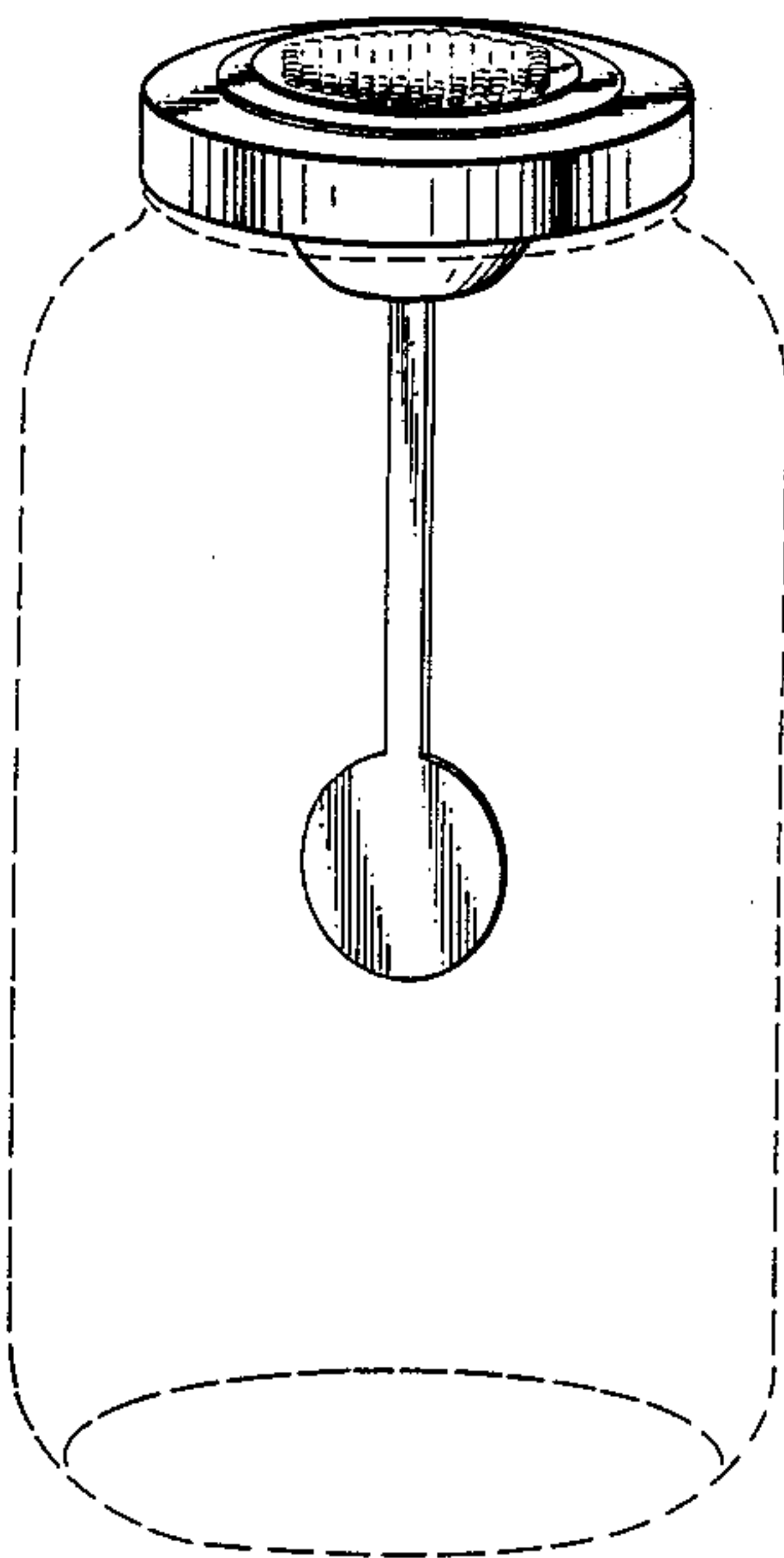


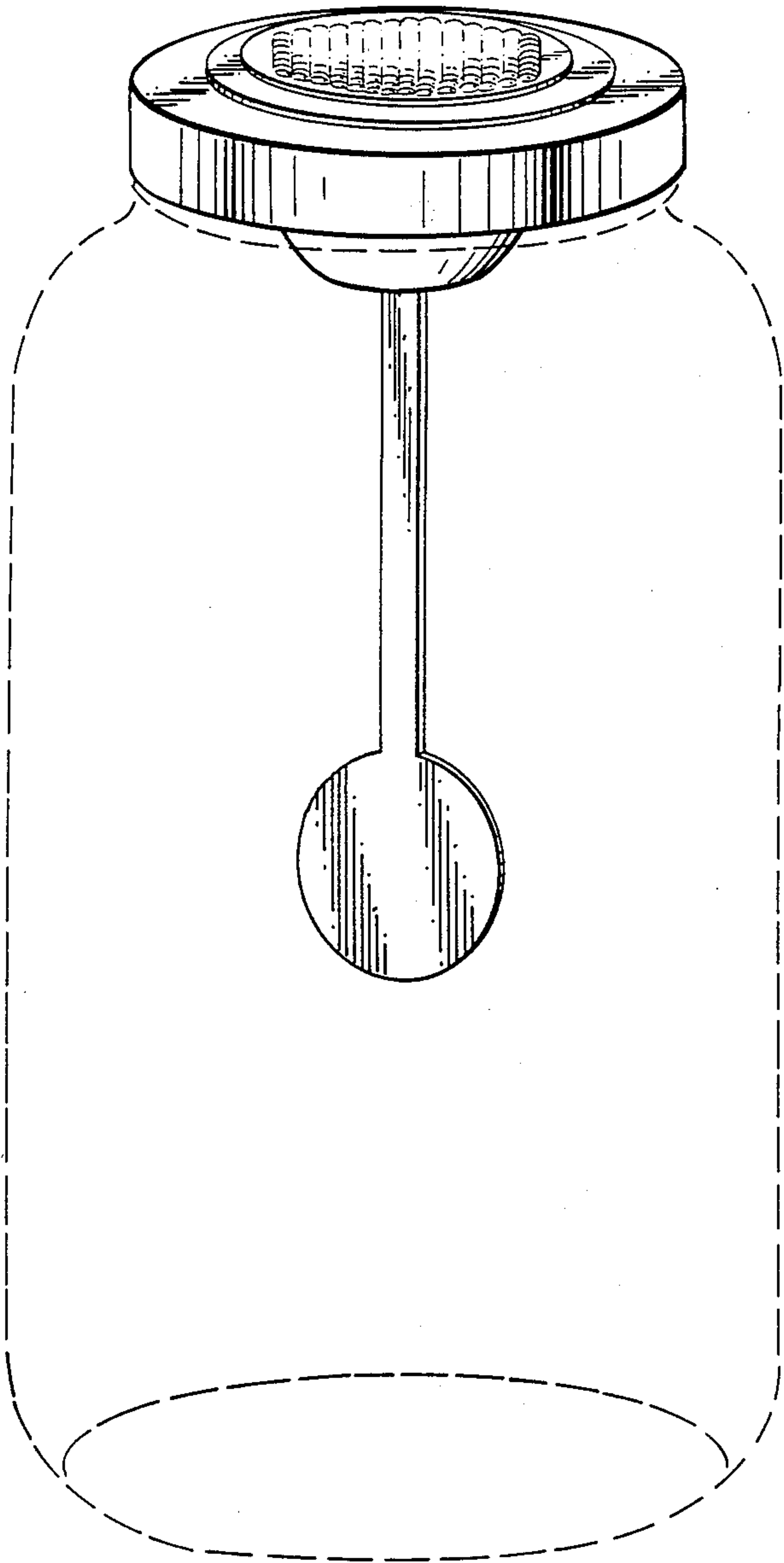

