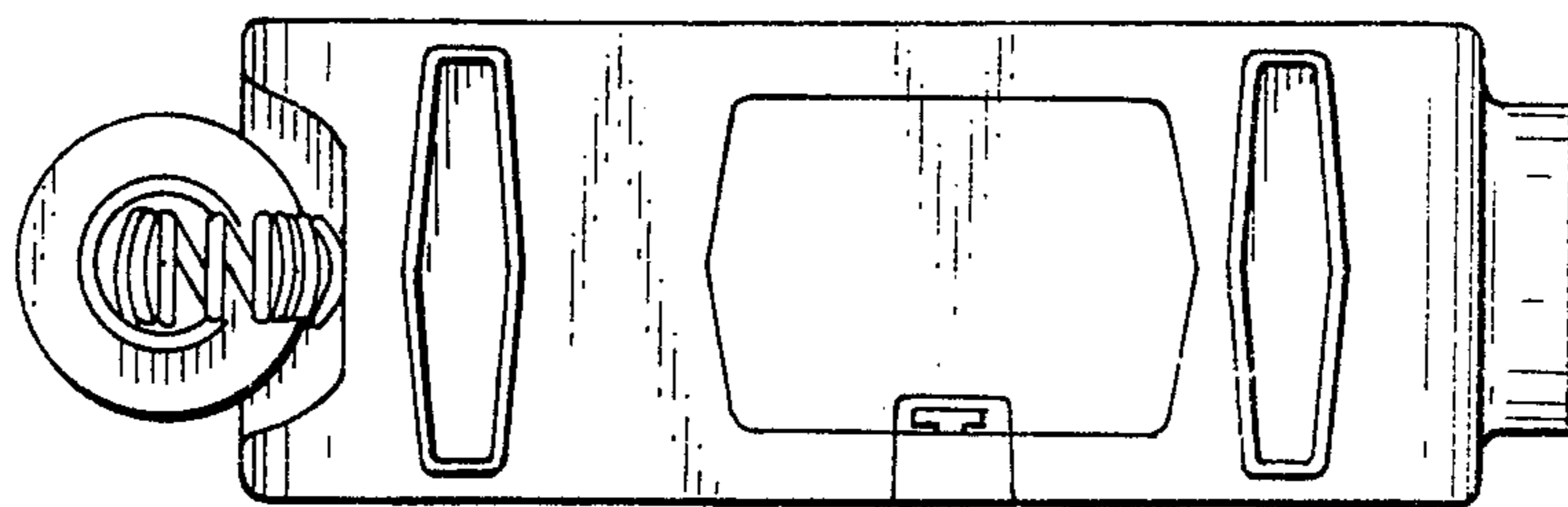

