DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a combined tape player and radio tuner showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top, front and left side perspective view thereof, shown with the lid in an open position;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

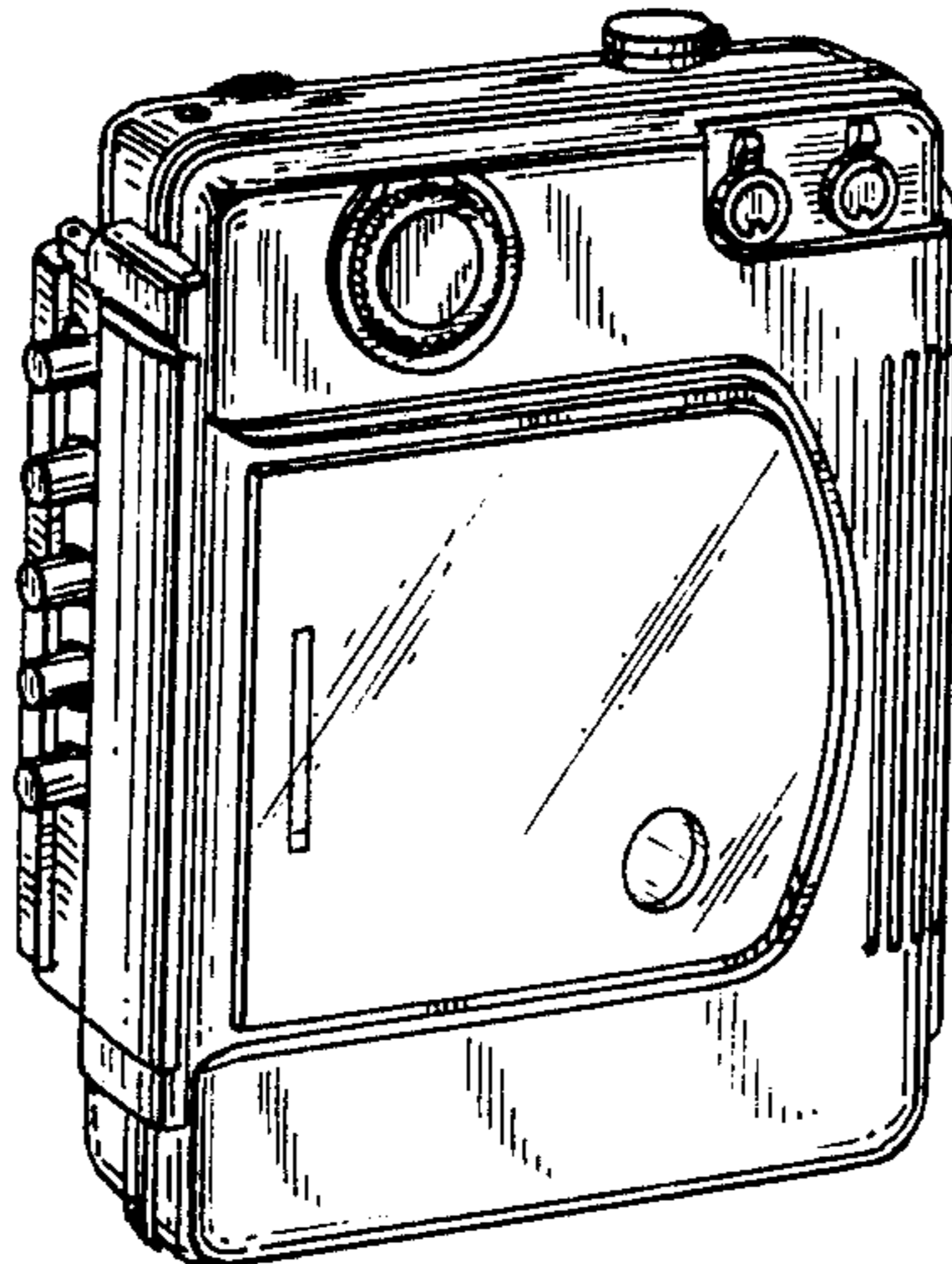
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.



