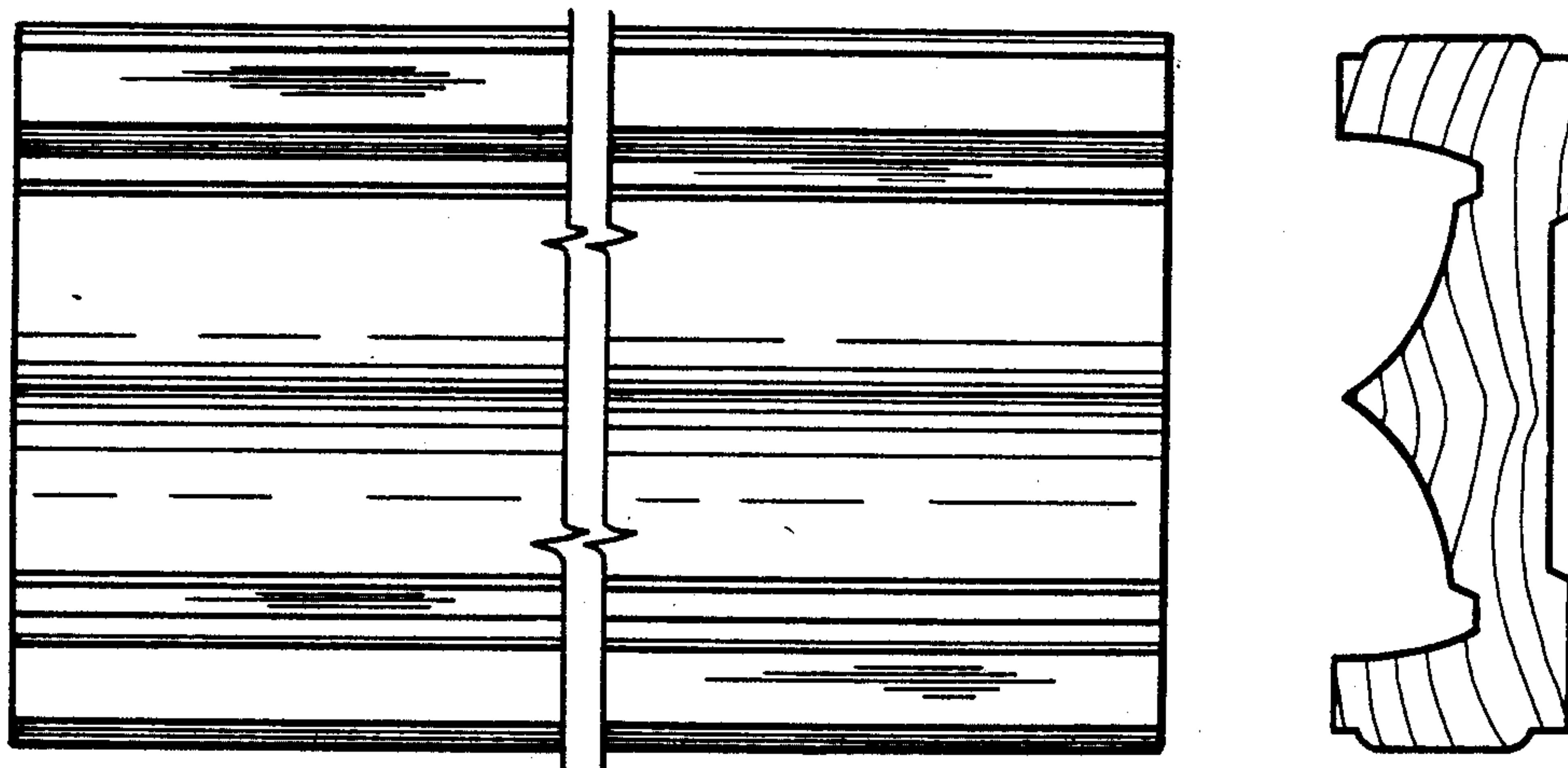

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a molding showing