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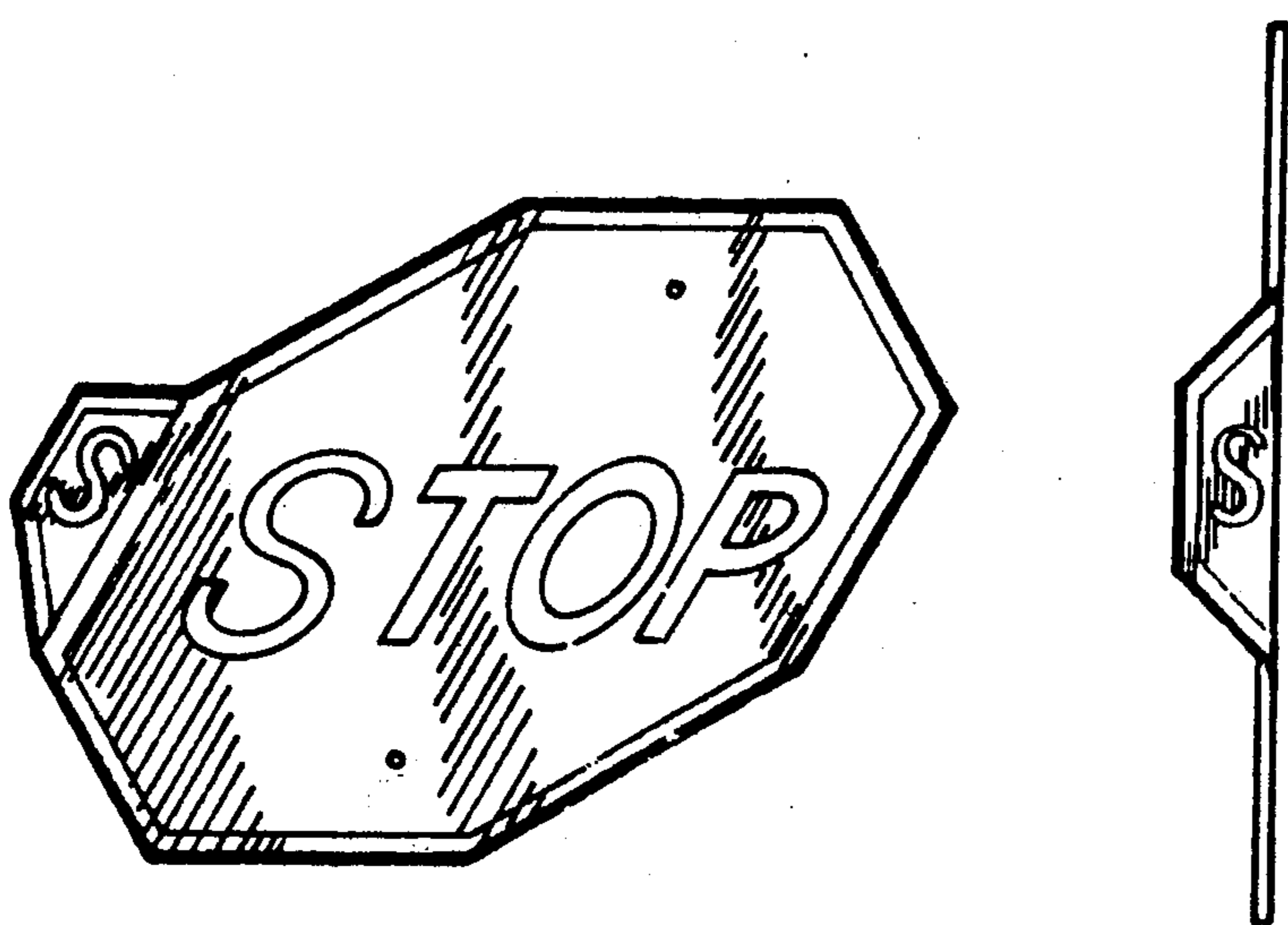

The ornamental design of a stop sign with lateral identification panels for cross traffic, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a stop sign with lateral identification panels for cross traffic showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view being a mirror image; and  
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image.



