DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a pipetting work station, showing my new design, the broken line portions being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part thereof;
FIG. 2 is a back elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line 7—7 of FIG. 1.

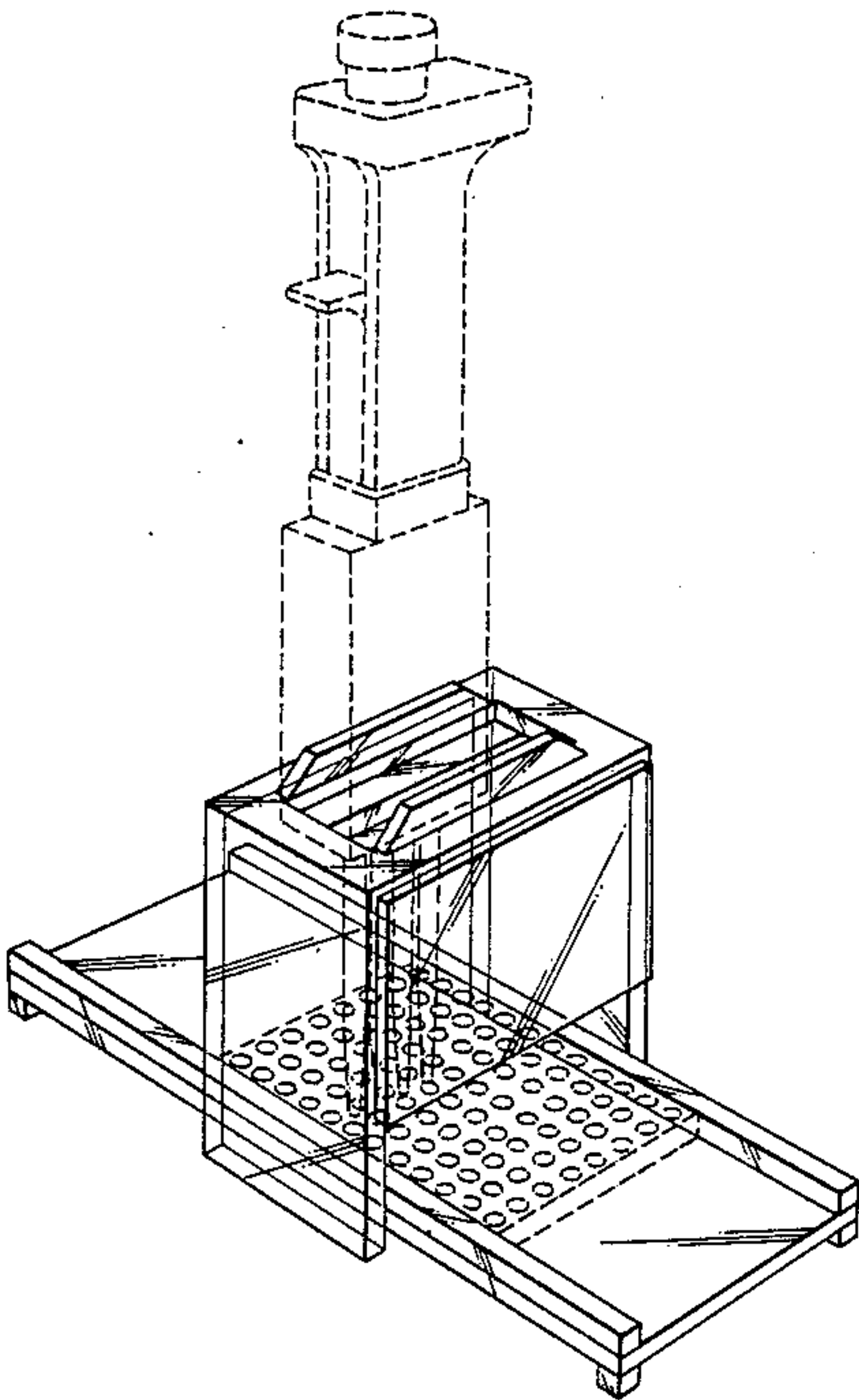

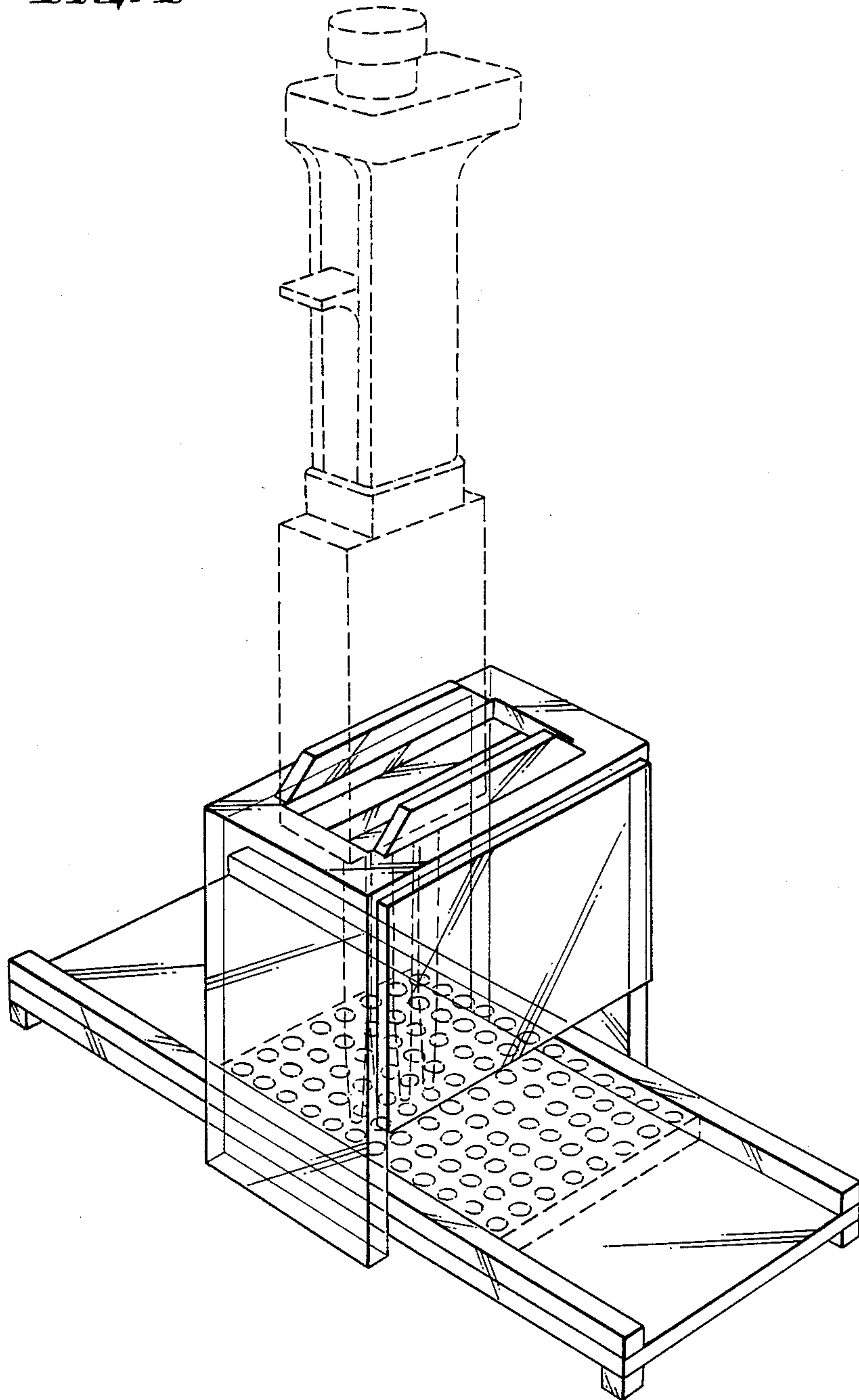

