FIG. 1 is an electronic display device for shopping carts showing my new design, with the broken lines shown for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 8 is an opposite end elevational view thereof.

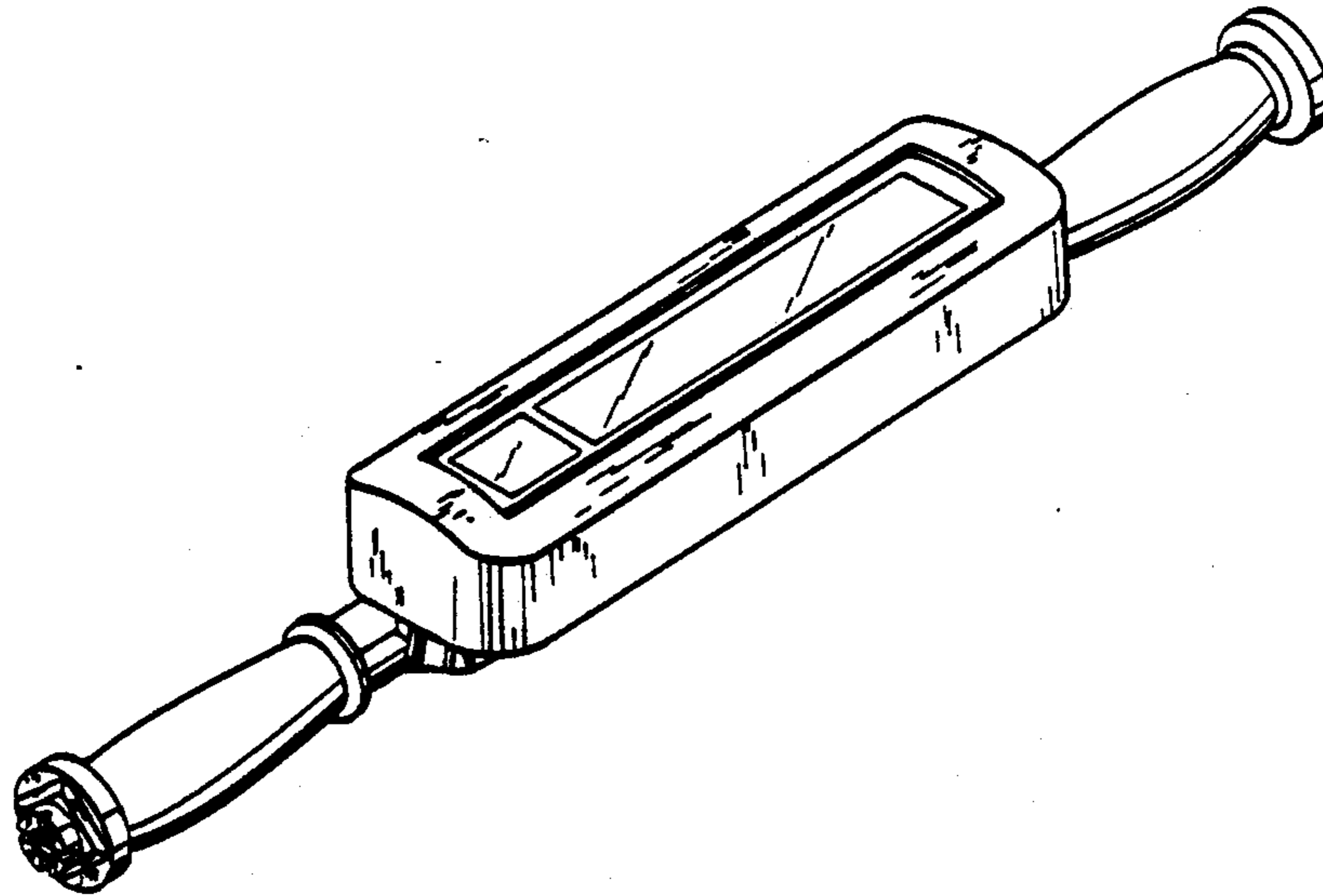
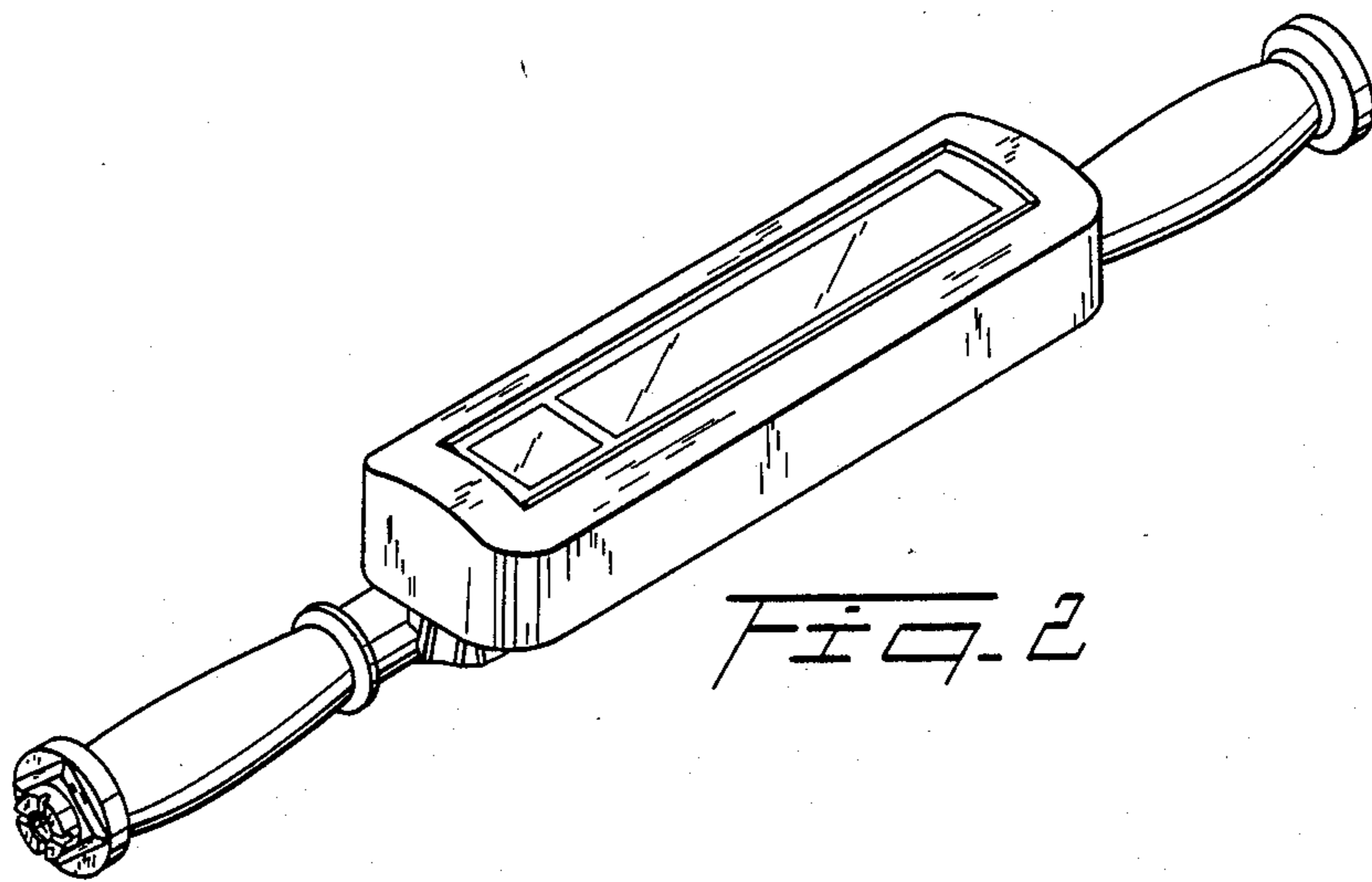

