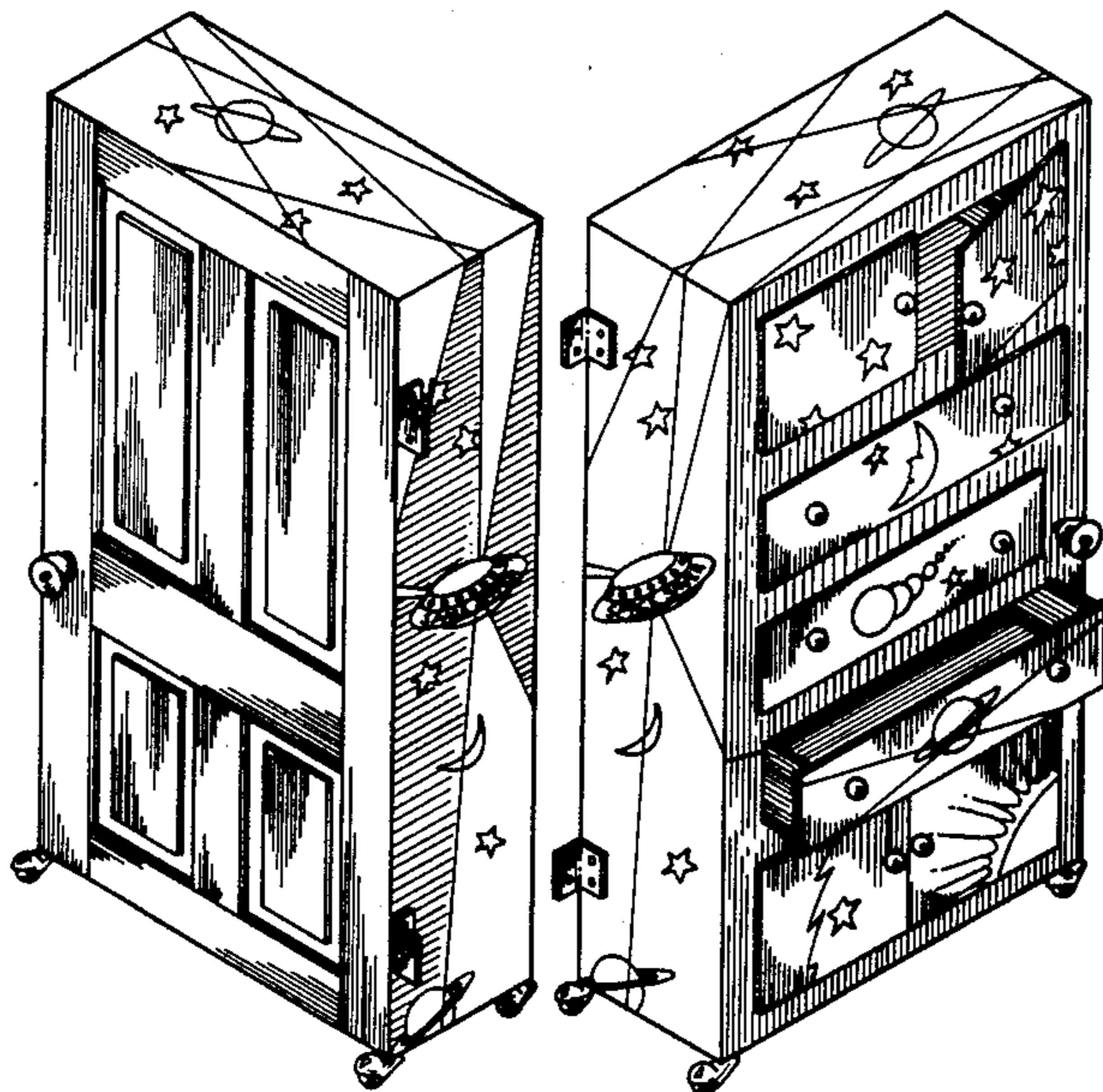
[57] CLAIM

