DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a seat embodying my new design;

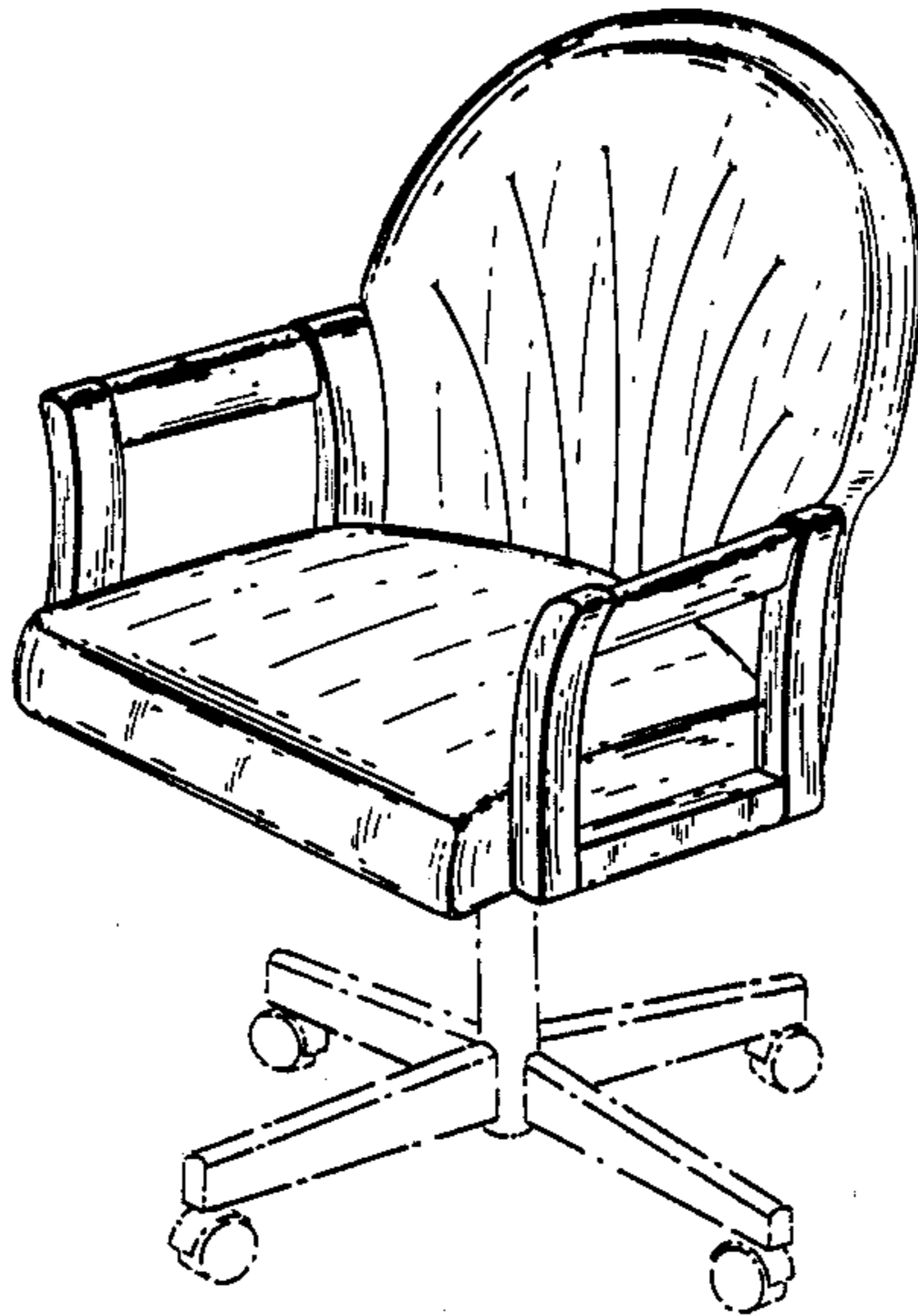
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

The pedestal shown in dotted lines in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only.



