The ornamental design for a travel bib, as shown and described.

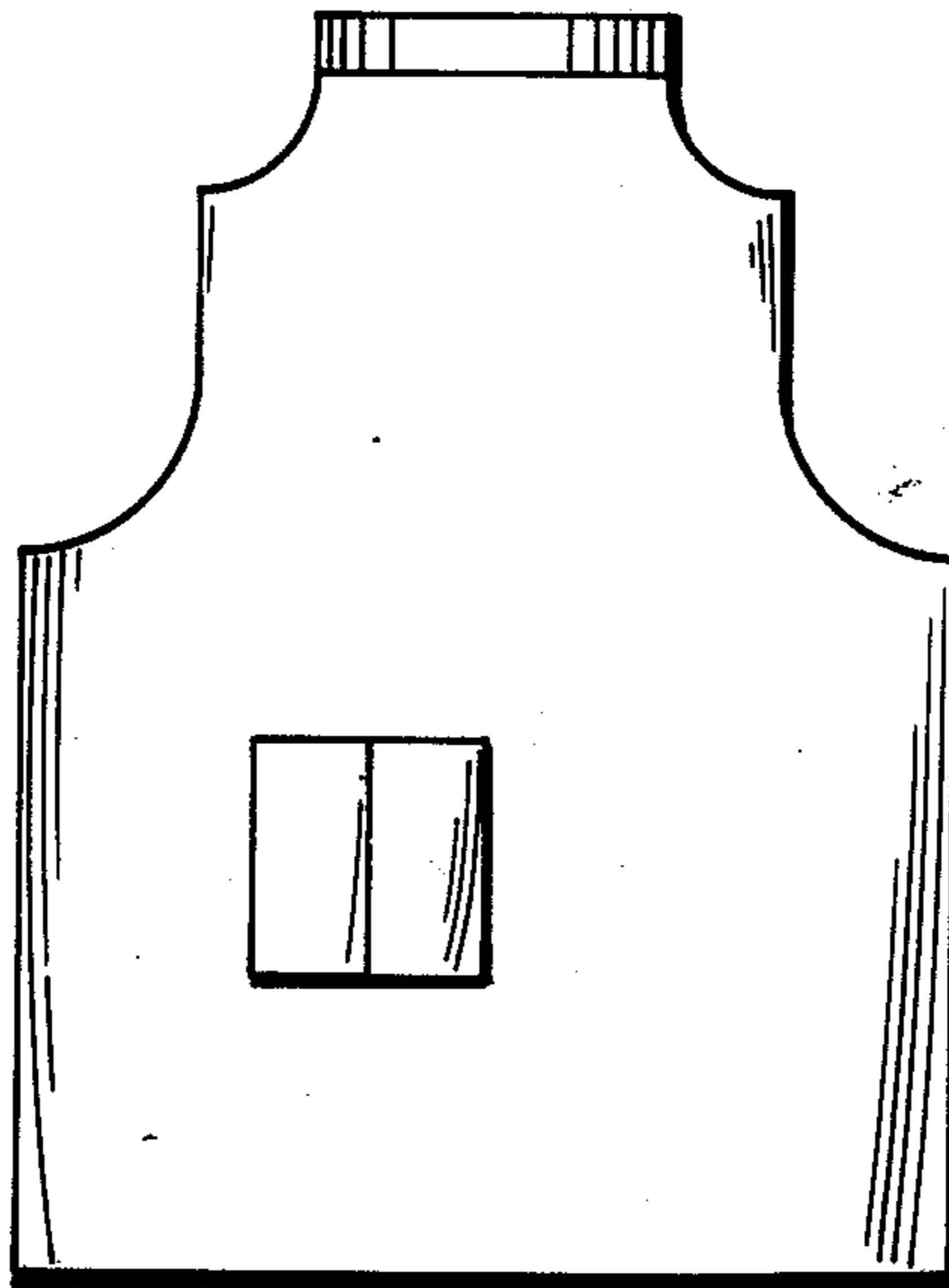
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof.



