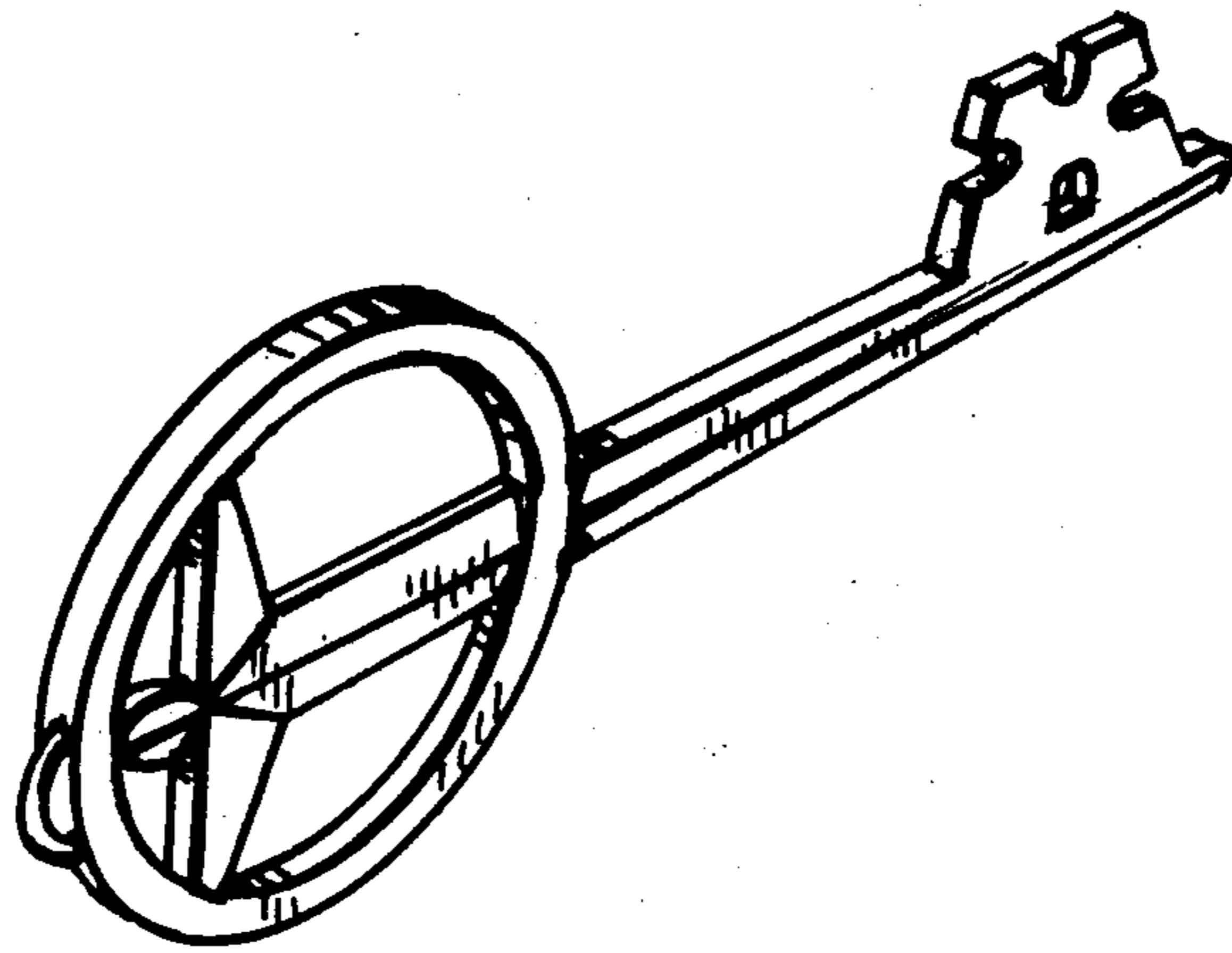

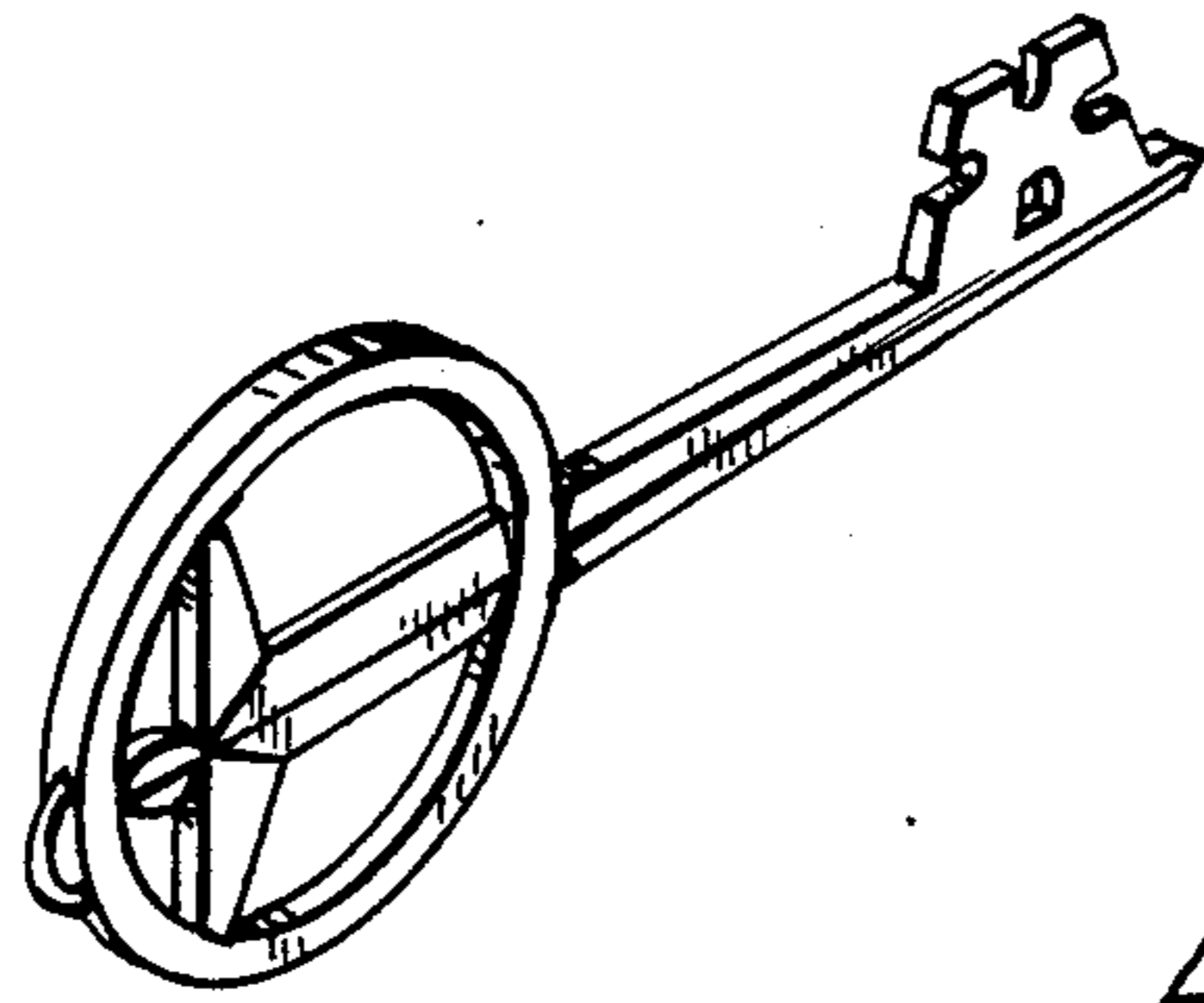