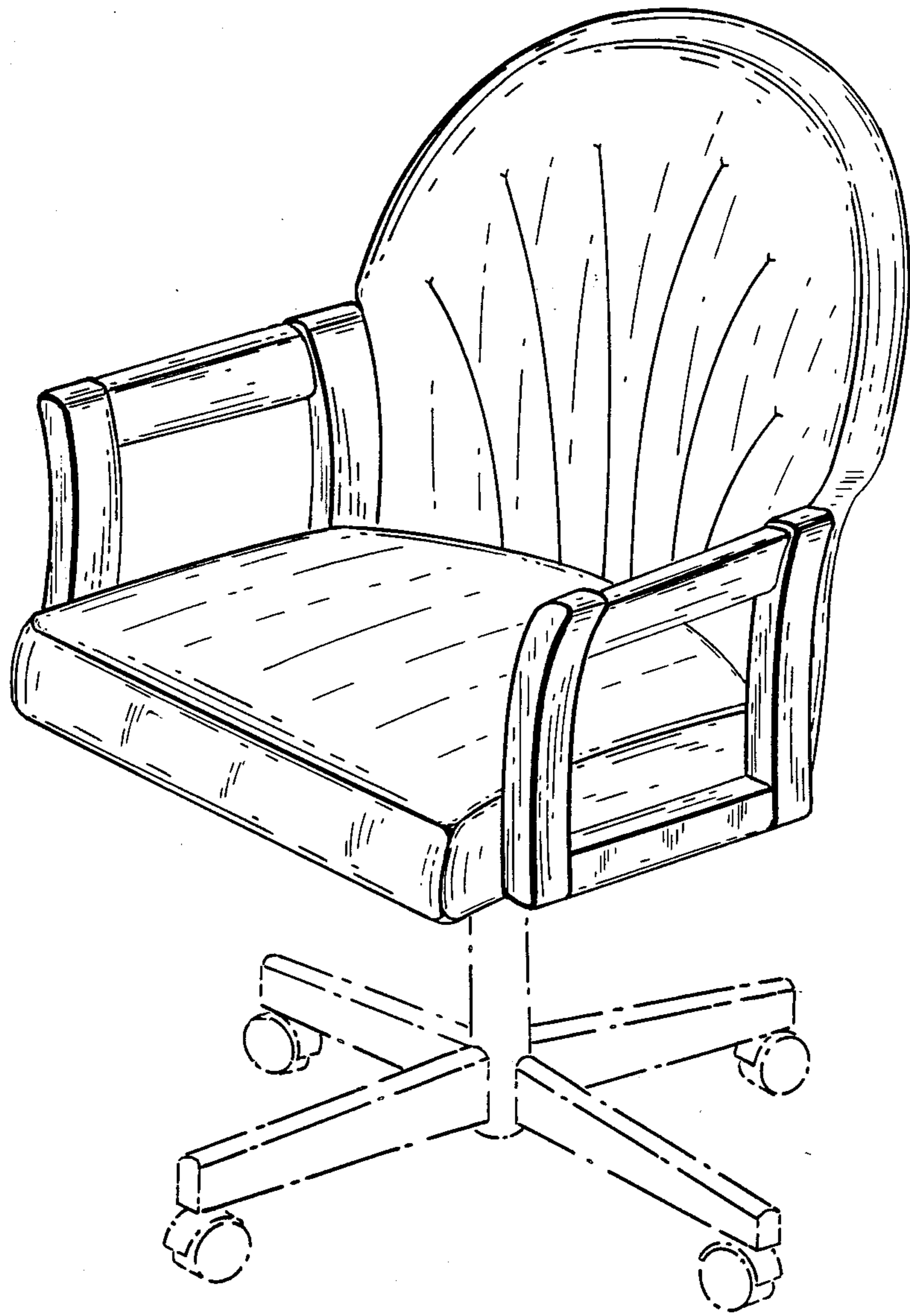

