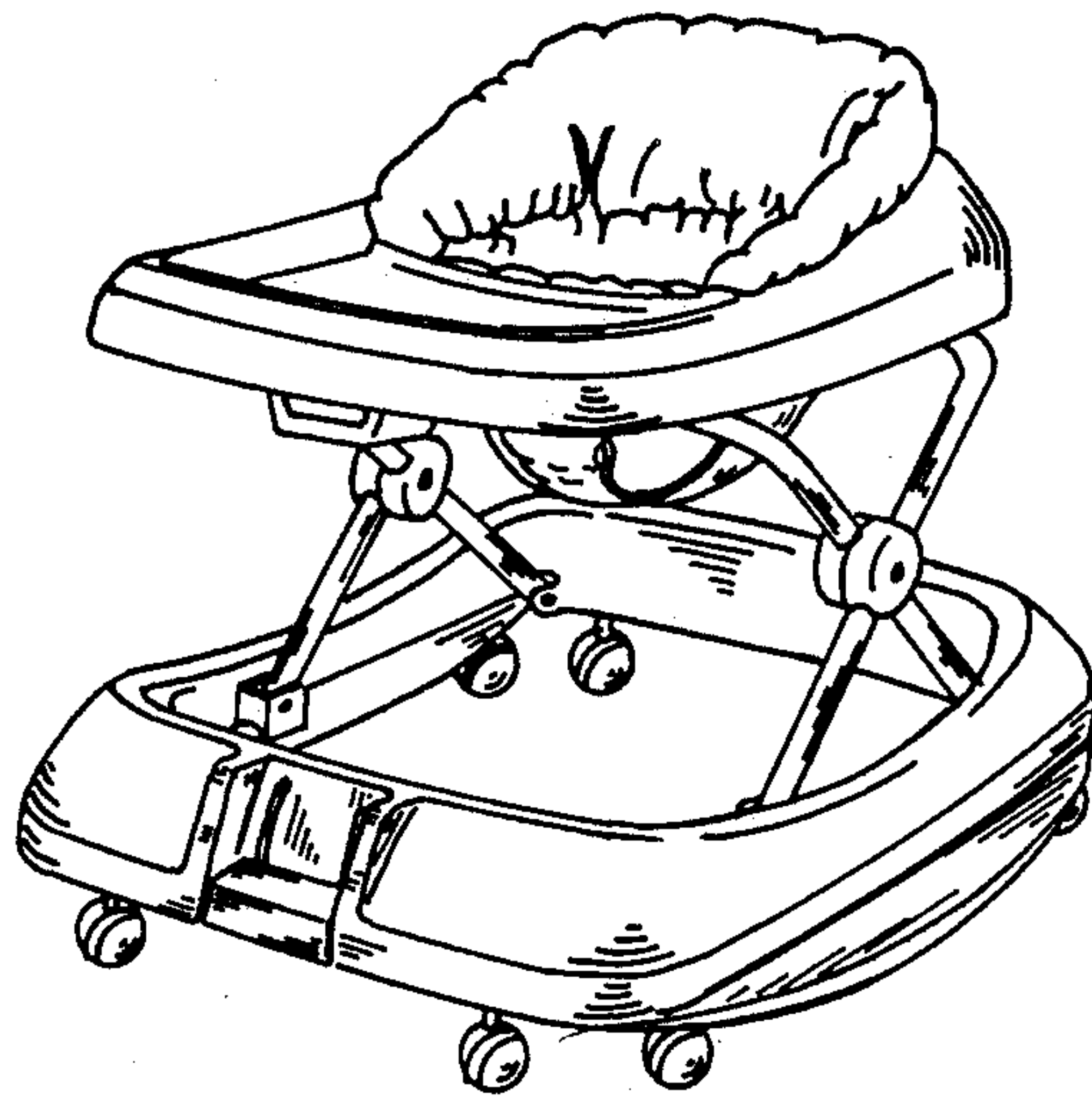
