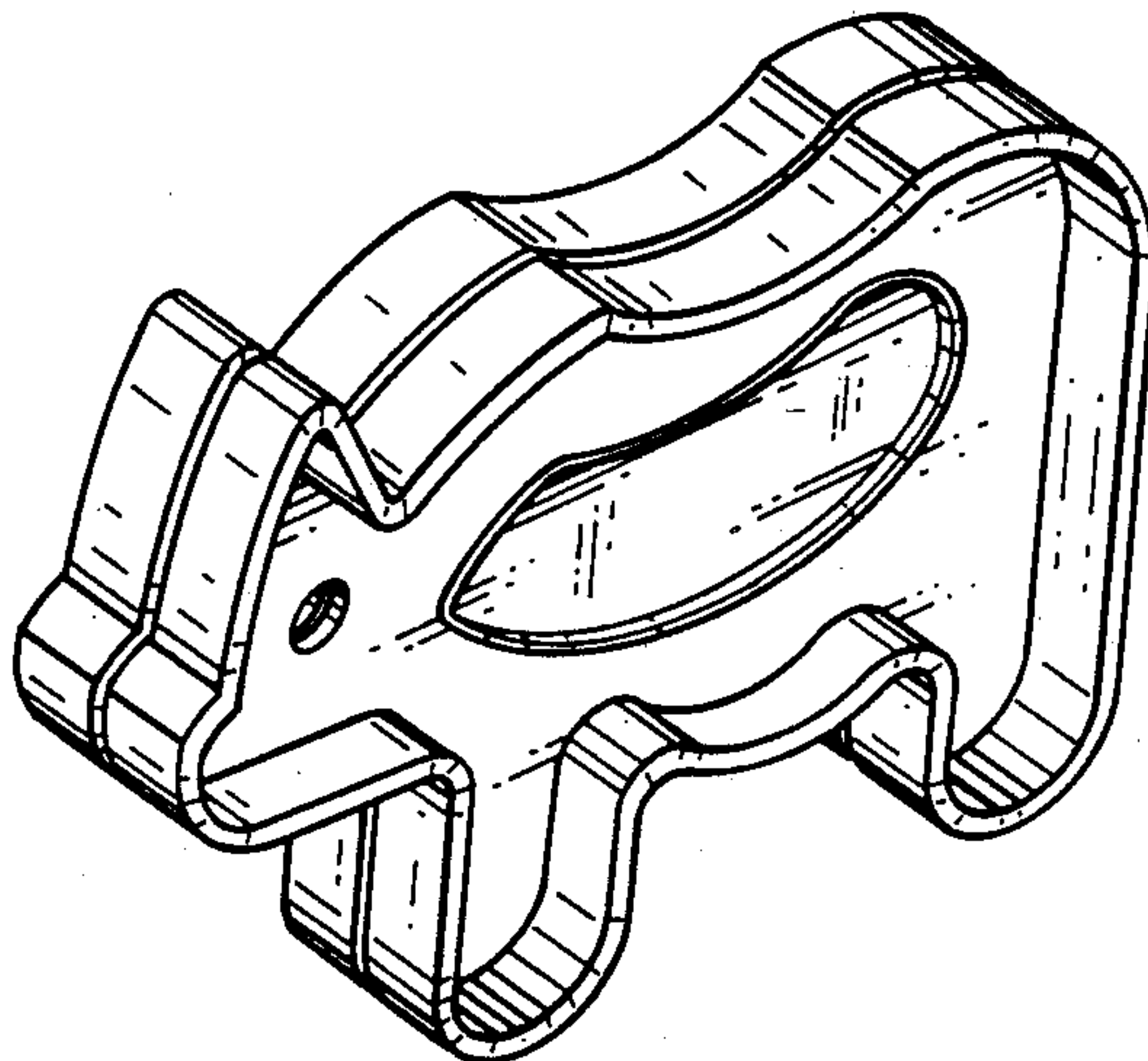

The ornamental design for a toy rhinoceros or the like, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the toy rhinoceros or the like showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the near side of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the far side of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a head end elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear end elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 8 is an exploded perspective view of FIG. 1.