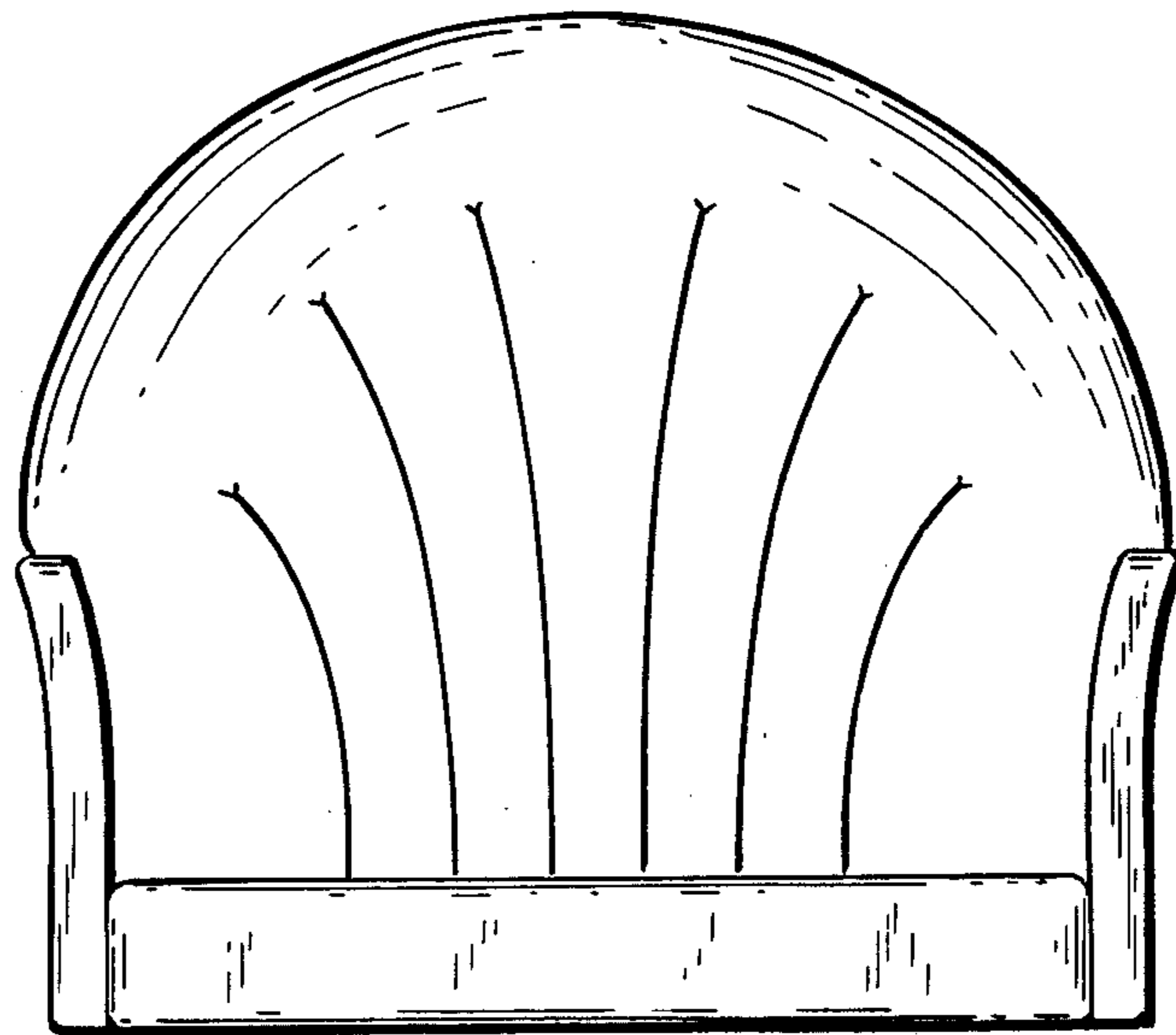

