FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a portable medical suction unit showing the new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

The cross-line pattern which is partially shown in FIGS. 1, 4 and 6 on the straps for ease of illustration, is intended to represent a conventional fabric.

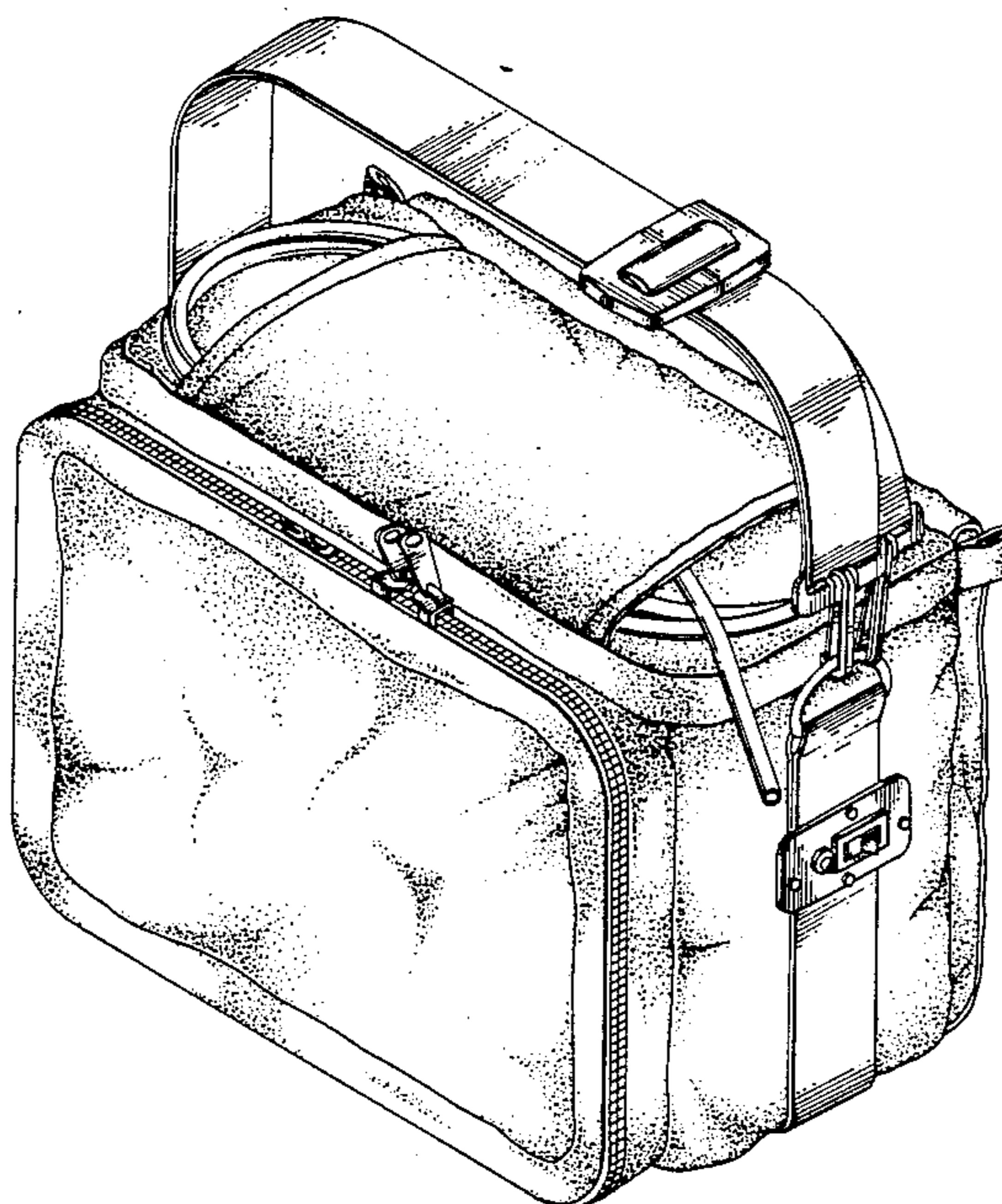

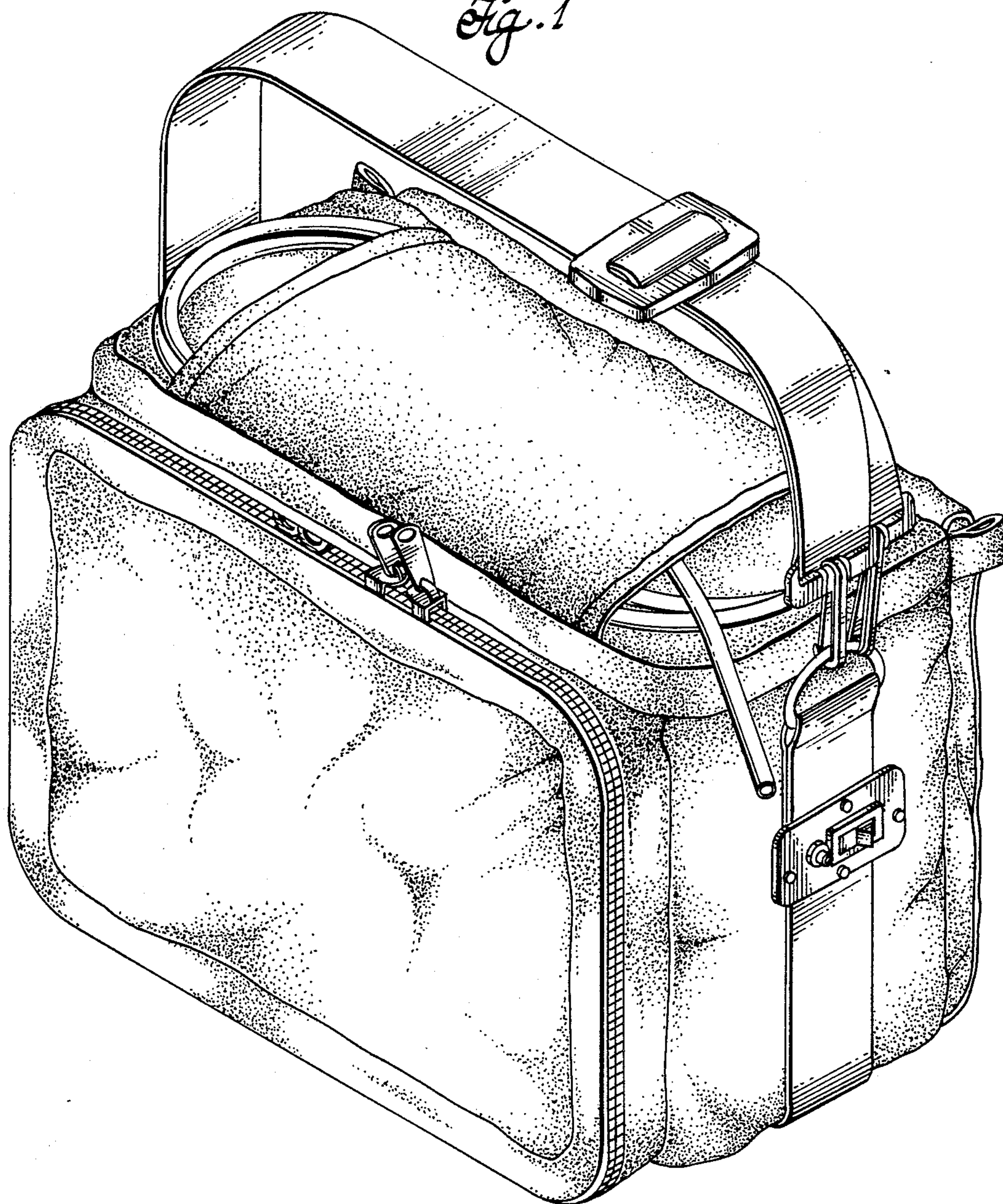

