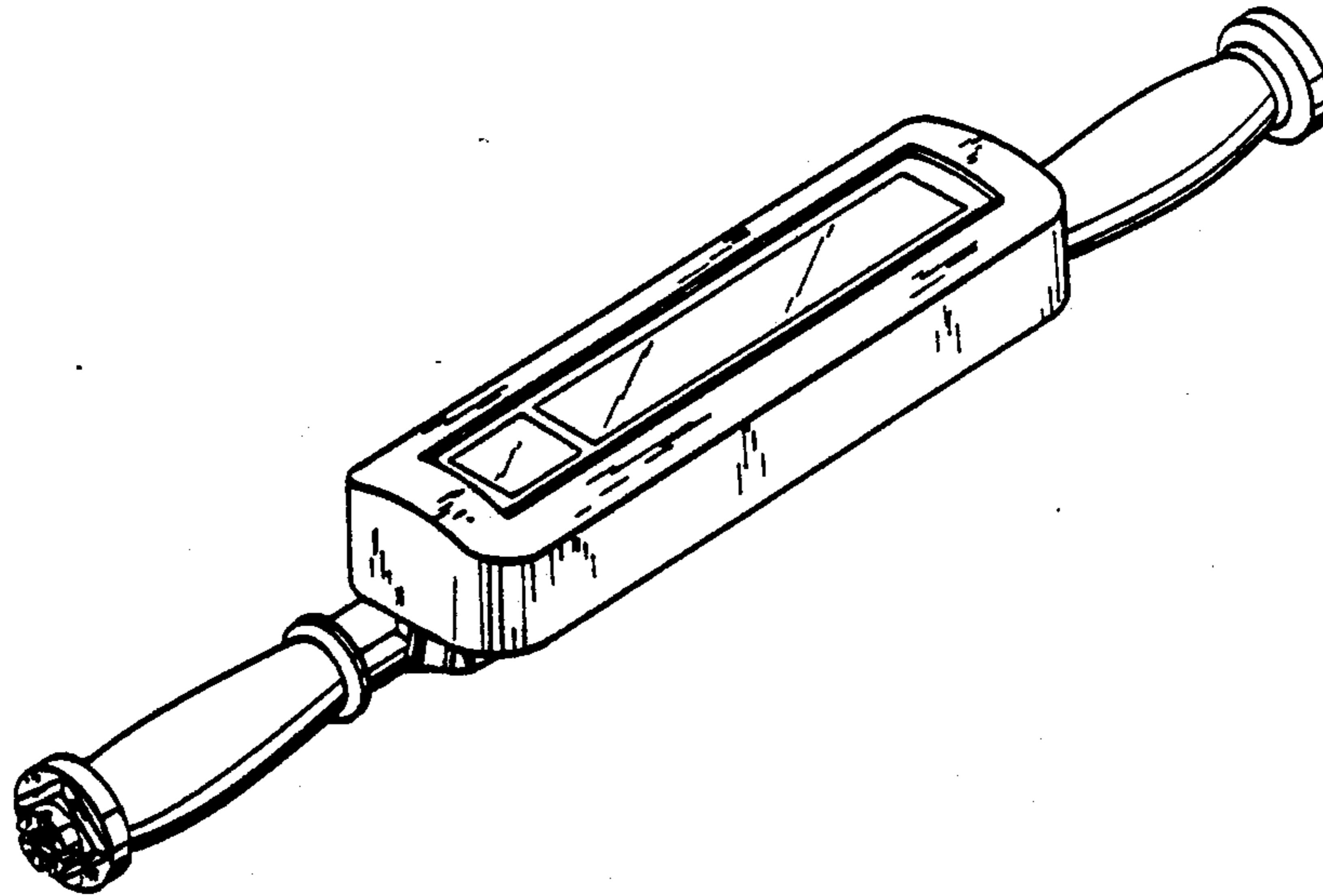

**DESCRIPTION**

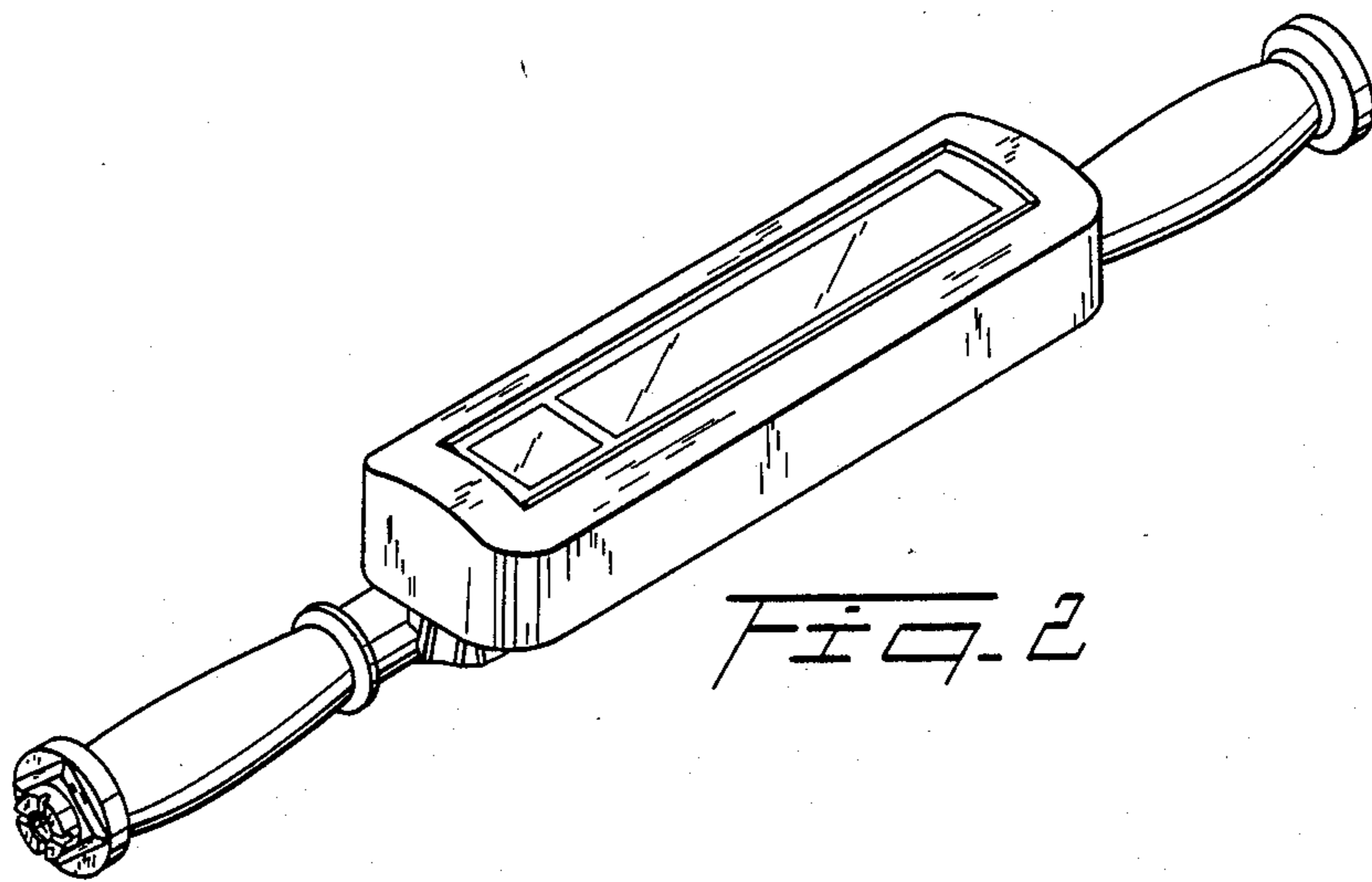
FIG. 1 is an electronic display device for shopping carts showing my new design, with the broken lines shown for illustrative purposes only;