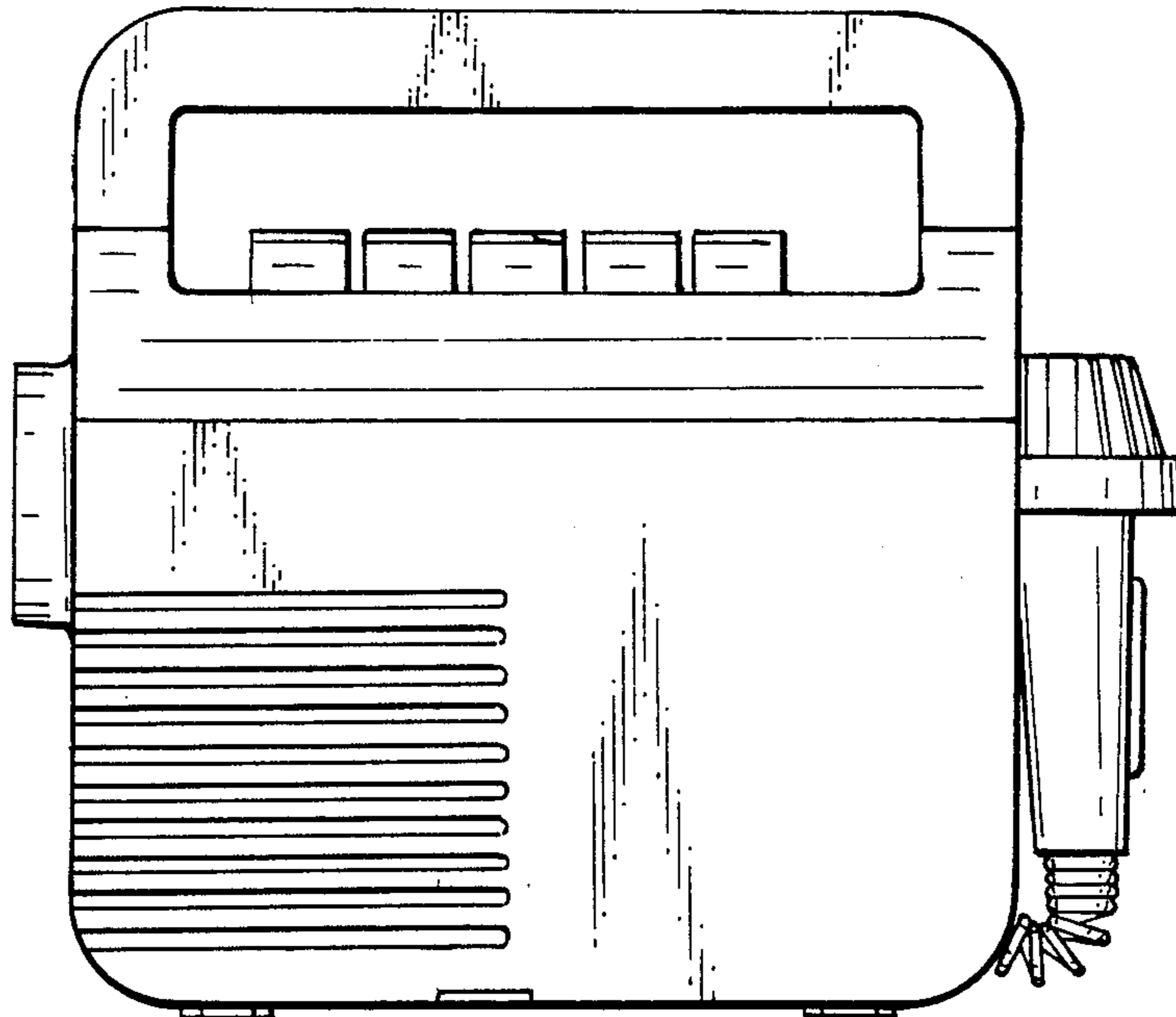

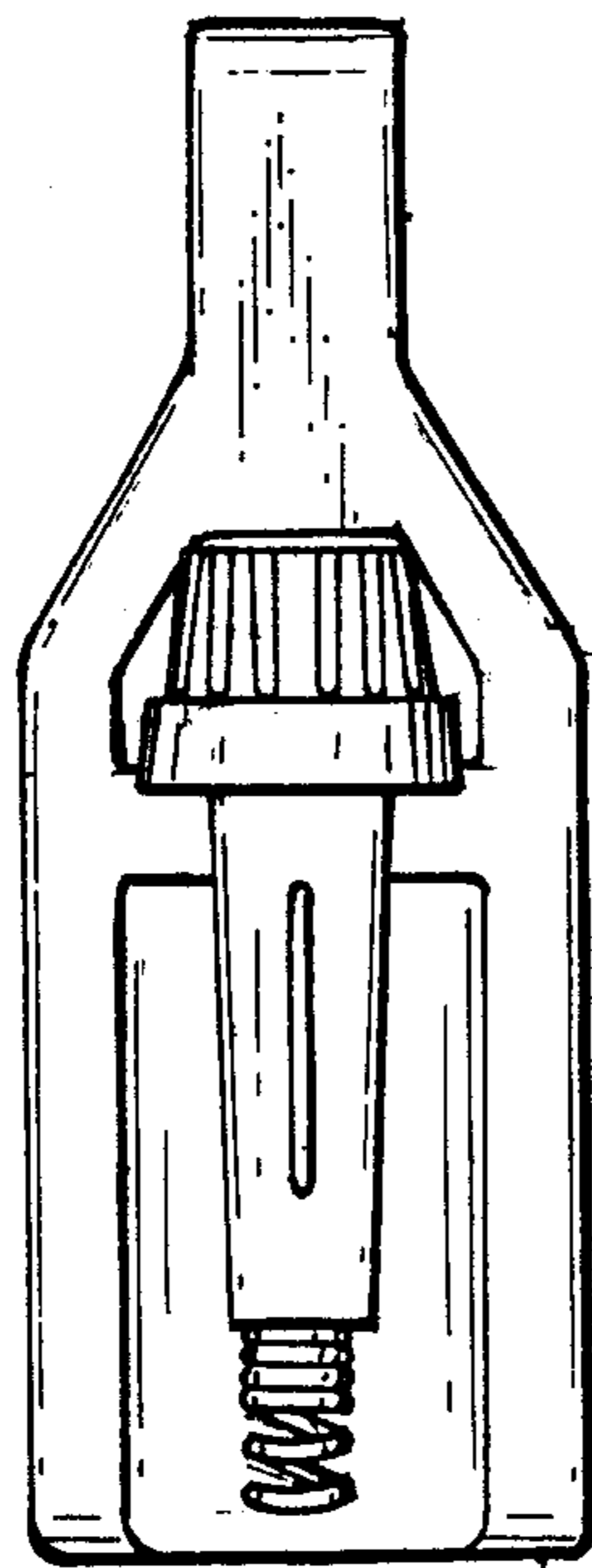