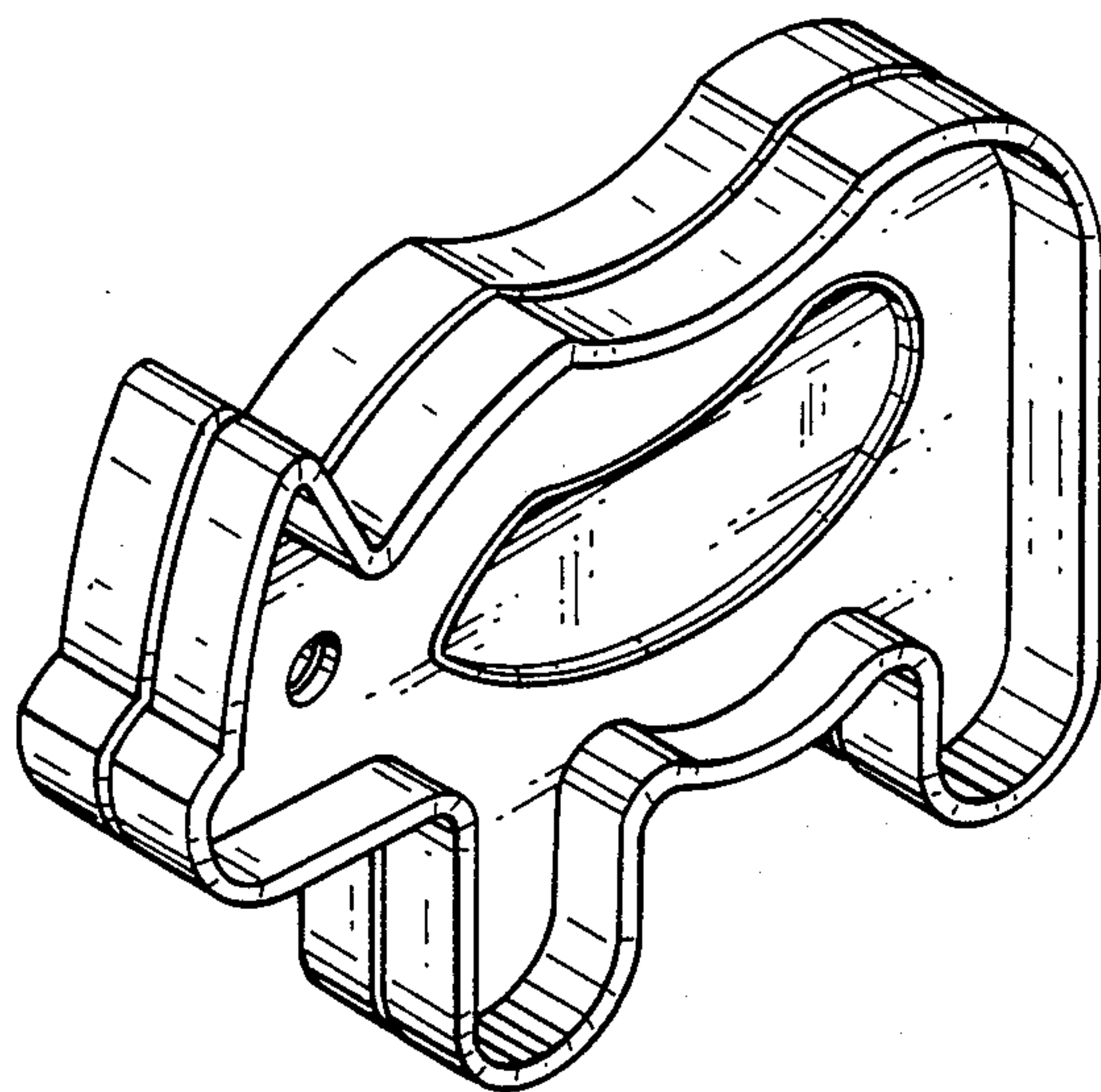

