[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined tape recorder, digital audio disc player and radio, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top and front perspective view of a combined tape recorder, digital audio disc player and radio showing our new design, with the antenna and handle in a raised position and the tape and disc holders in an open position;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

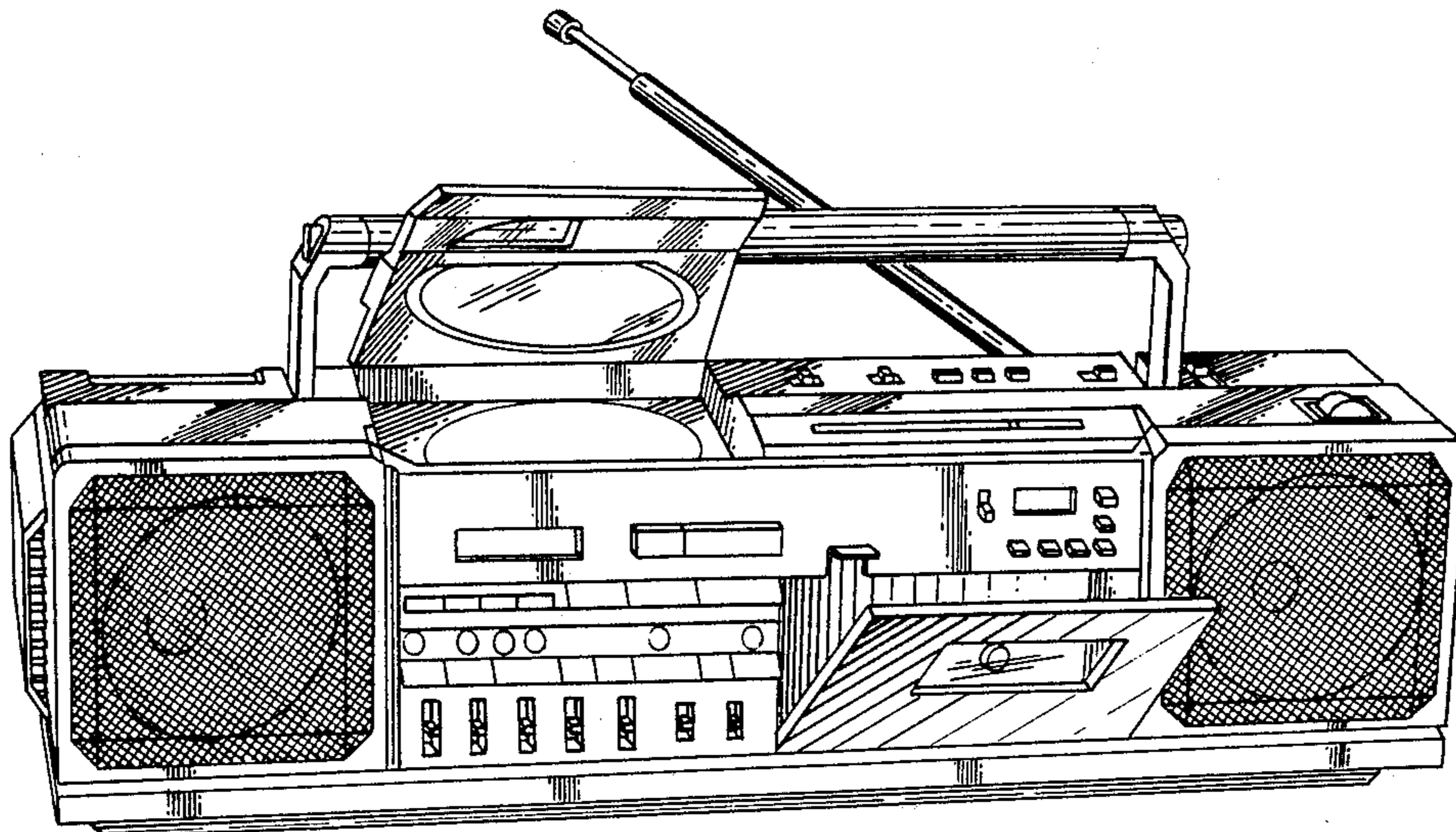
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a sectional view taken along the line 8—8 of FIG. 2.



