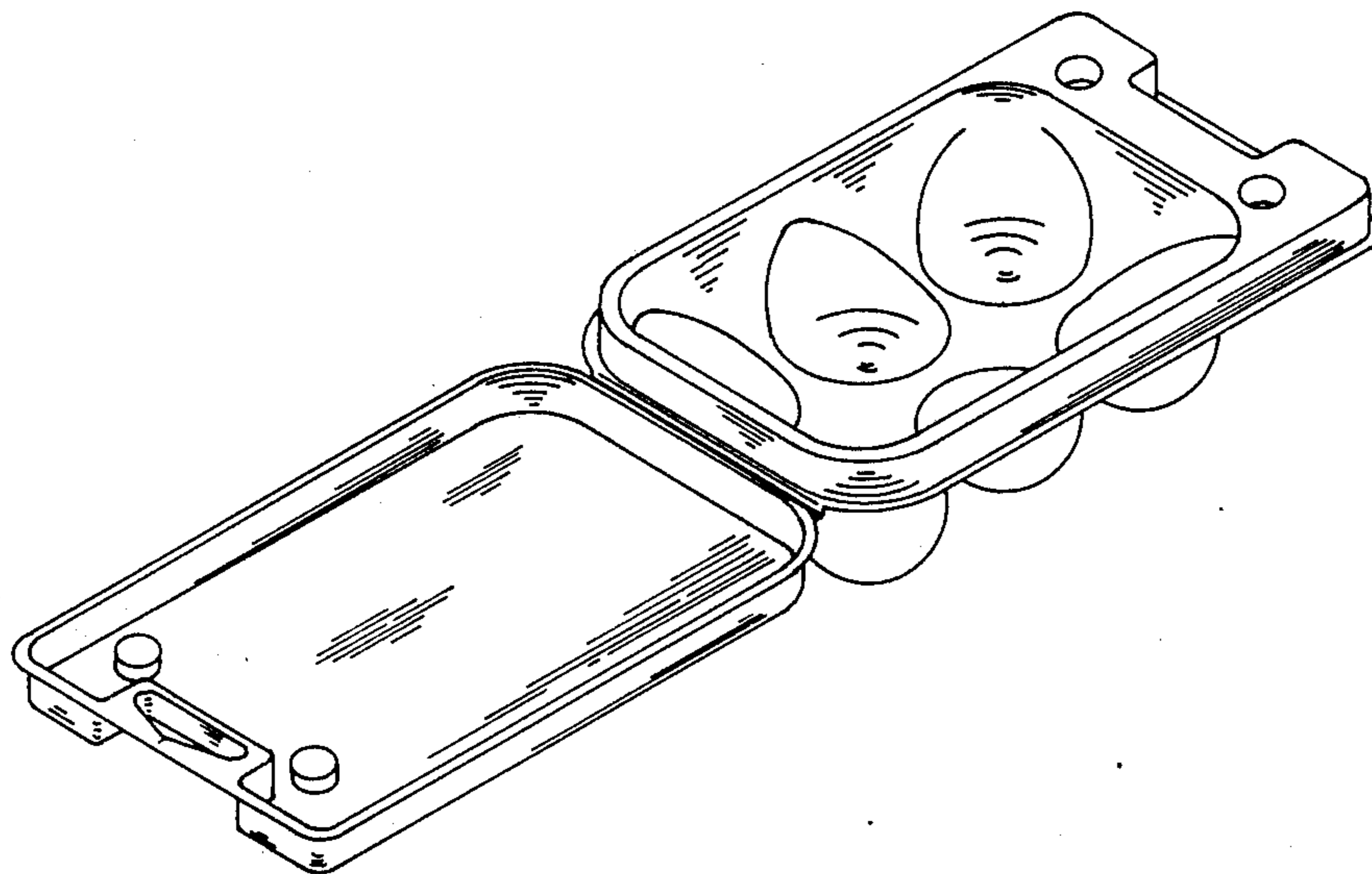

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear side elevation of a golf ball package showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevation thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevation thereof, the right side elevation being a mirror image; and
FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof, in an open position.