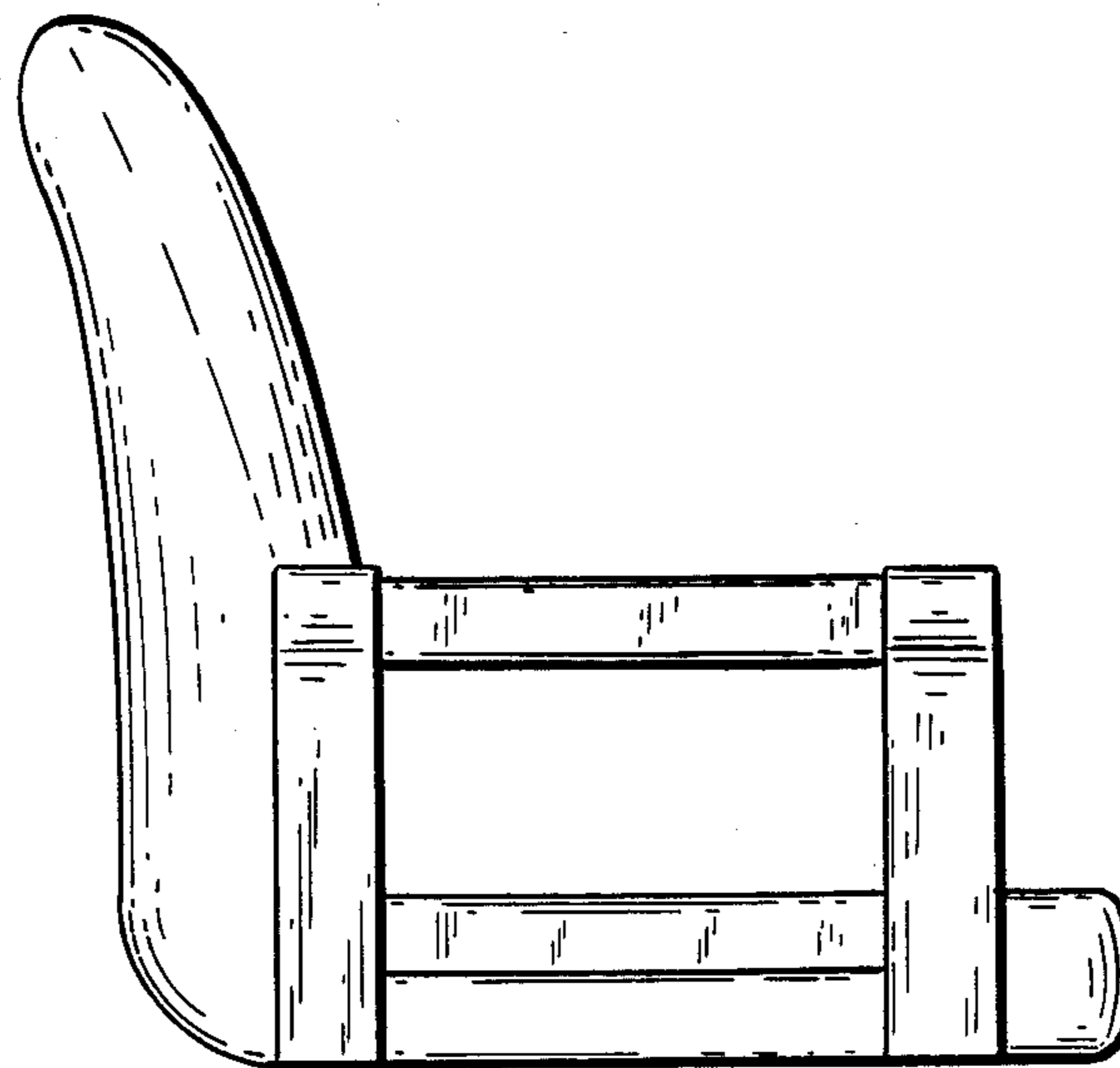