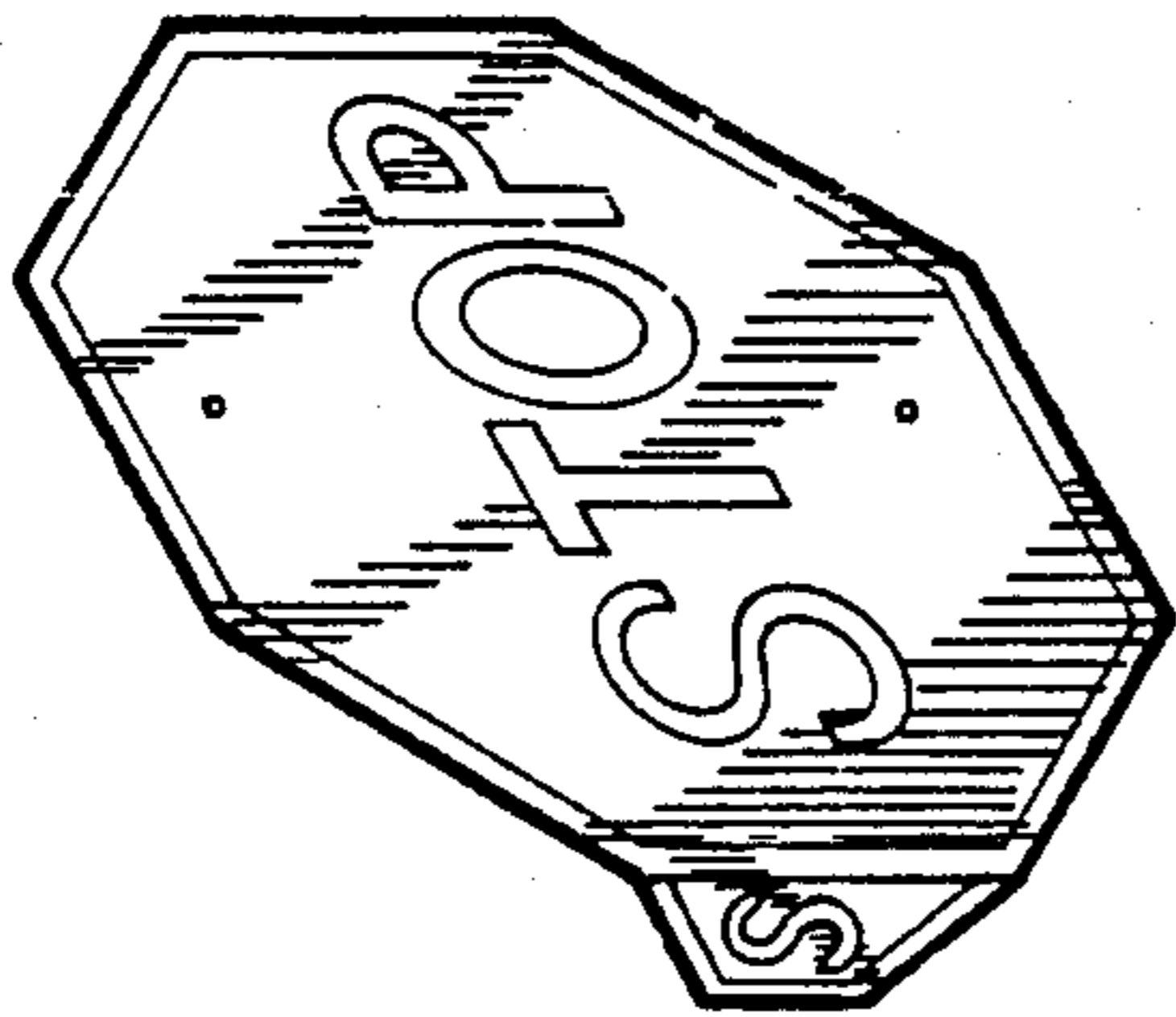

