elevational view being flat and unornamented;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of a second embodi-
ment of FIG. 1, the only difference residing the front
panel.

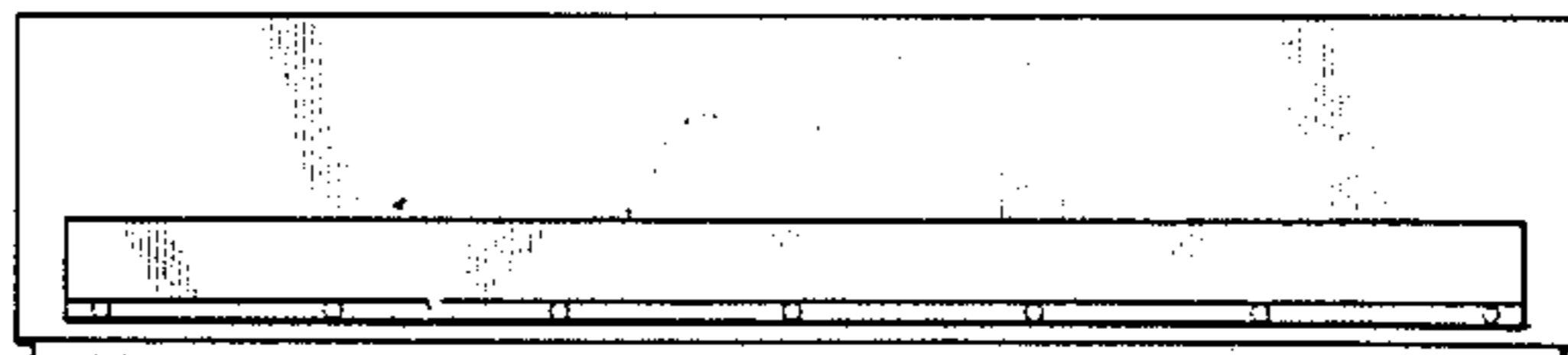

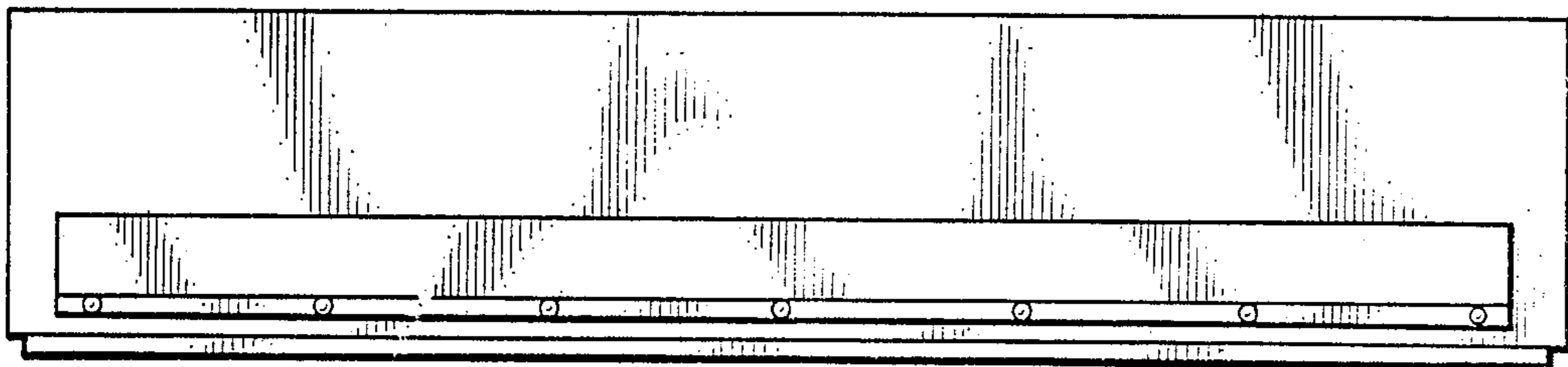

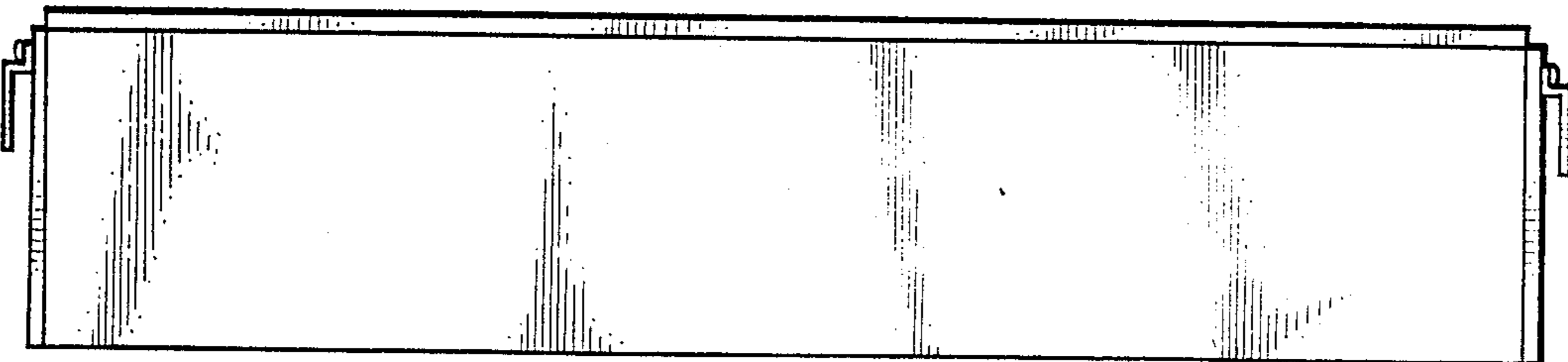

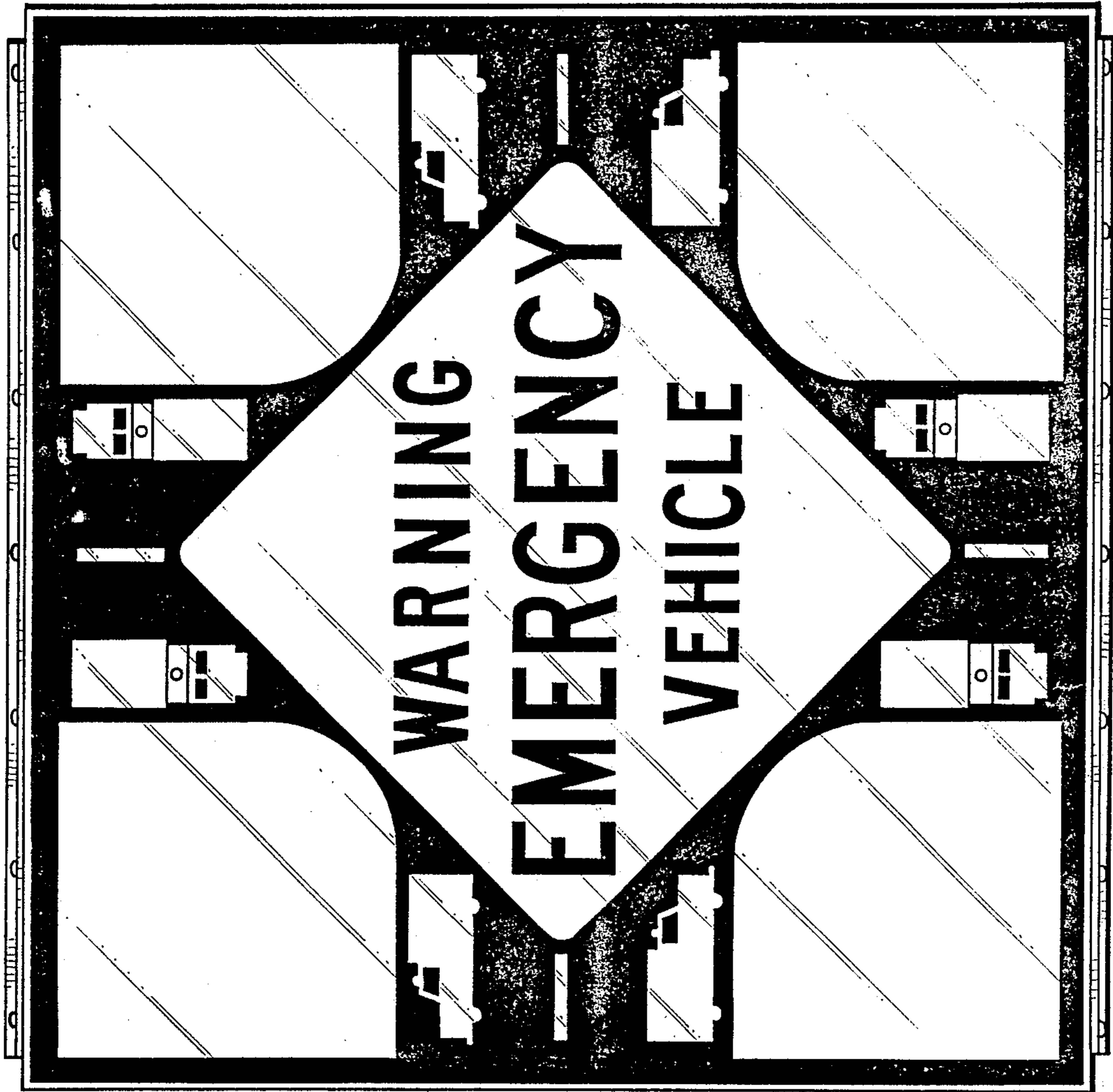