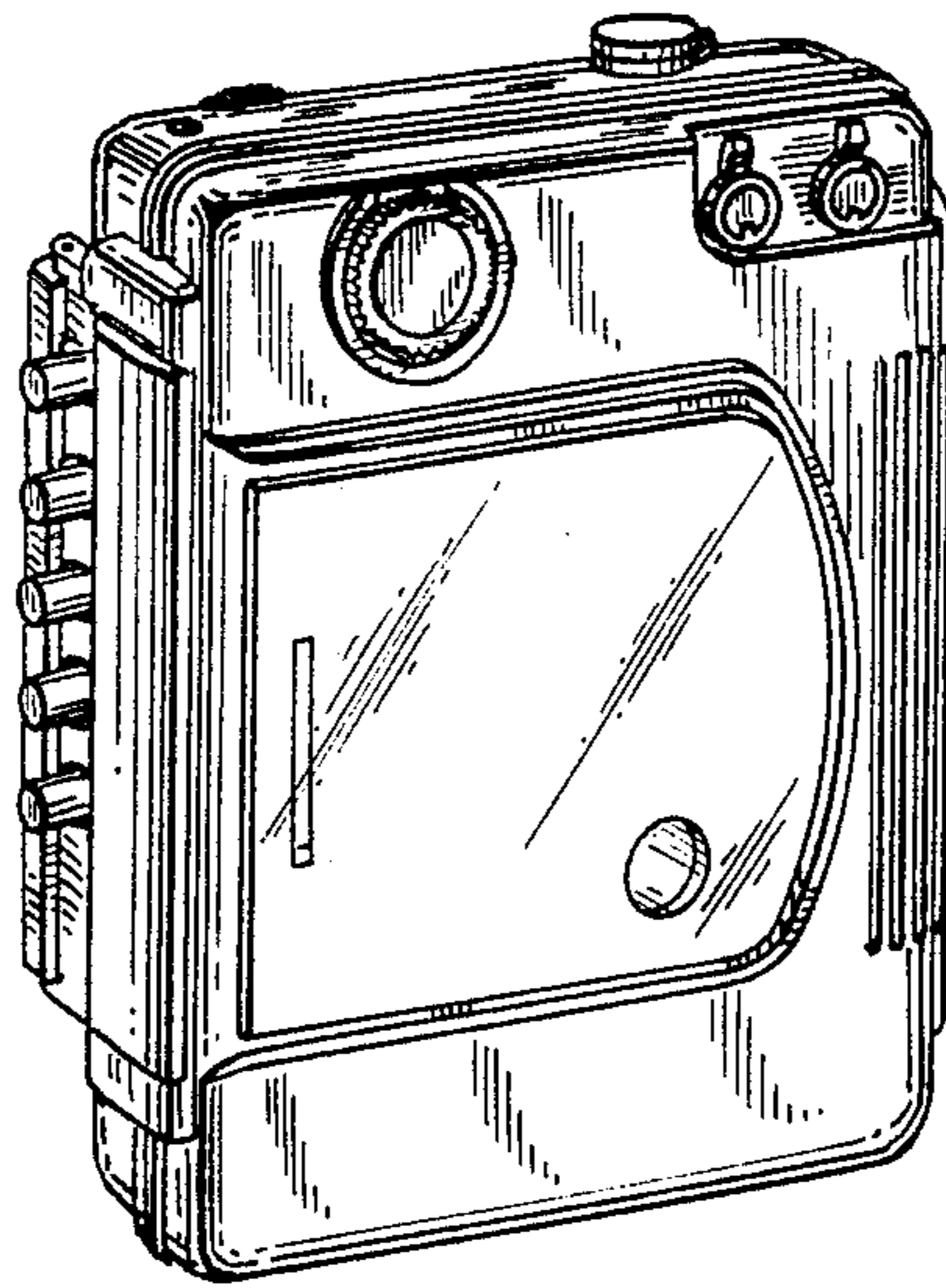

