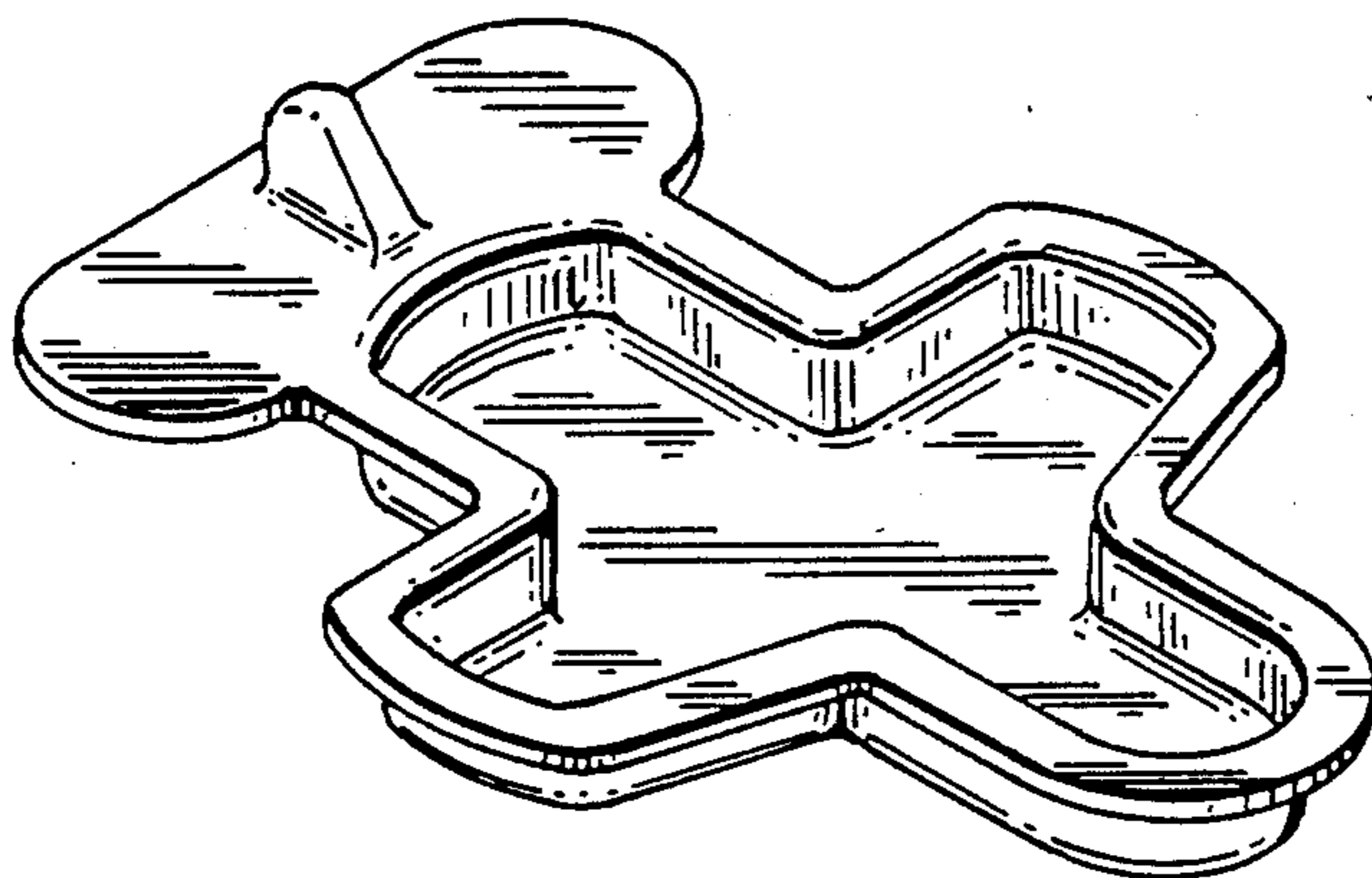

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a food bowl