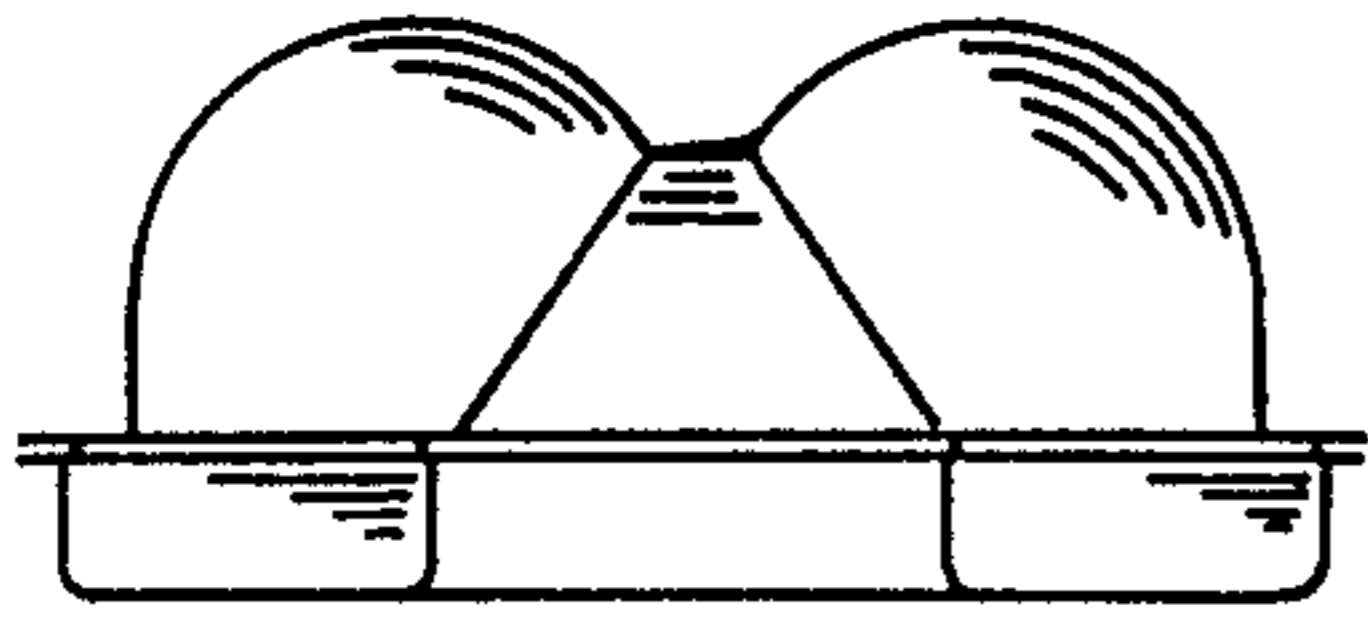

