[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a child's bookcase and toy chest unit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a child's bookcase and toy chest unit showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view, the right side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

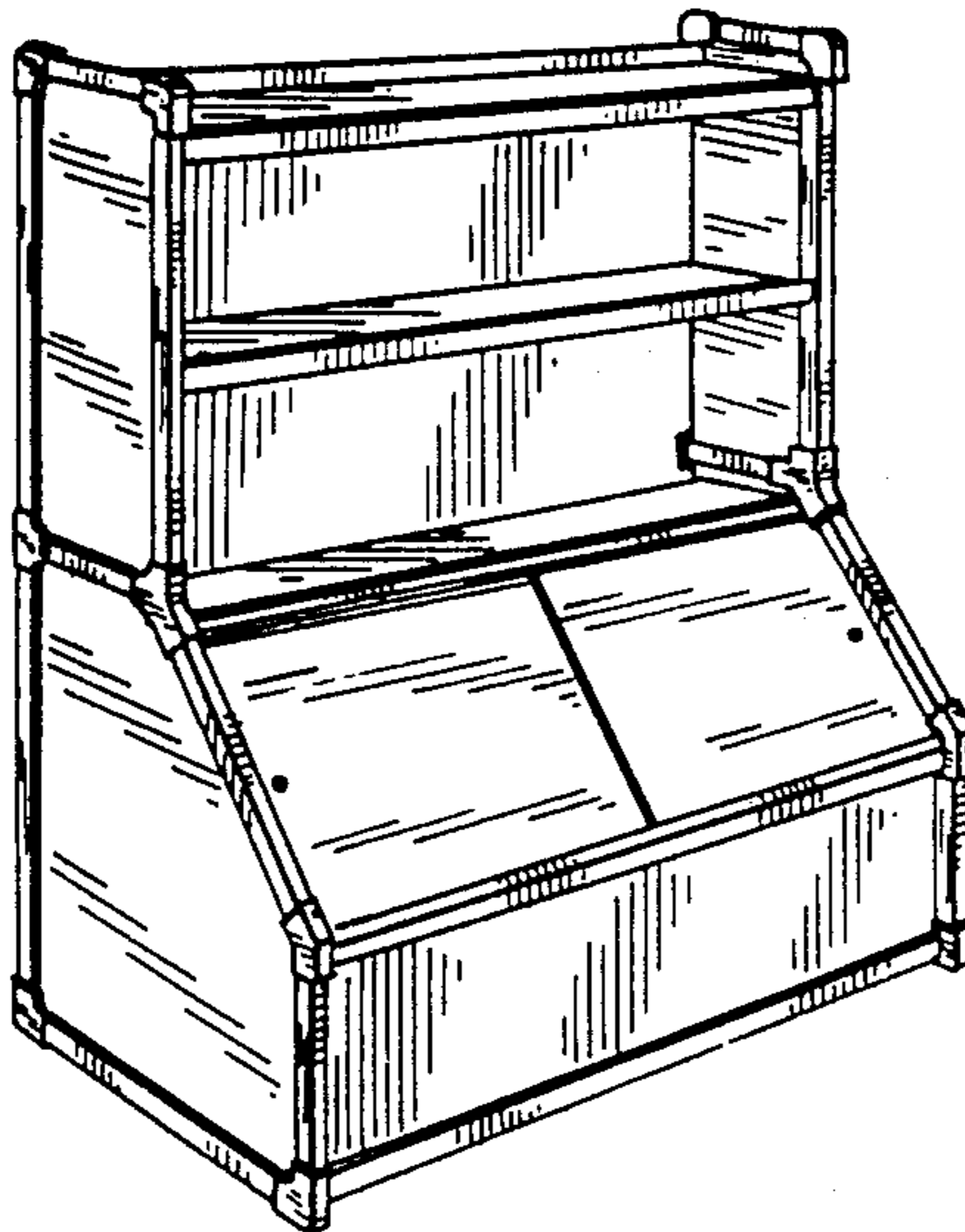

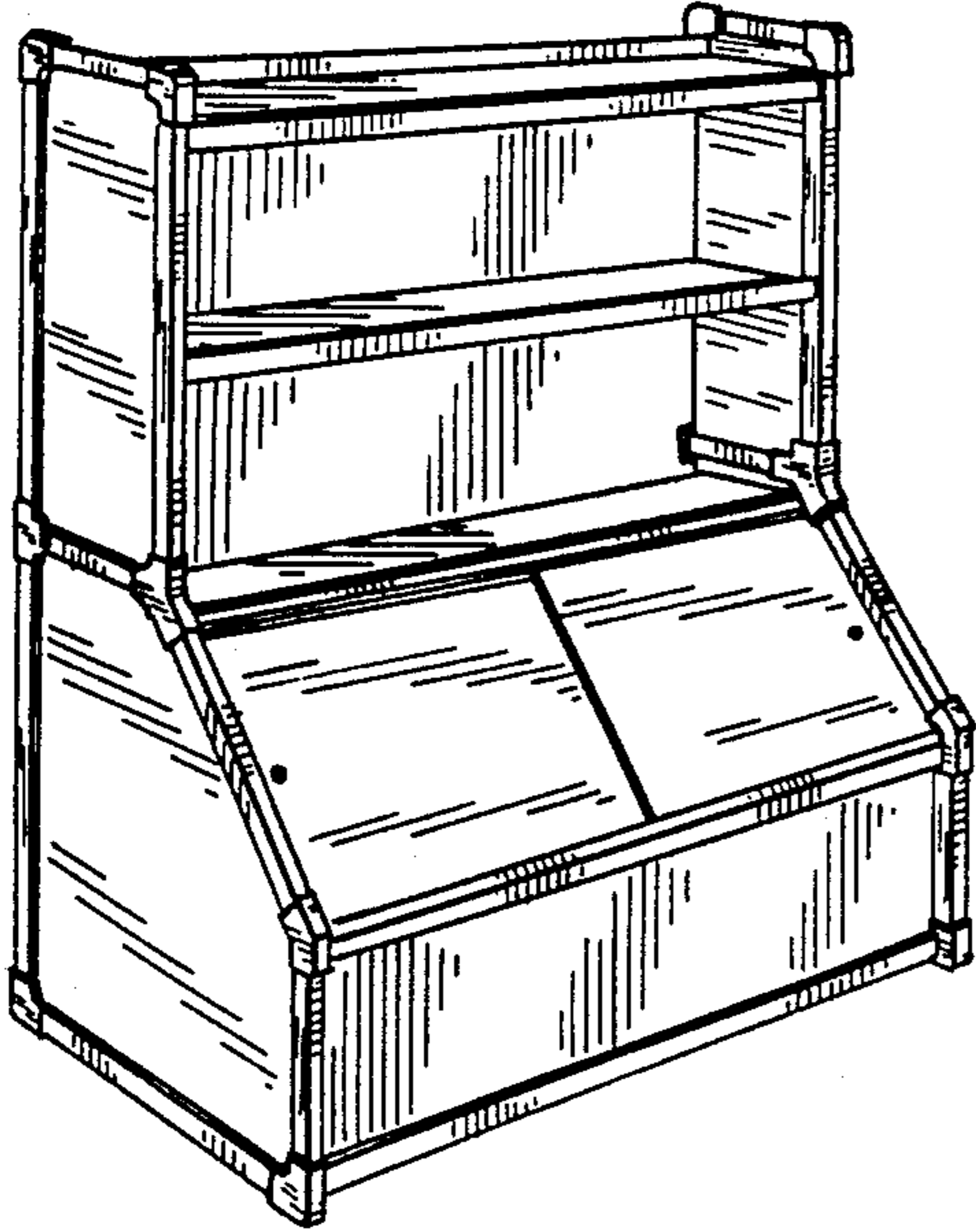