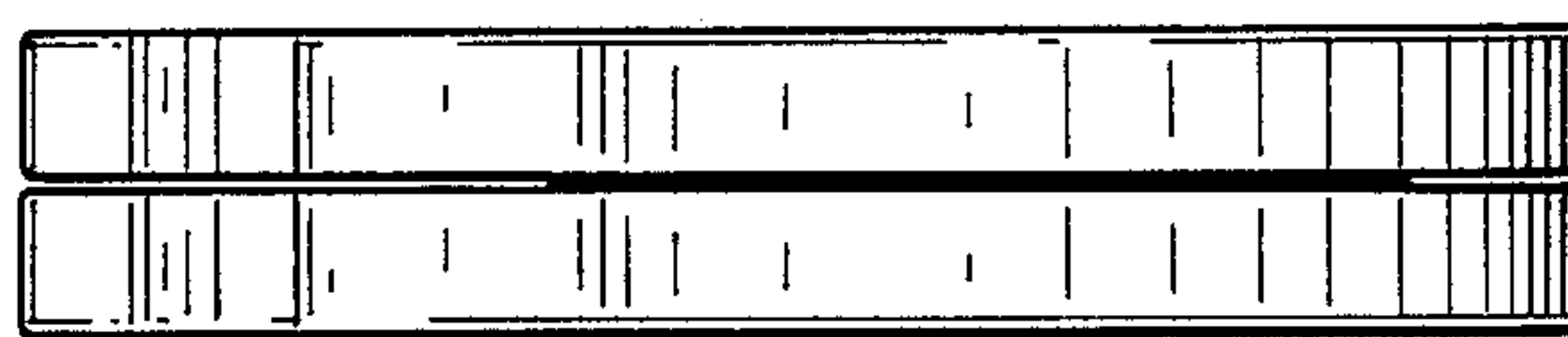

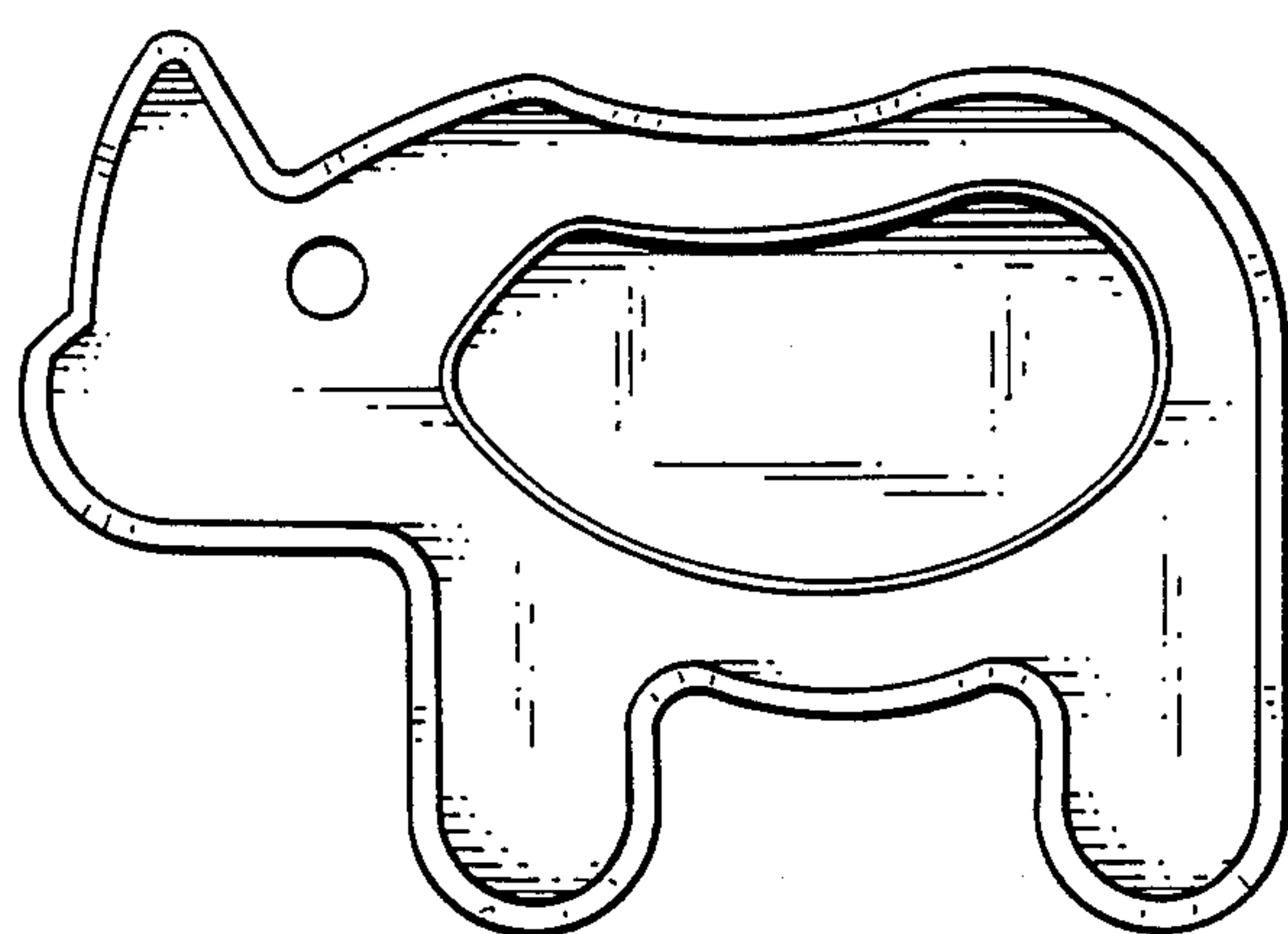