or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a food bowl or similar article showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the side opposite is a mirror image thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



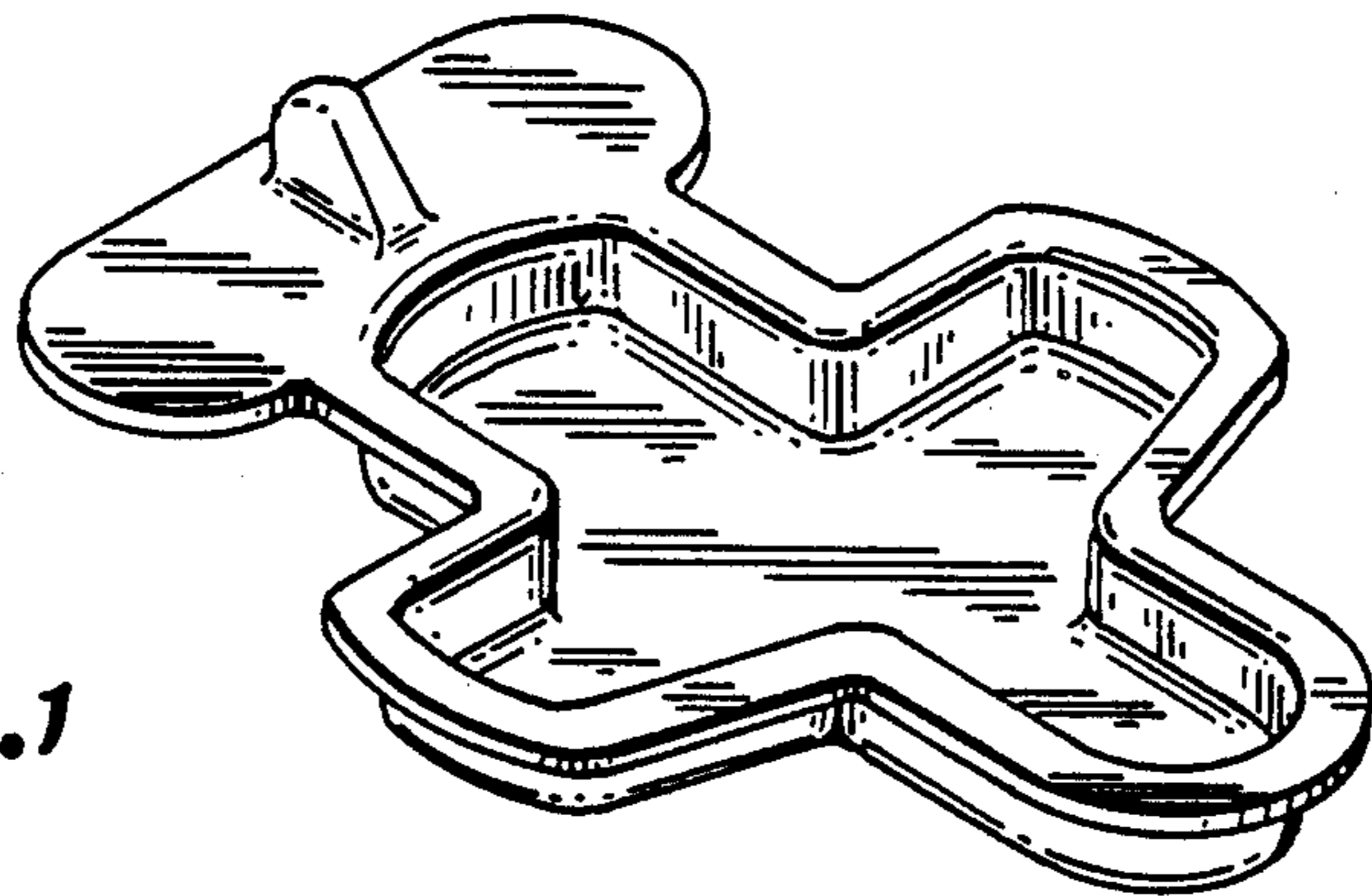

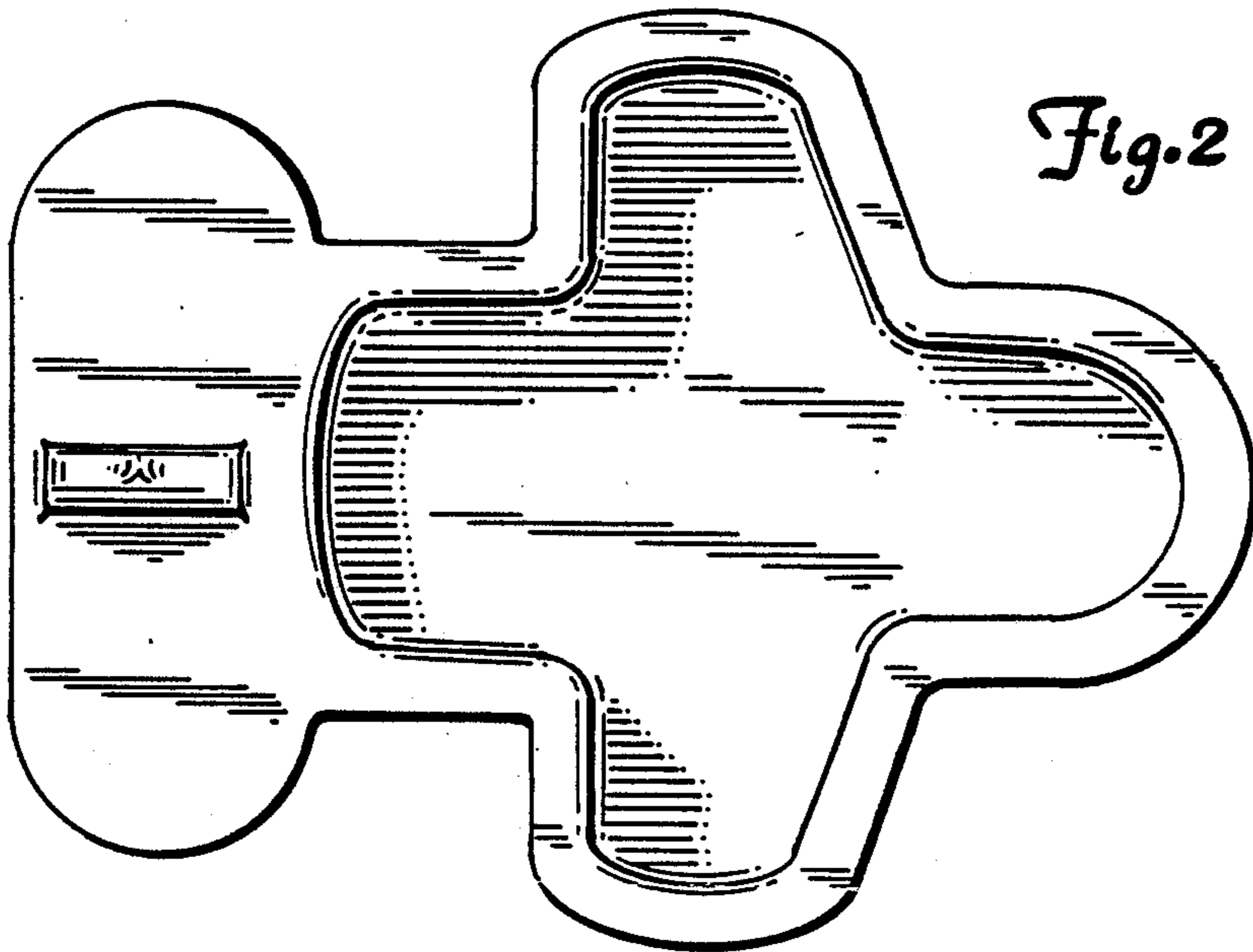