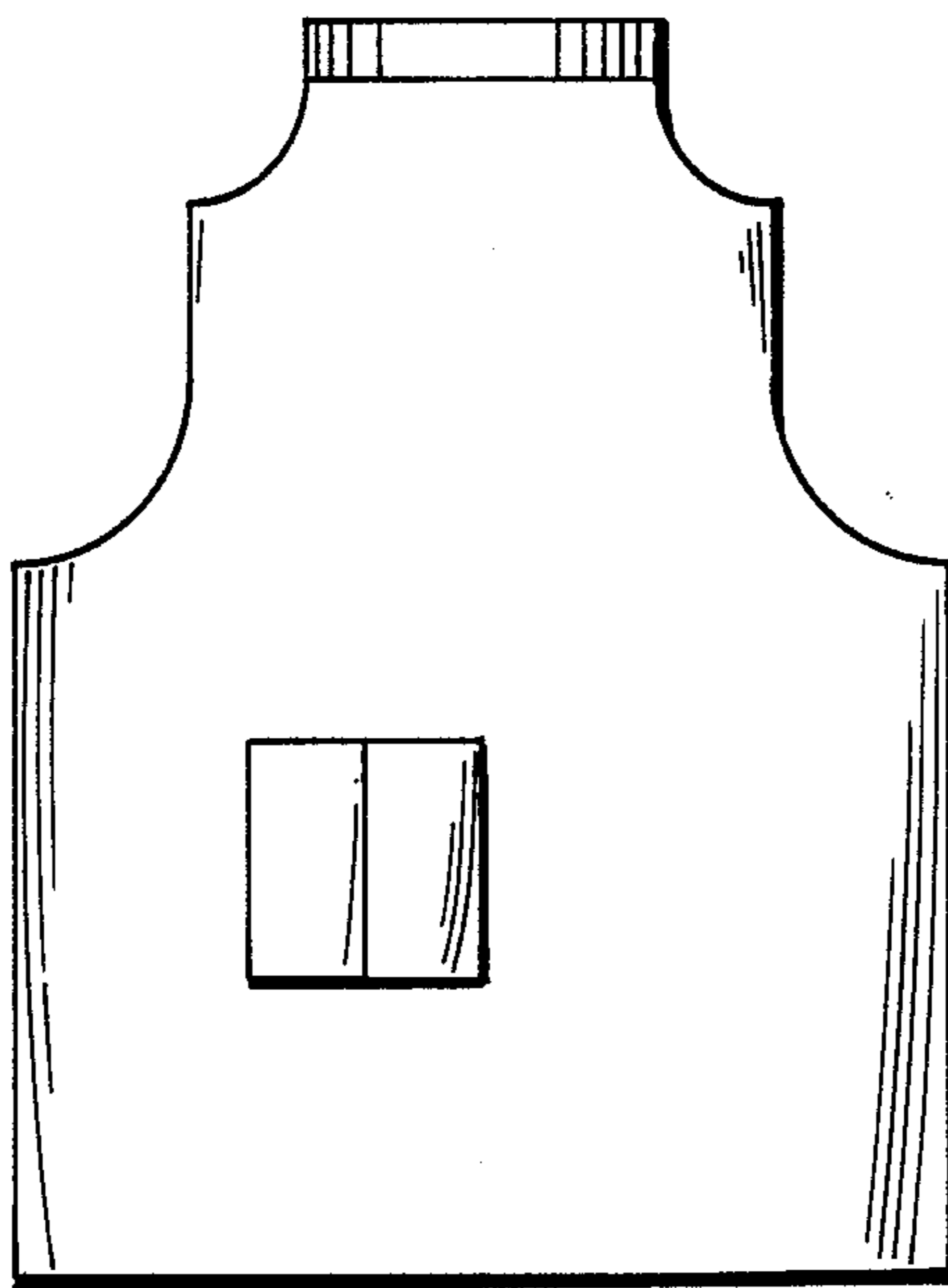

