DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a digital audio compact disk player showing my new design;

 FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof.

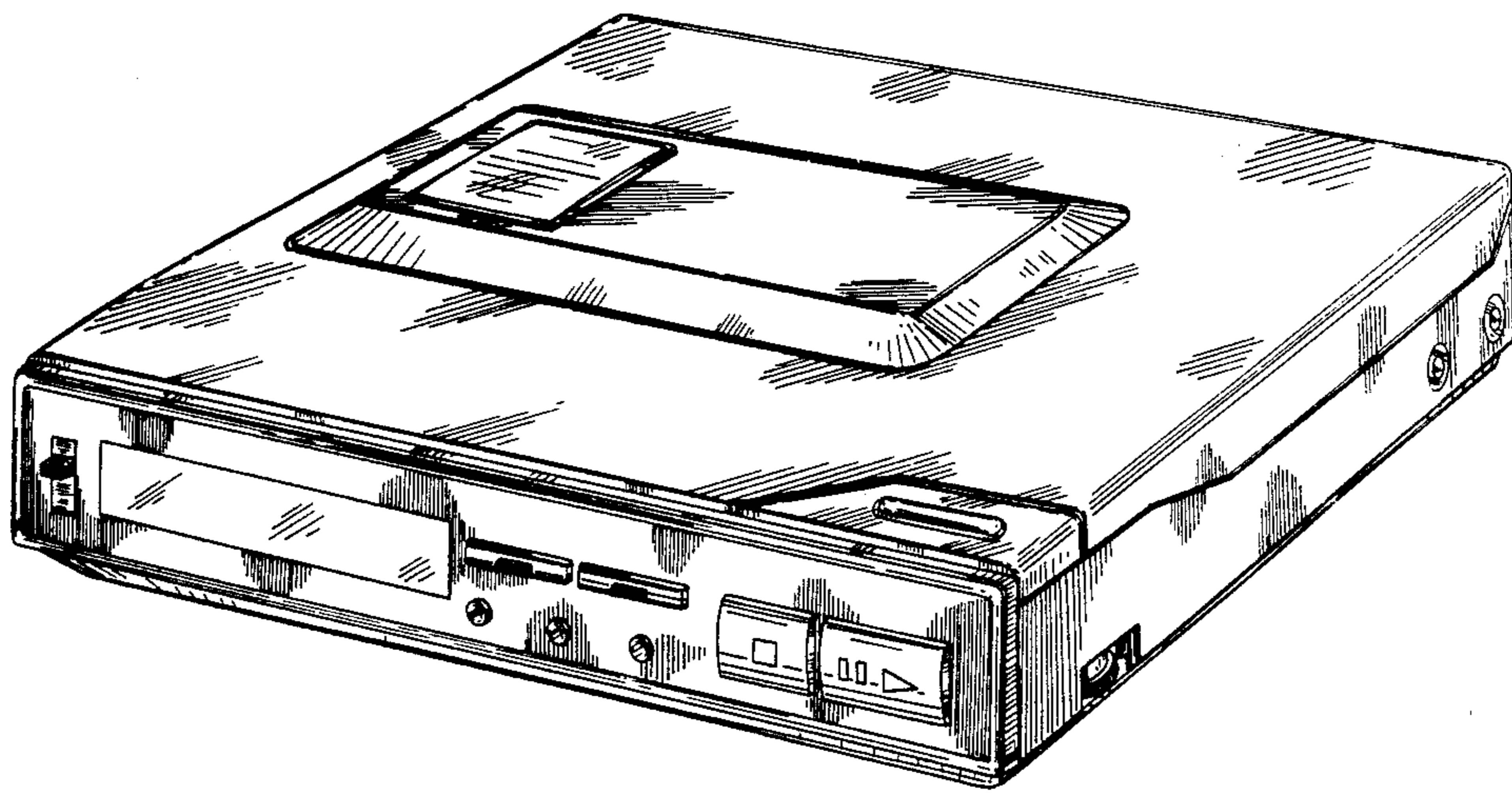

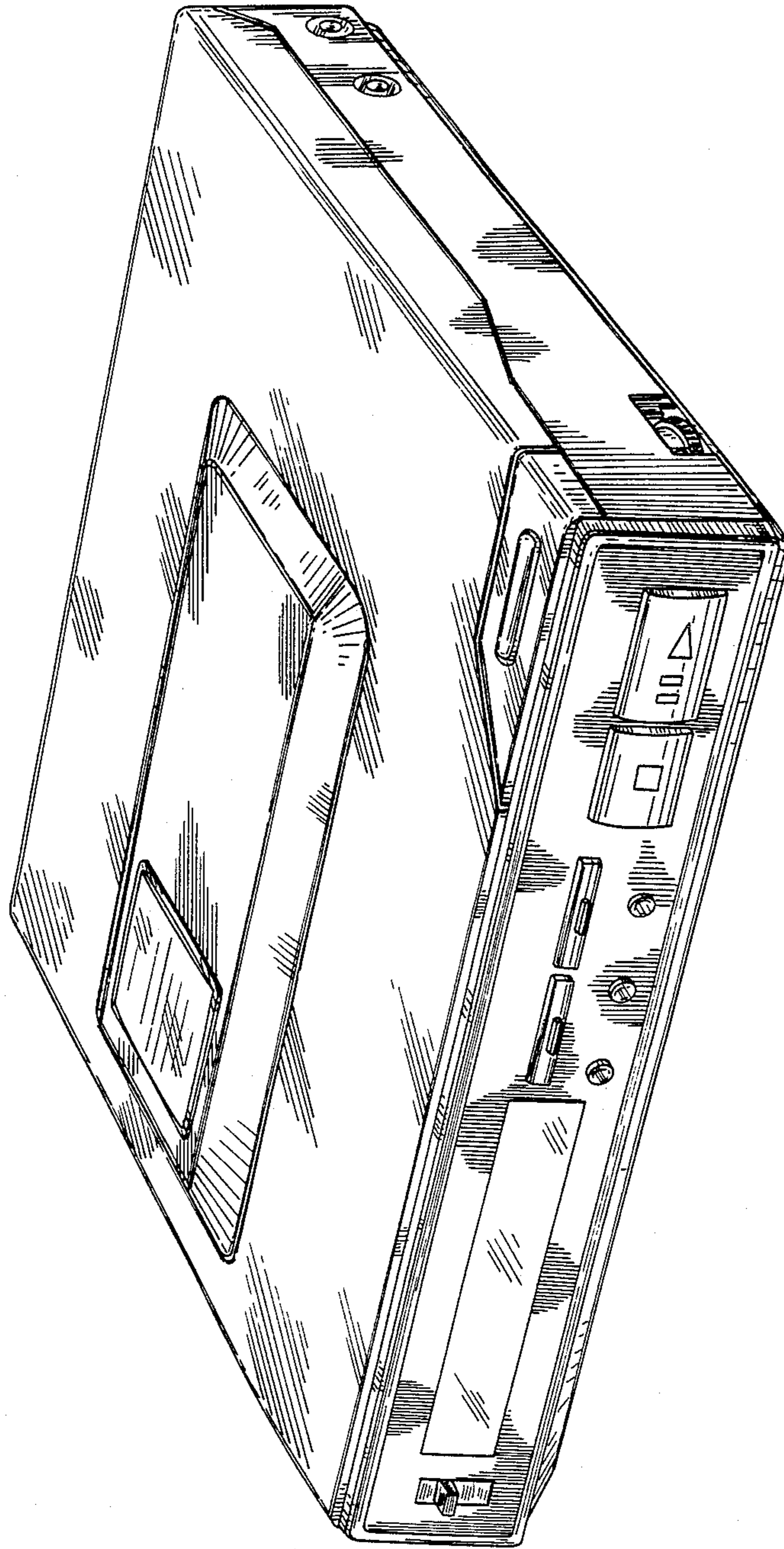

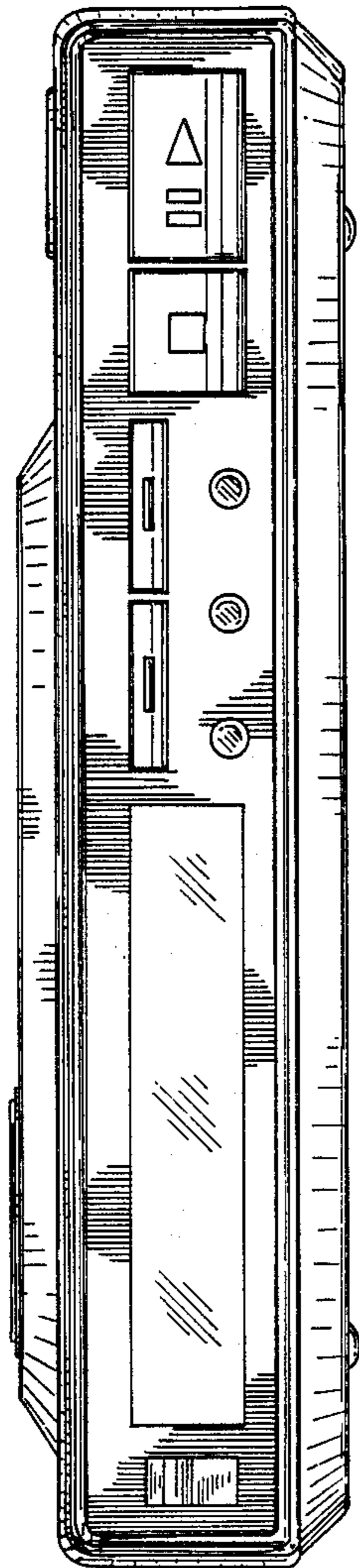

