DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a simulative toy pencil sharpener showing our new design;

 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a perspective view thereof with the front cover lifted; and
 FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof with the rear cover lifted.

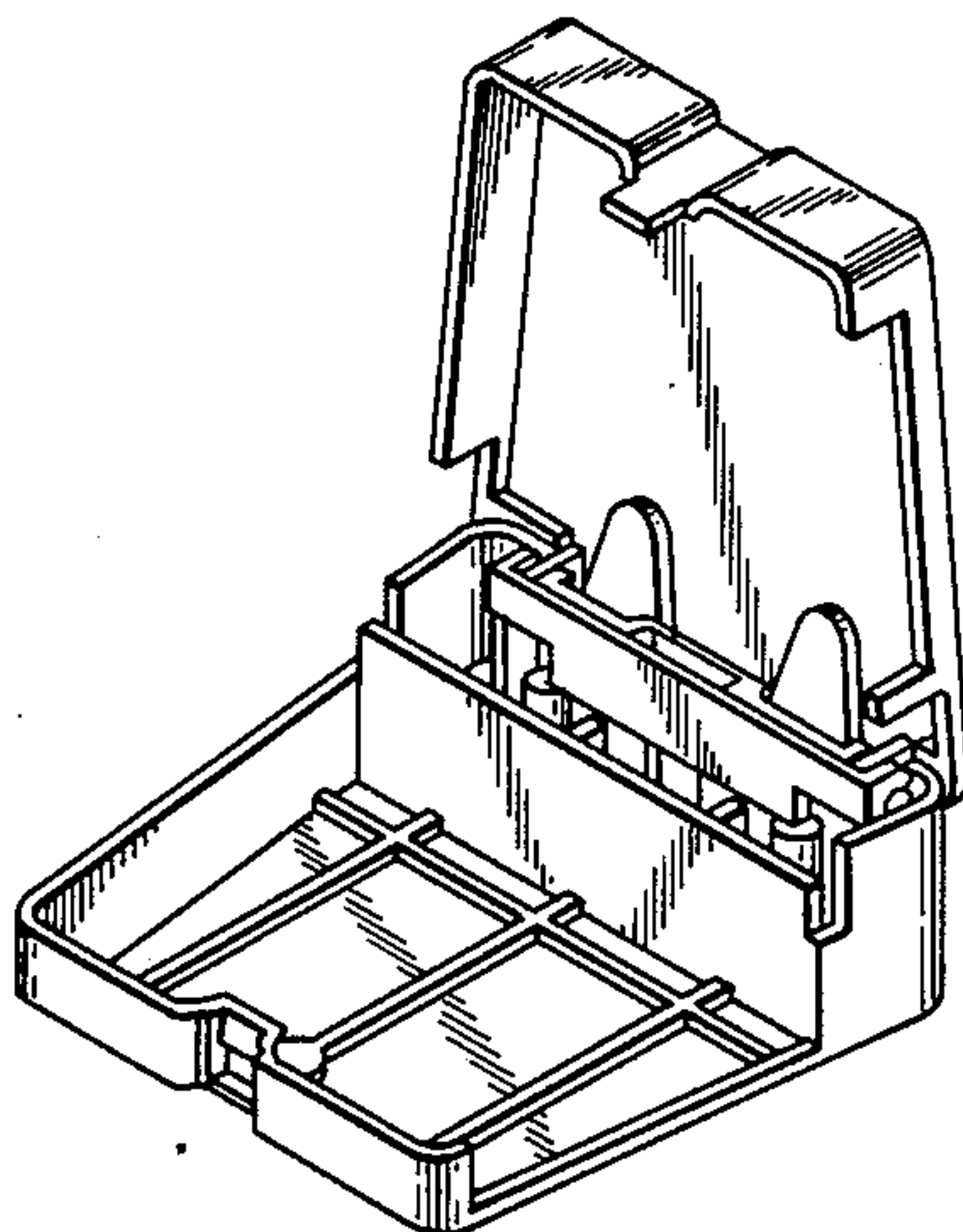