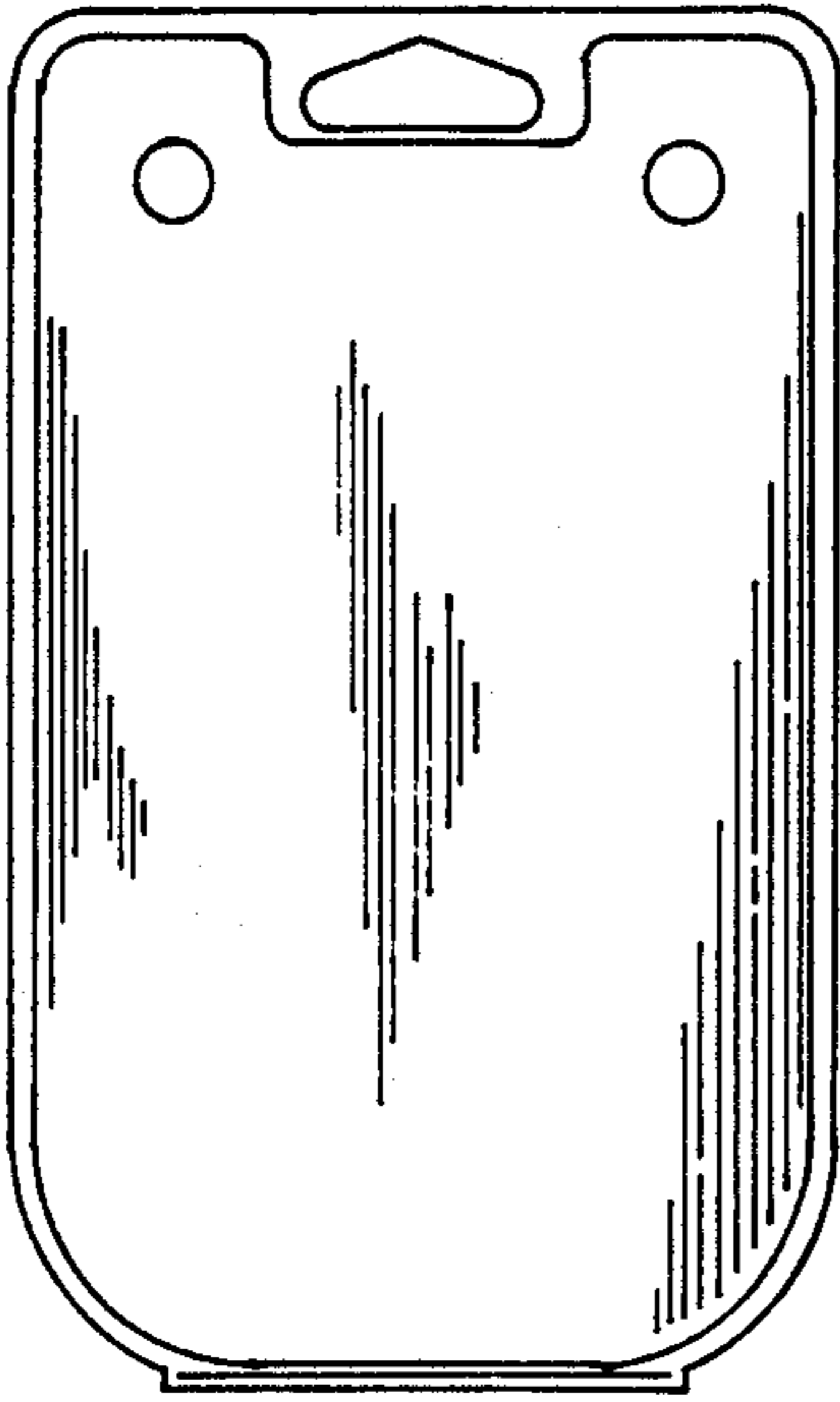