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cruciform key medal showing my new design;

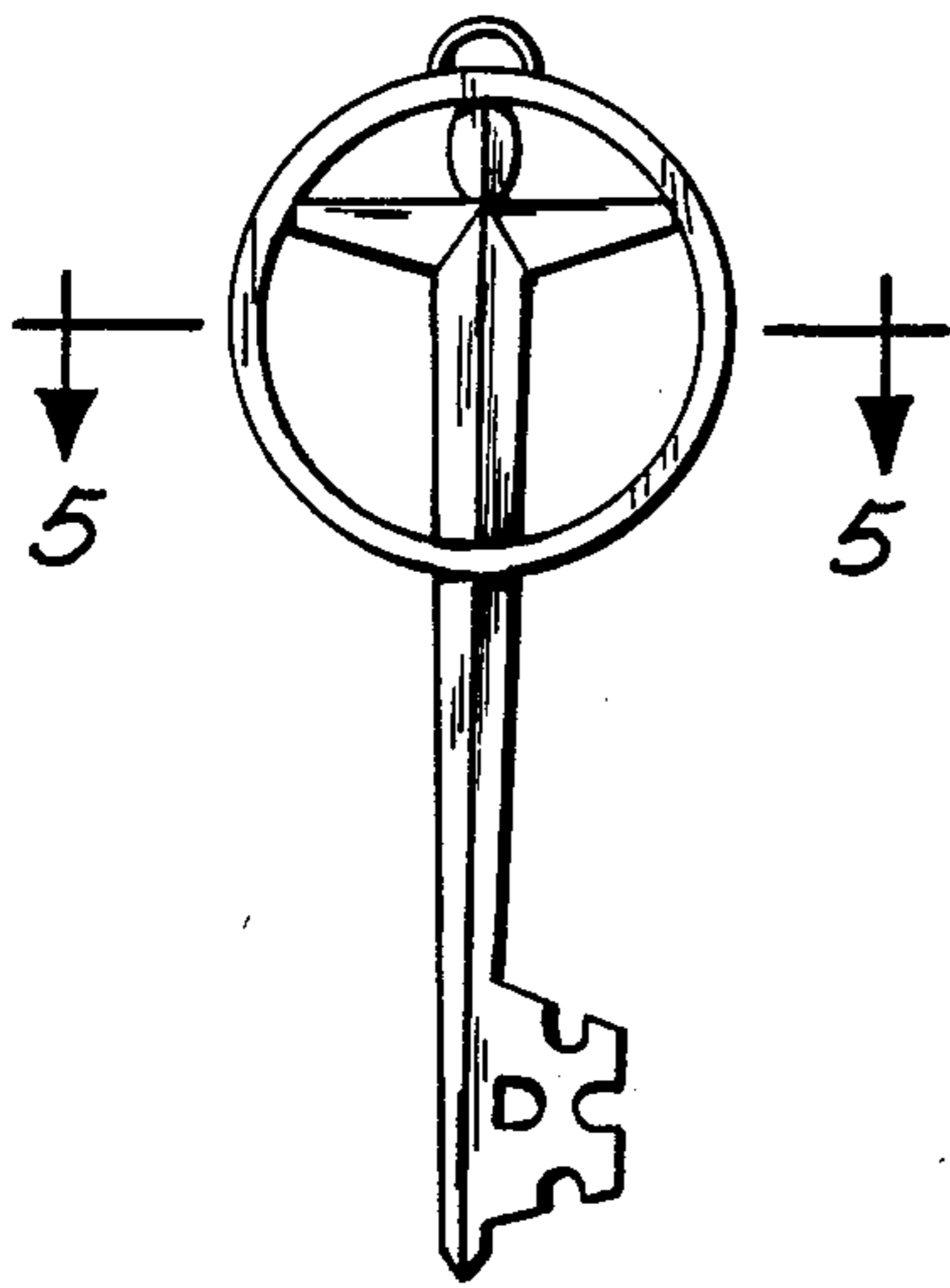