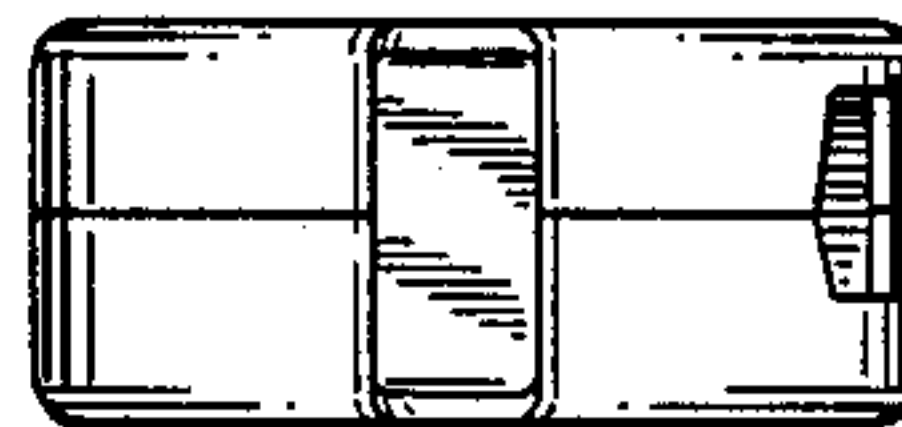

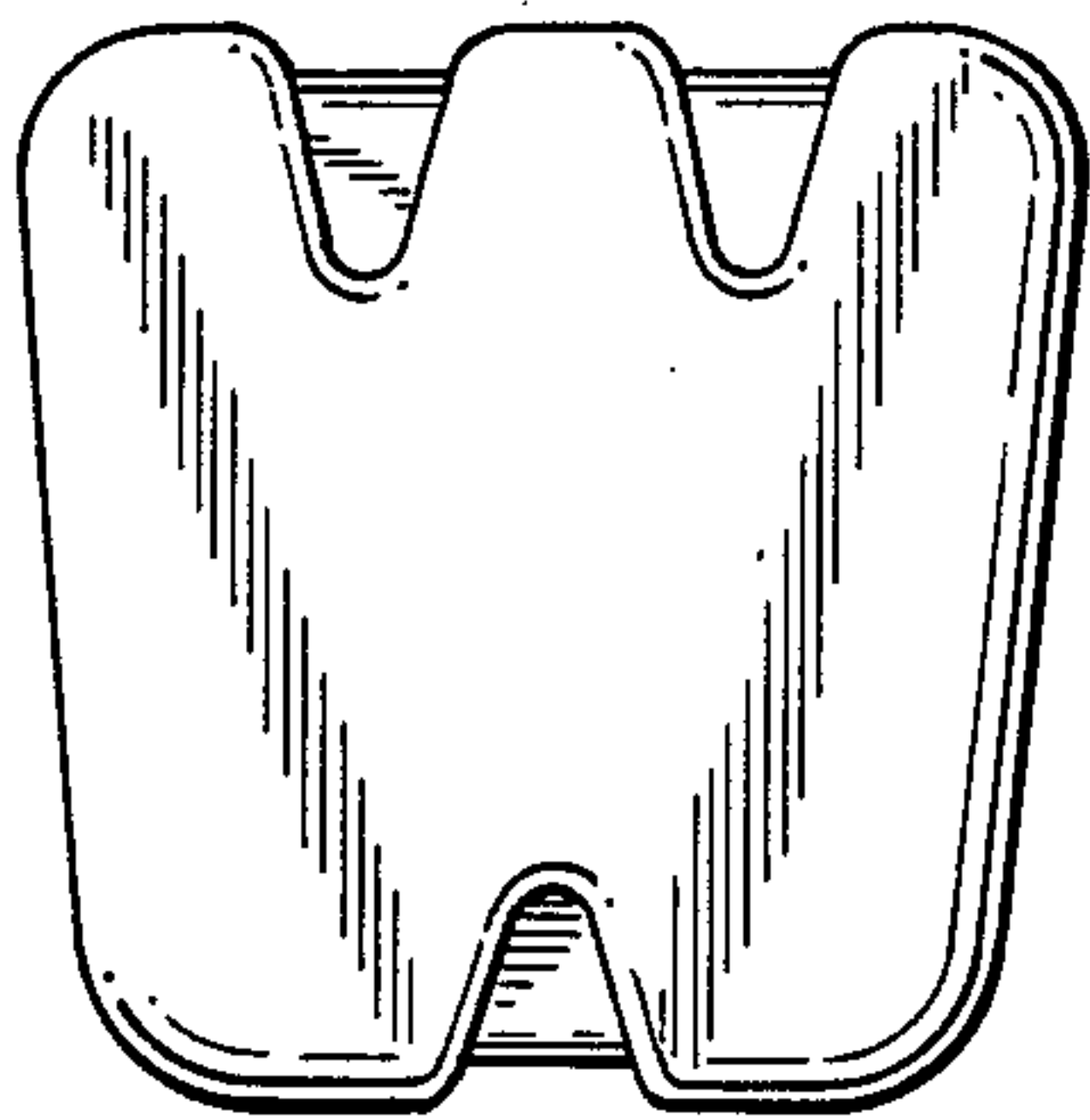

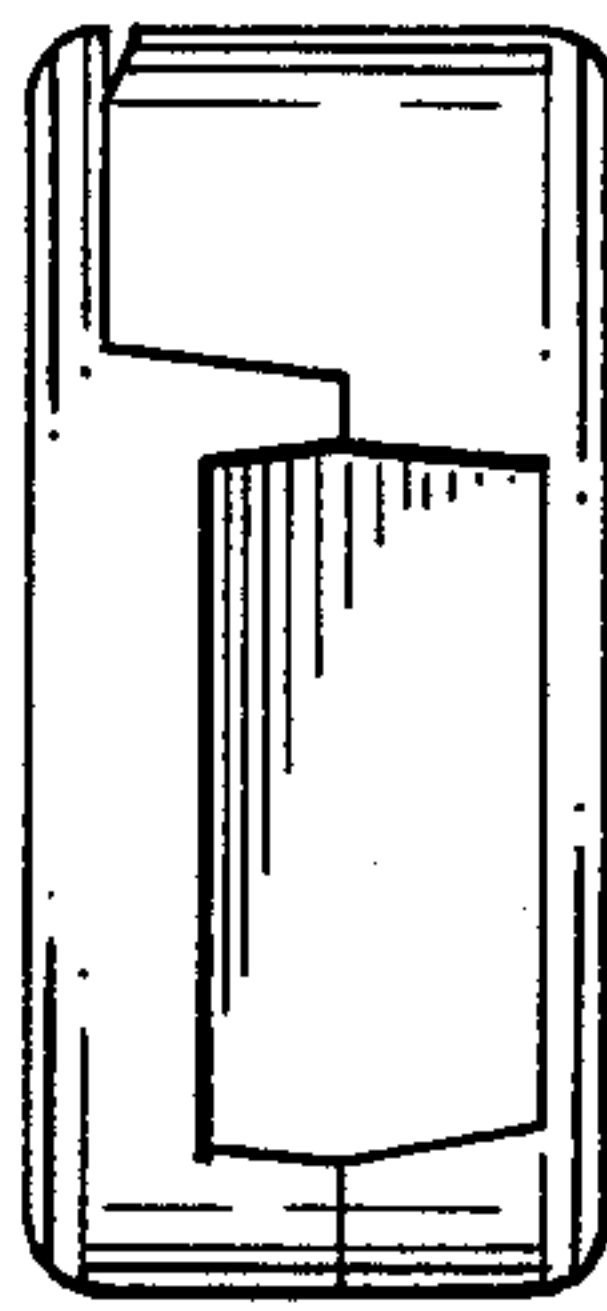