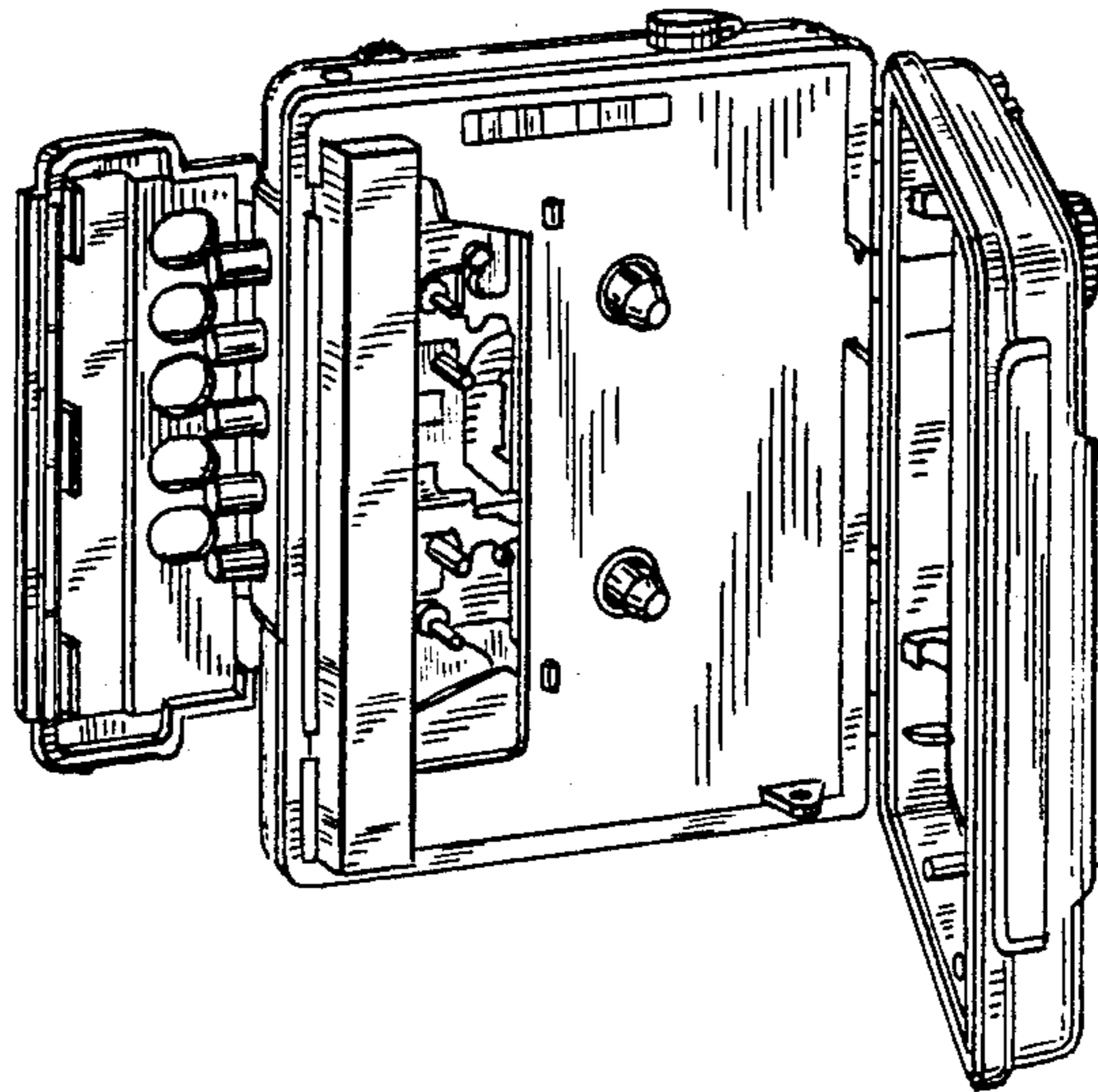