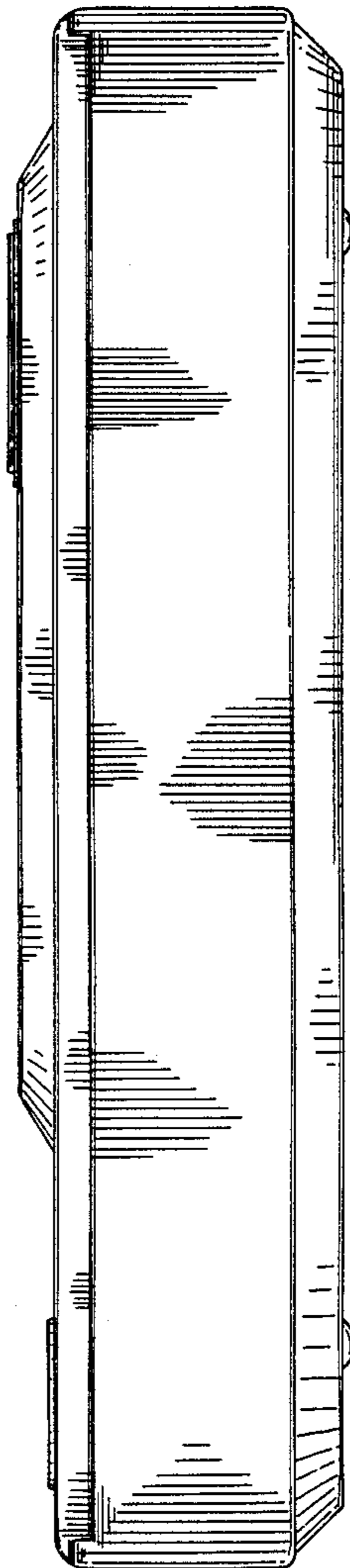

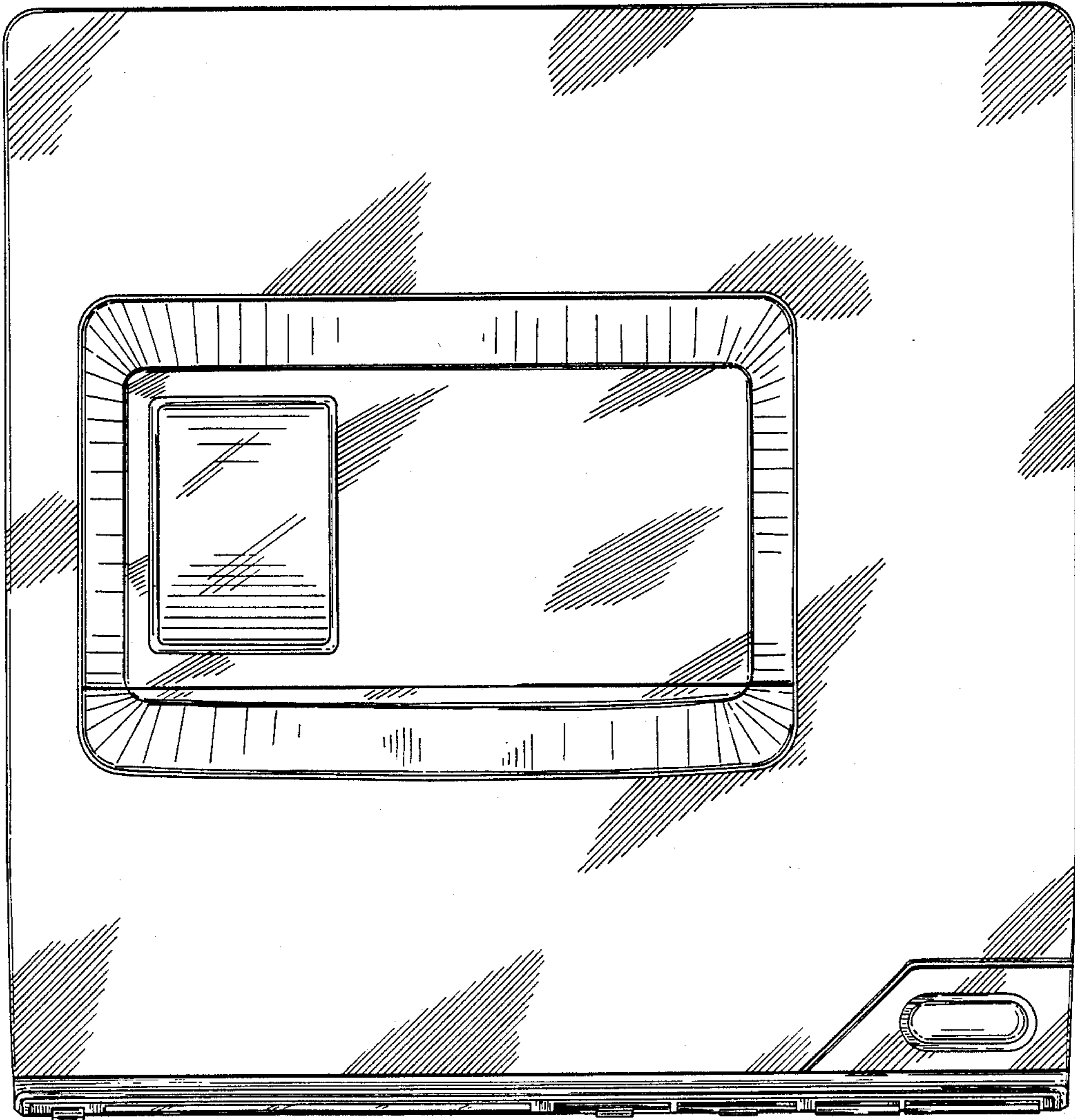