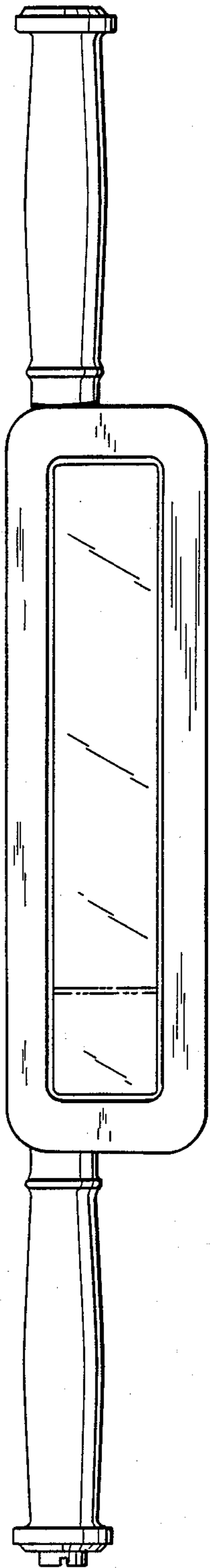

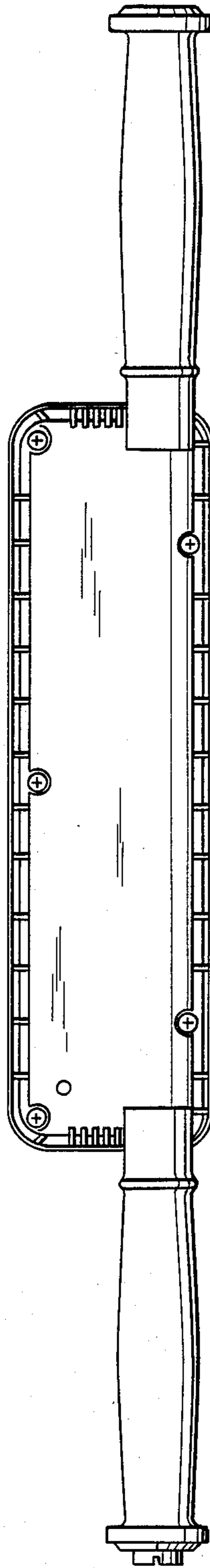

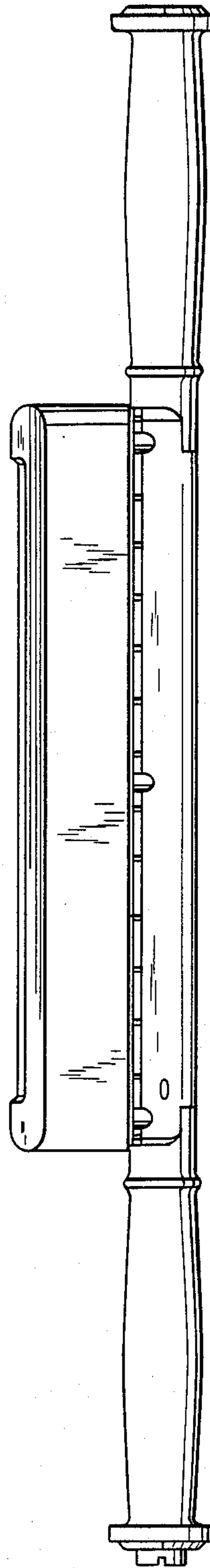