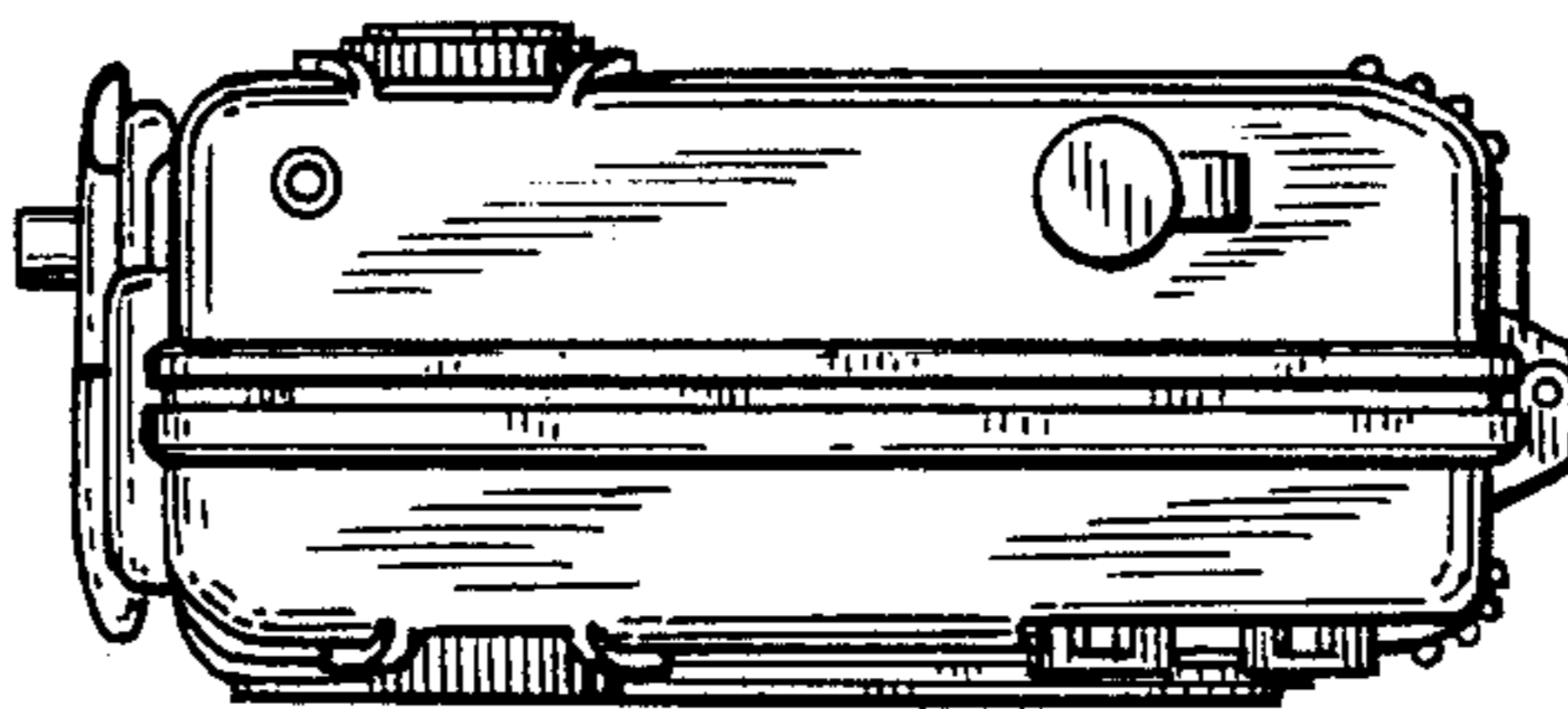