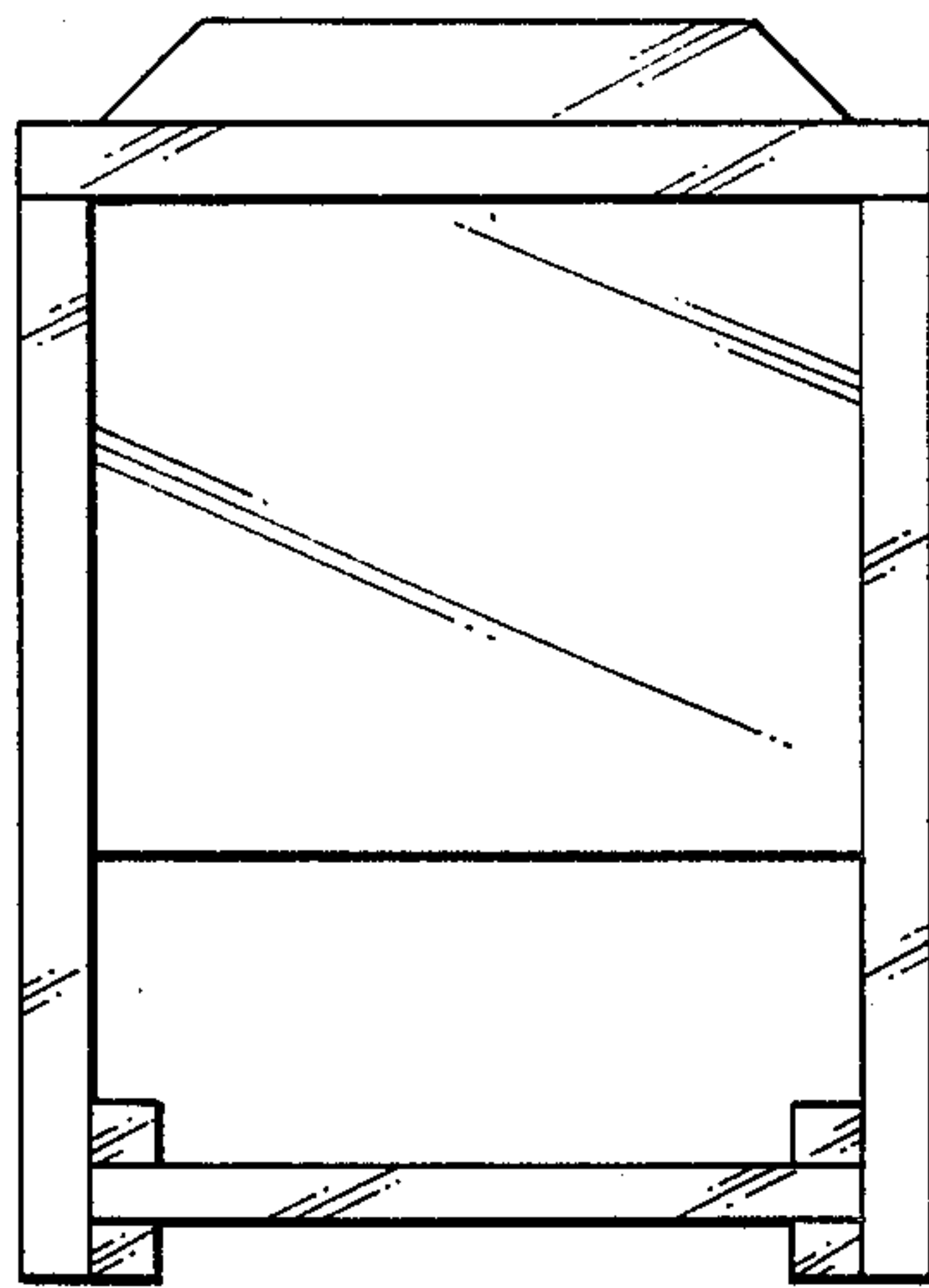

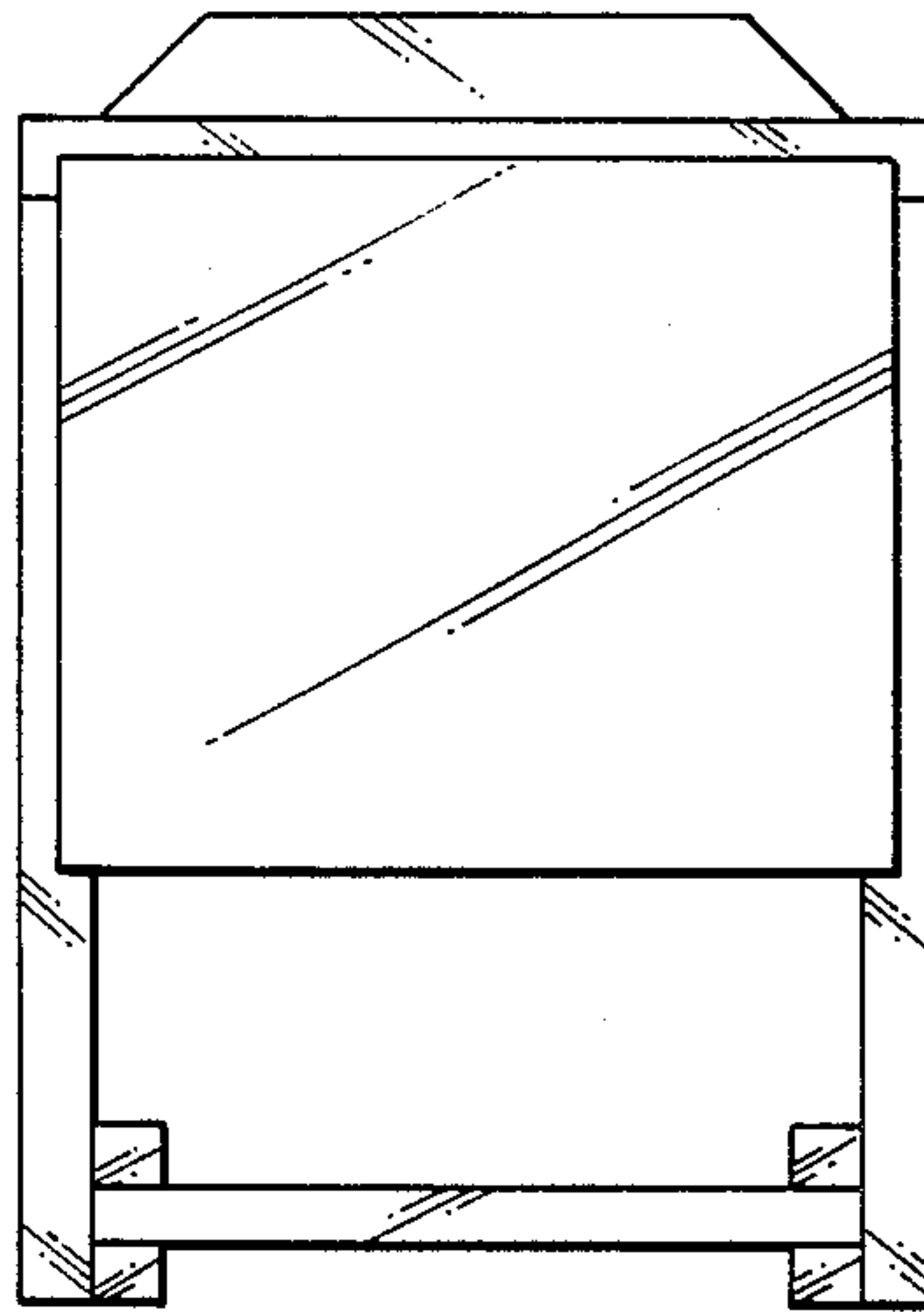

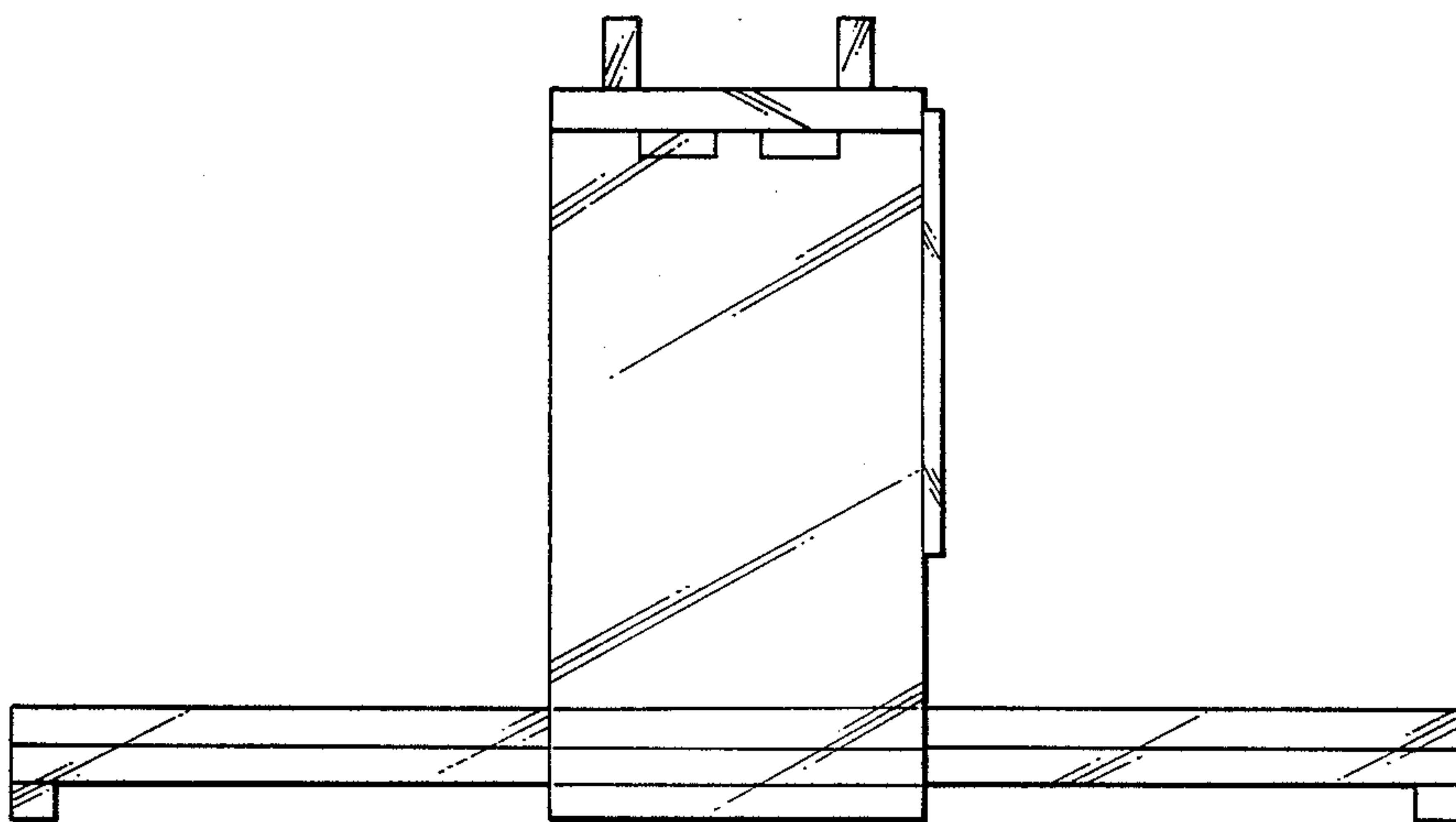