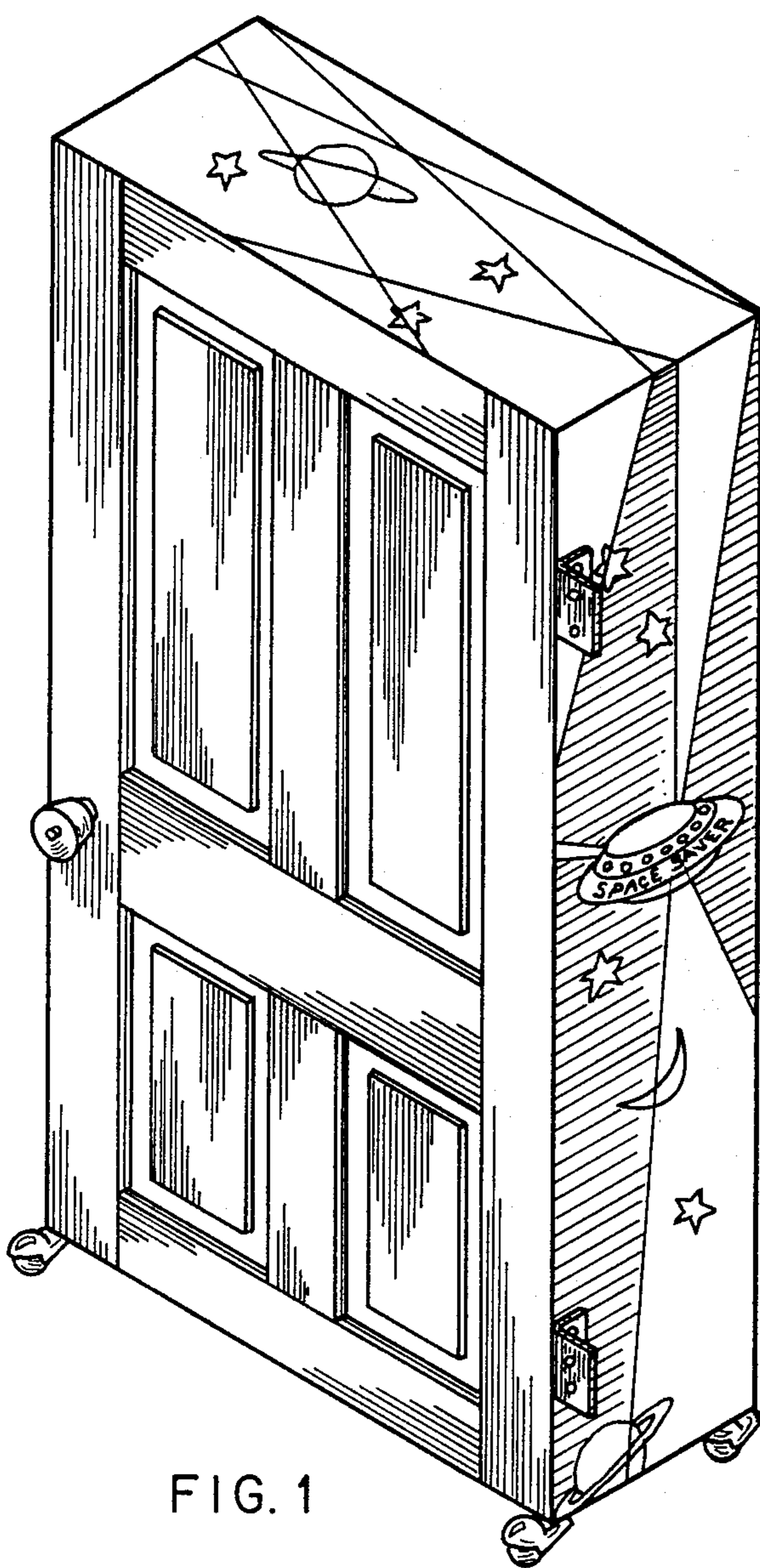

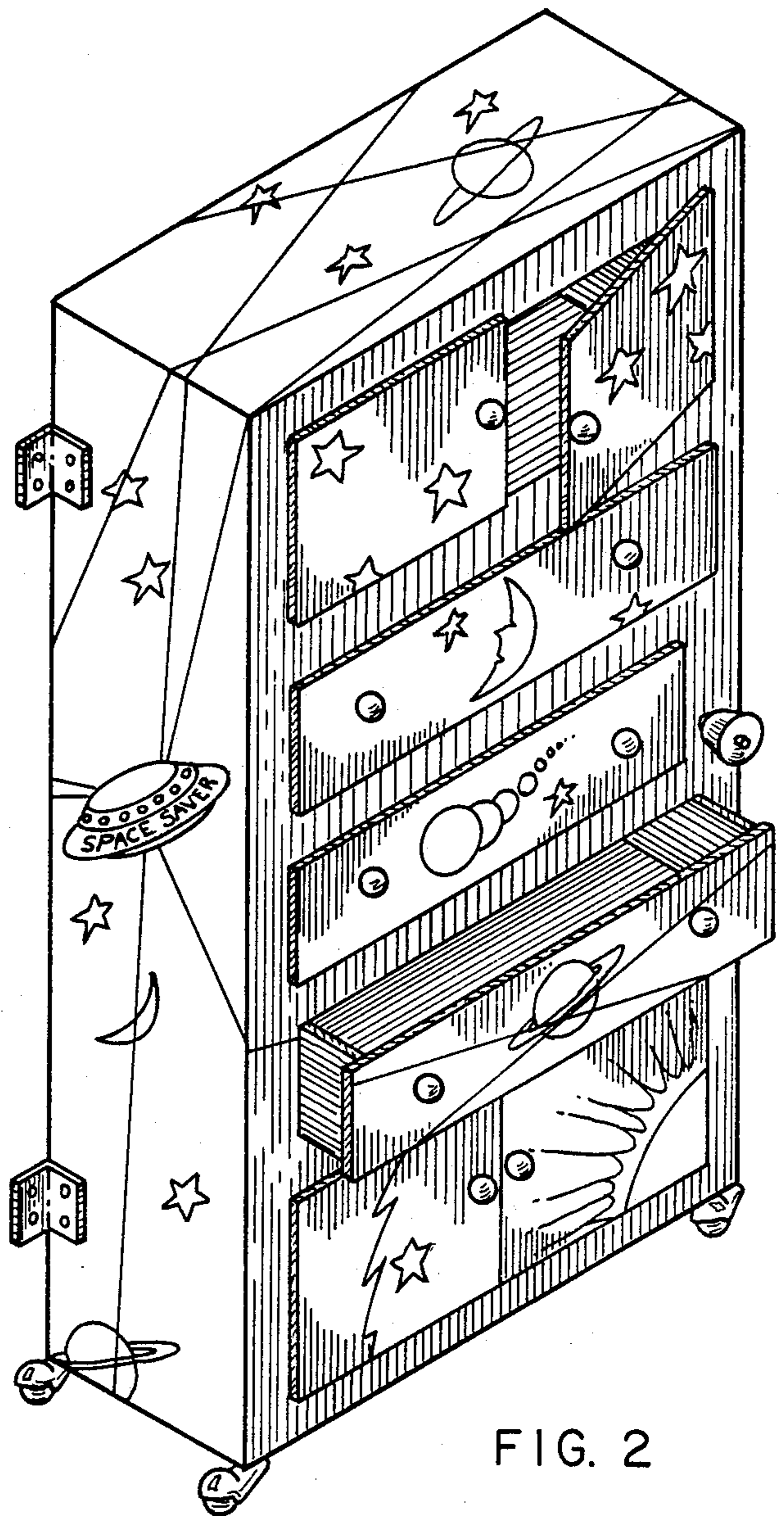