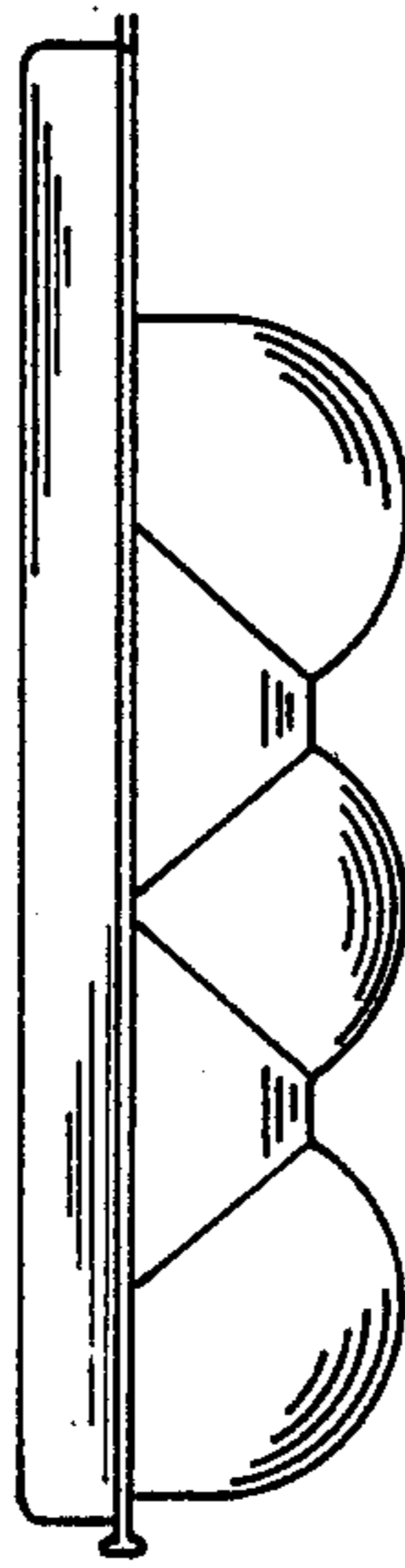

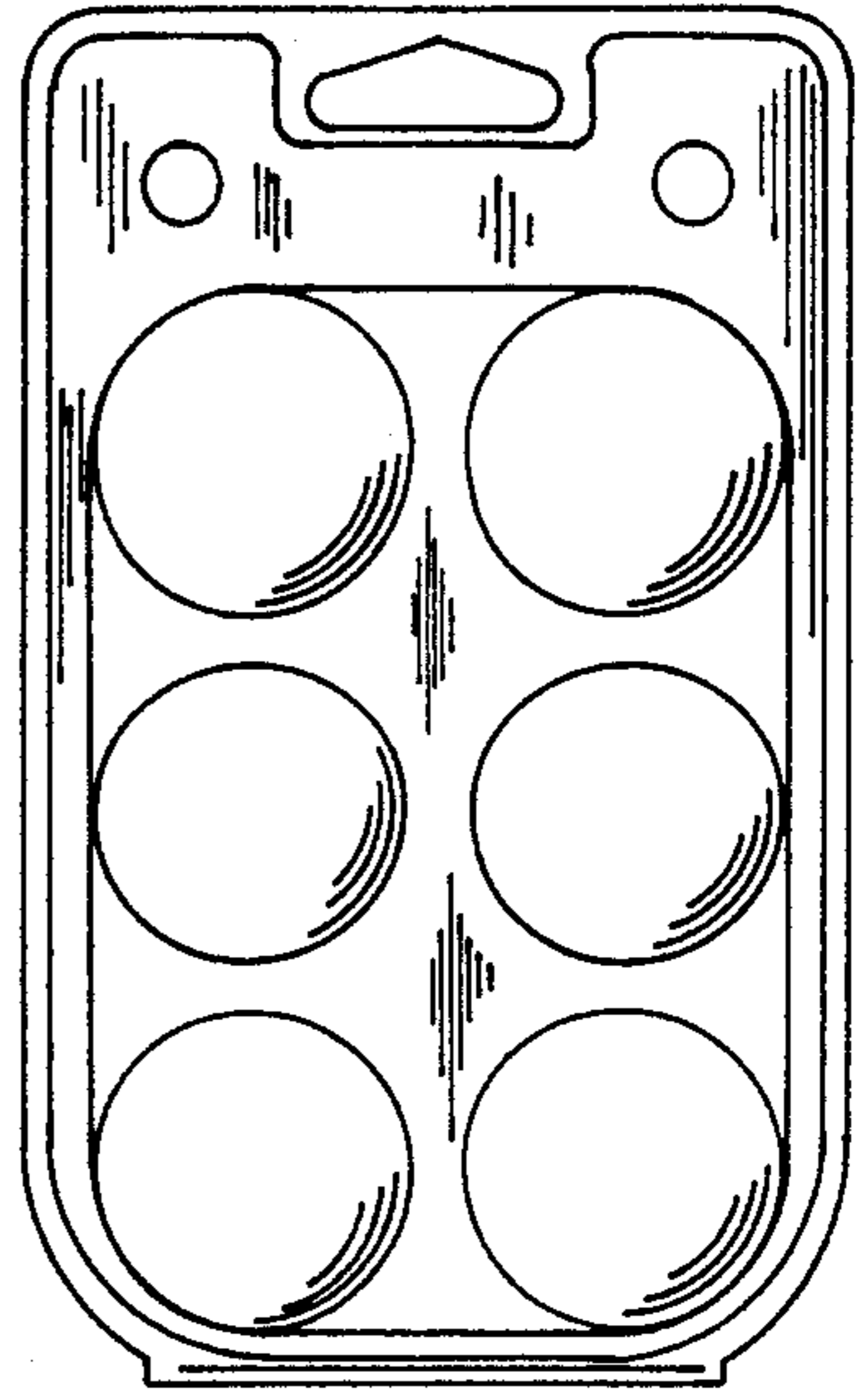