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side elevational view being a mirror image of that shown;

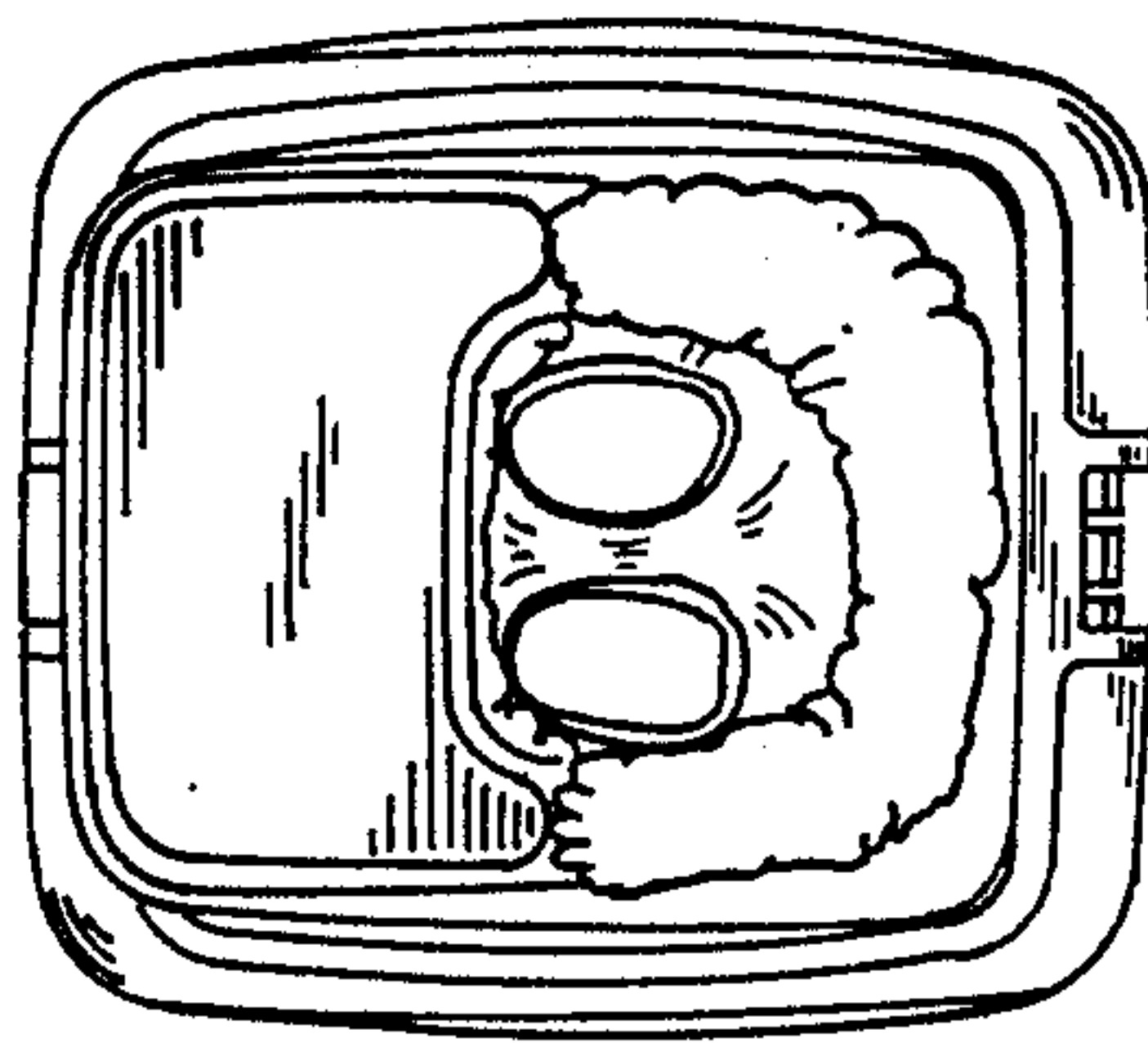