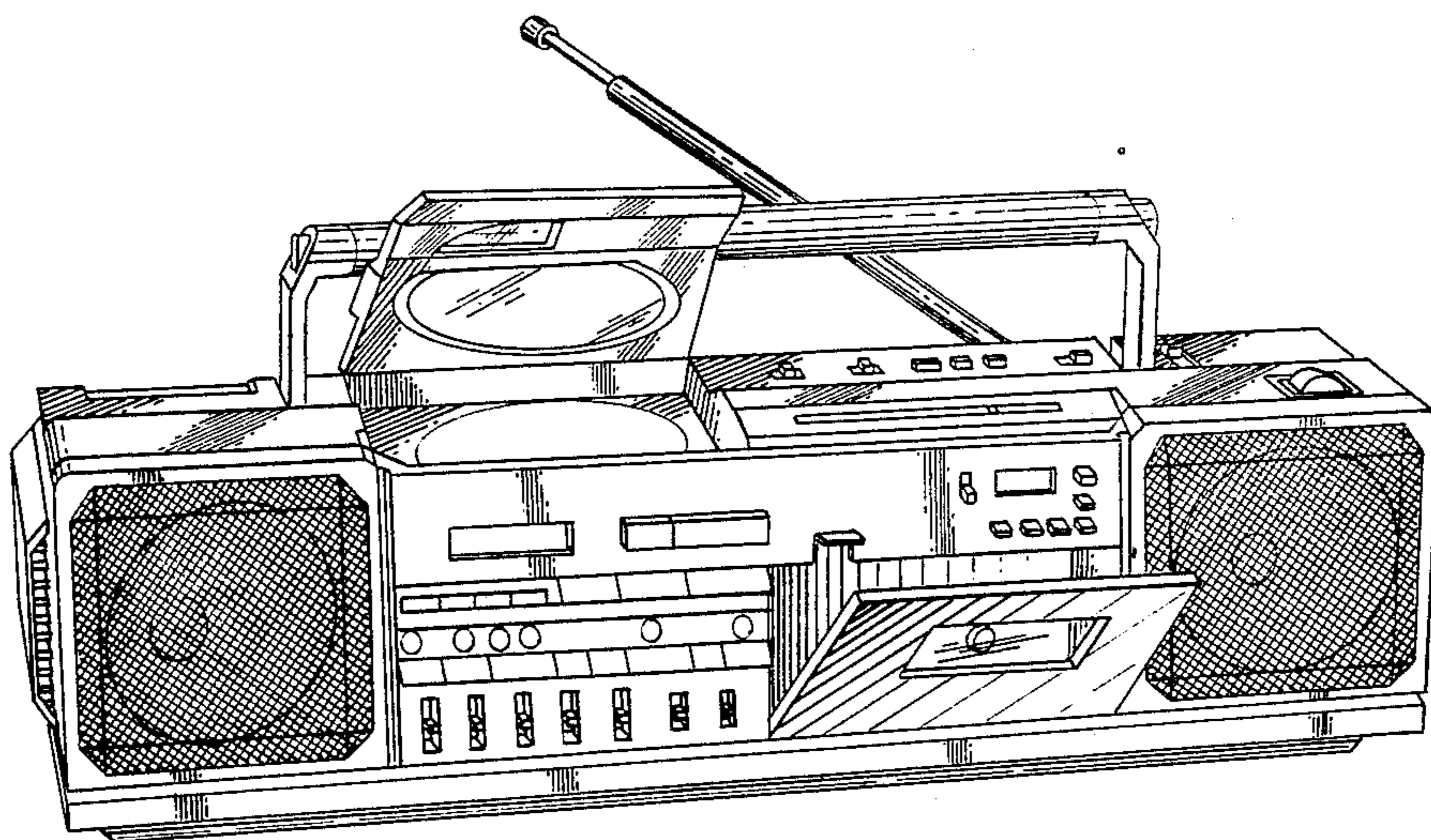