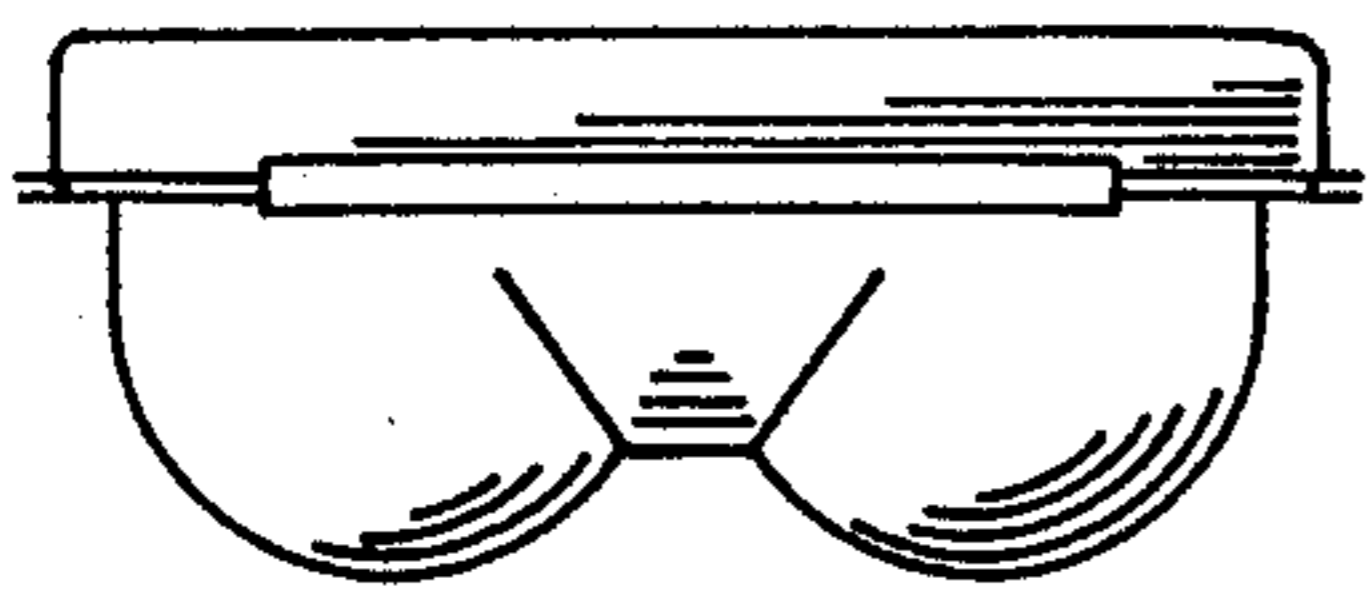