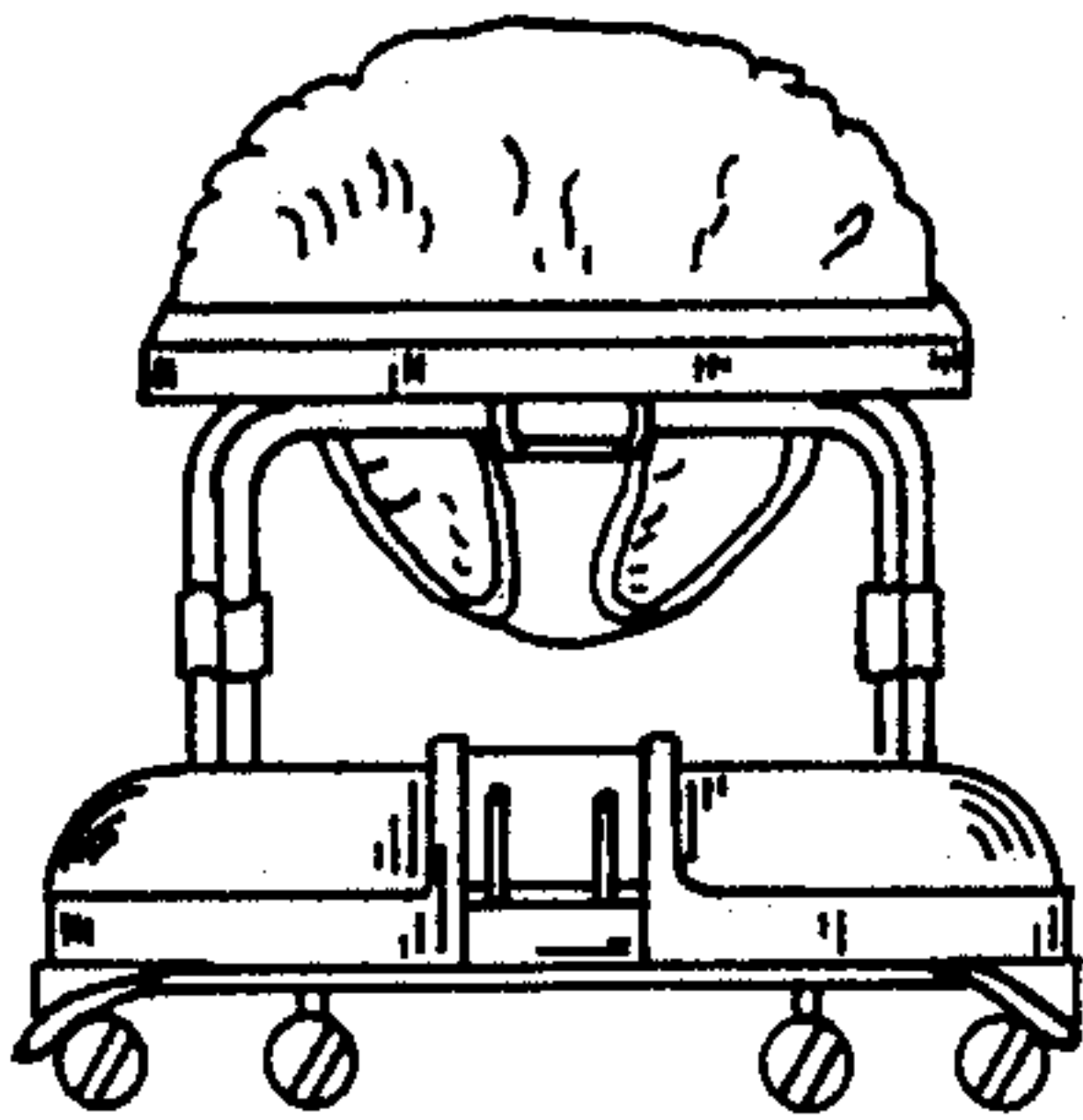