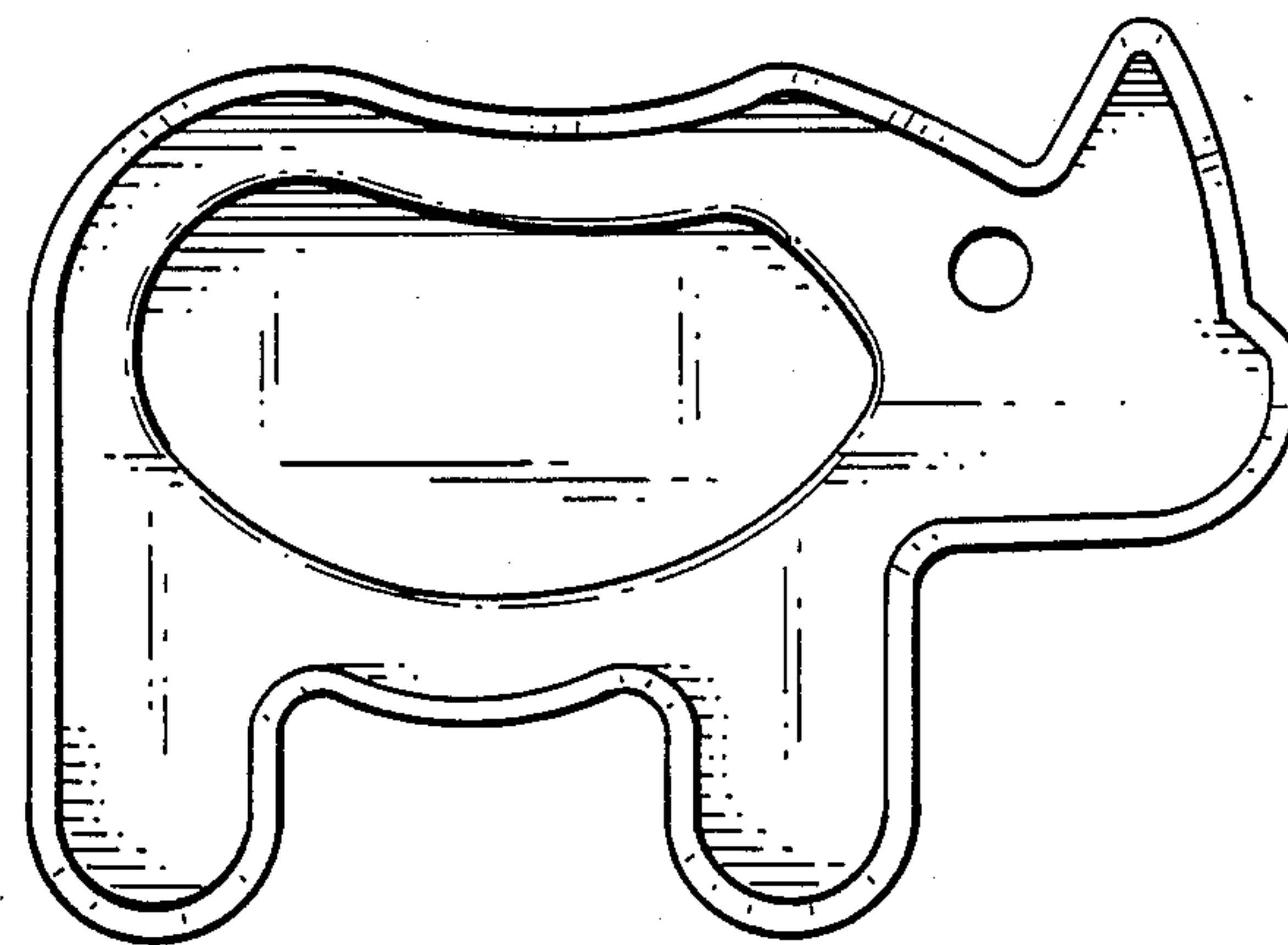