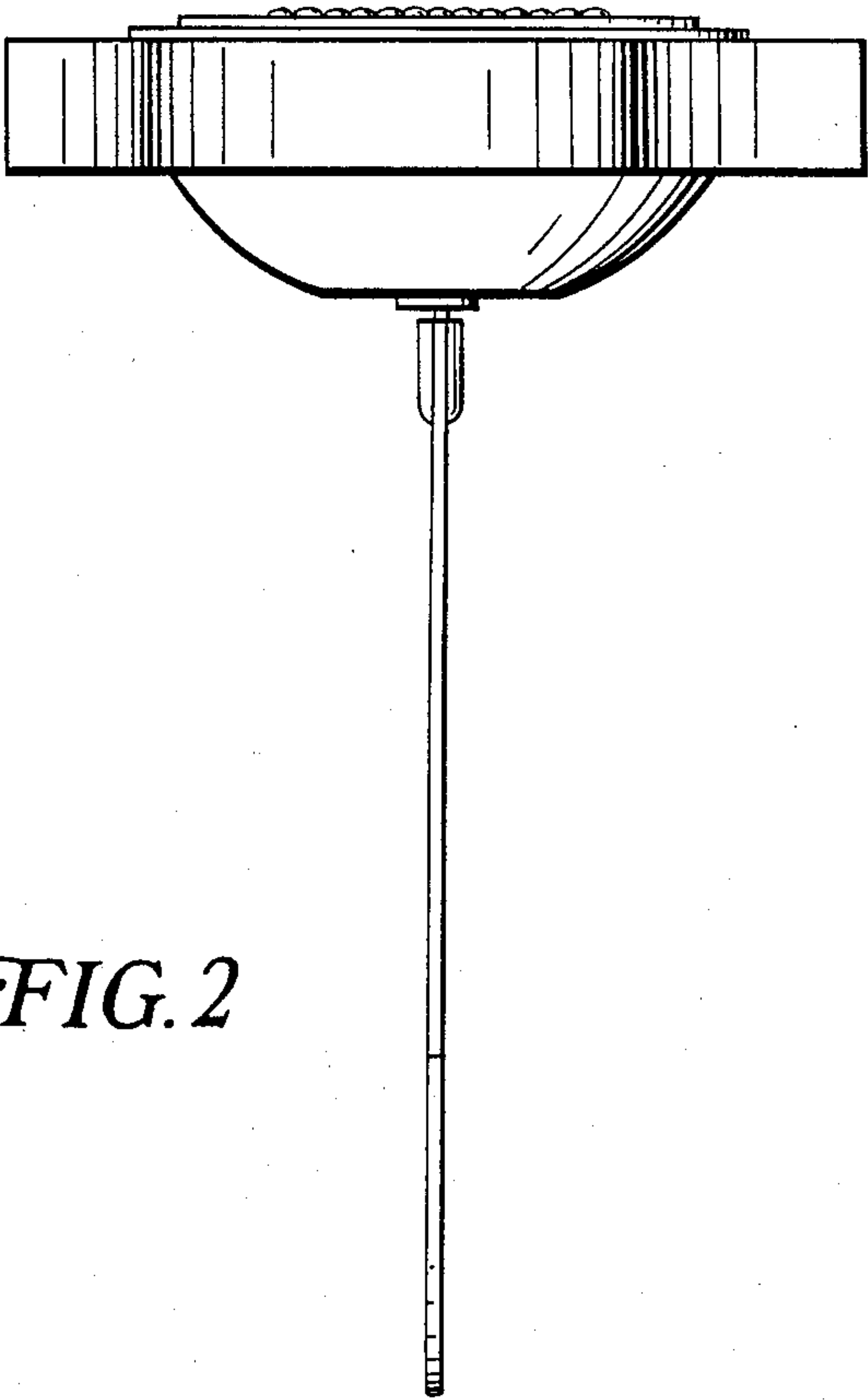
[57] CLAIM  
The ornamental design for solar tea stirrer