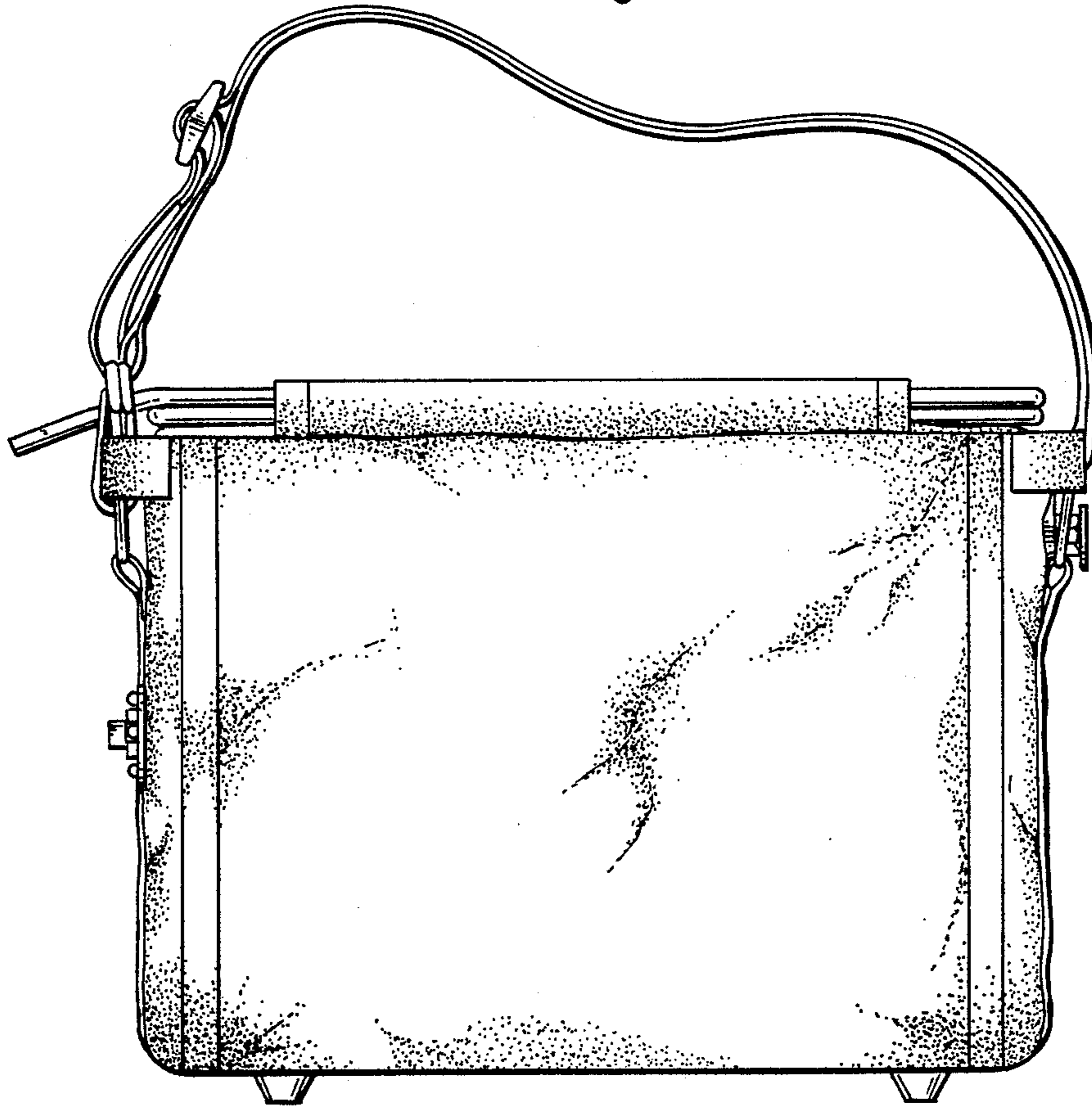

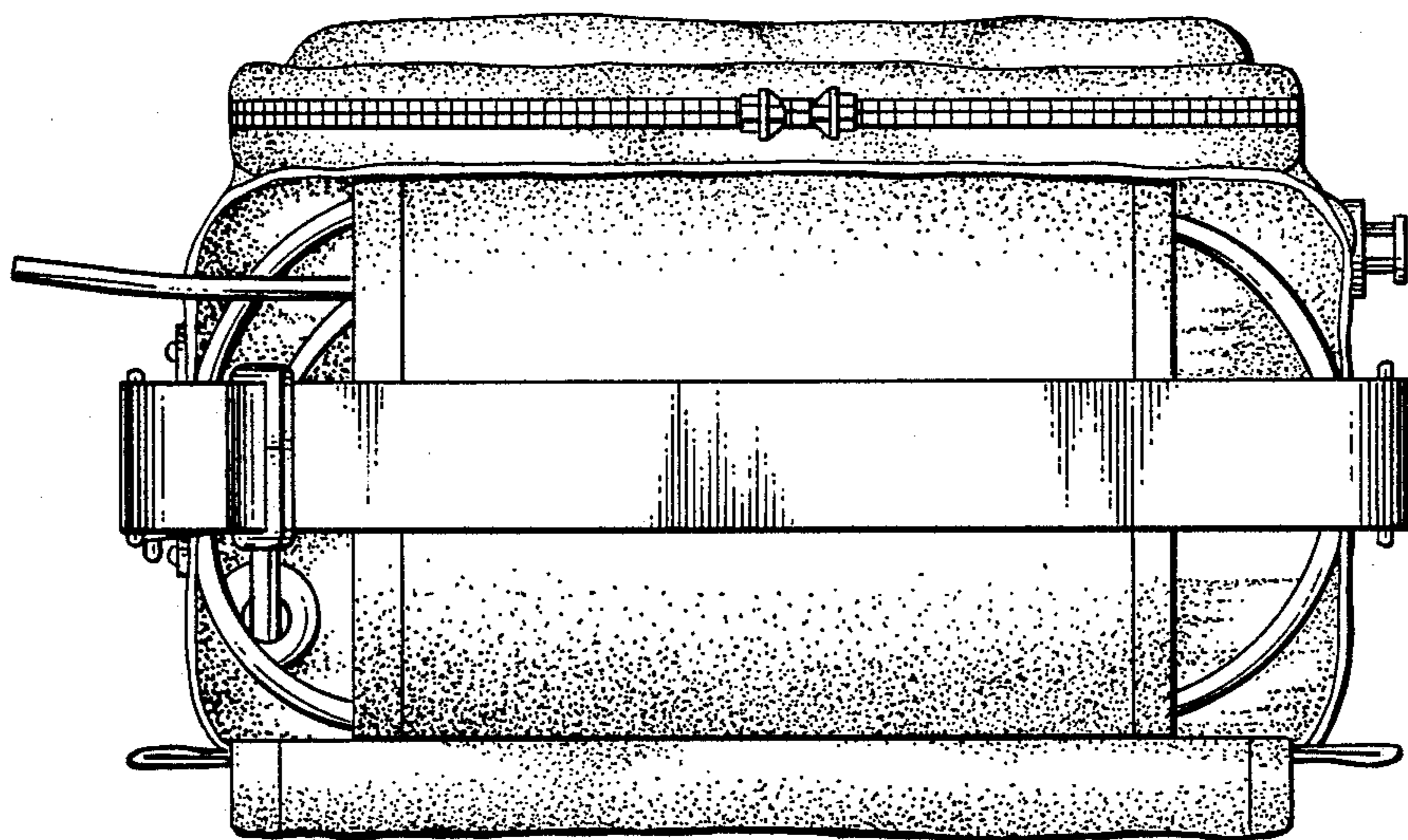

