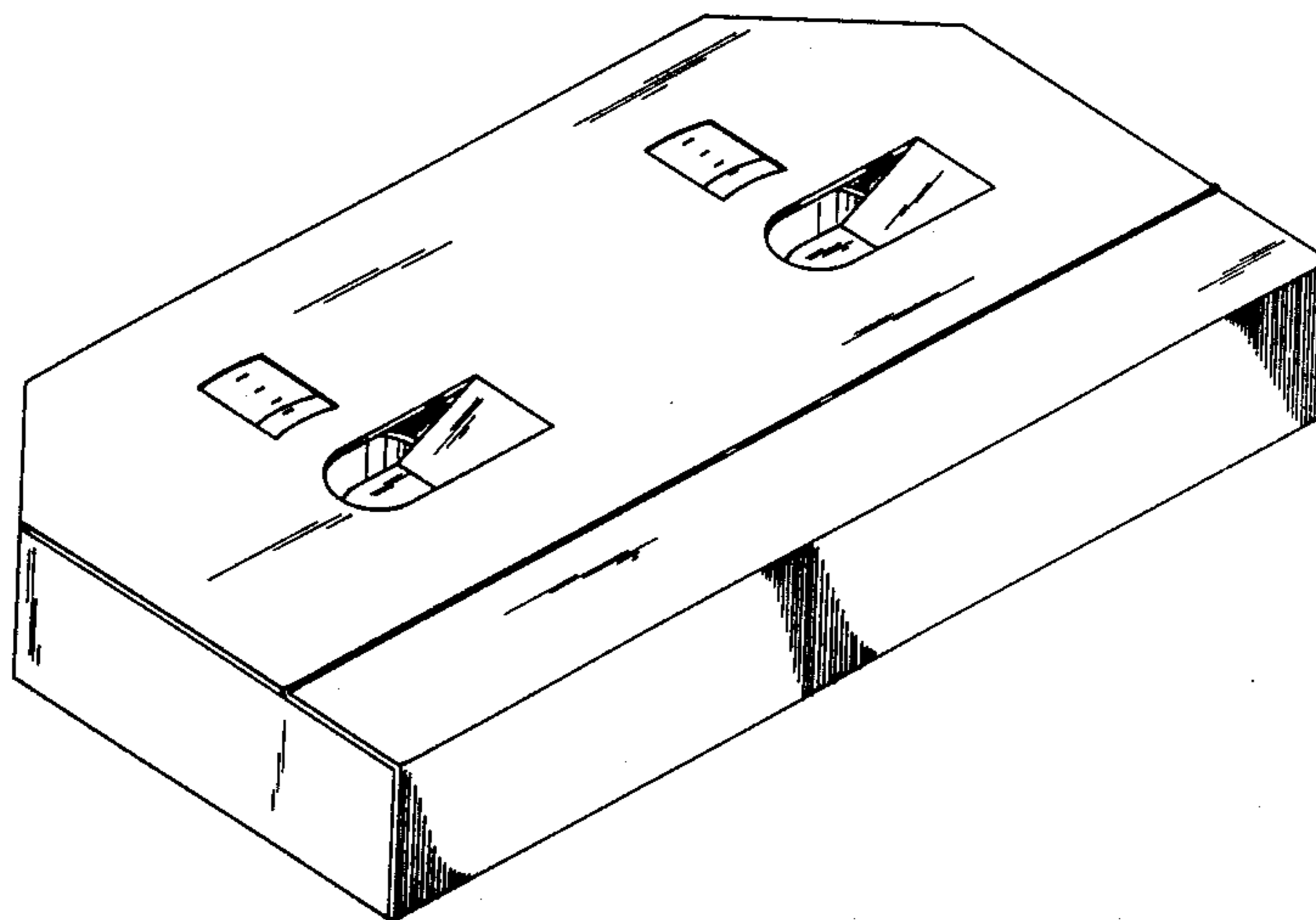
[57] CLAIM

FIG. 2 is a bottom, rear and right side perspective view thereof.



