DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a thermostat housing or the like showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof turned 180° with respect to FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side view being a mirror image thereof.
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

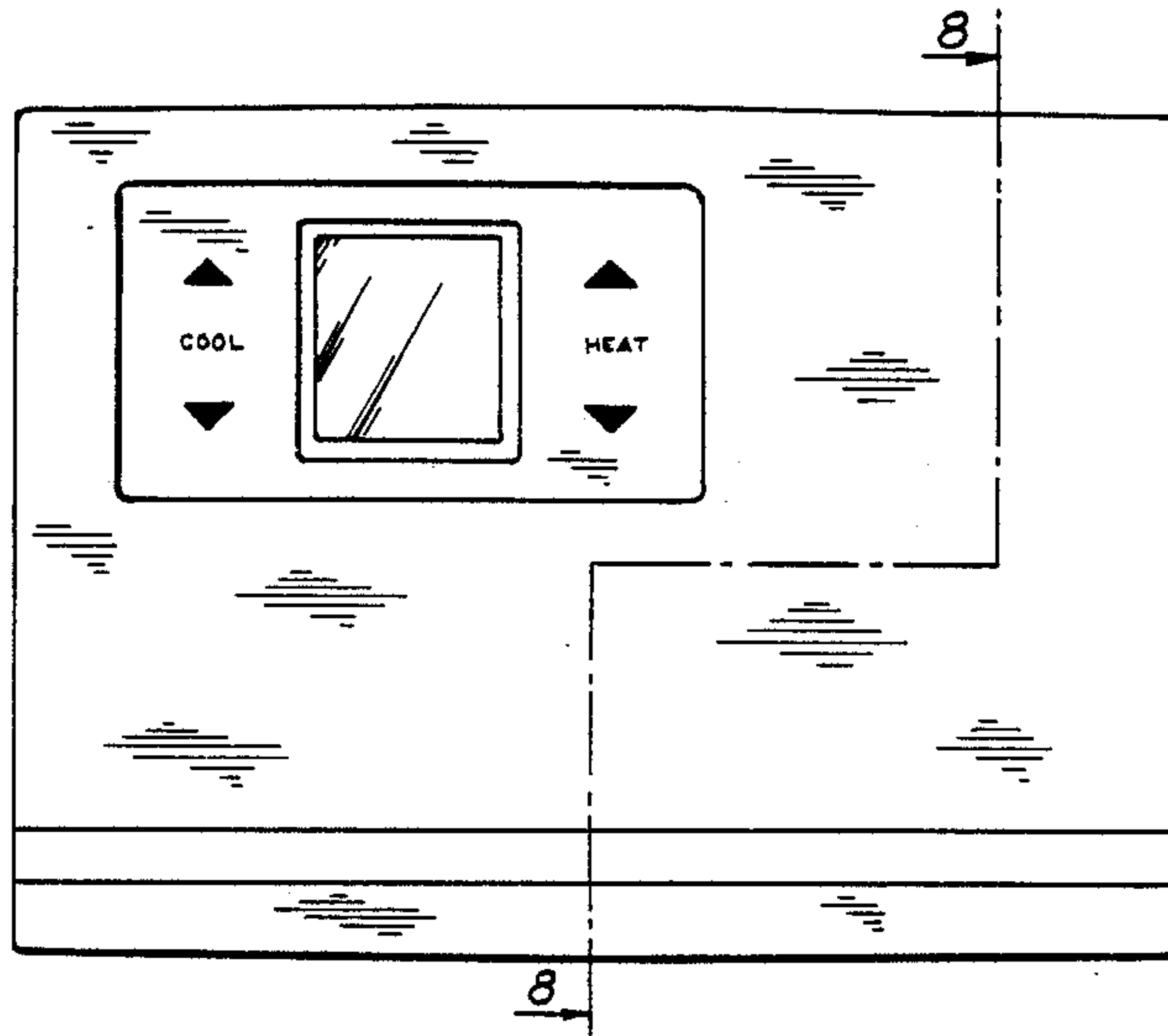

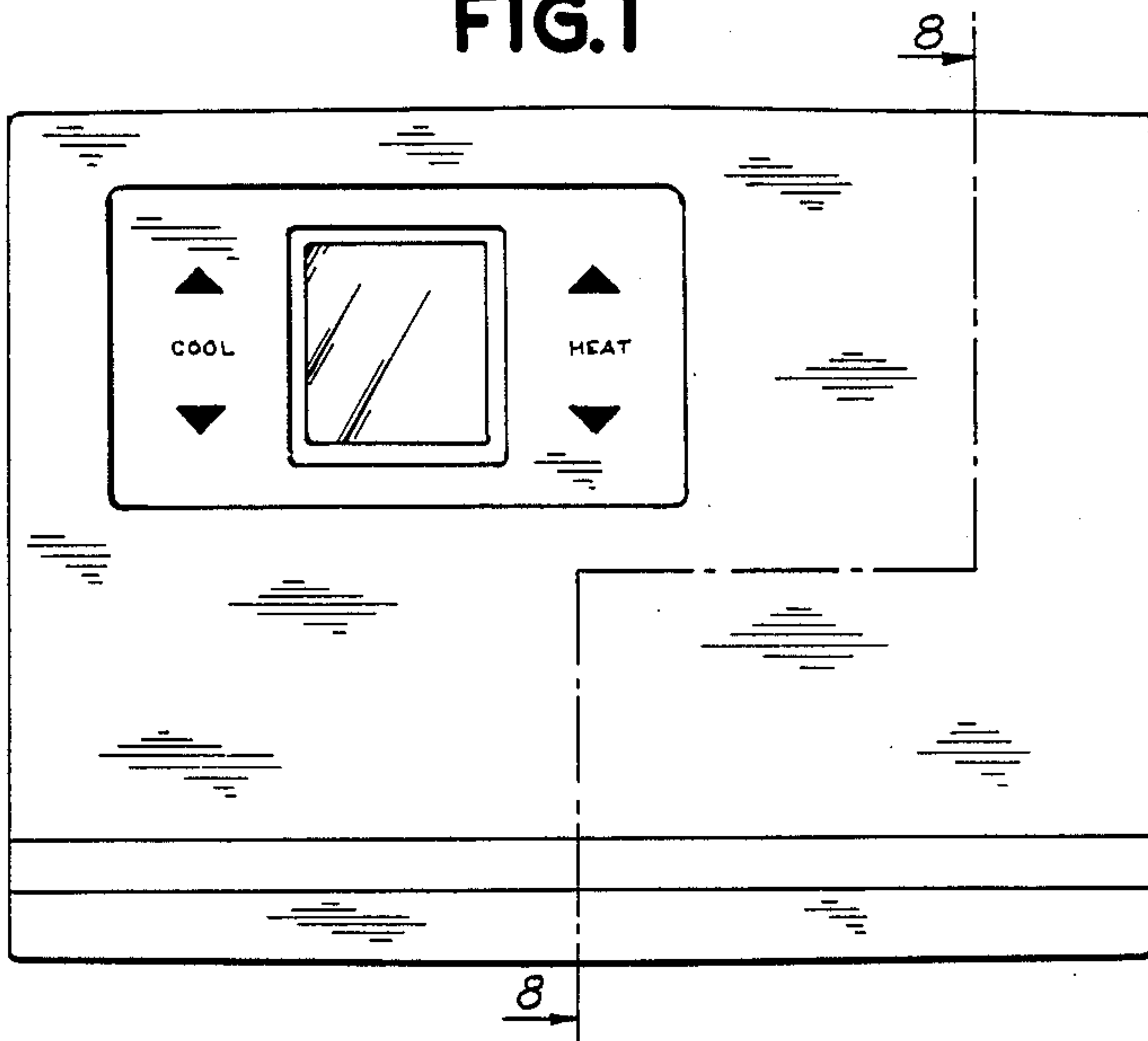

