DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the combination
wrench and screwdriver for skateboards showing our
new design, the rear view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along the
line 5—5 in FIG. 3;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

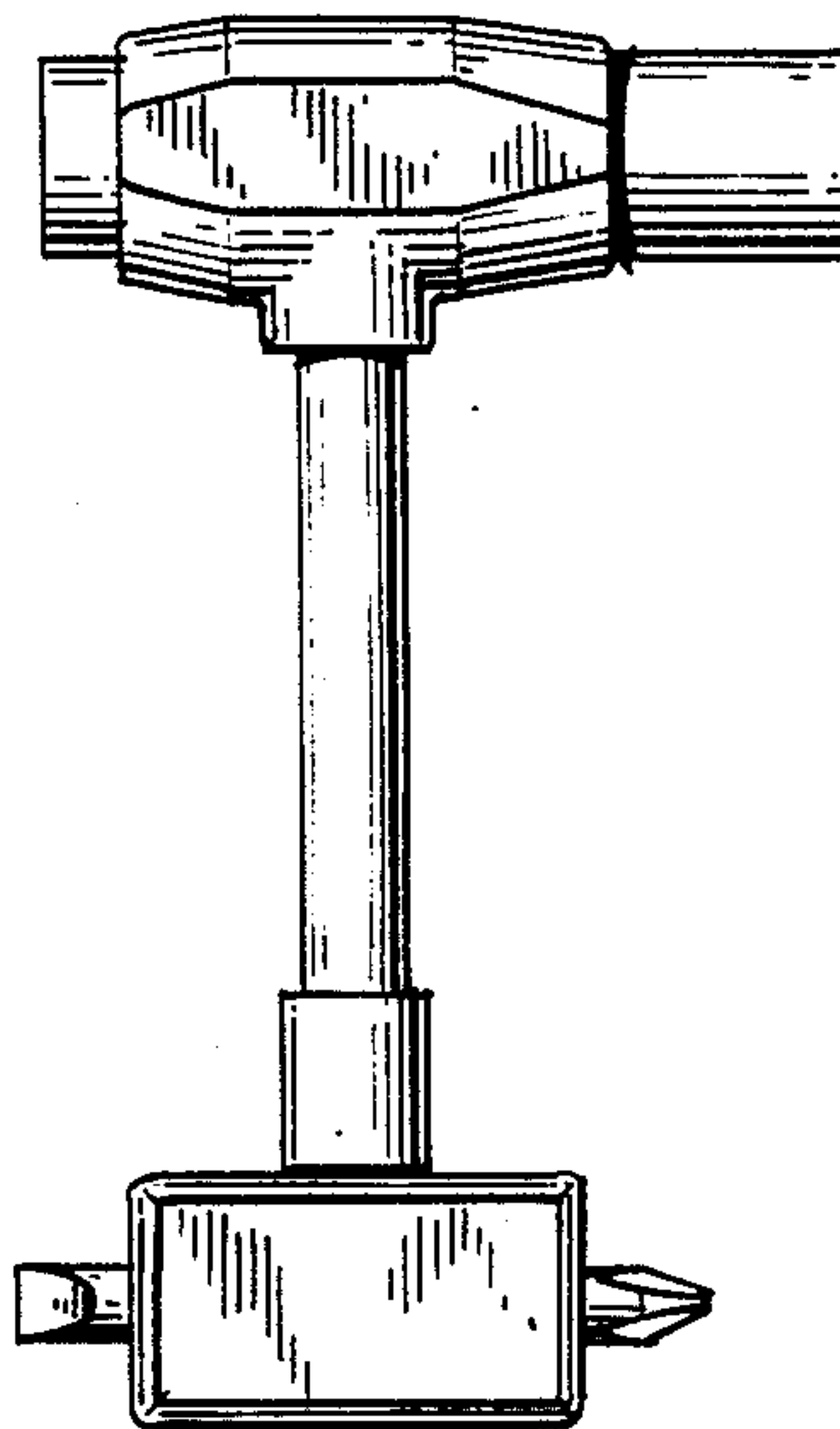

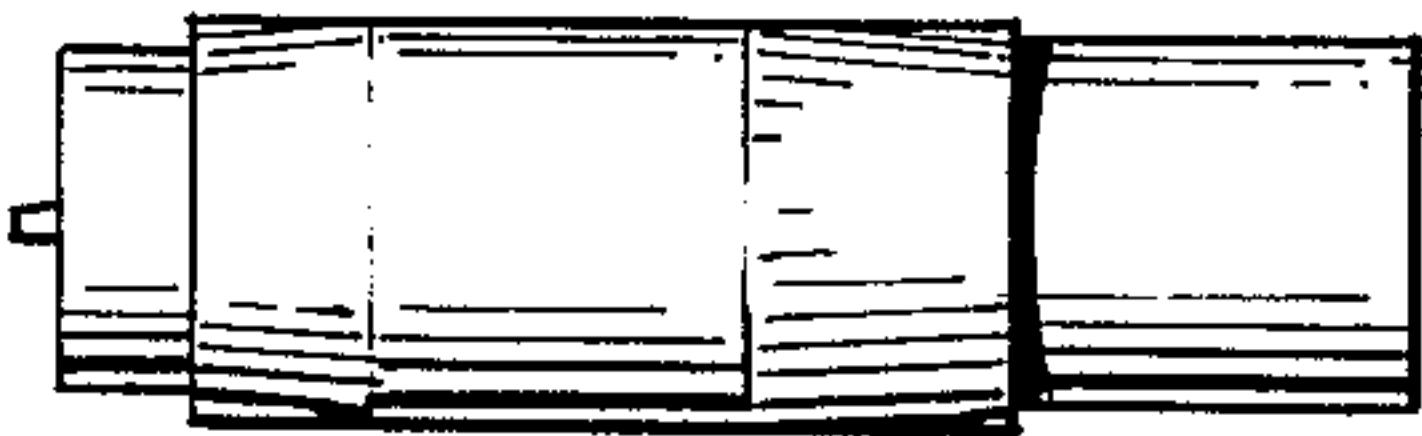

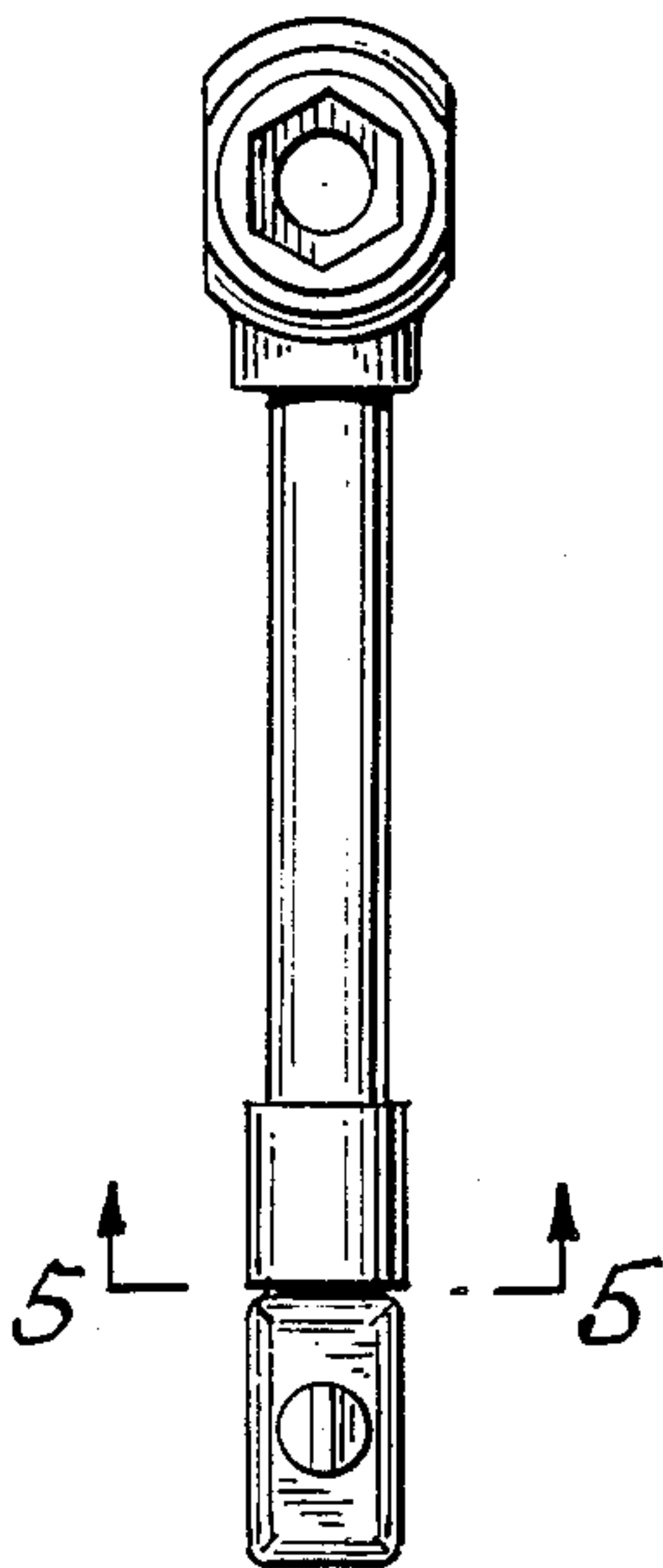