my new design broken away to indicate indeterminate length; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



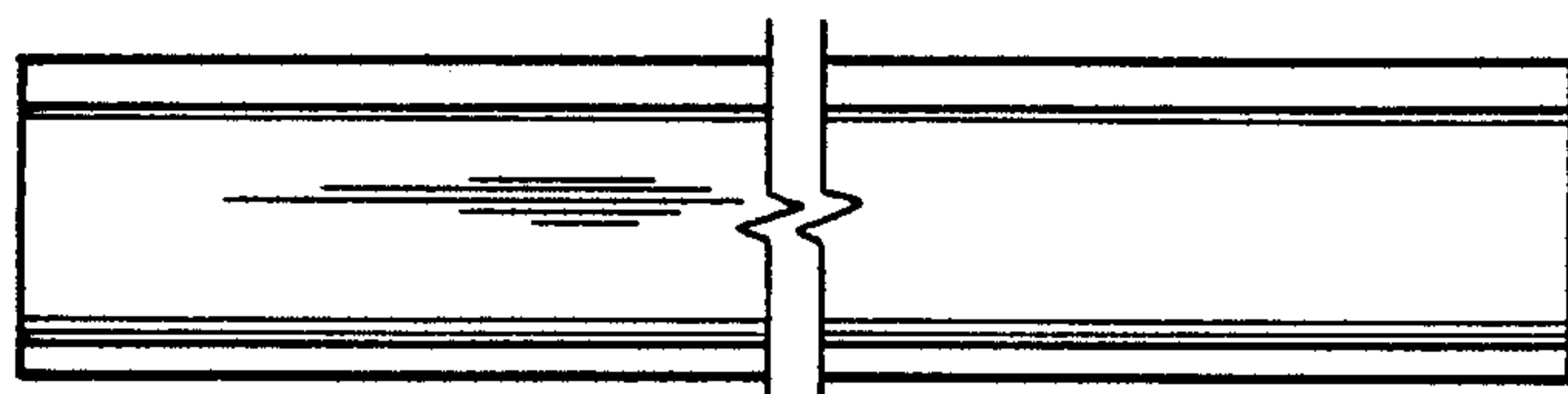

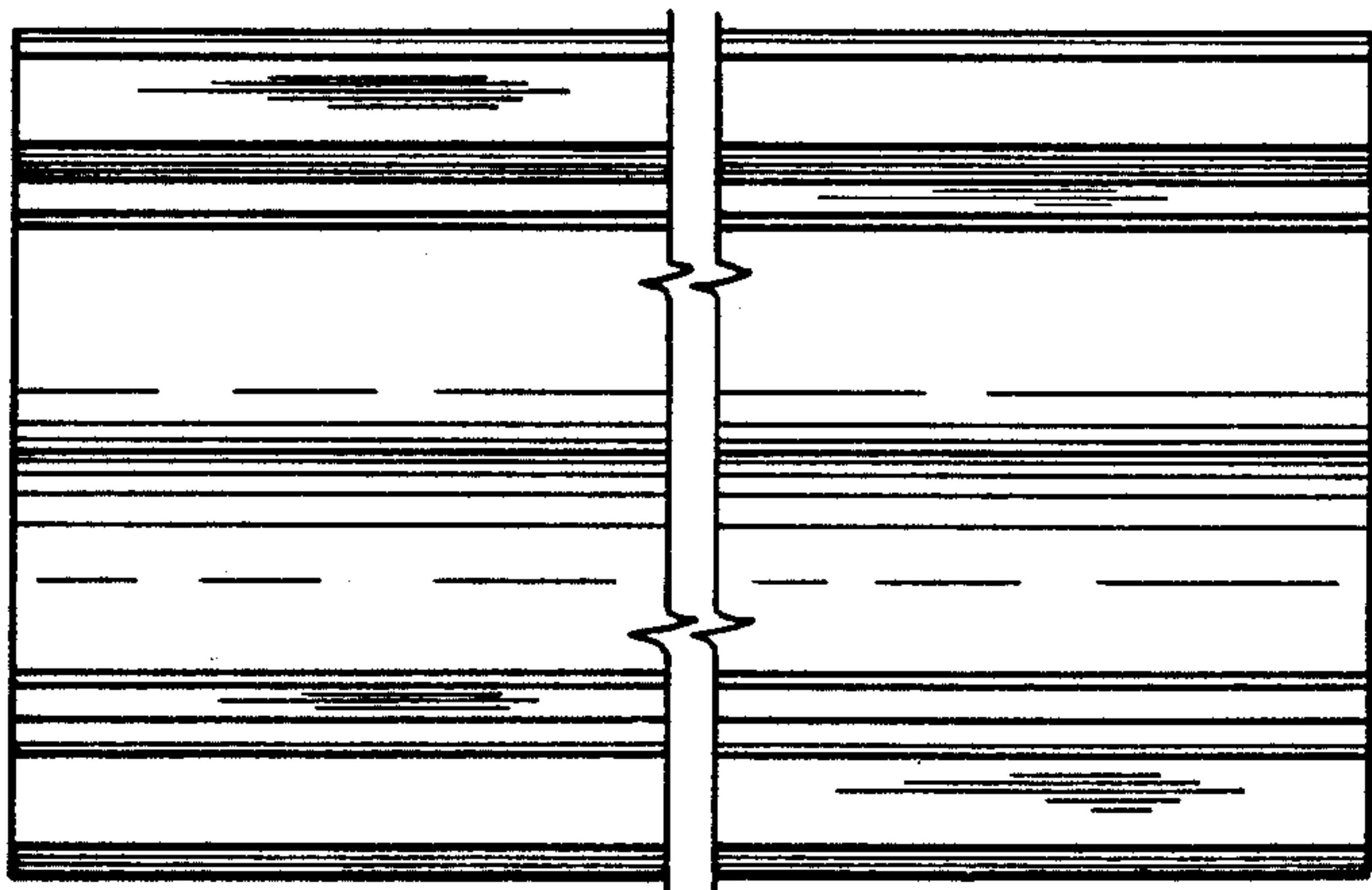