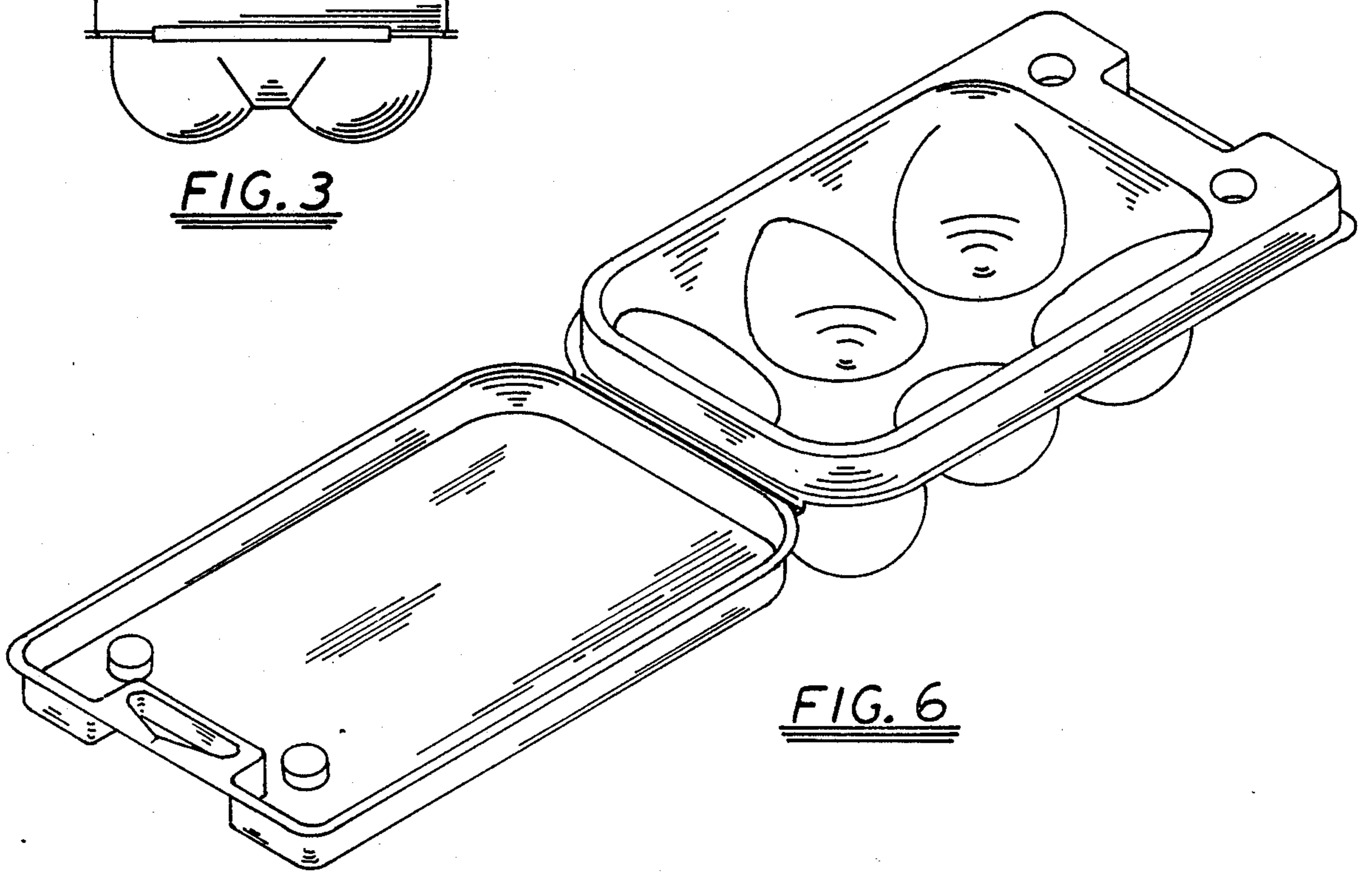