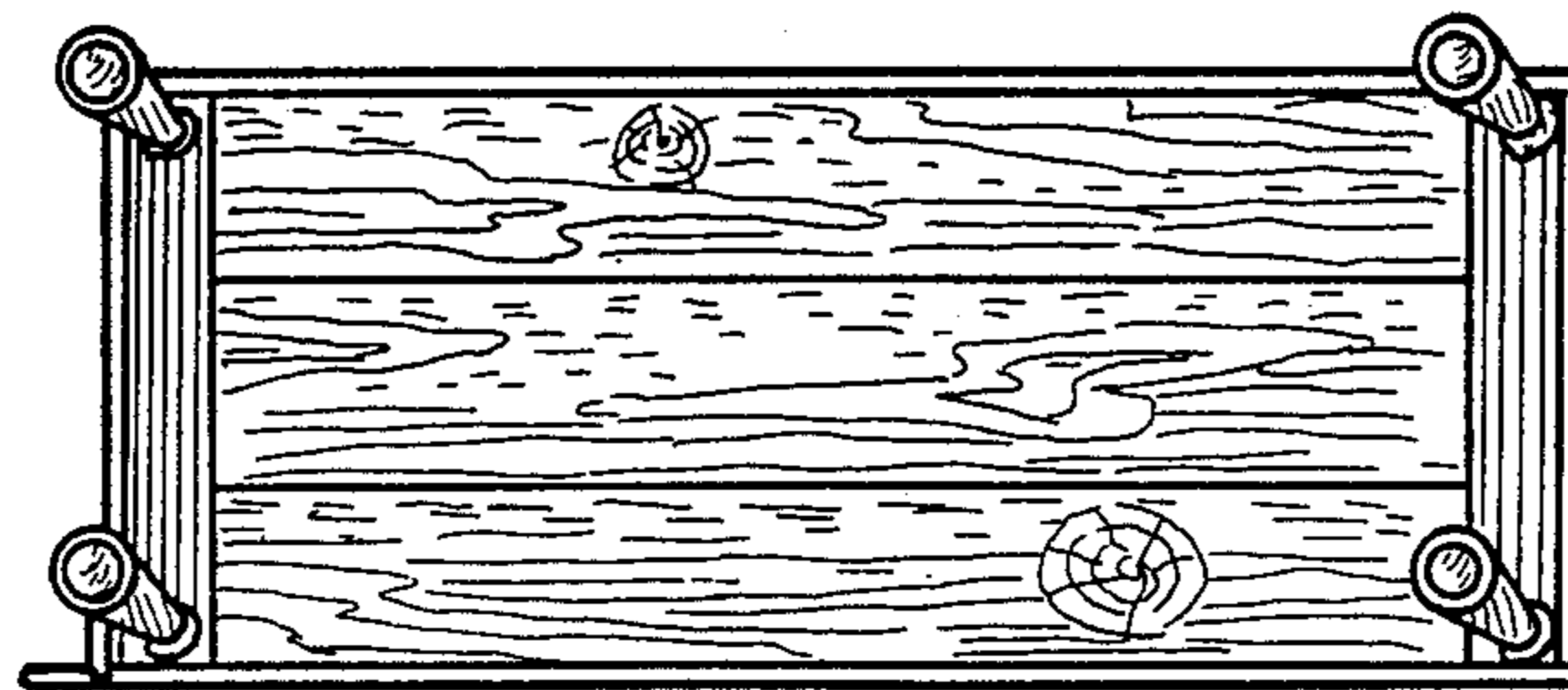