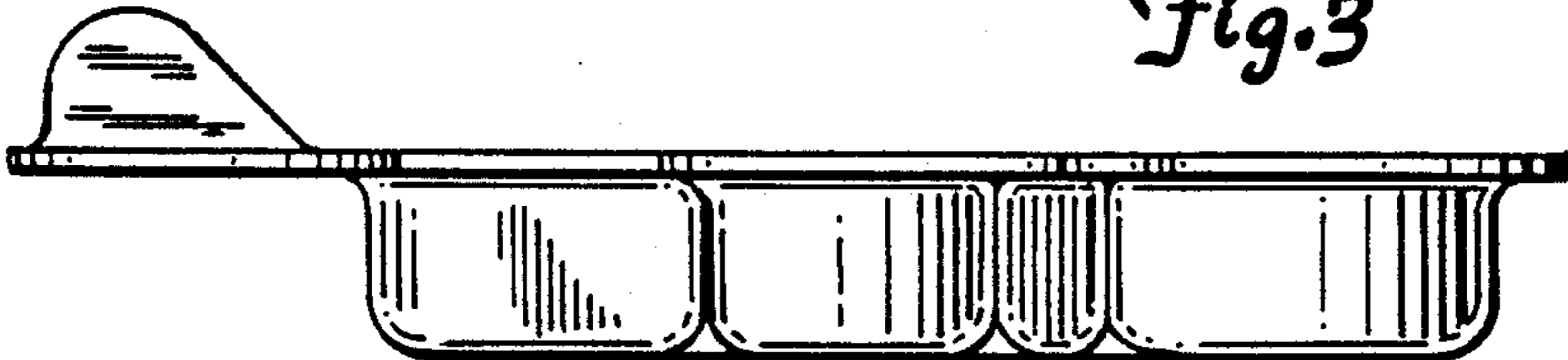

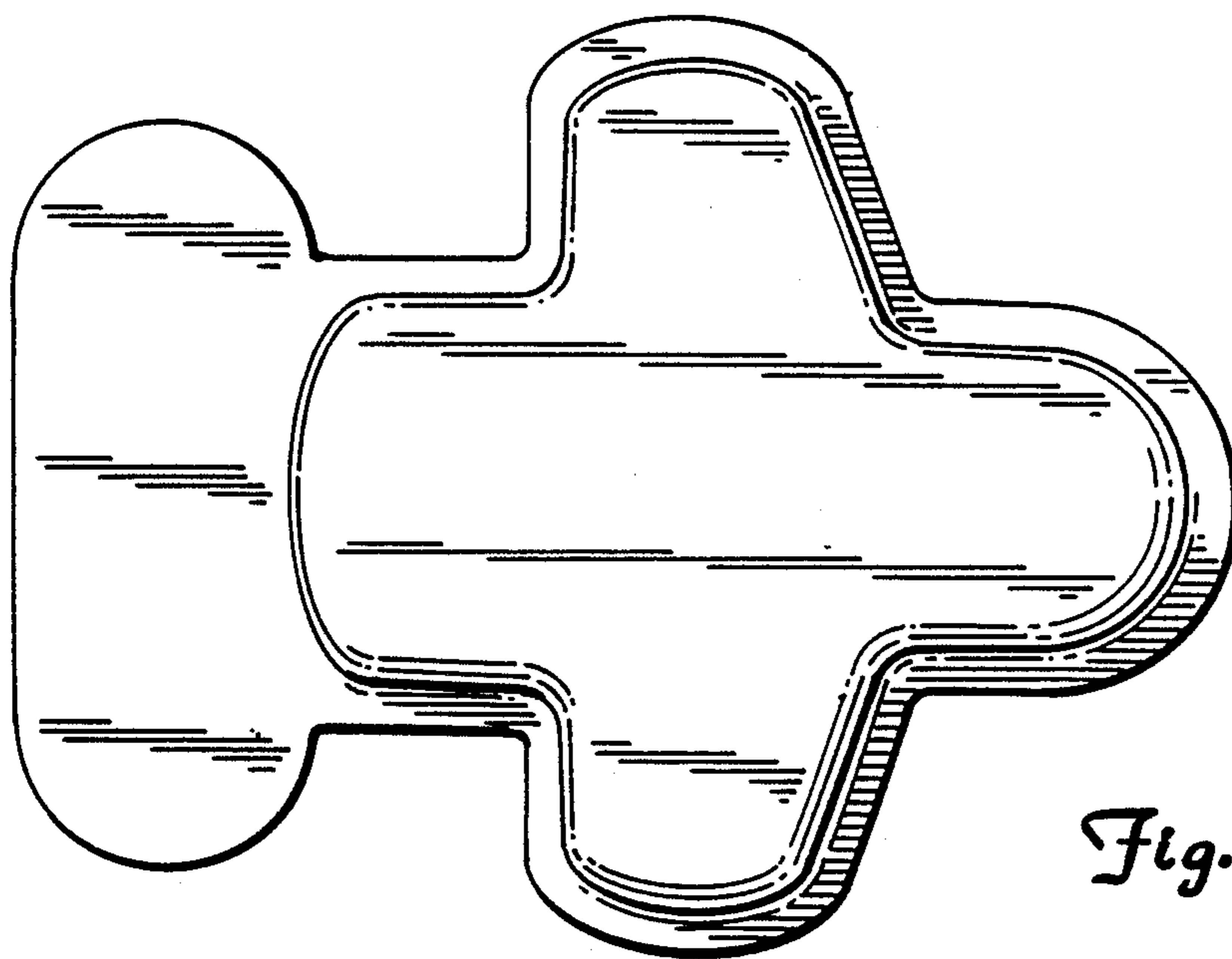

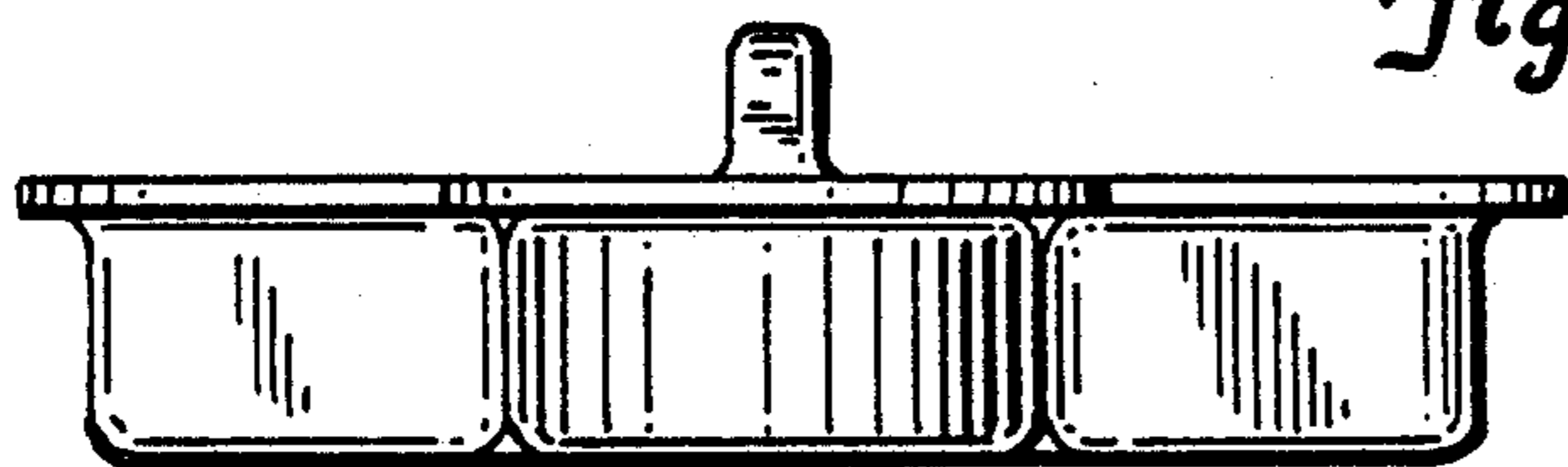