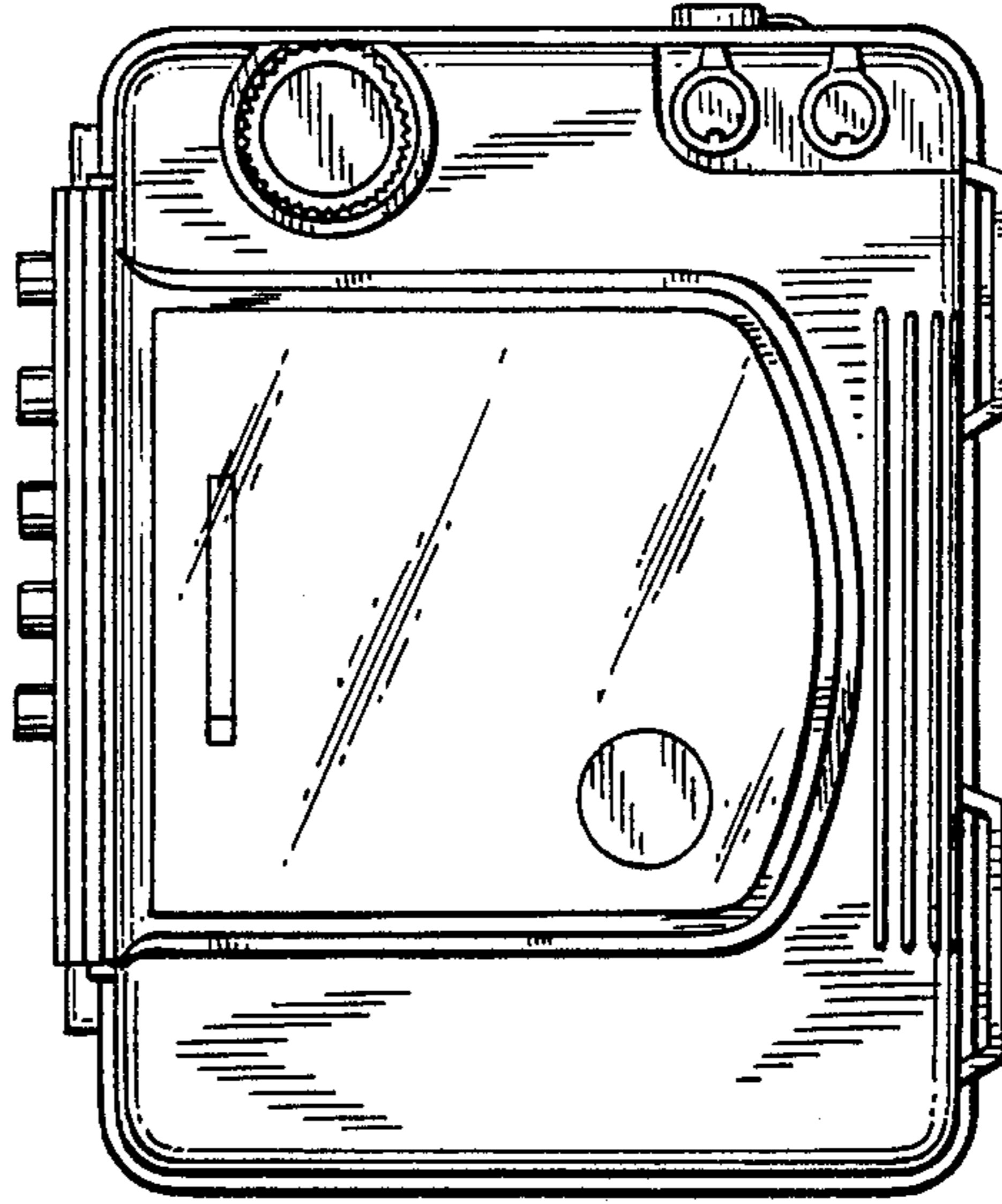

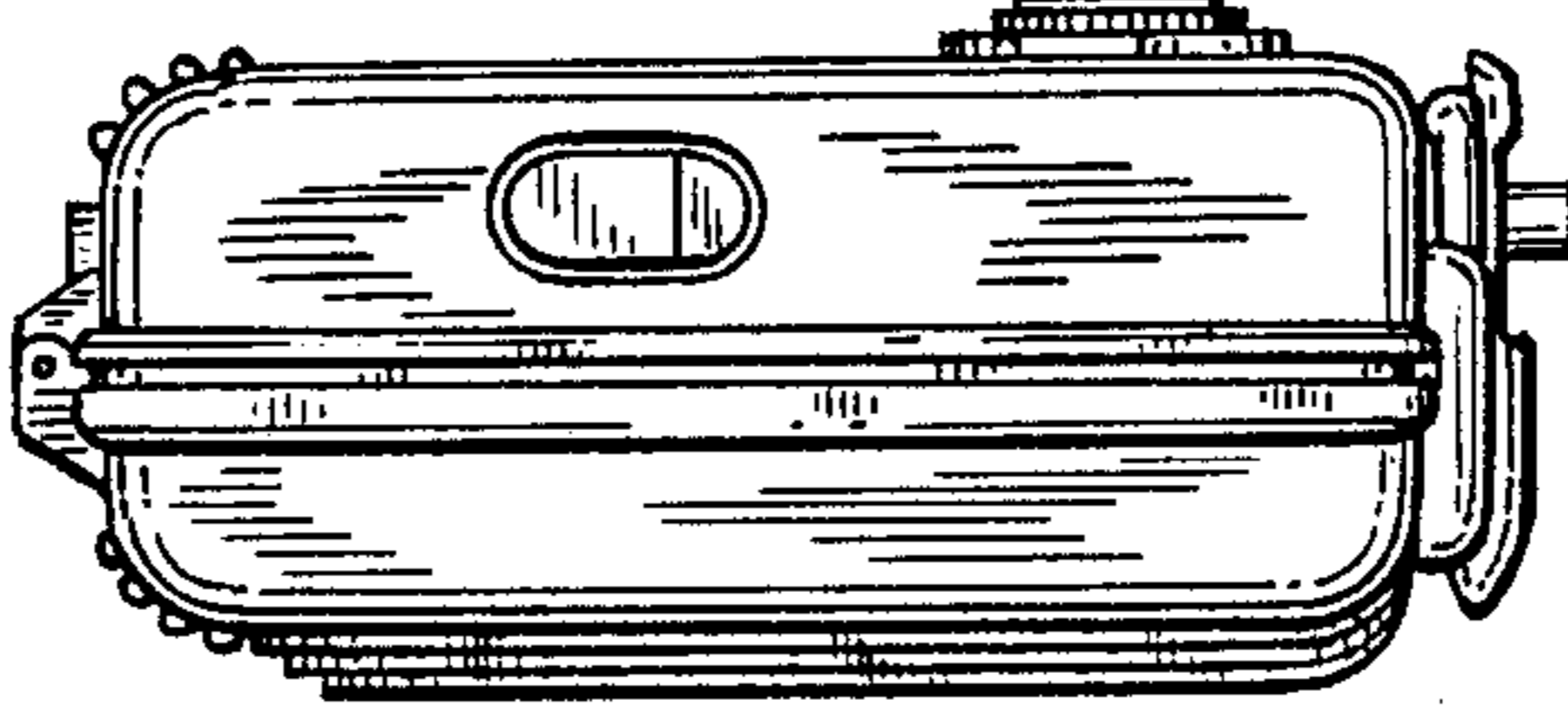