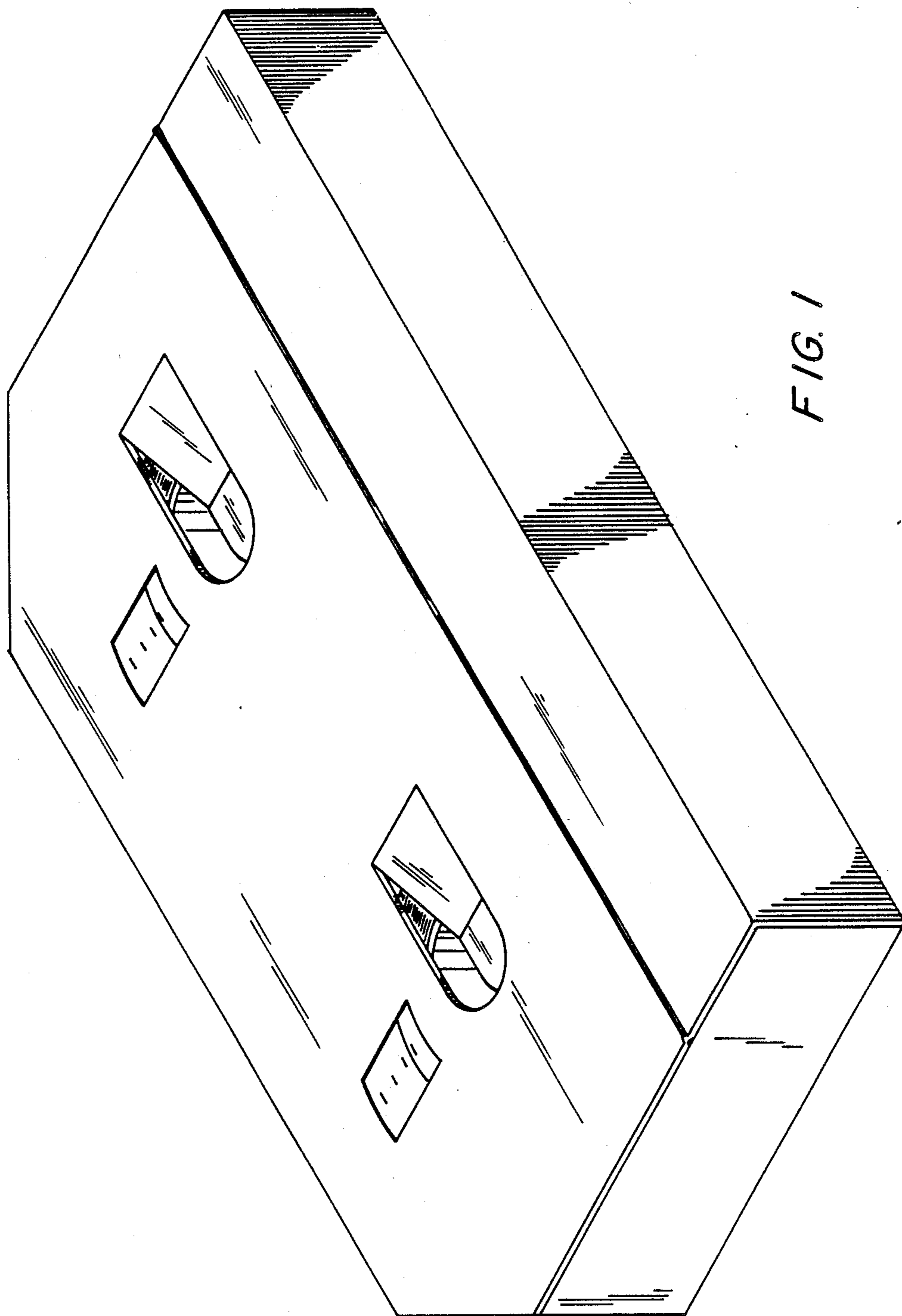