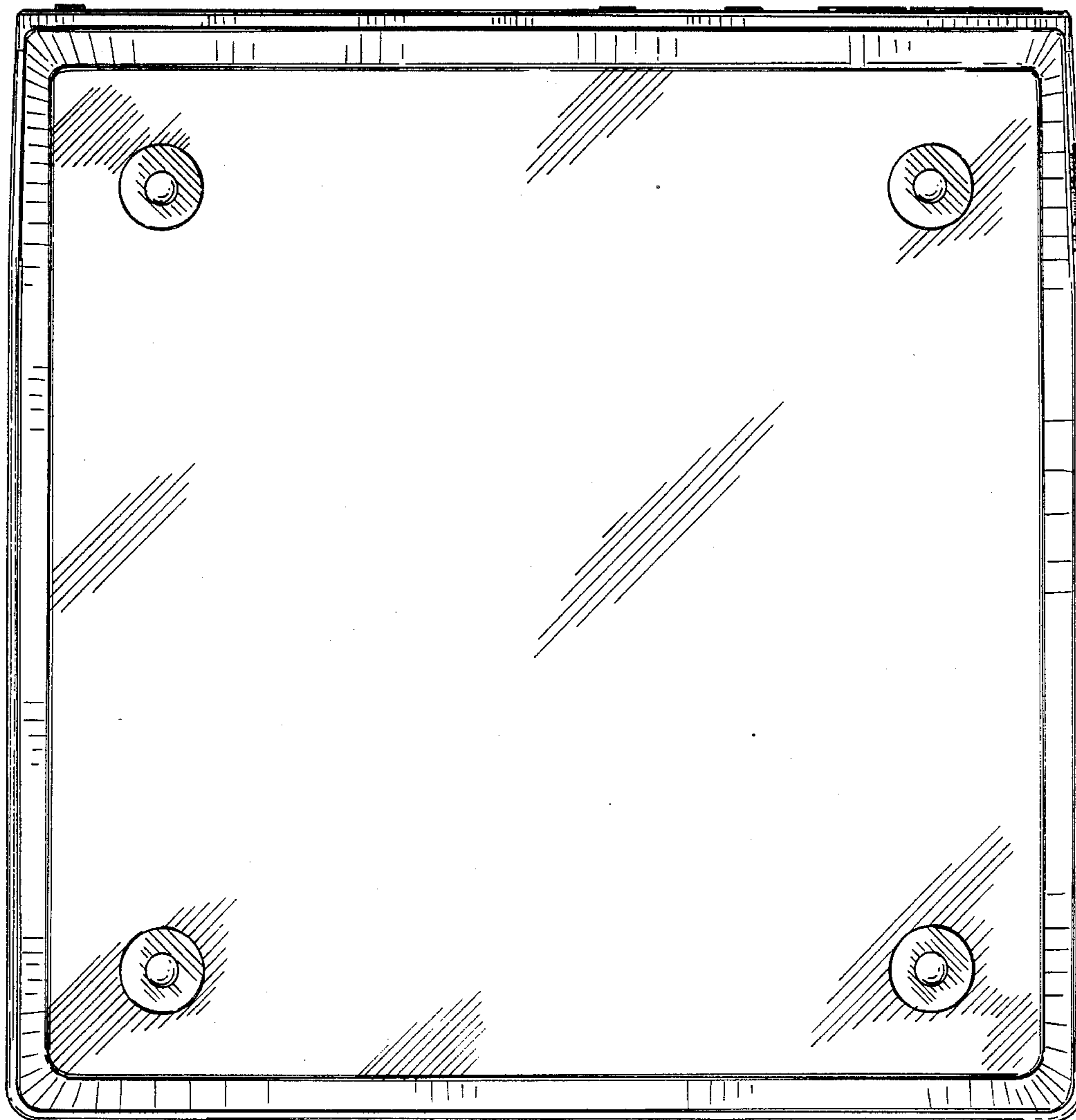

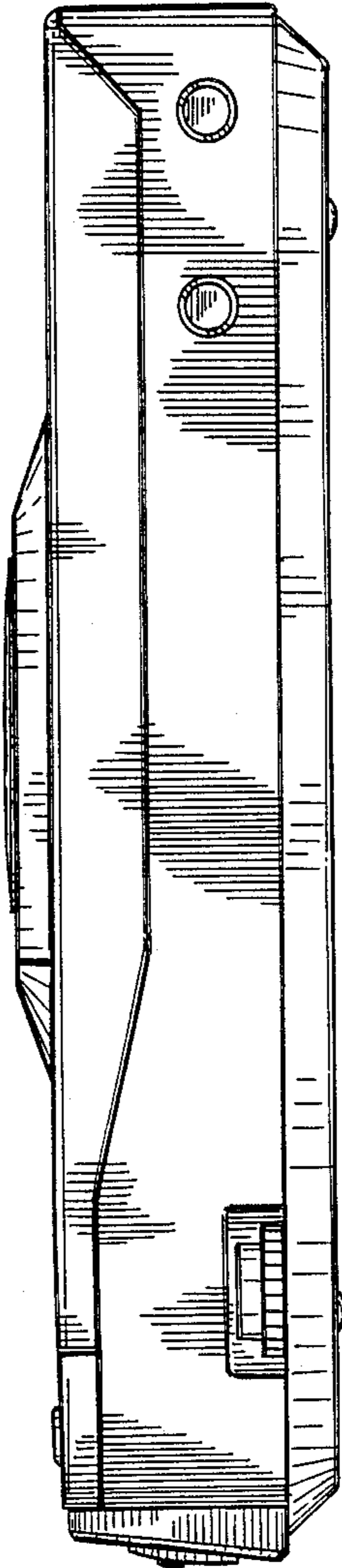