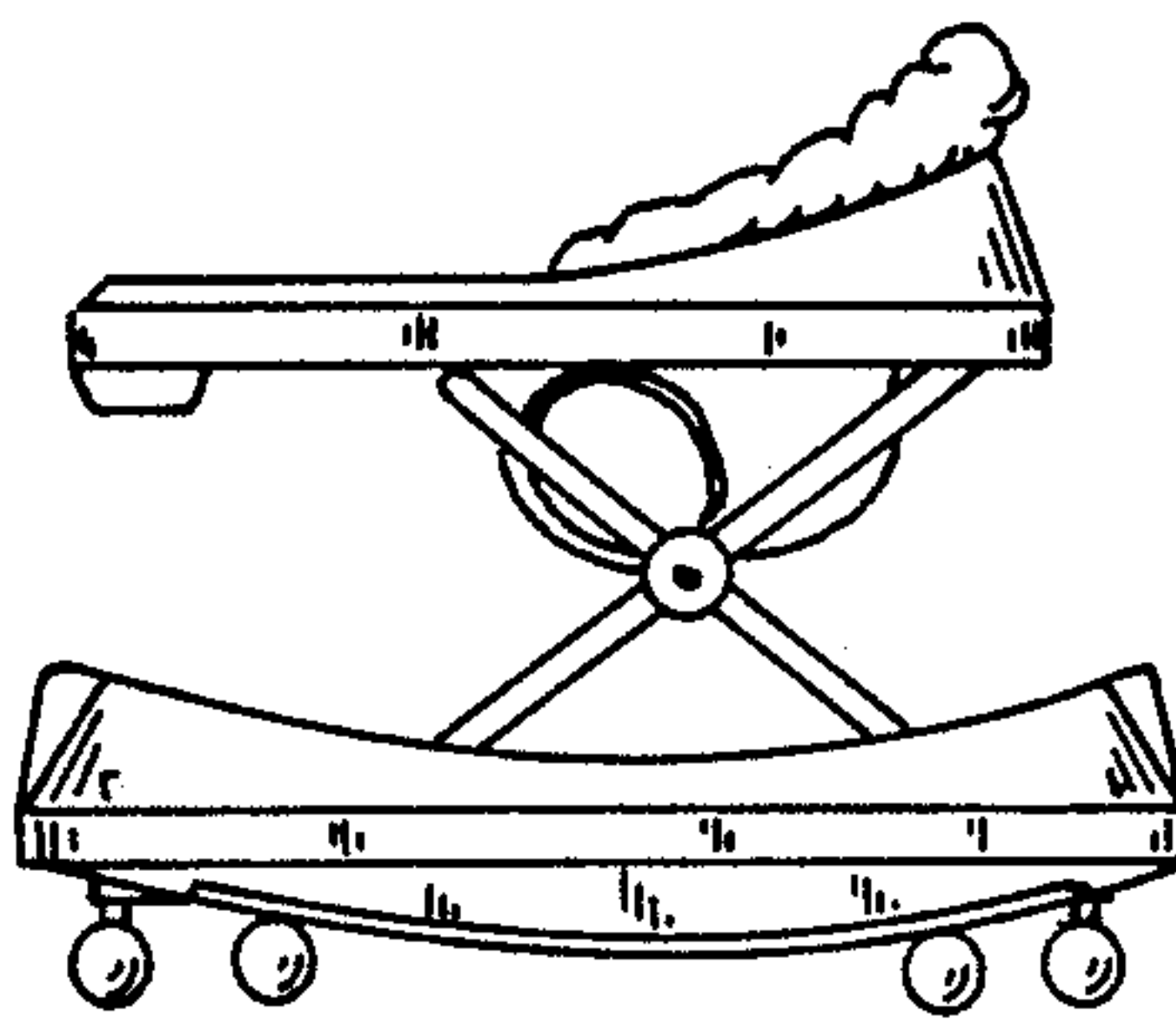

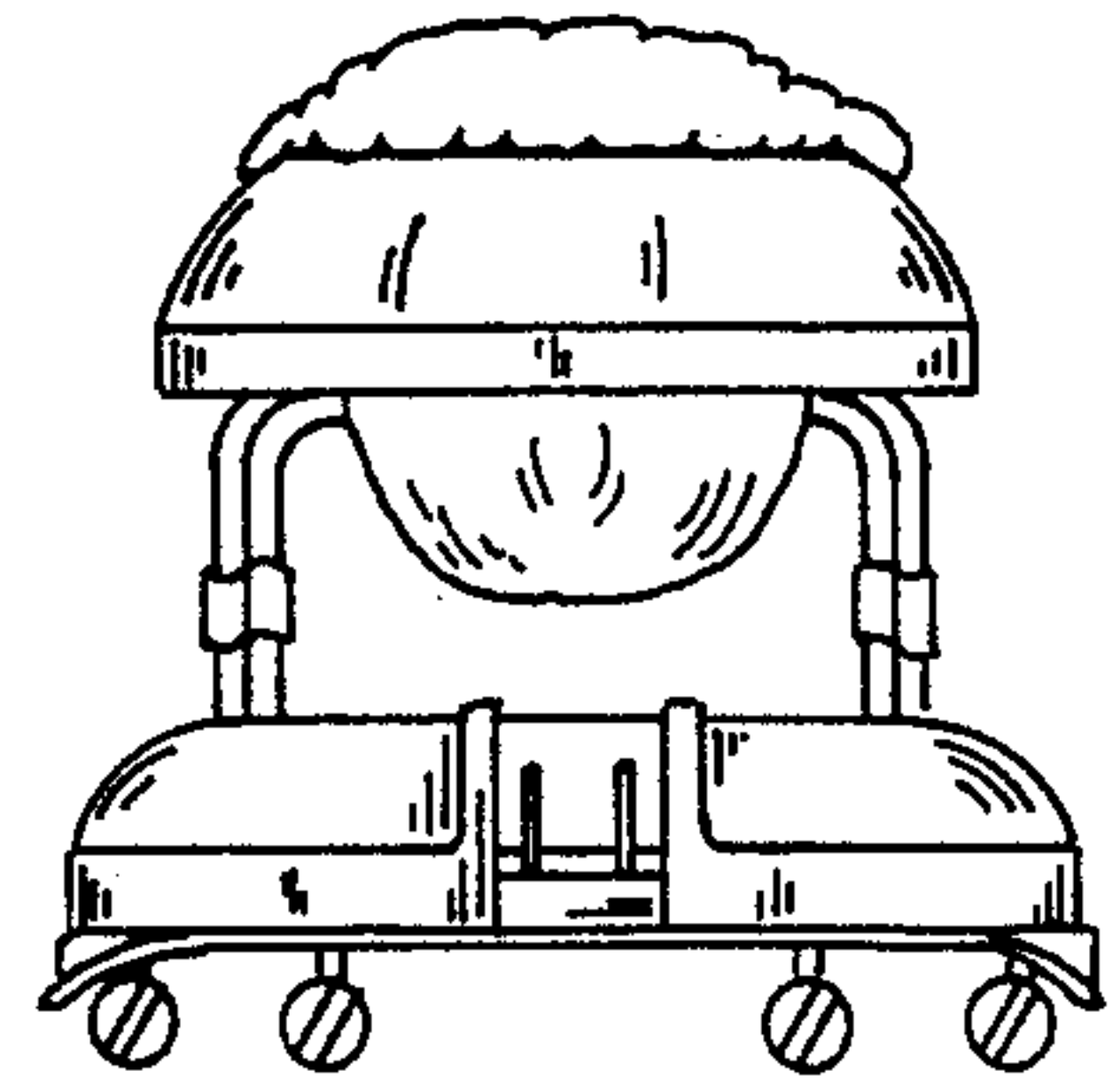

