DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a handle for an article of flatware showing our new design.


FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along line 5—5 on FIG. 1.

The broken line showing of the fork tines in FIGS. 1-4 is illustrative of environmental structure only and forms no part of the claimed design.