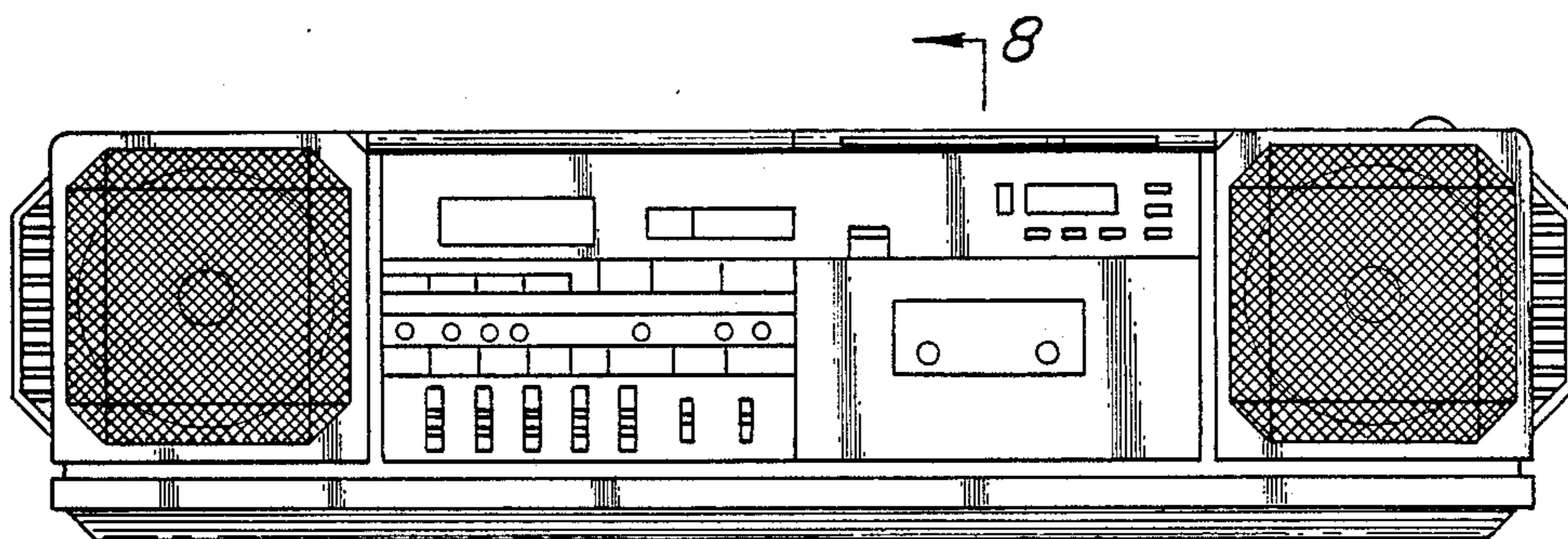

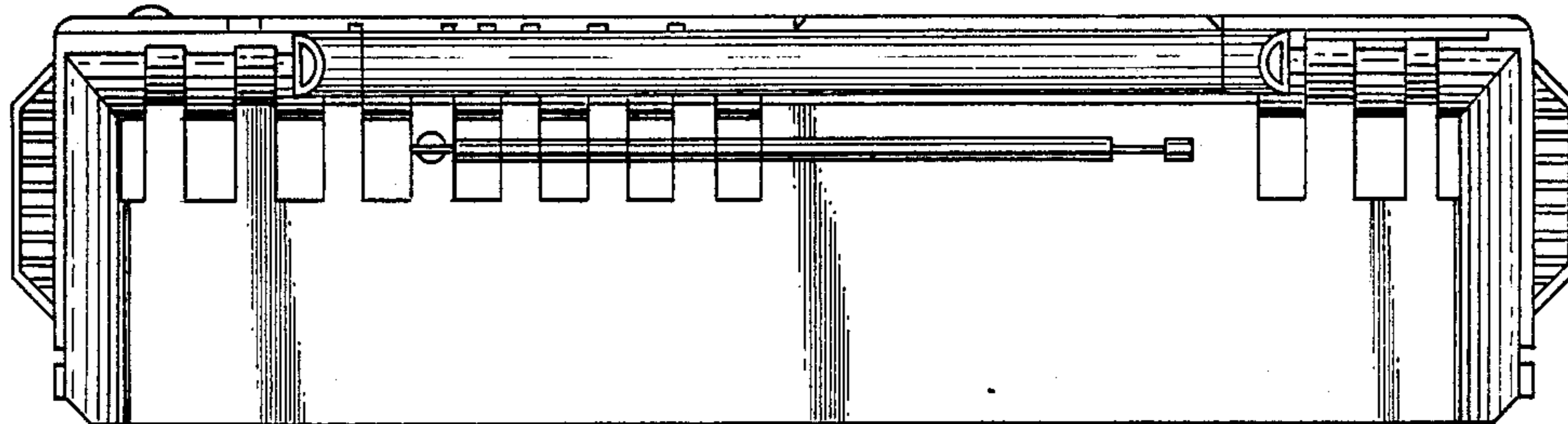