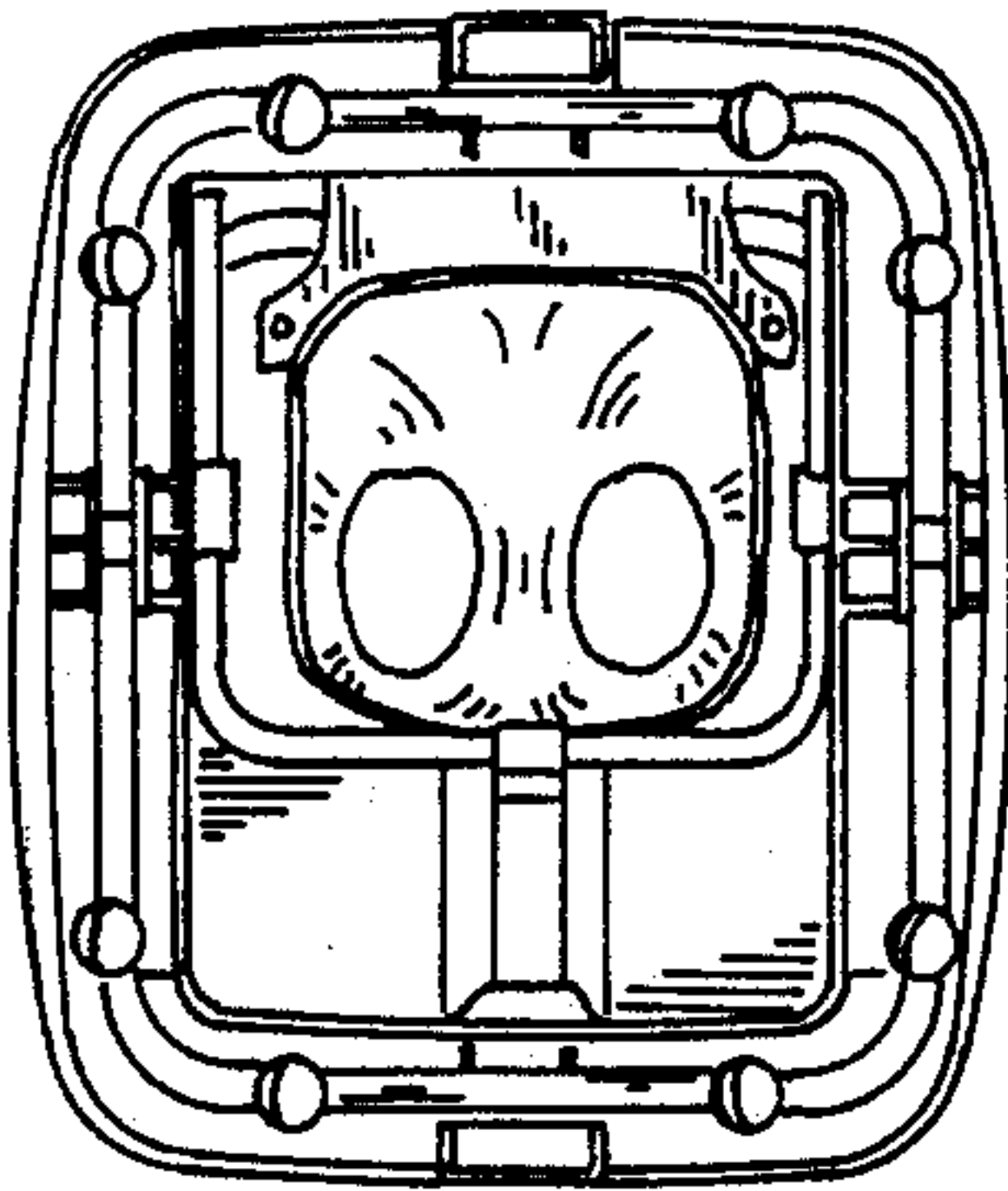