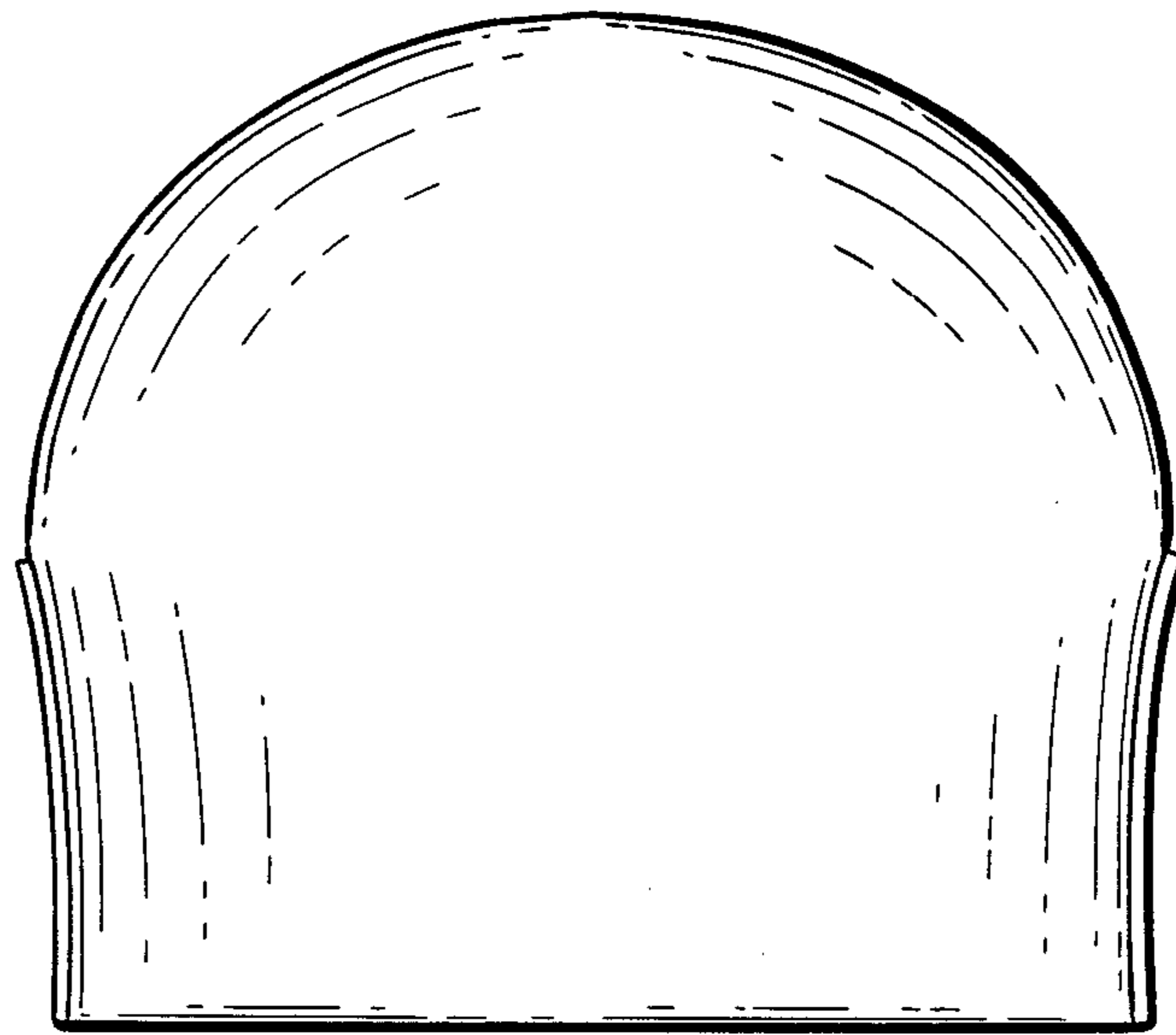