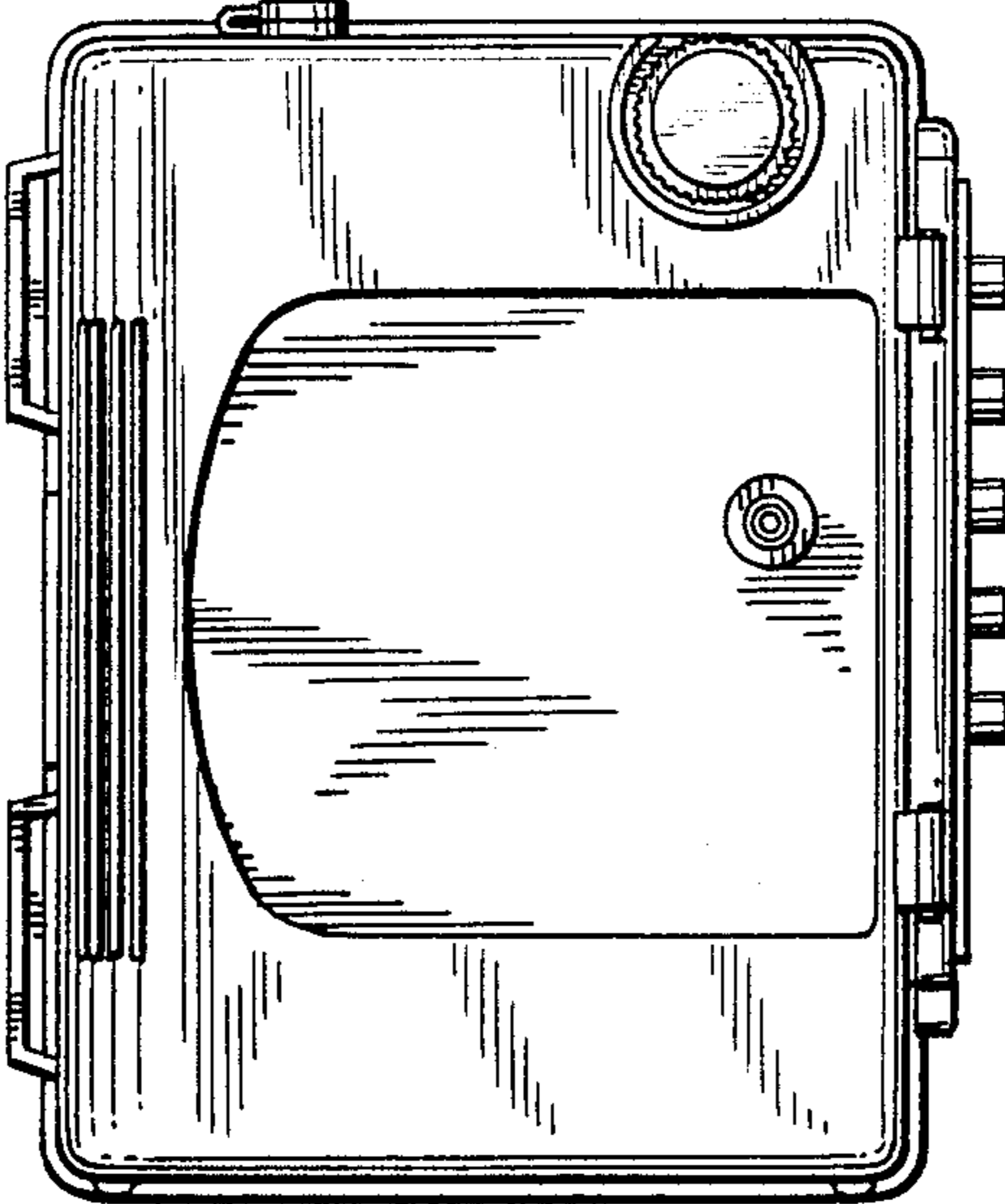