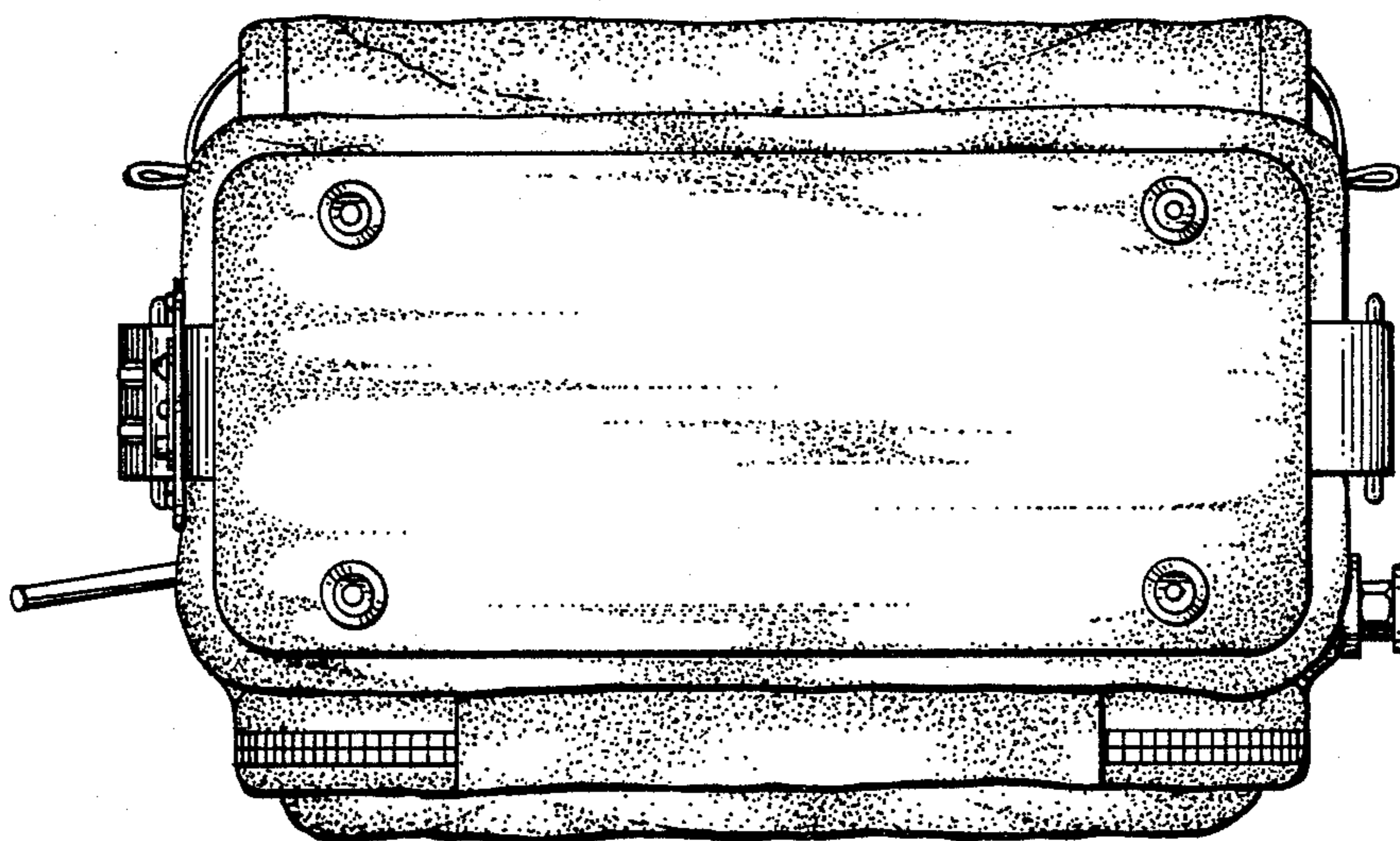

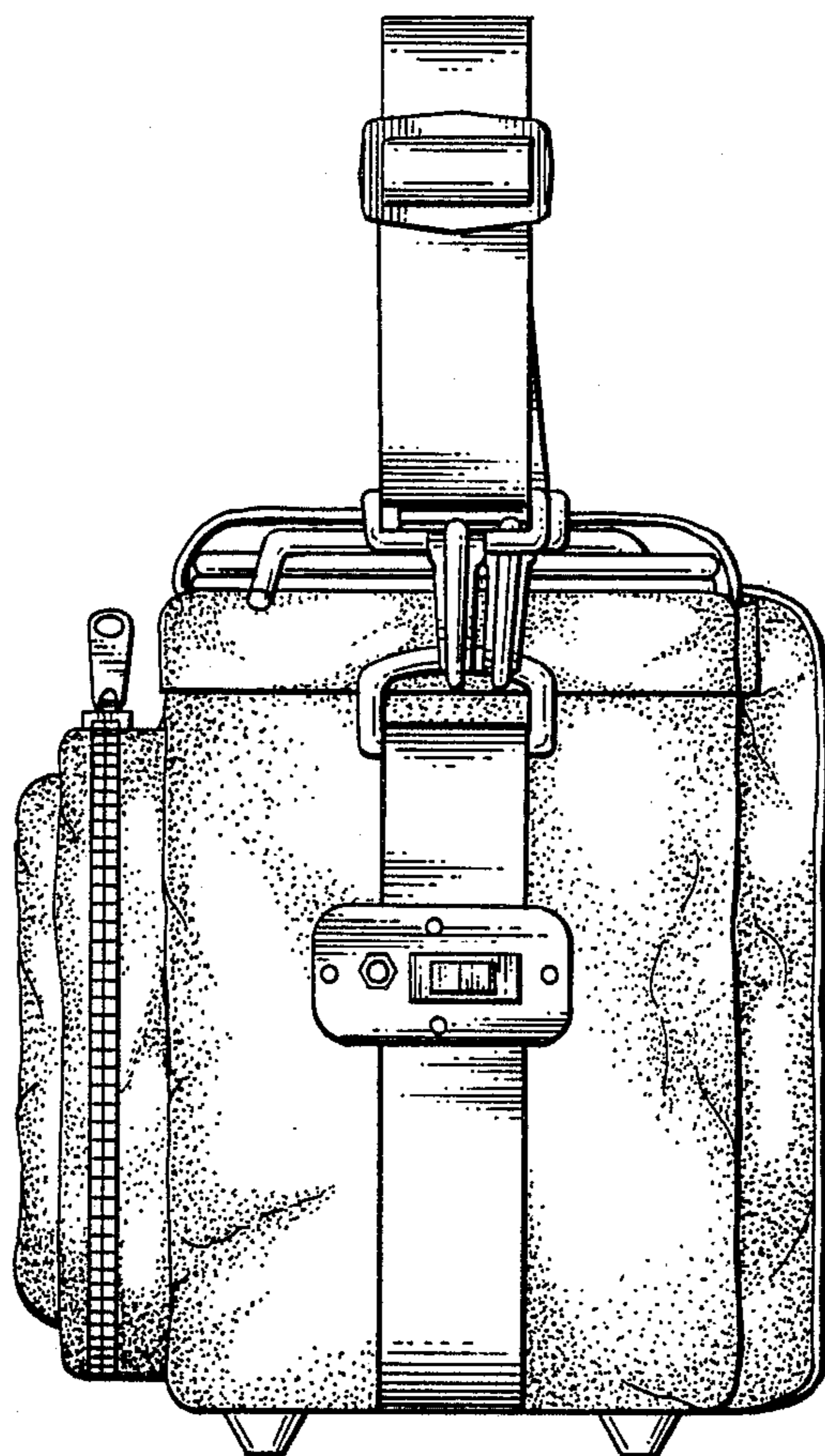