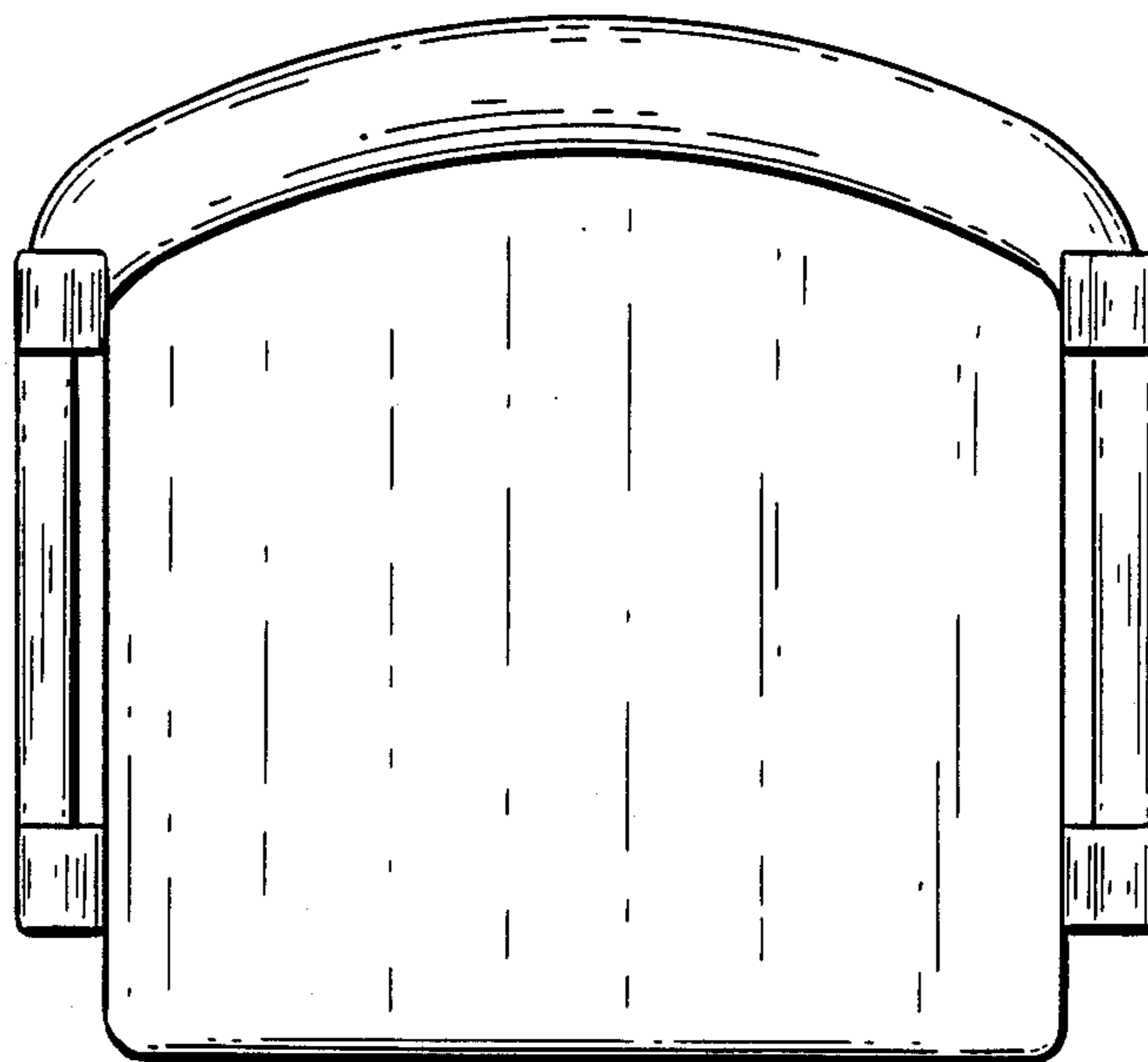