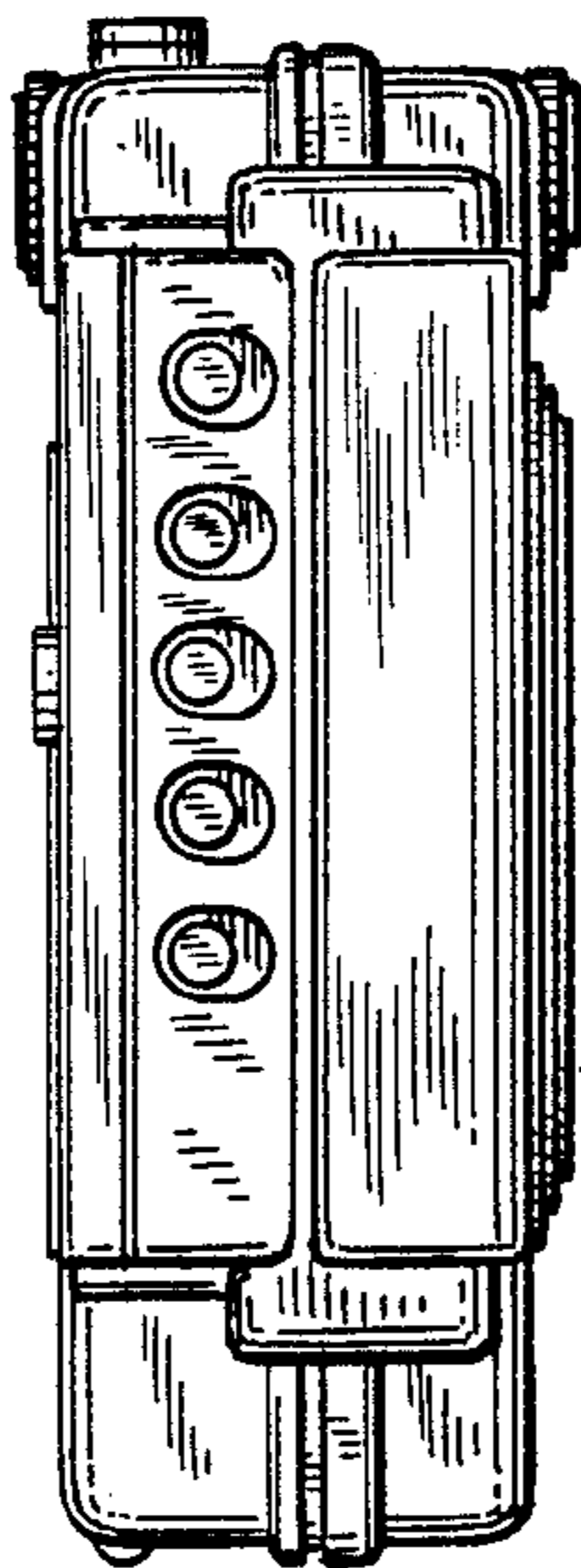