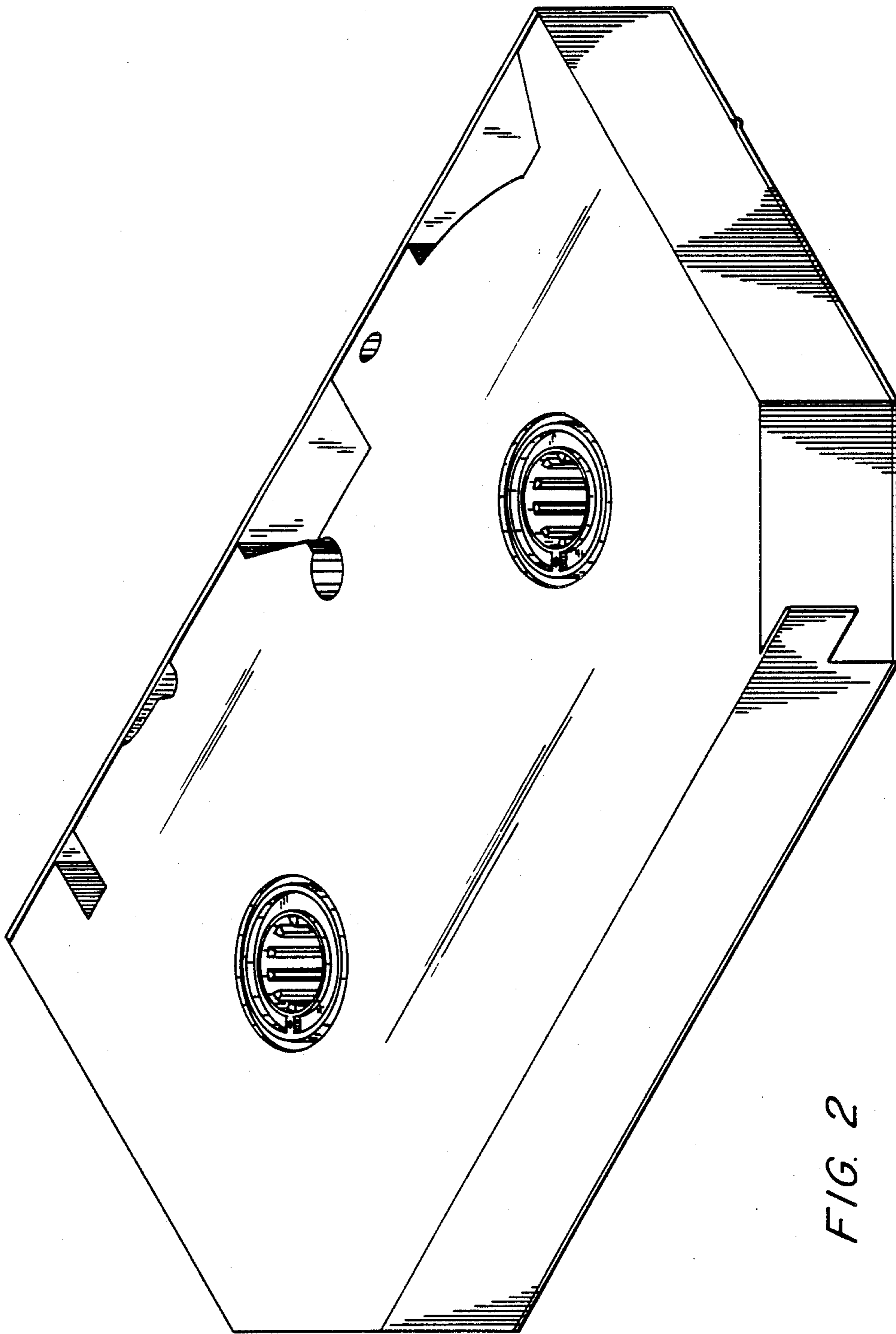