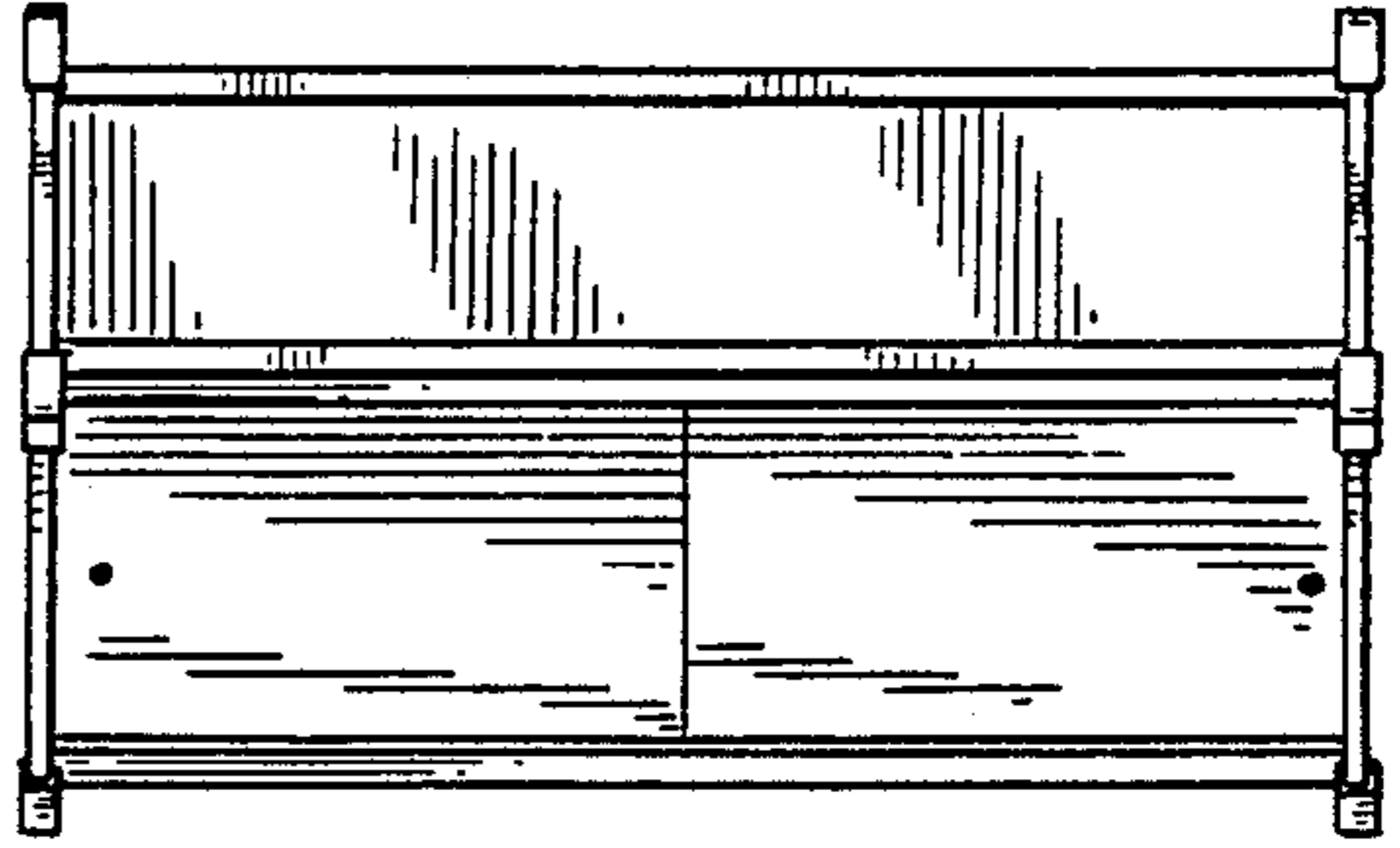

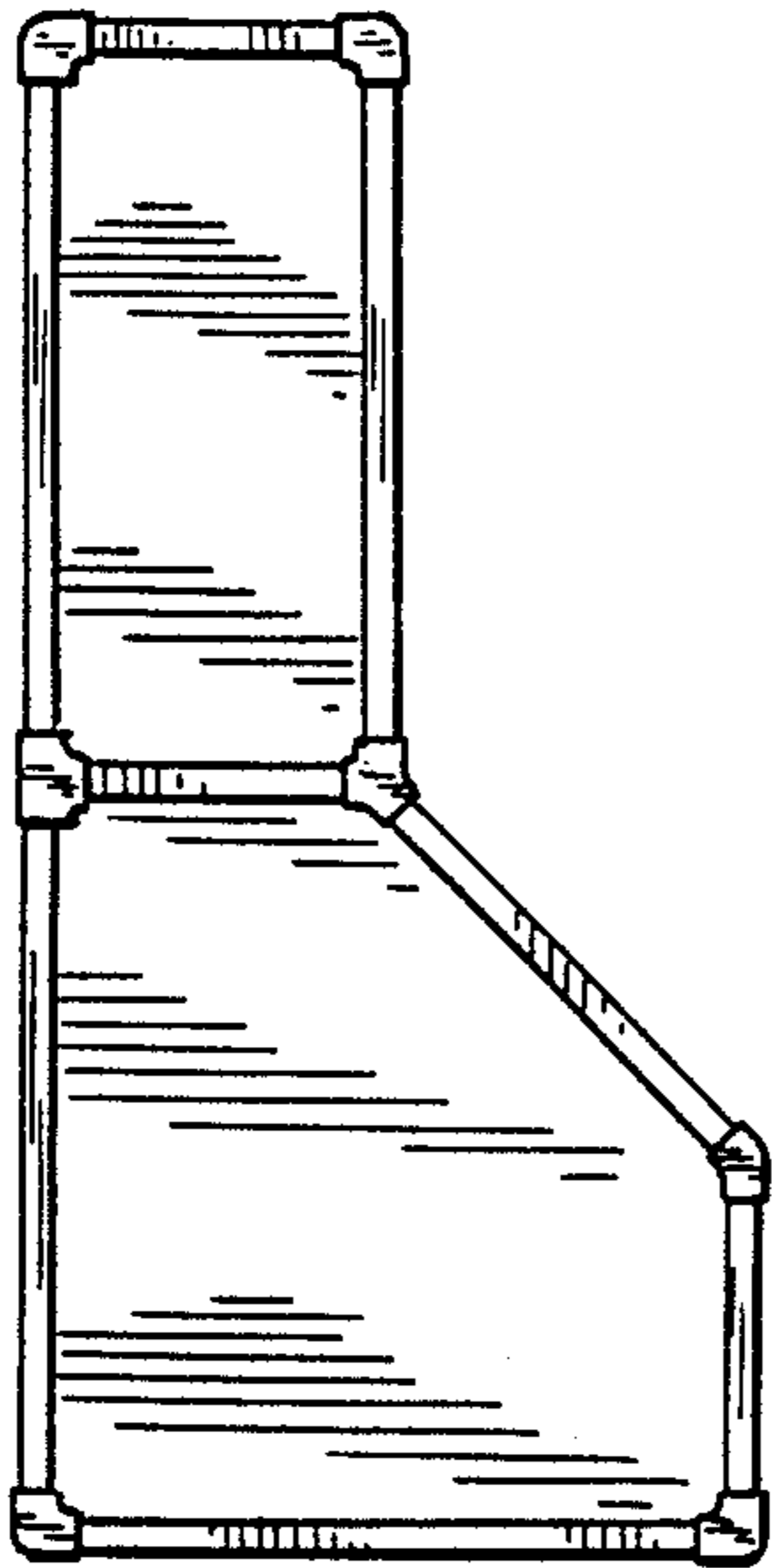
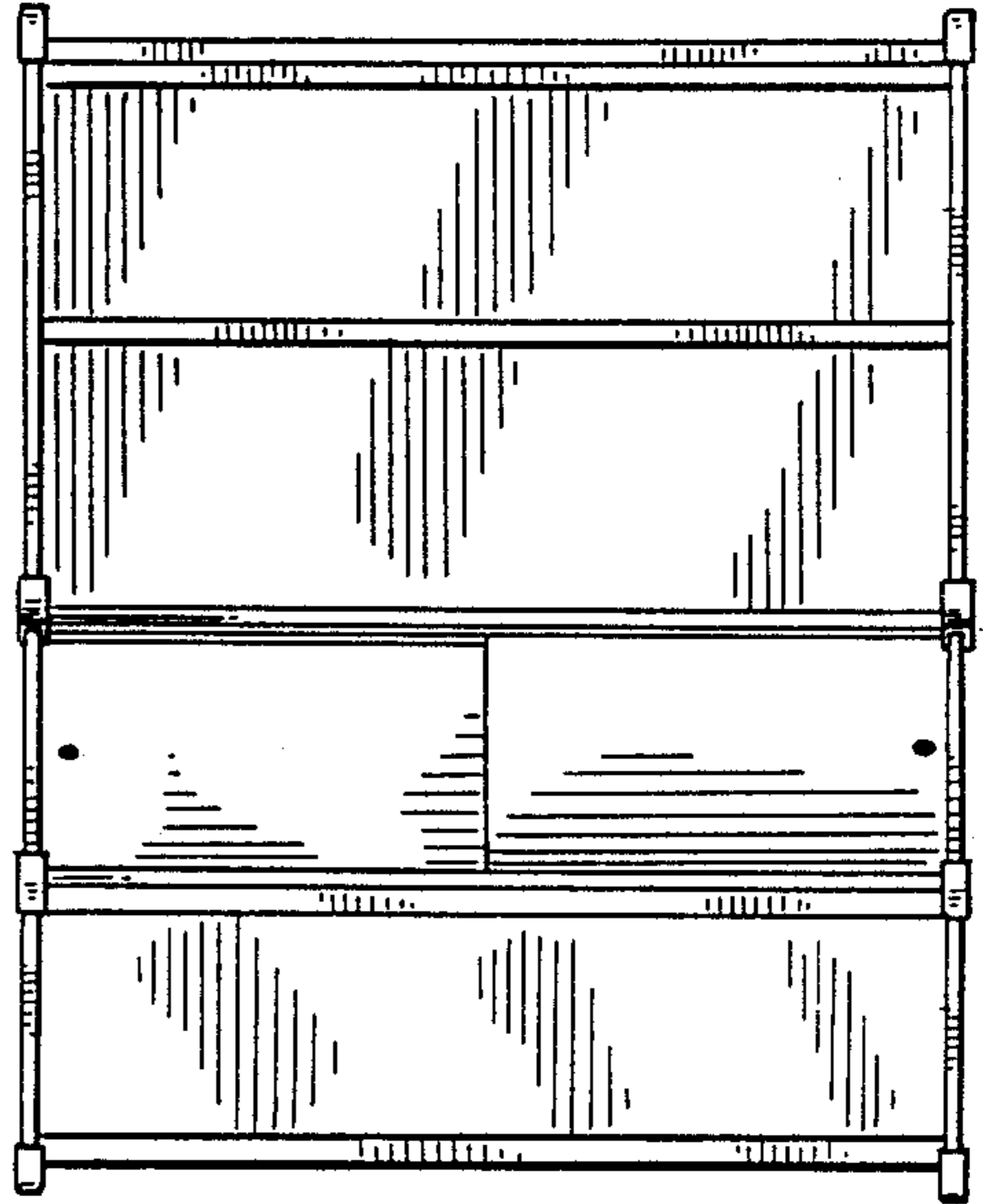