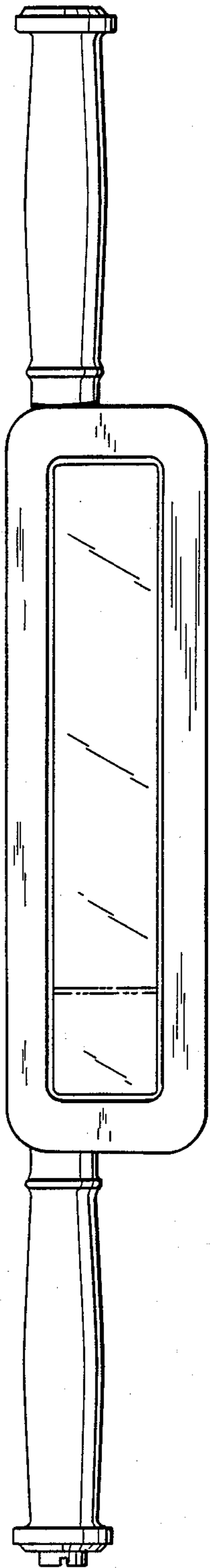

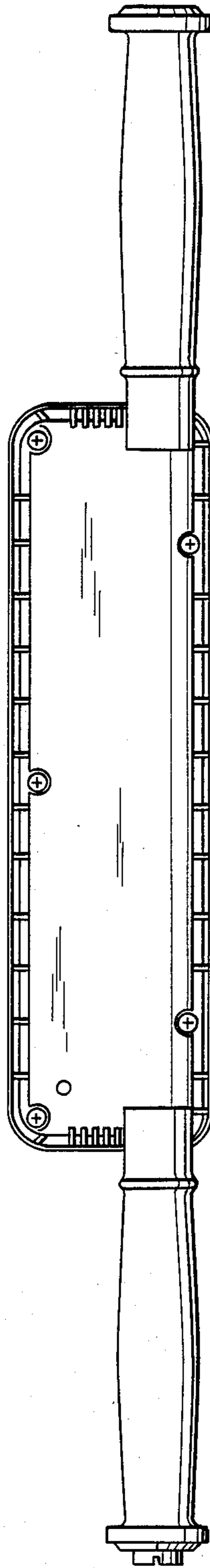

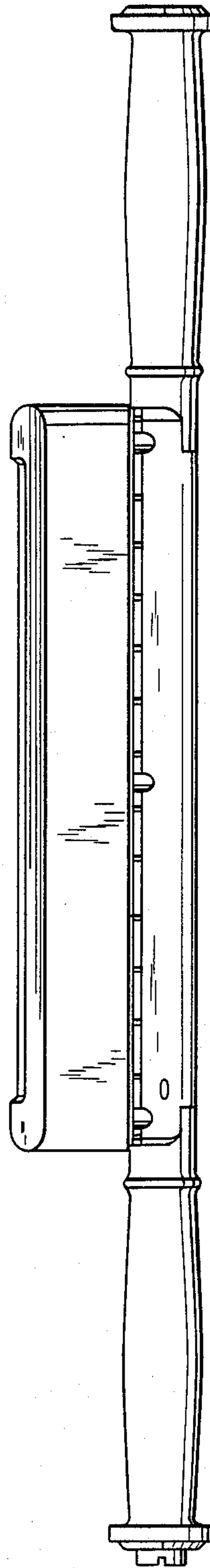