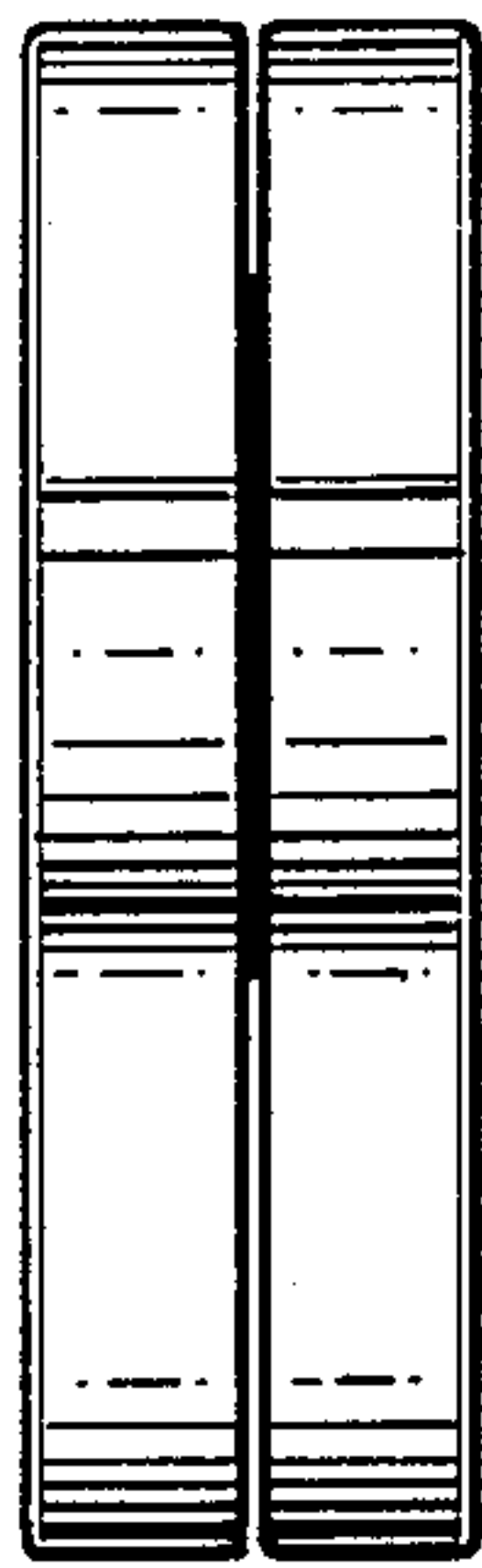