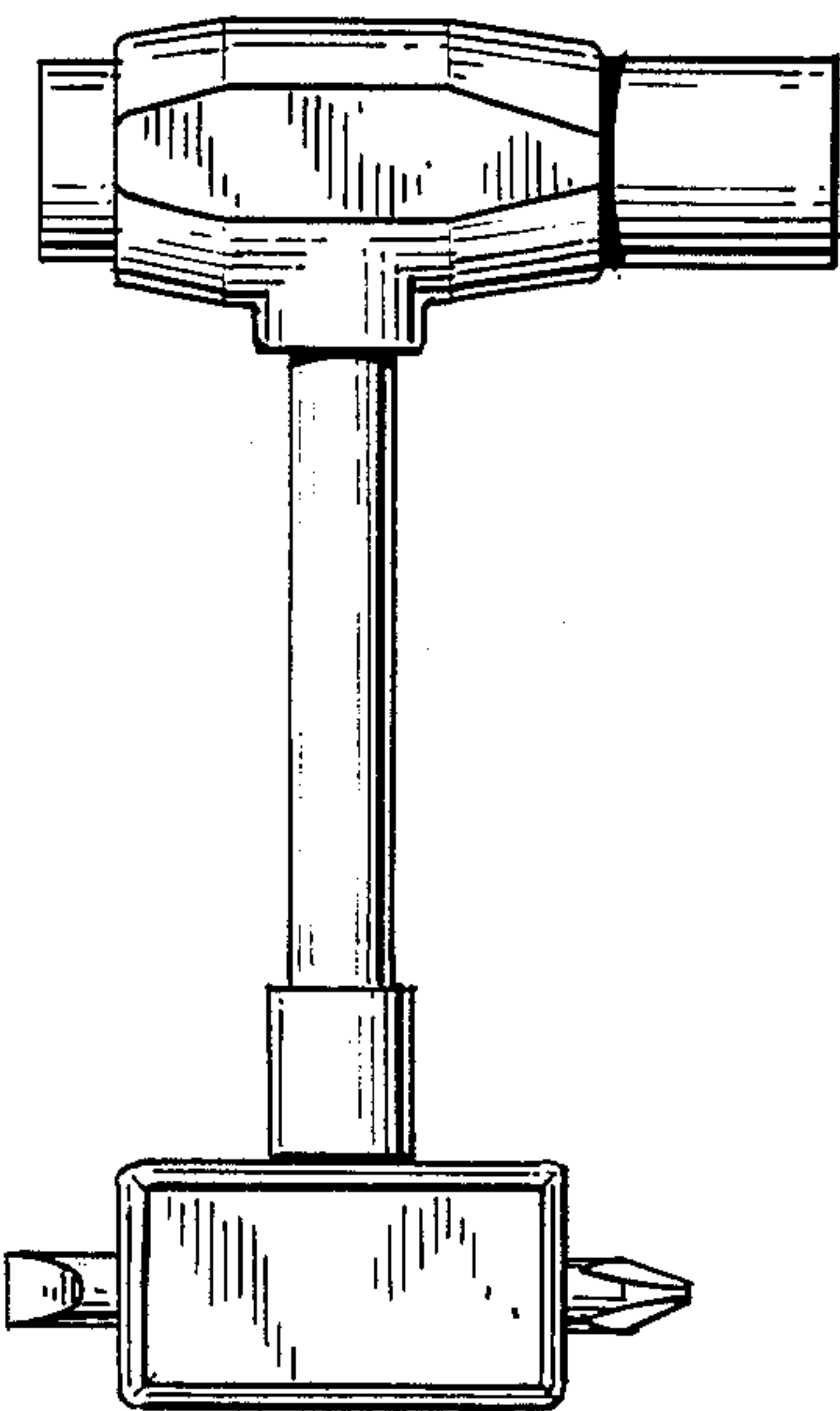

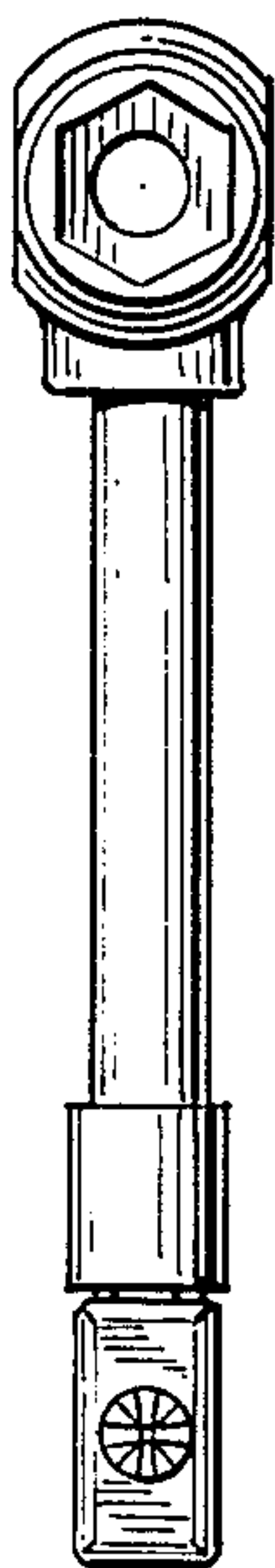

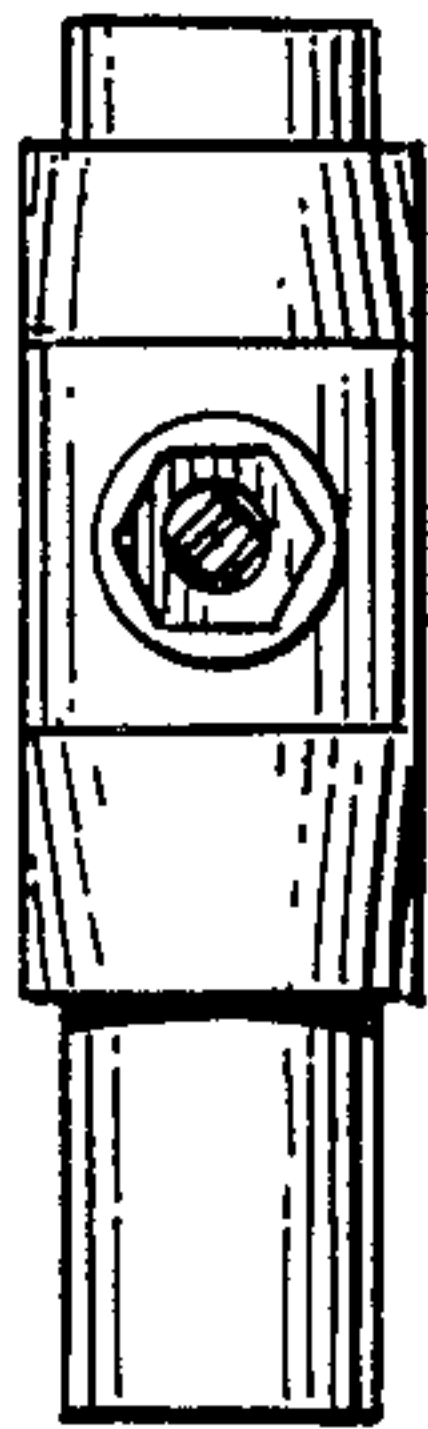