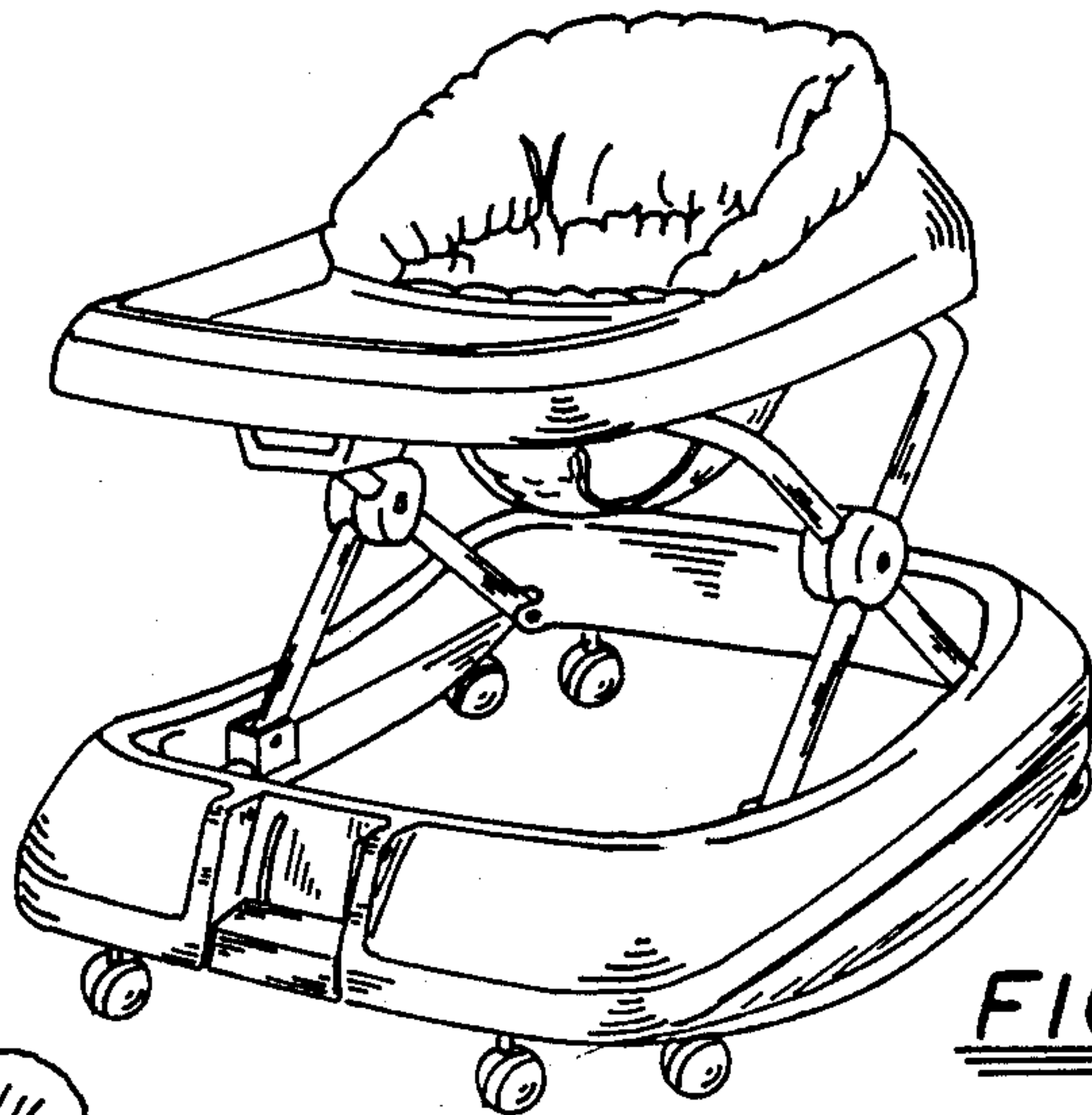

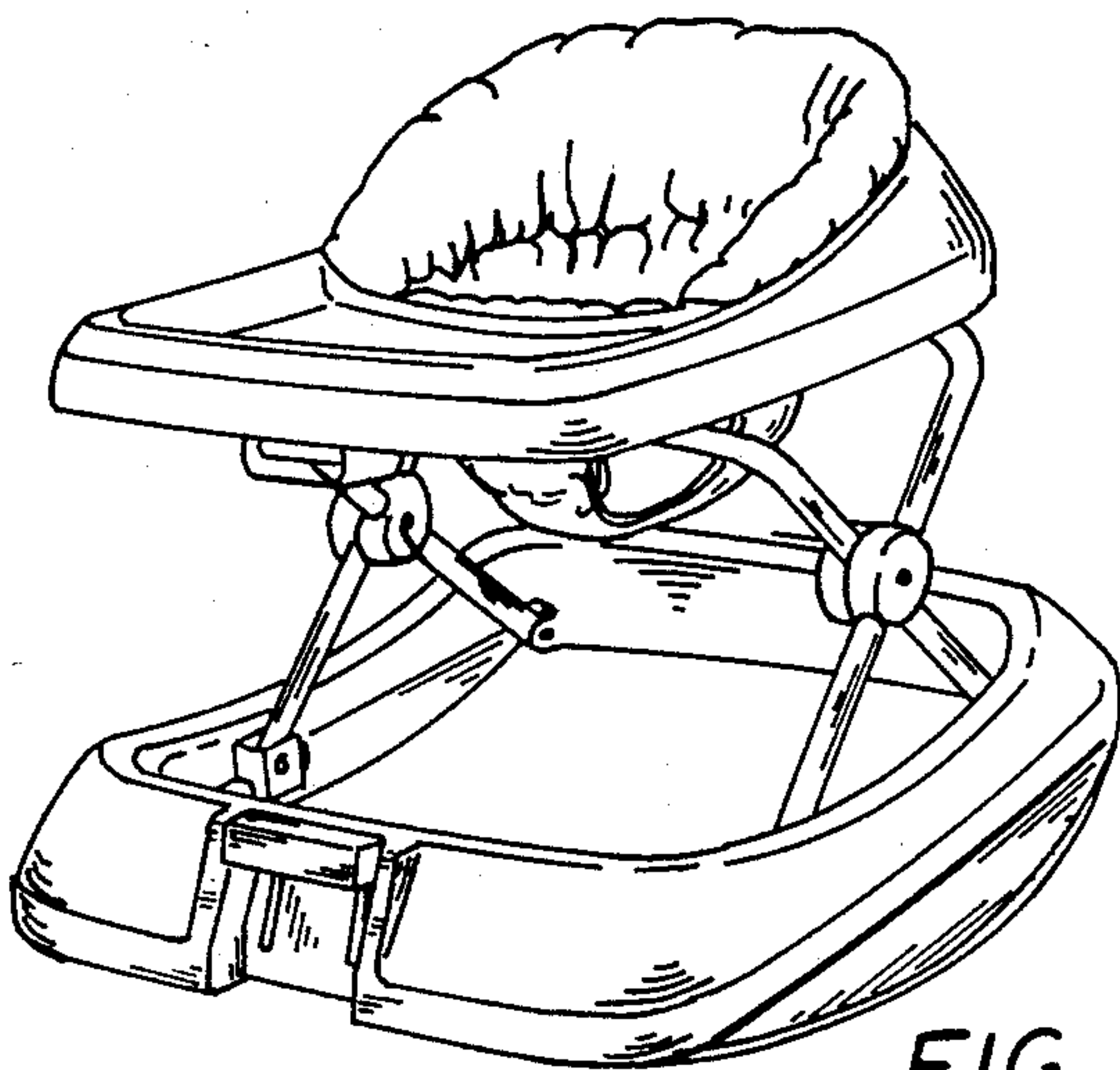