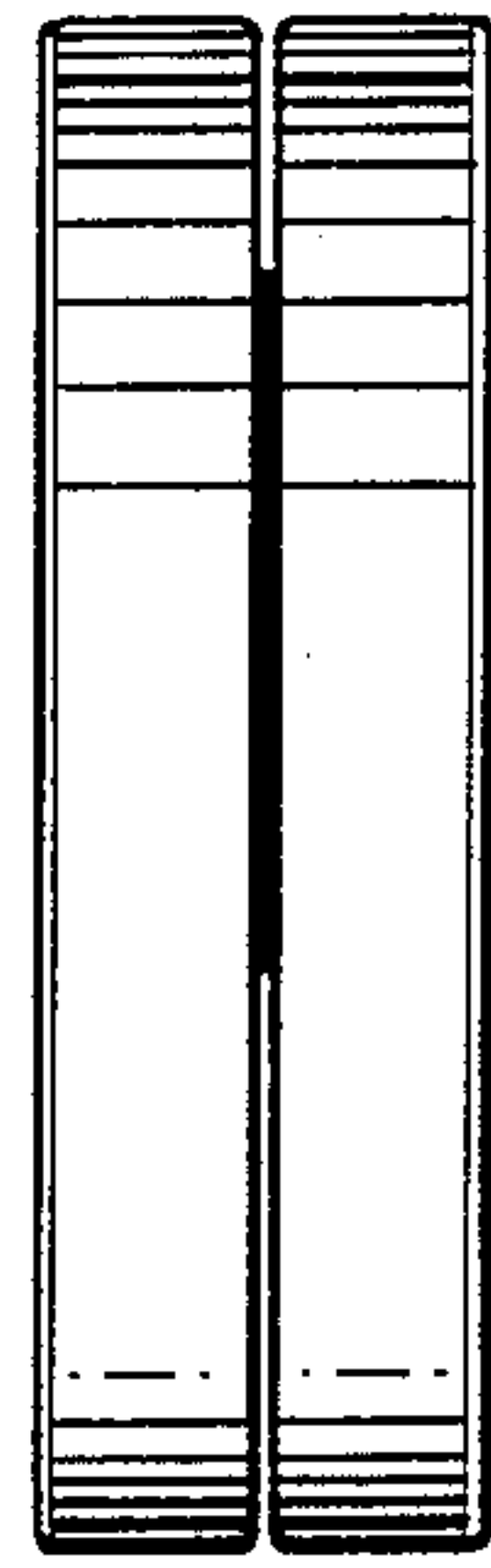

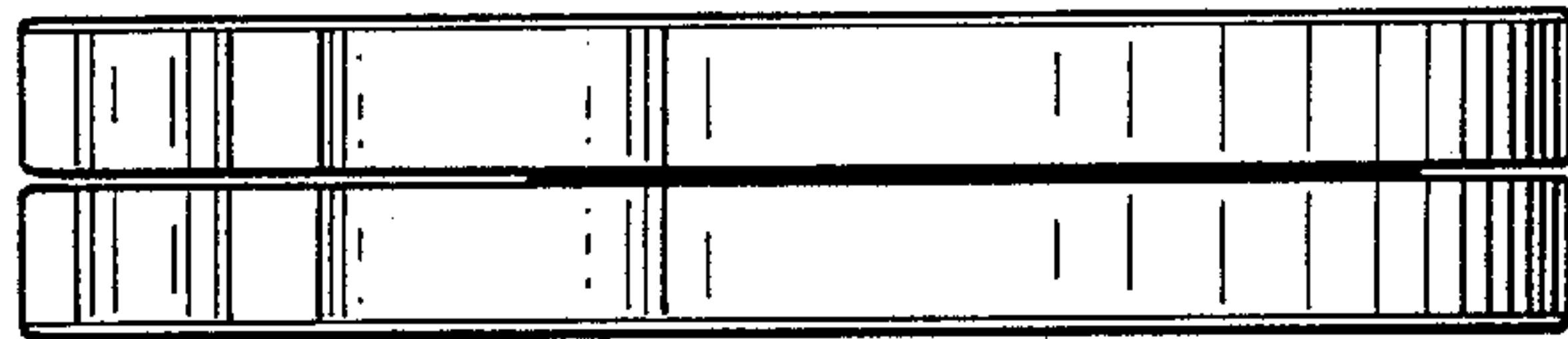