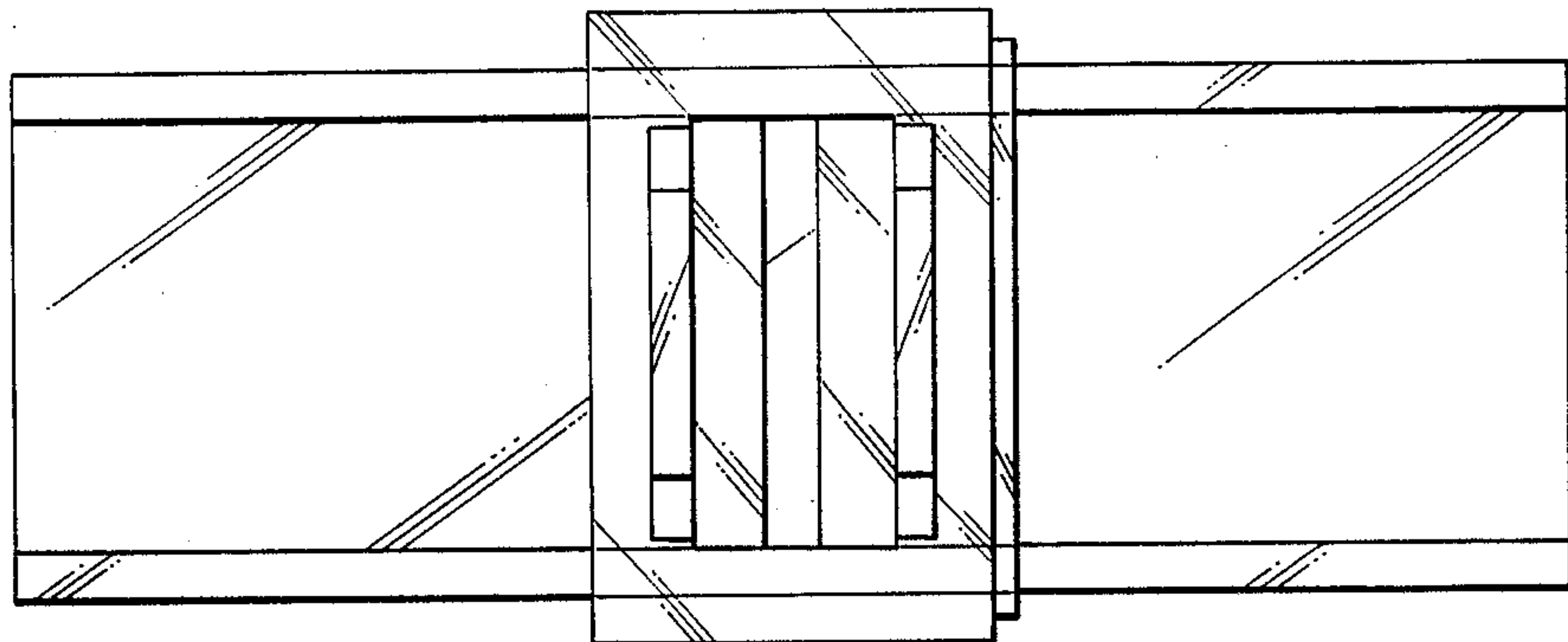

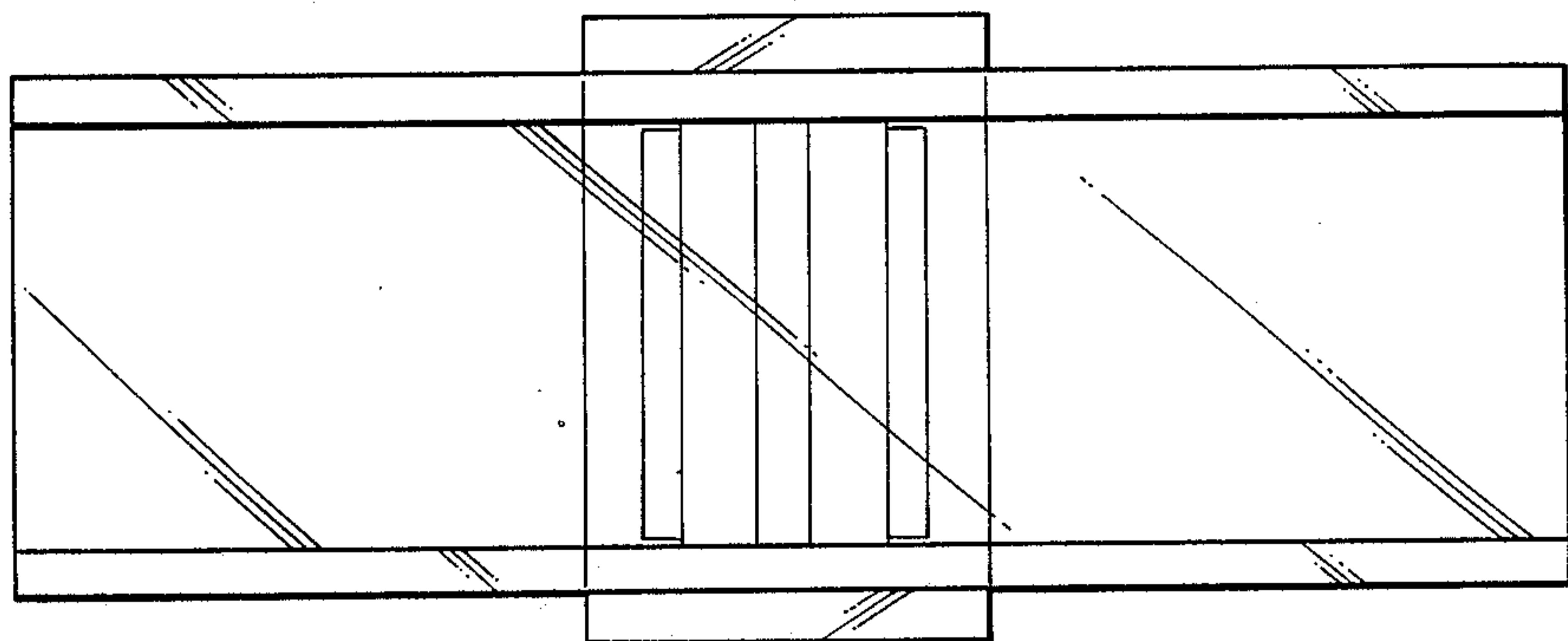