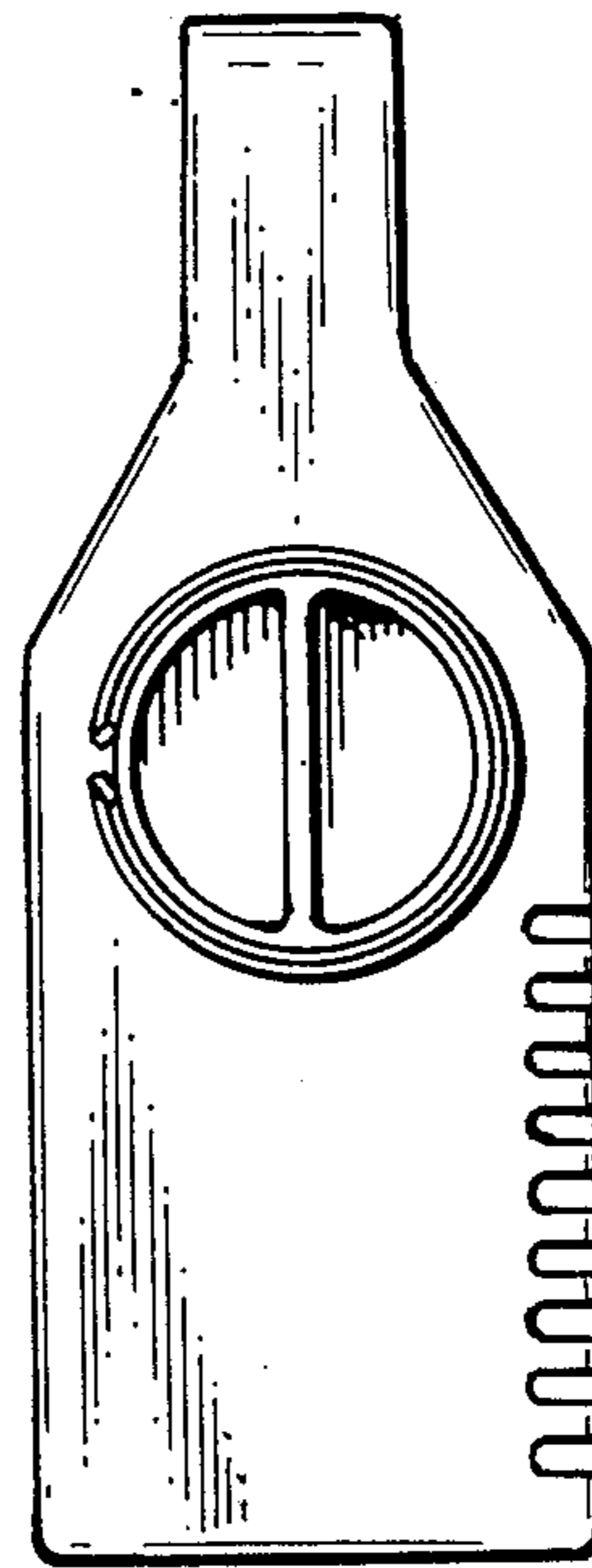