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION  
FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a solar tea stirrer showing my new design, the bottle shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;  
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



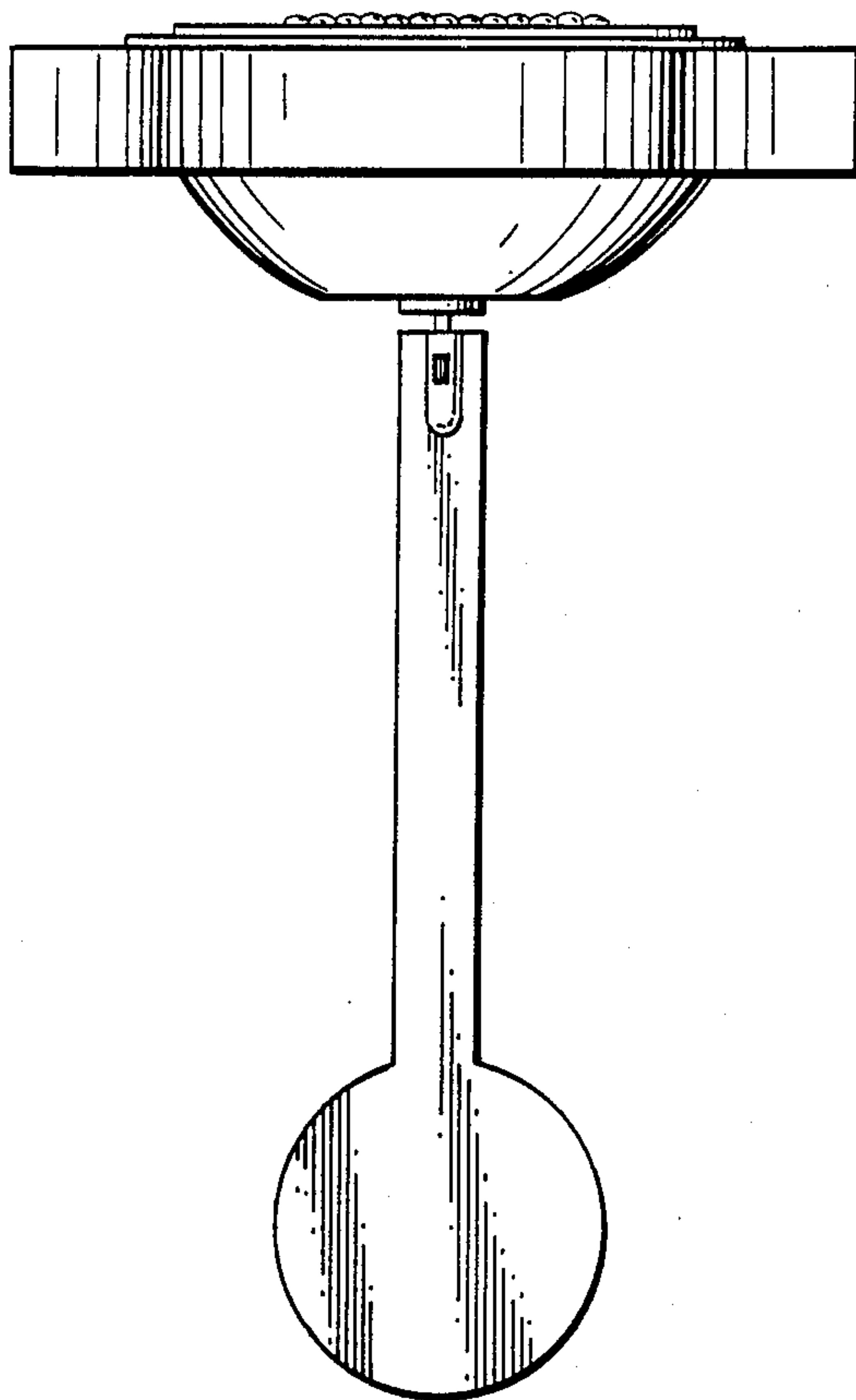