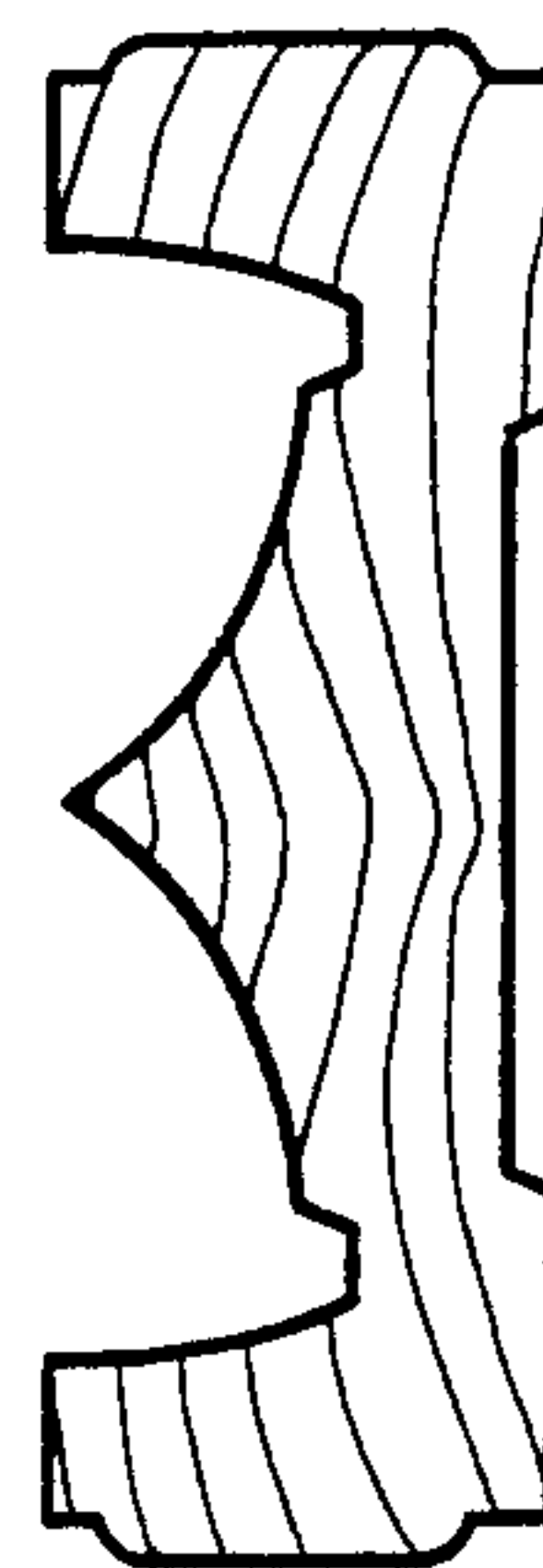

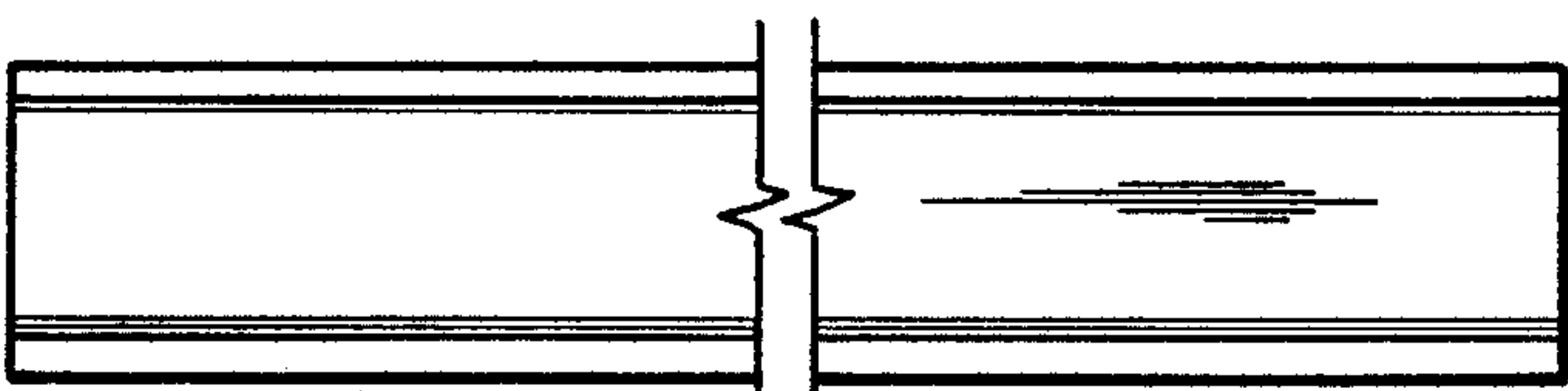

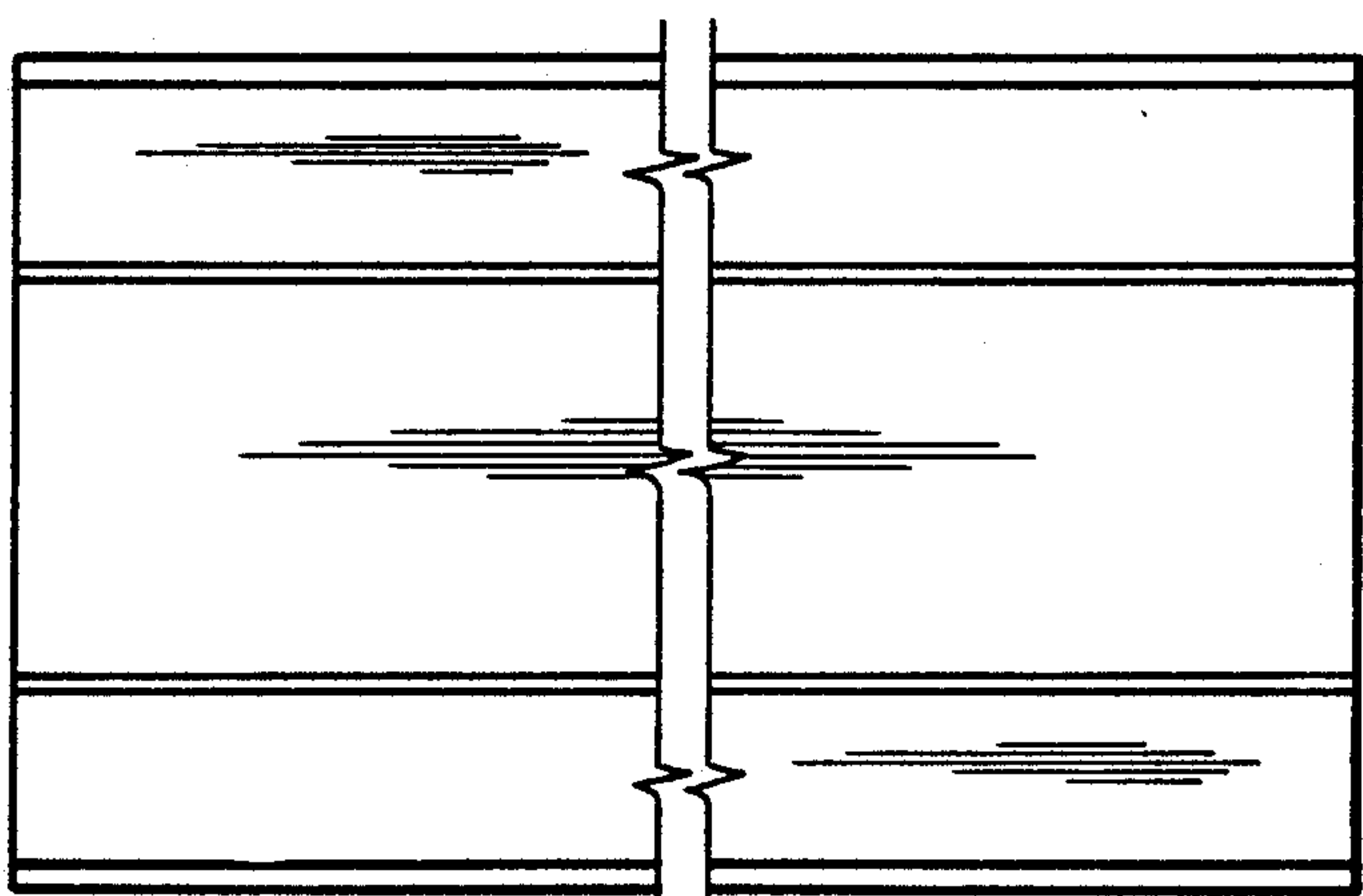