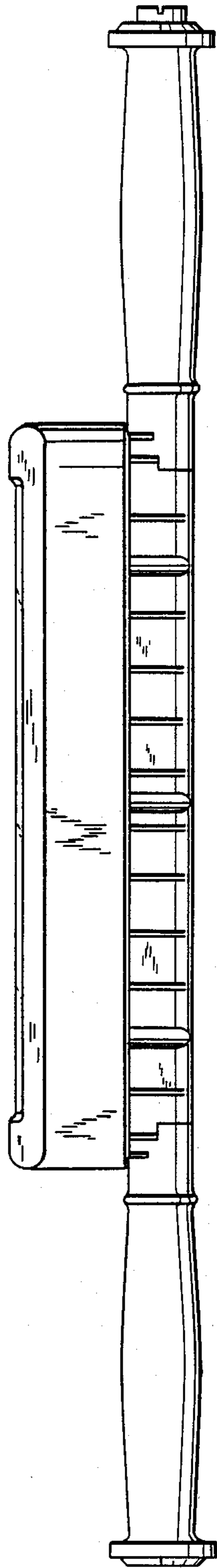

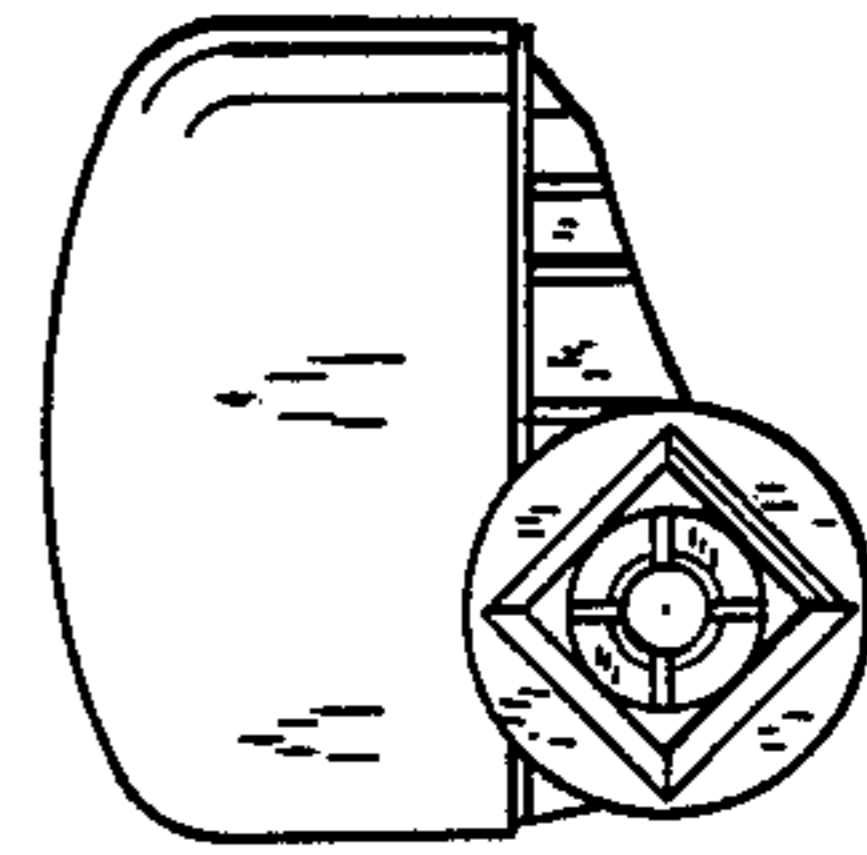

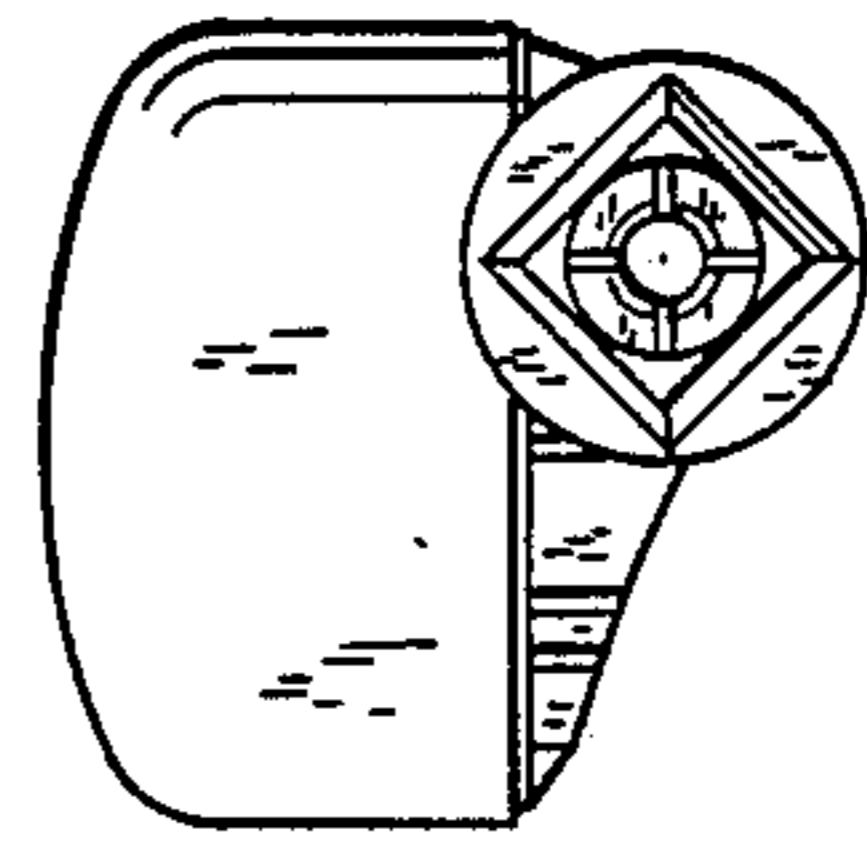