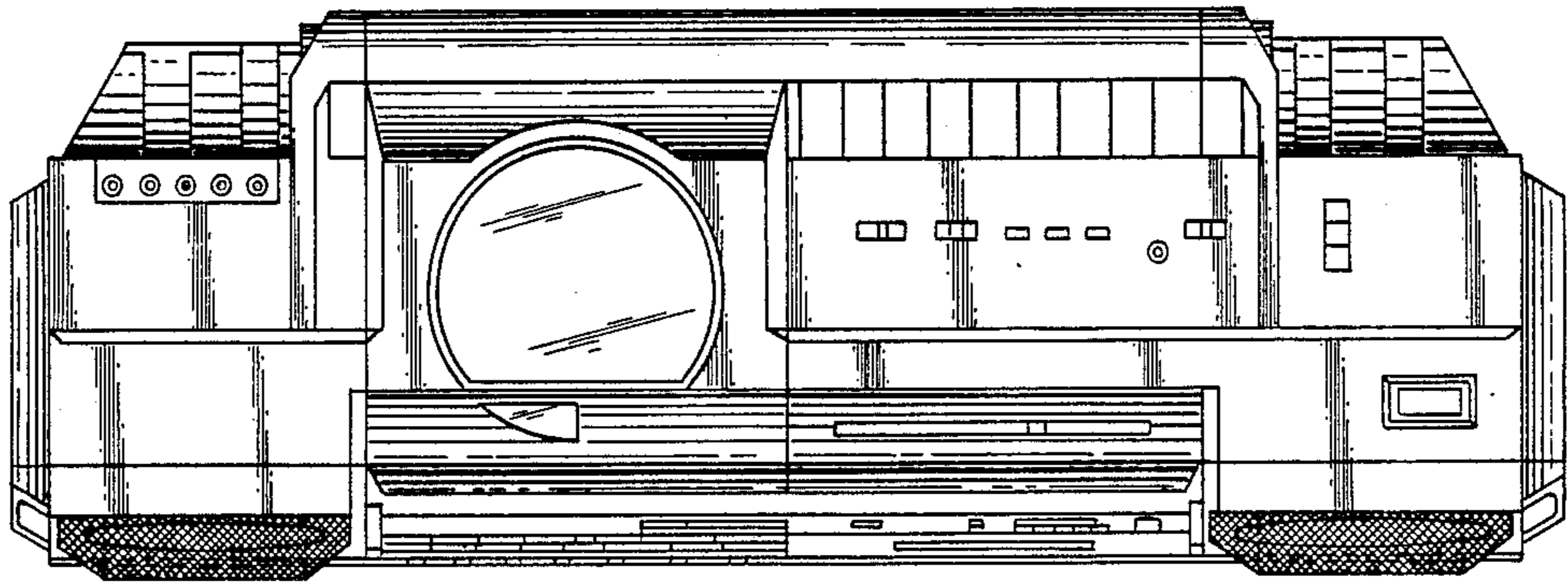