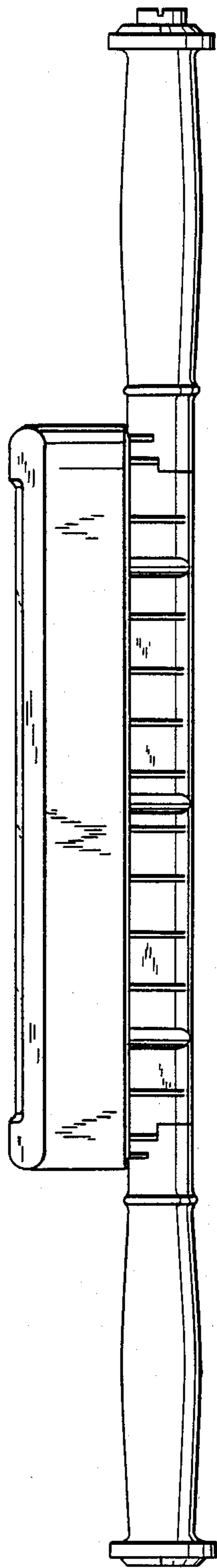

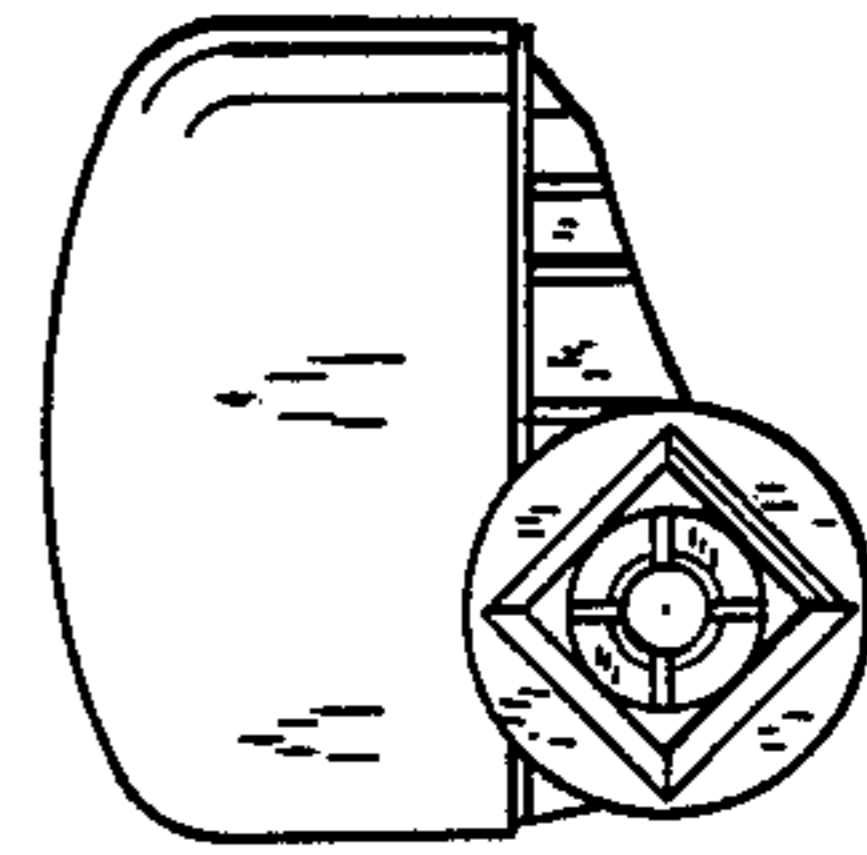

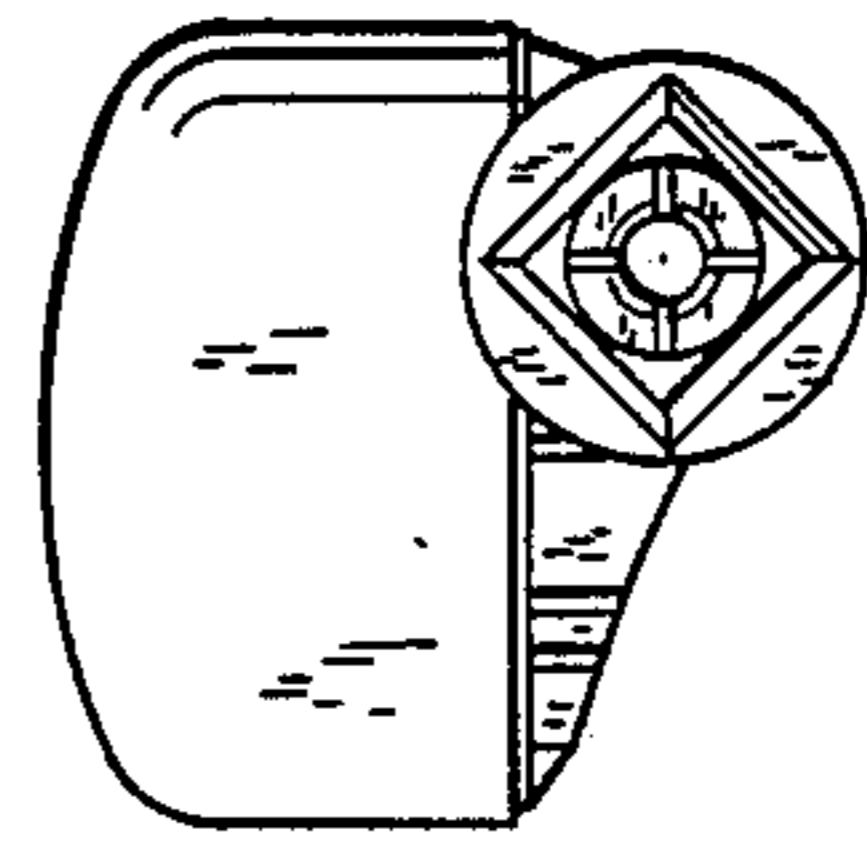