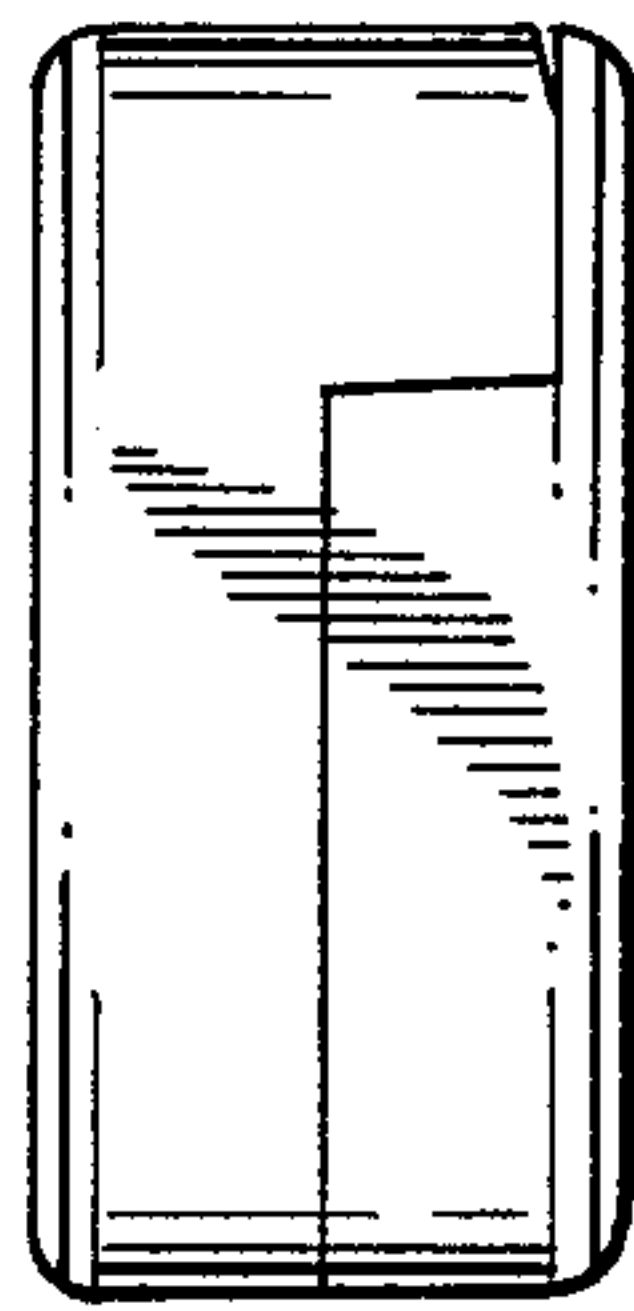

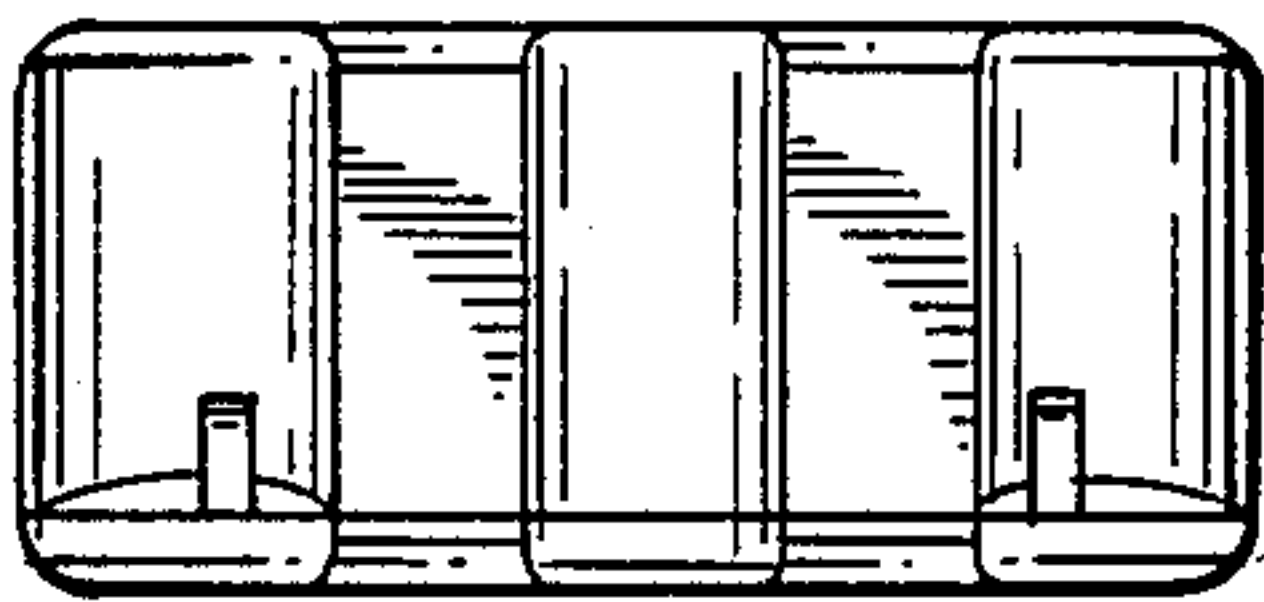

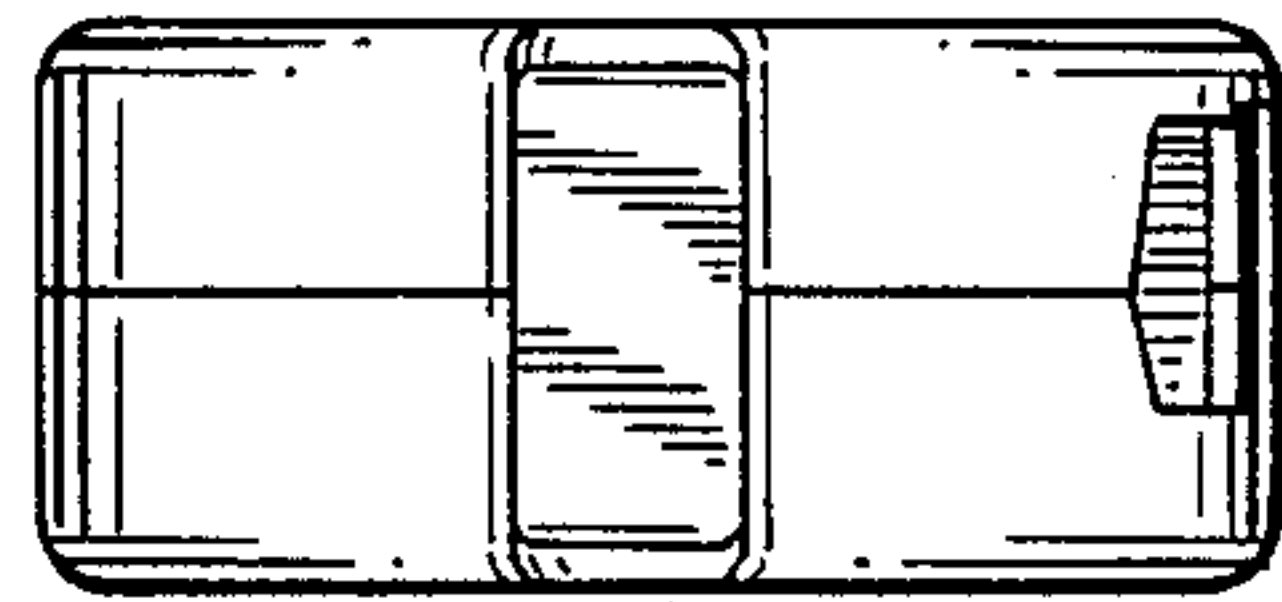