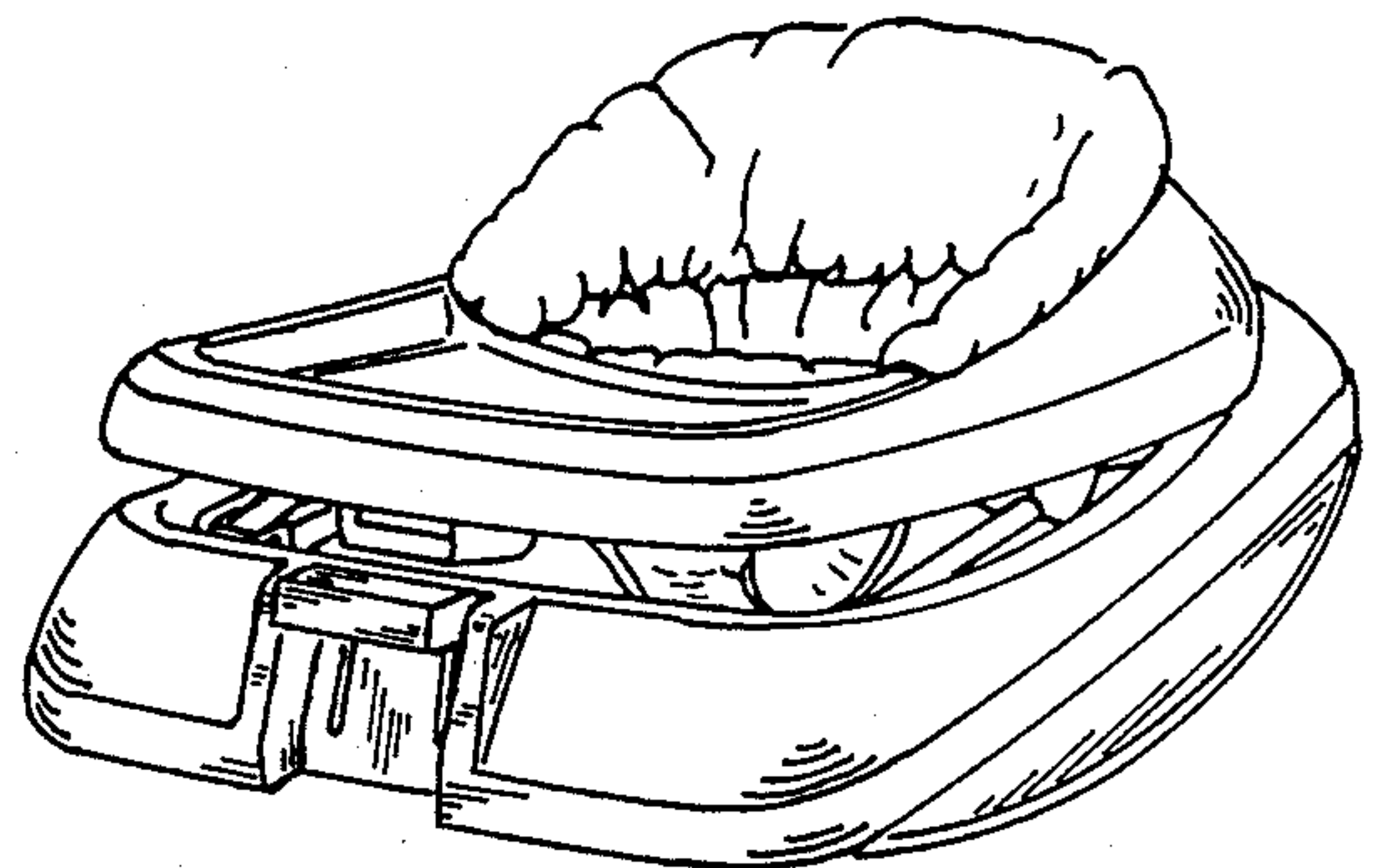