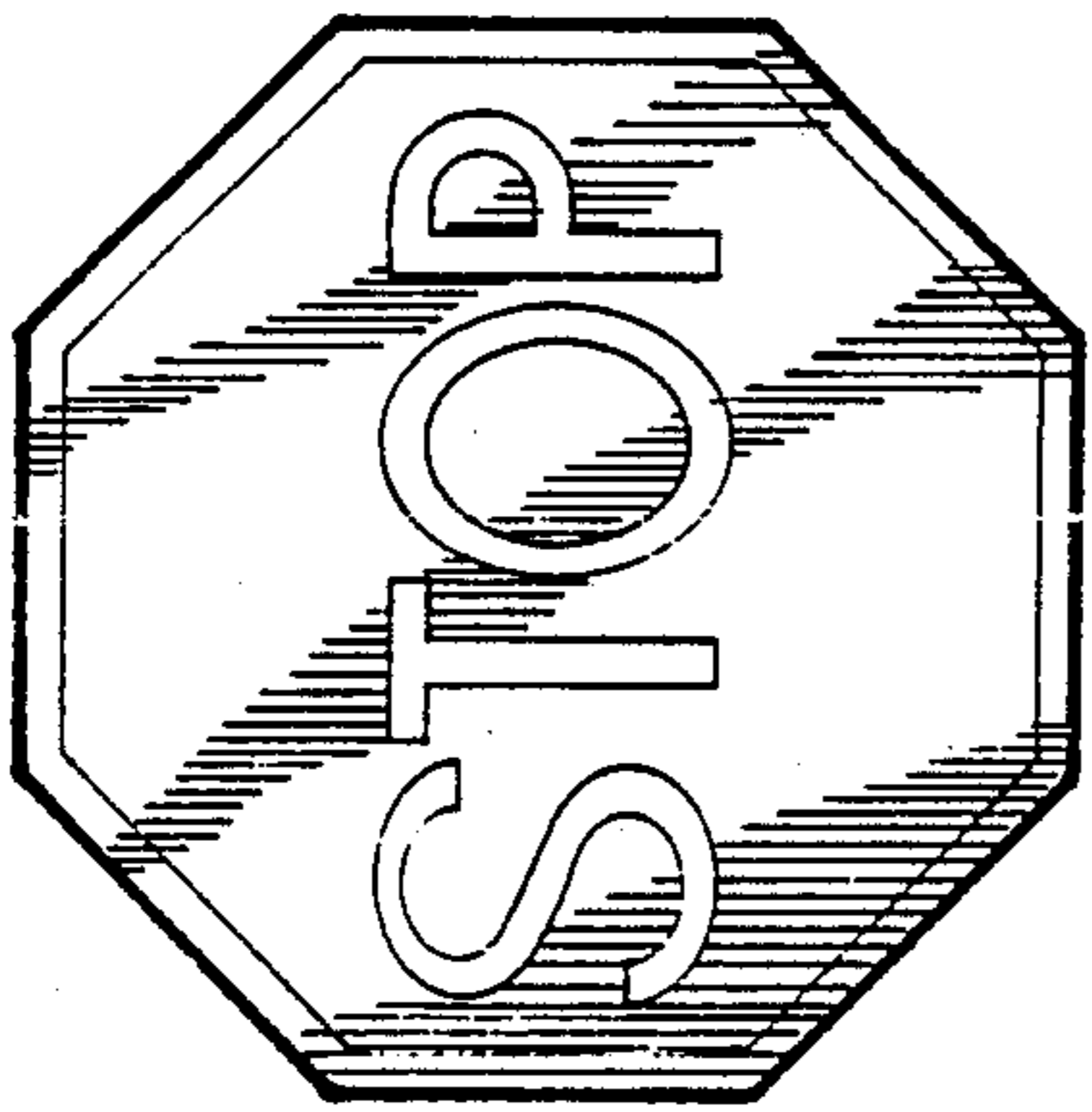

