The ornamental design for the lapel button, as shown and described.

## **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a lapel button showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of a label button showing a second embodiment of my new design;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of a lapel button showing a third embodiment of my new design, the embodiment having a convex front surface and with a rear view as shown in FIG. 3;

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a lapel button showing a fourth embodiment of my new design, this embodiment being otherwise the same as the third embodiment.





FIG. 1 FIG. 2-B

The concentric shading of FIGS. 1, 4, 5 and 7 is indicative of iridescence.