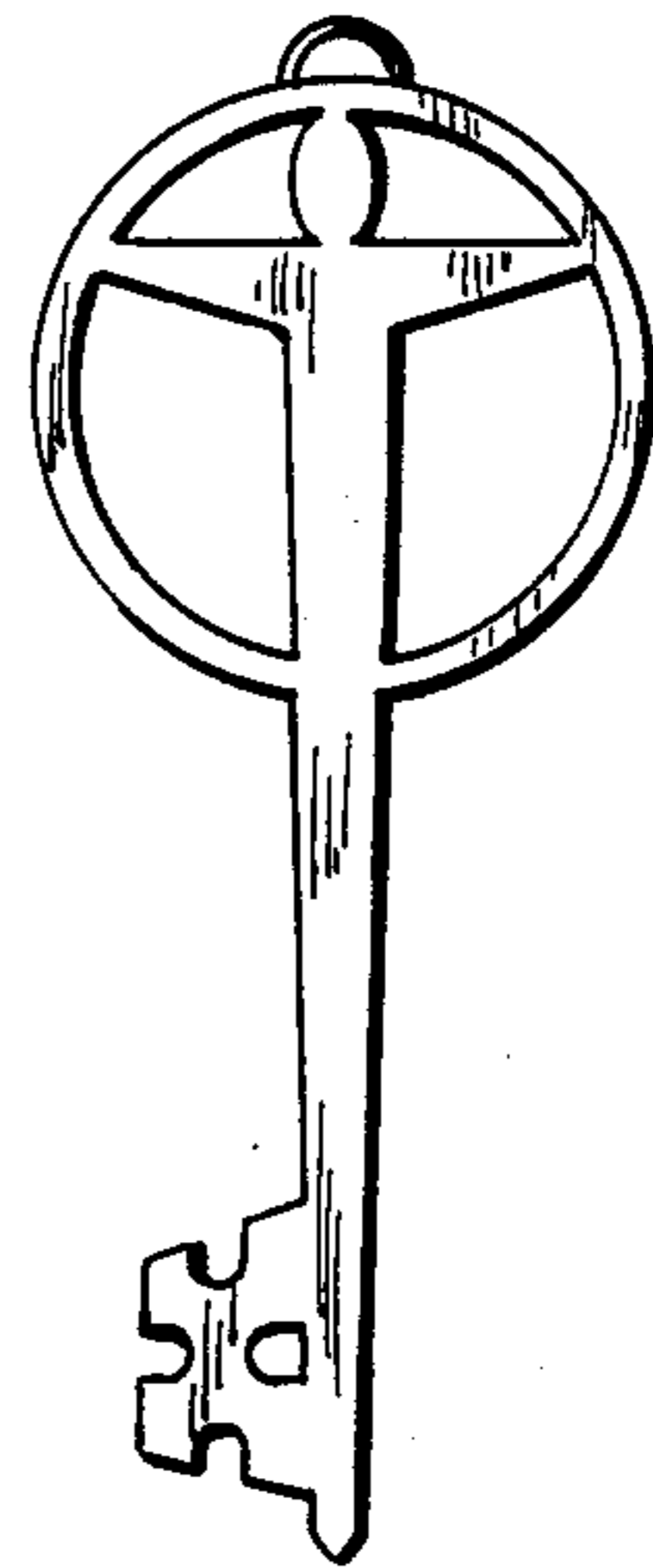

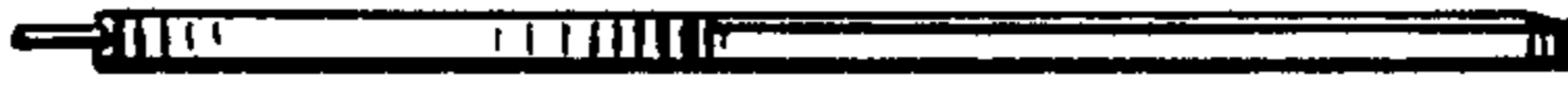