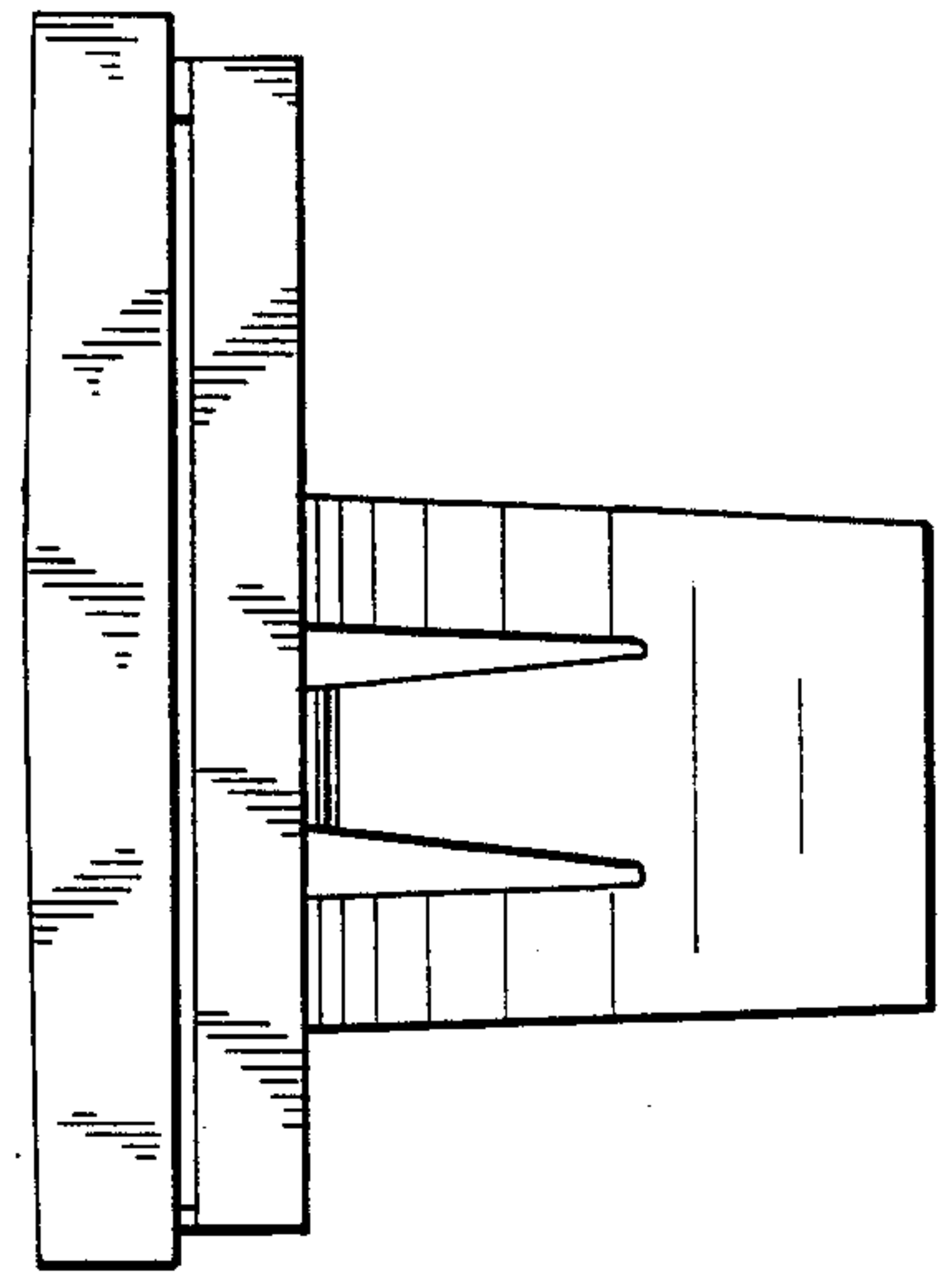

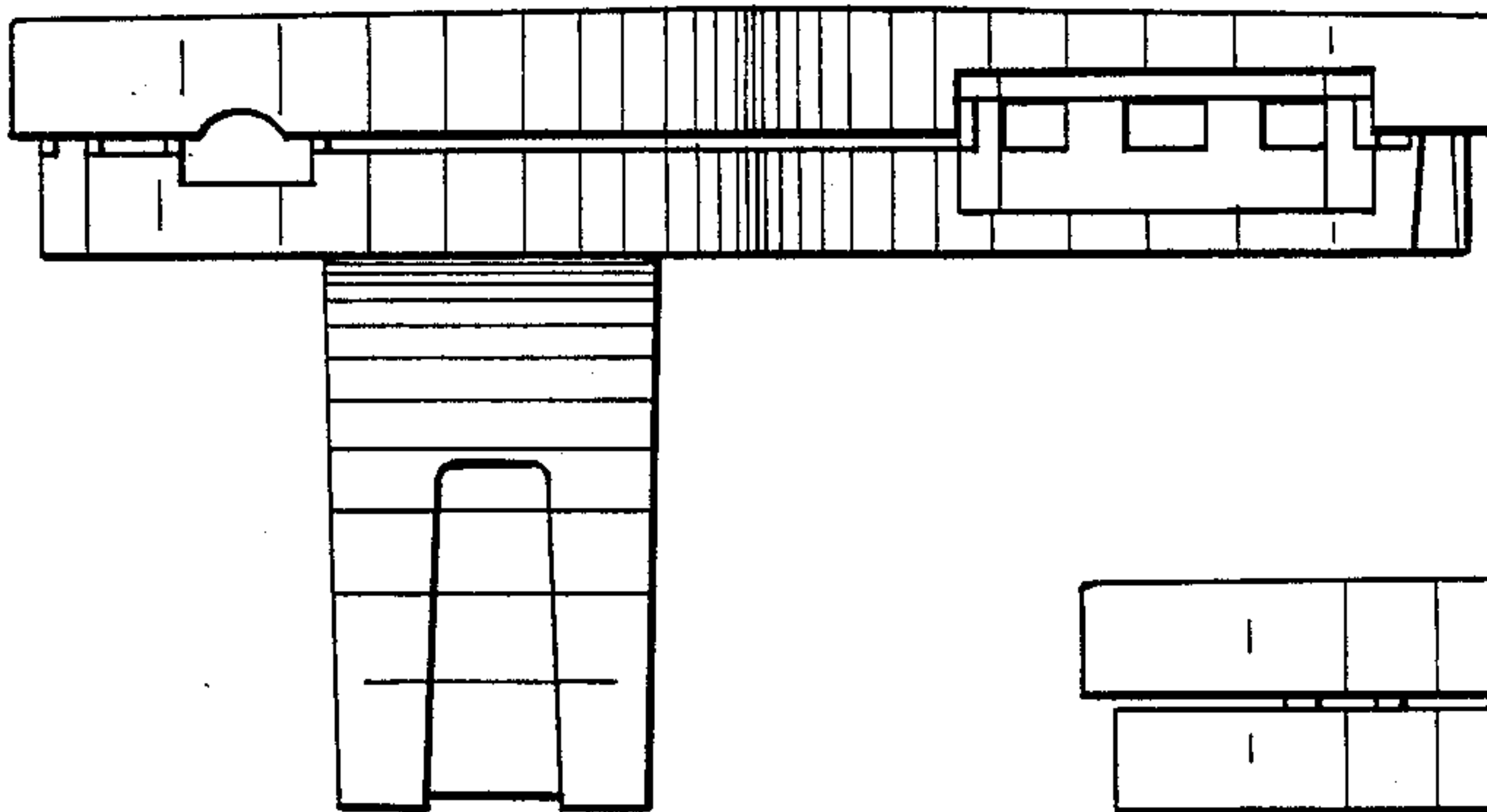

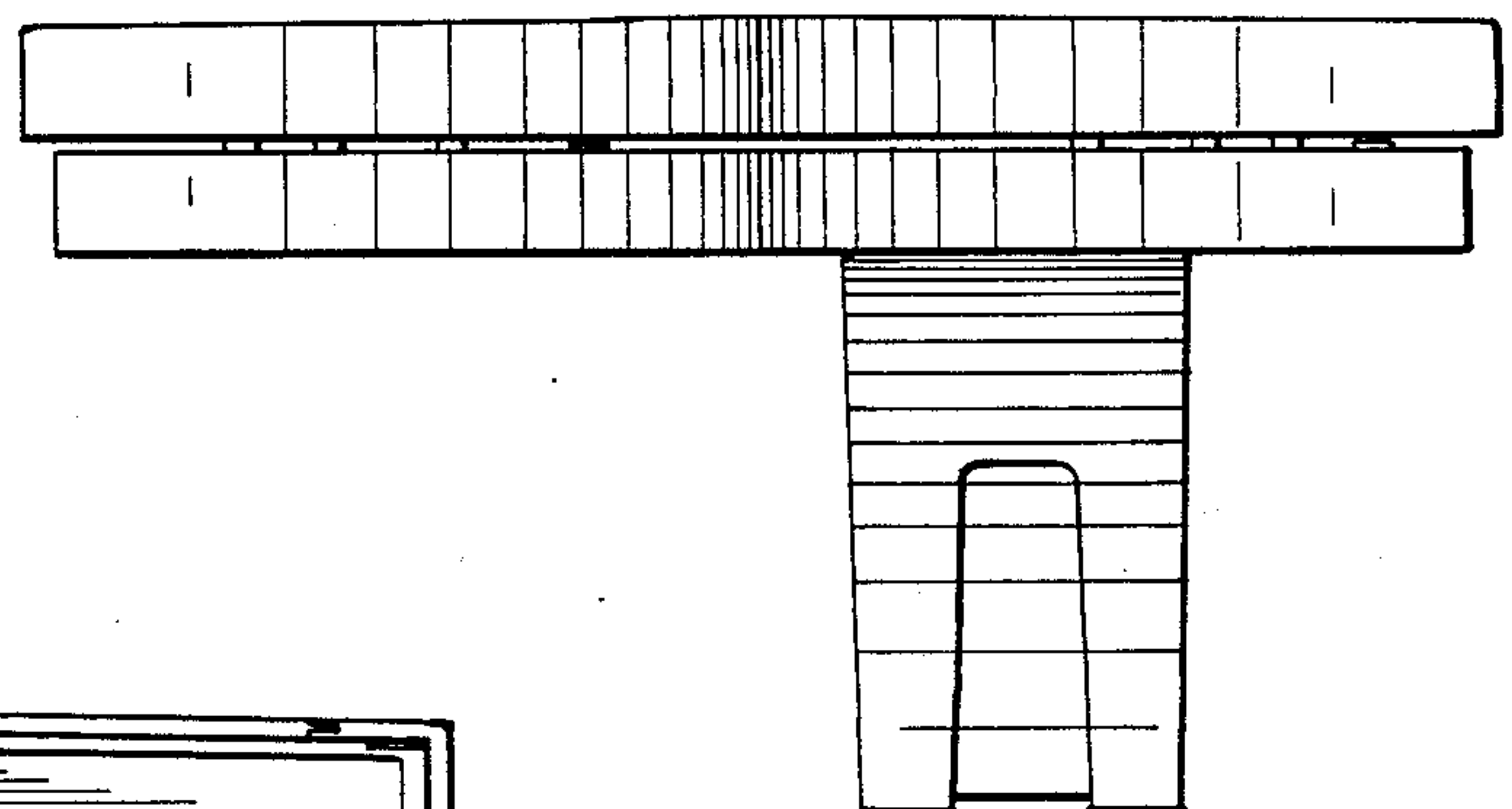