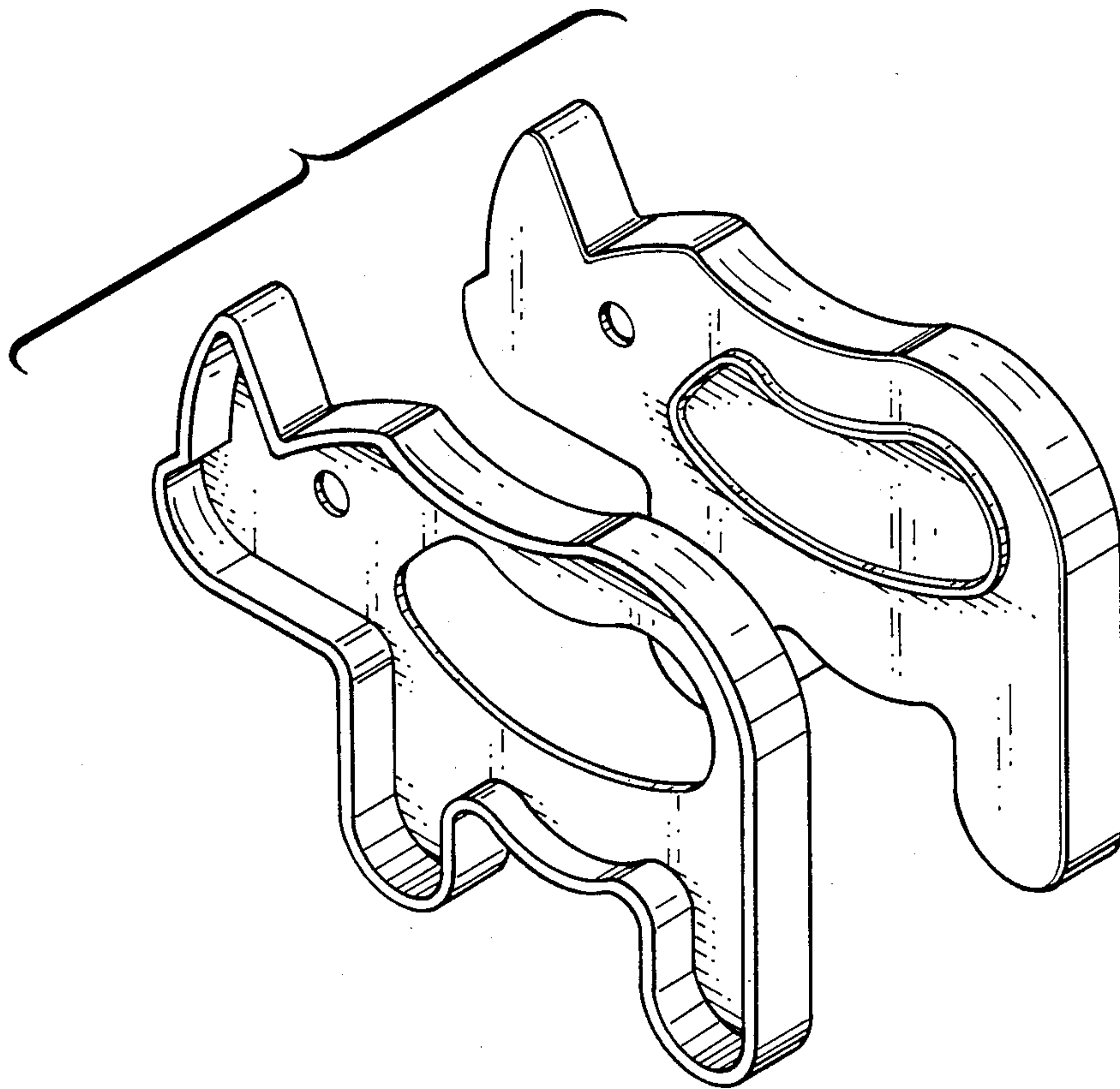