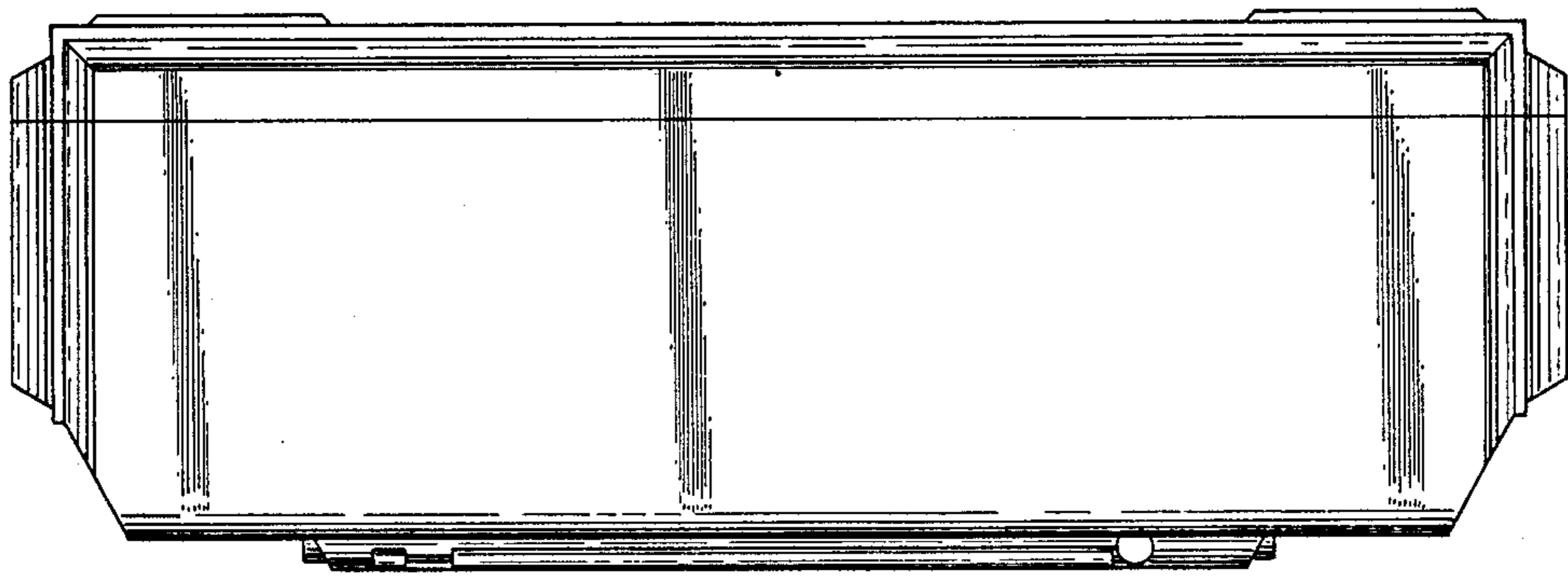

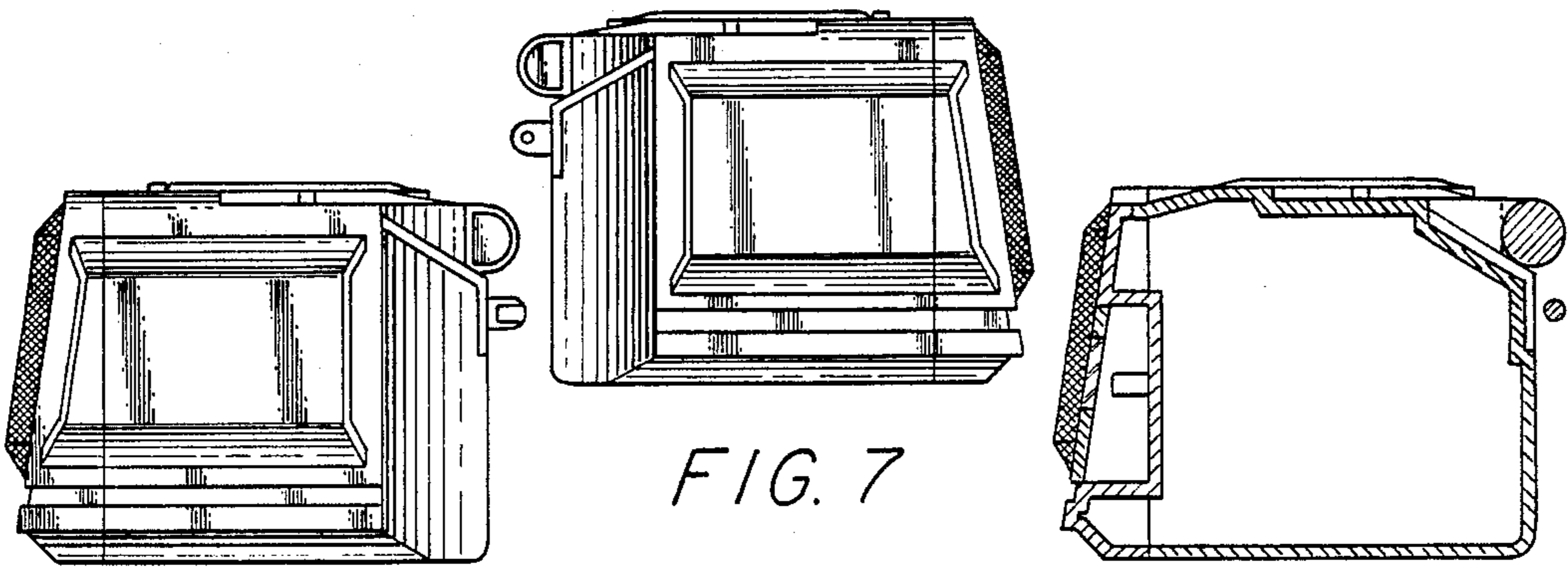
