[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a seat, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a seat showing my new design, a pedestal base being shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view; and FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof. The left side view (not shown) of the seat is the mirror image of the right side view of FIG. 3.

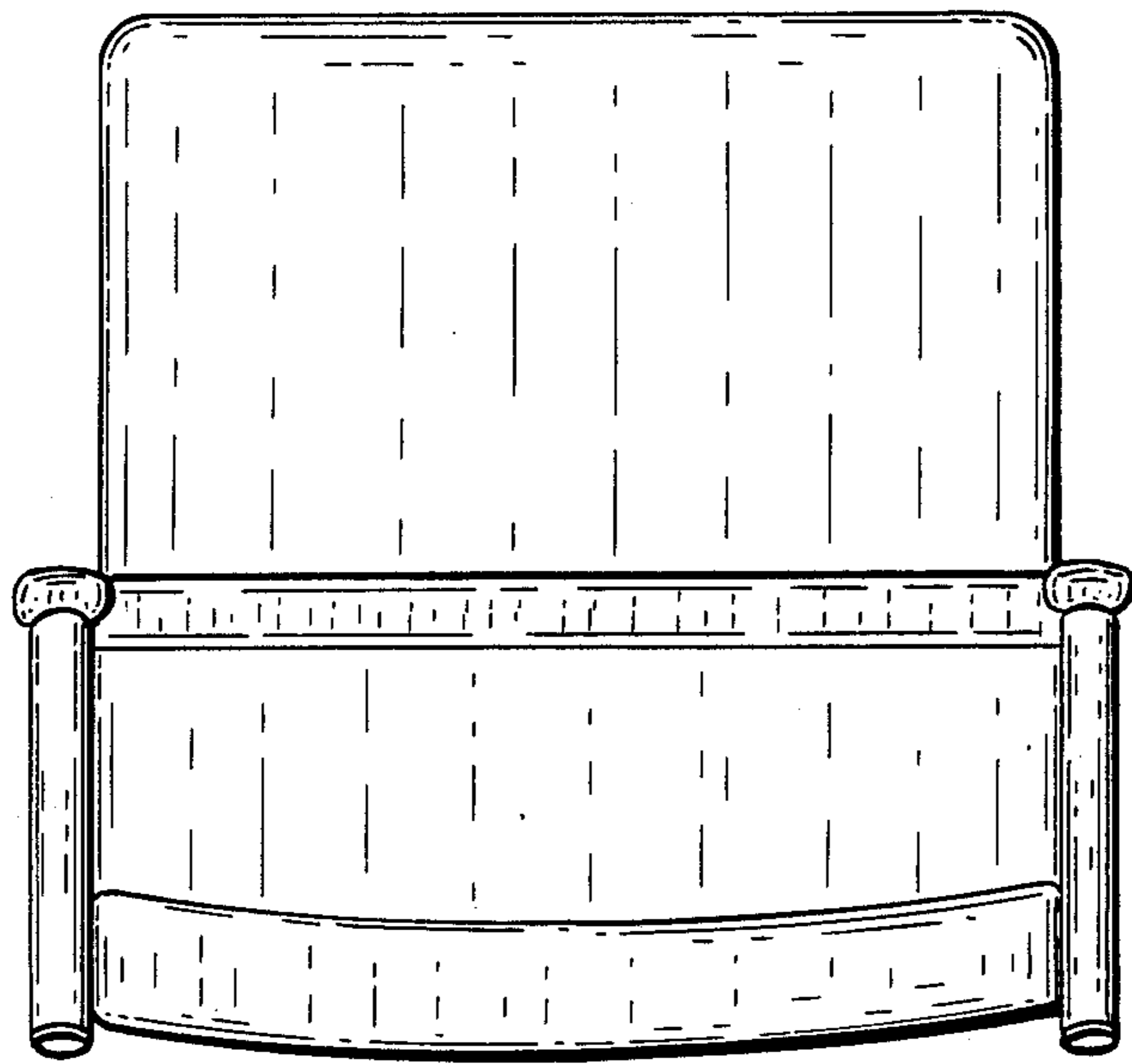