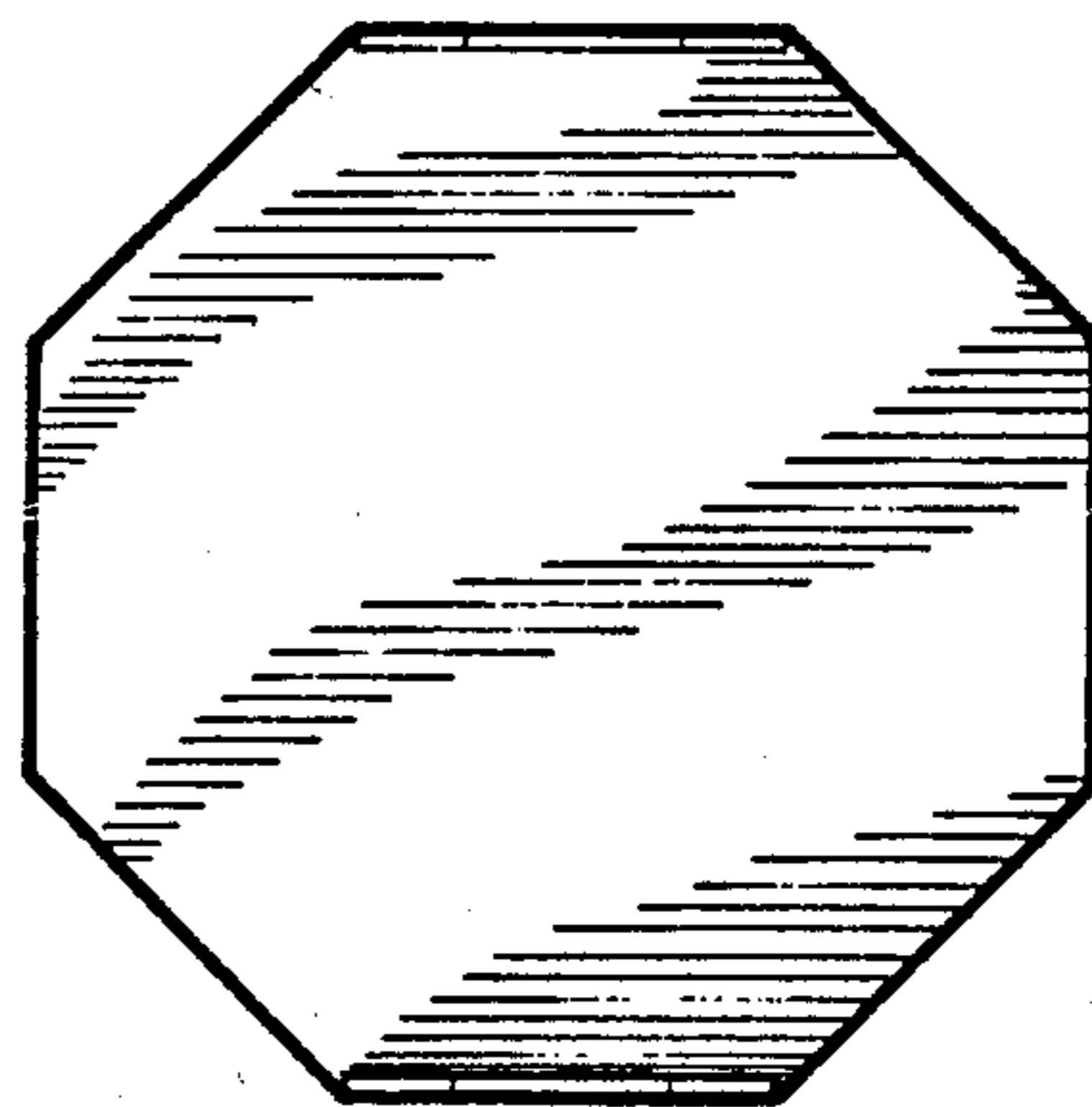