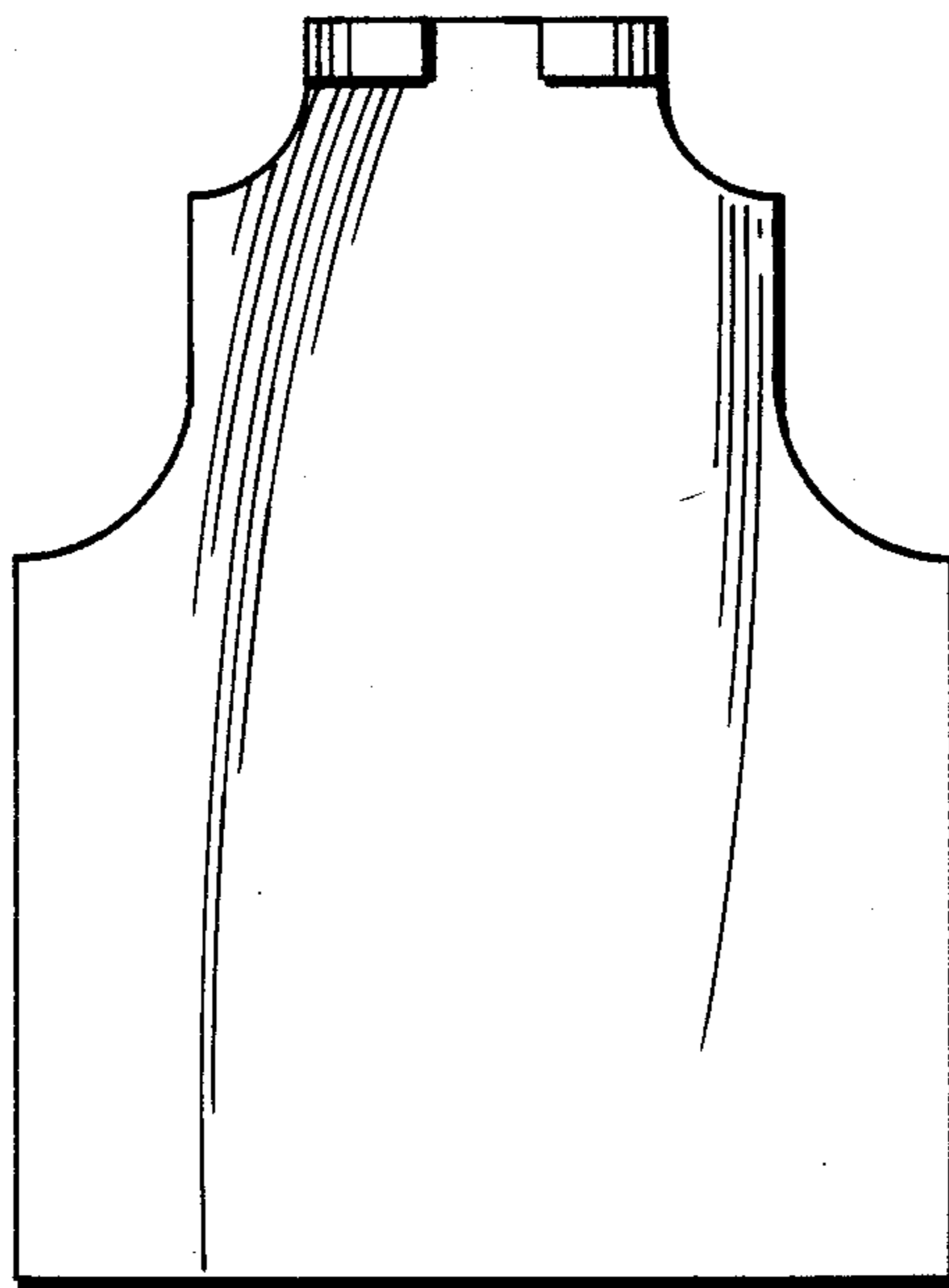

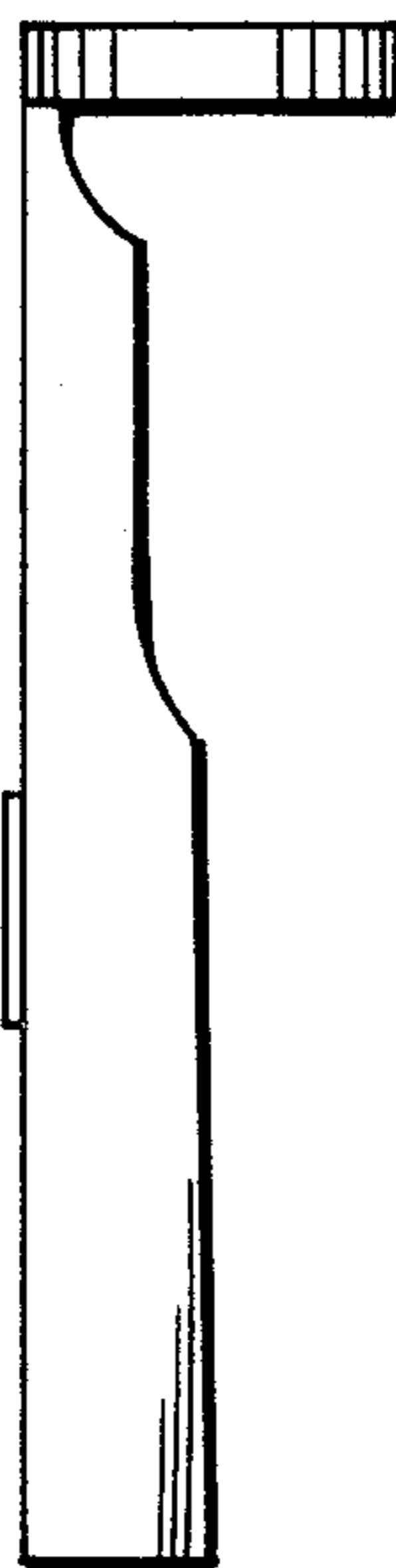