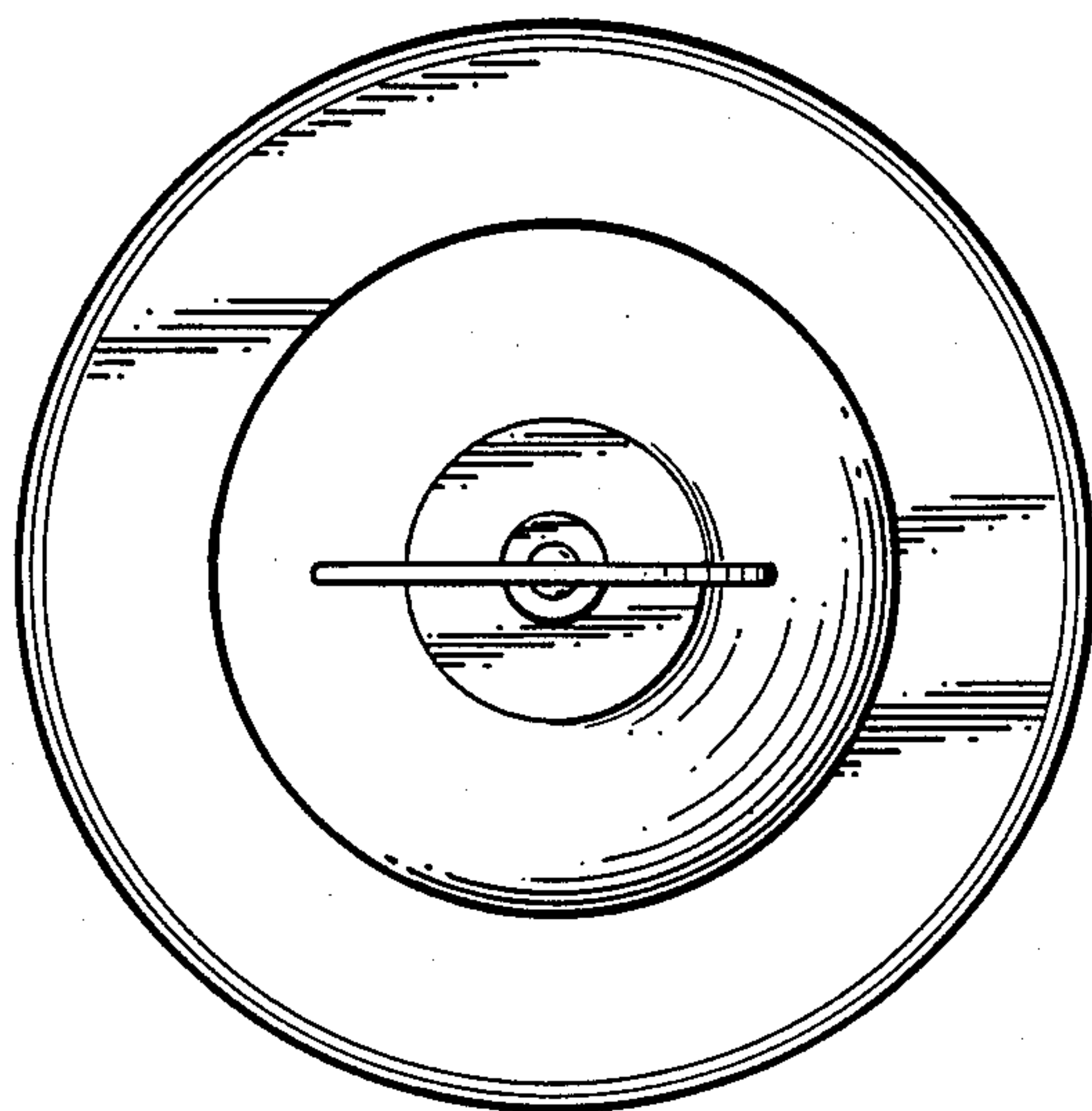
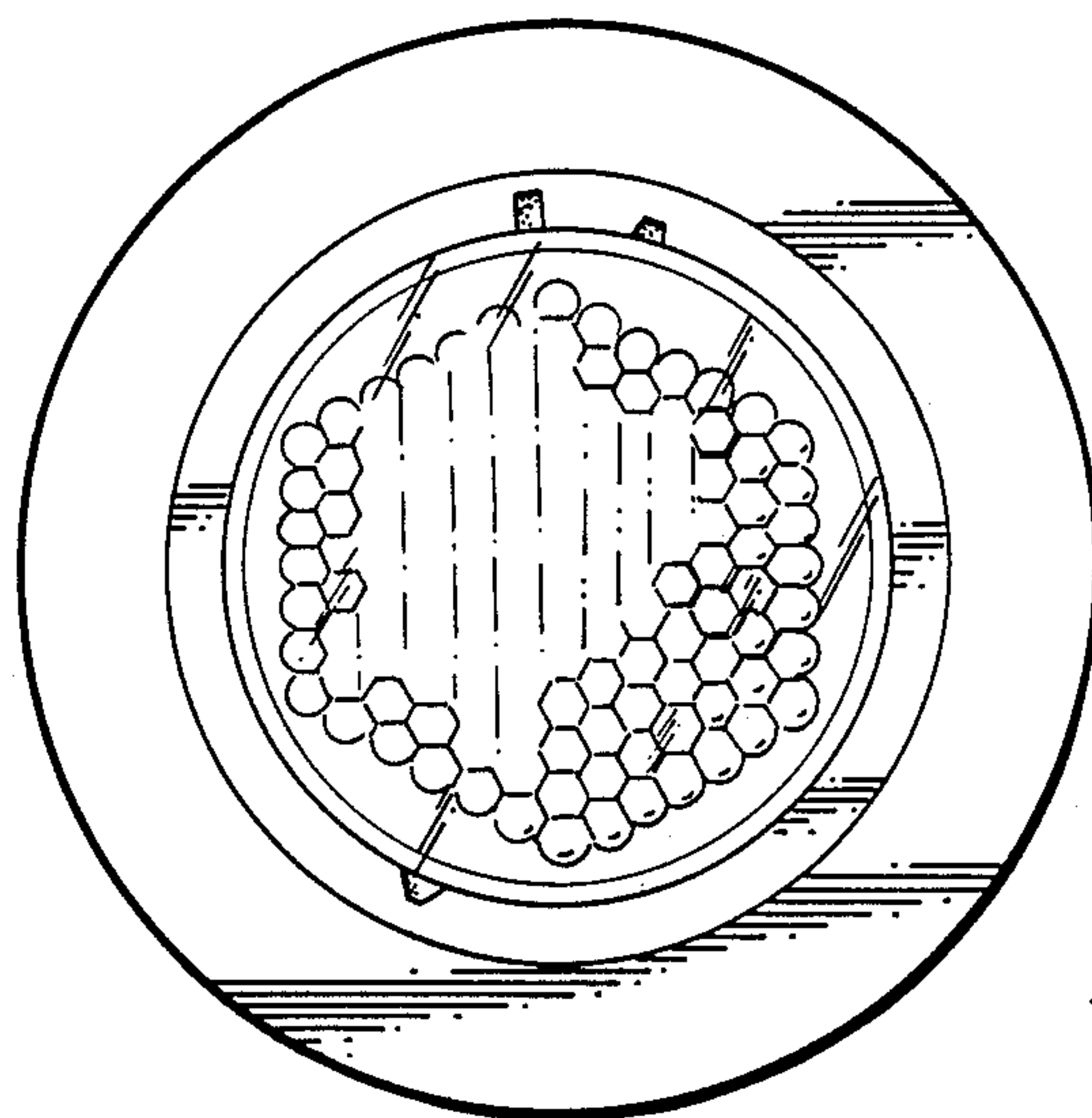