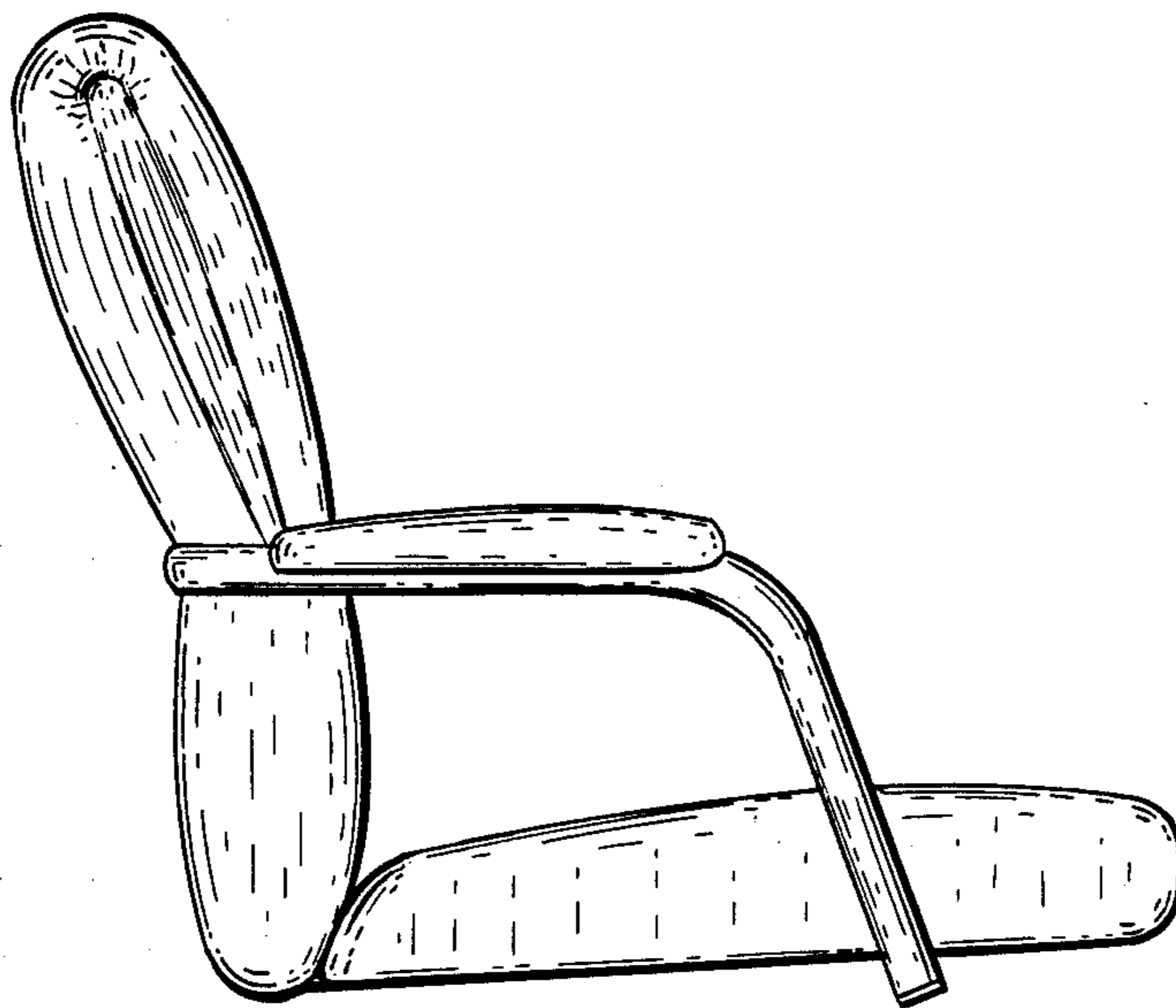

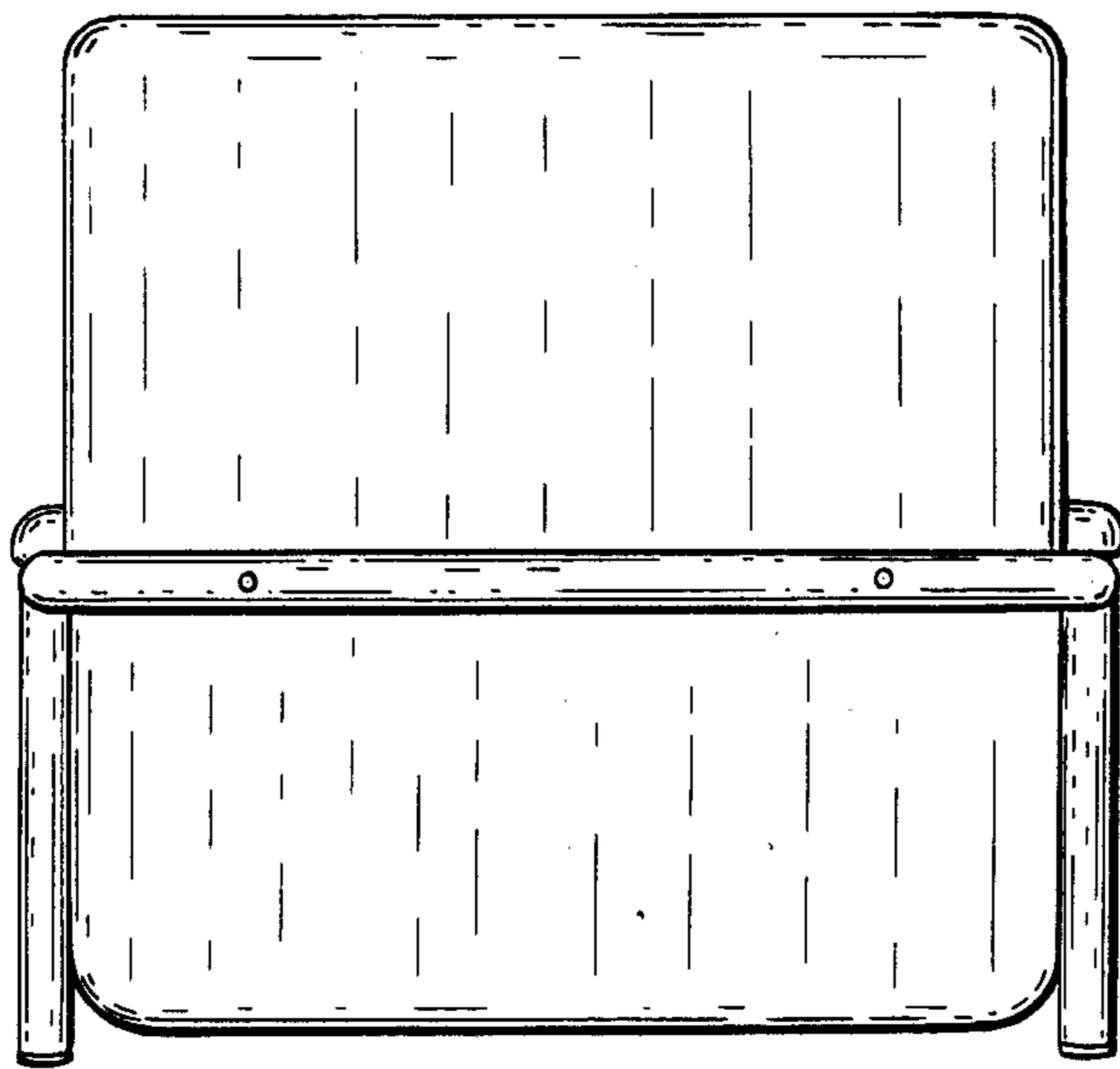

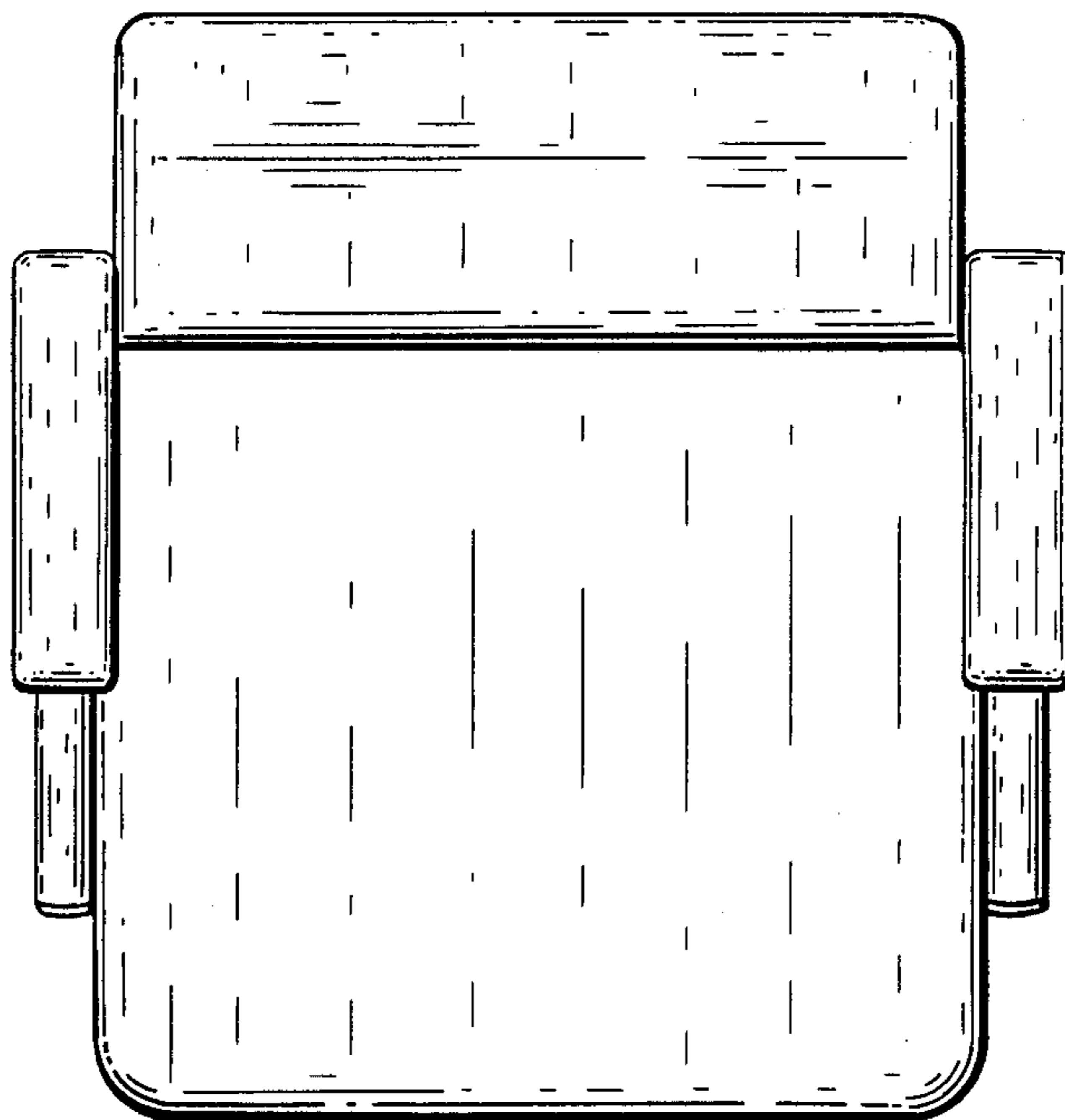
