DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a clip-on mirror showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left-side elevational view thereof; the right view being a mirror image.

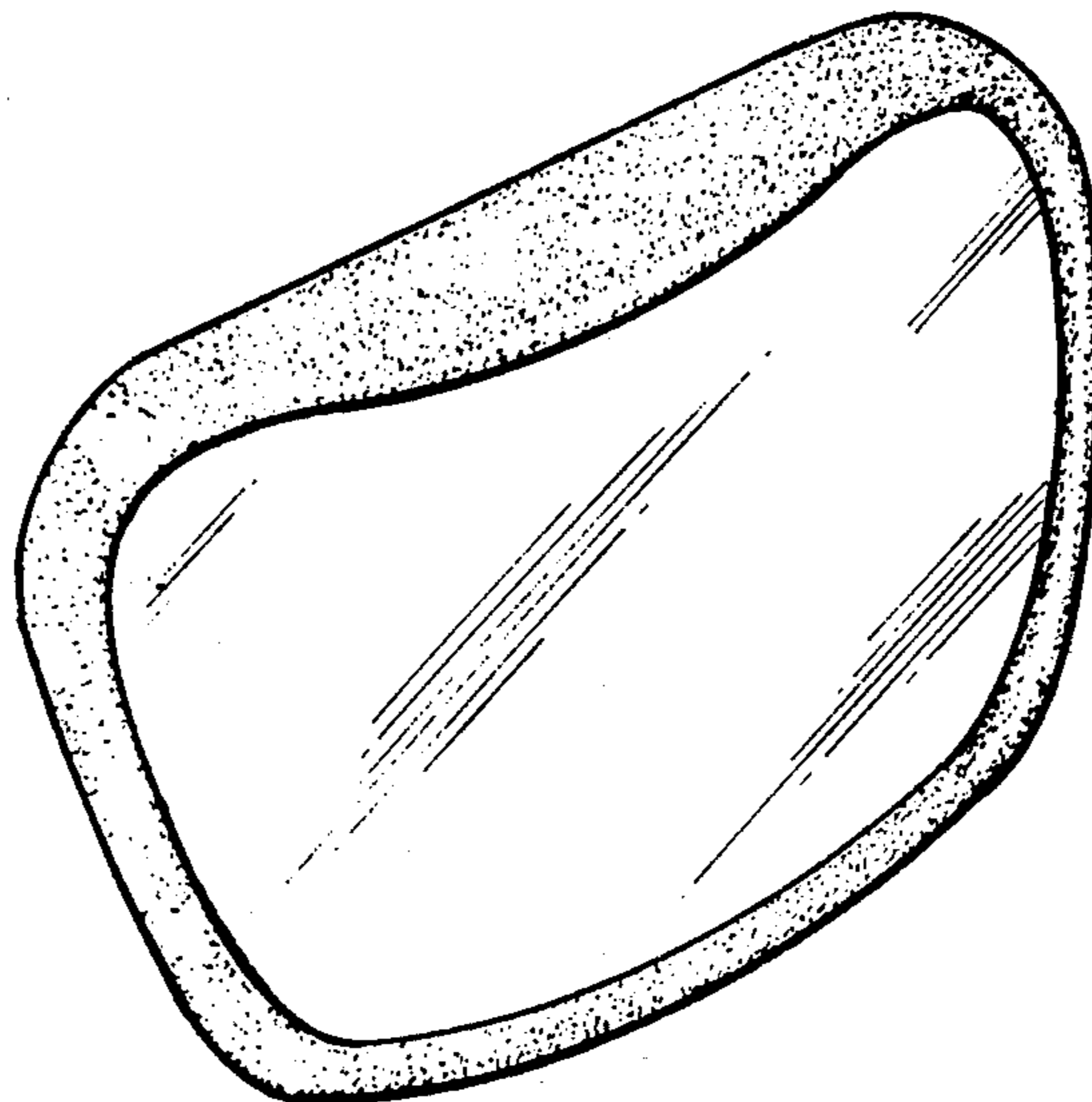

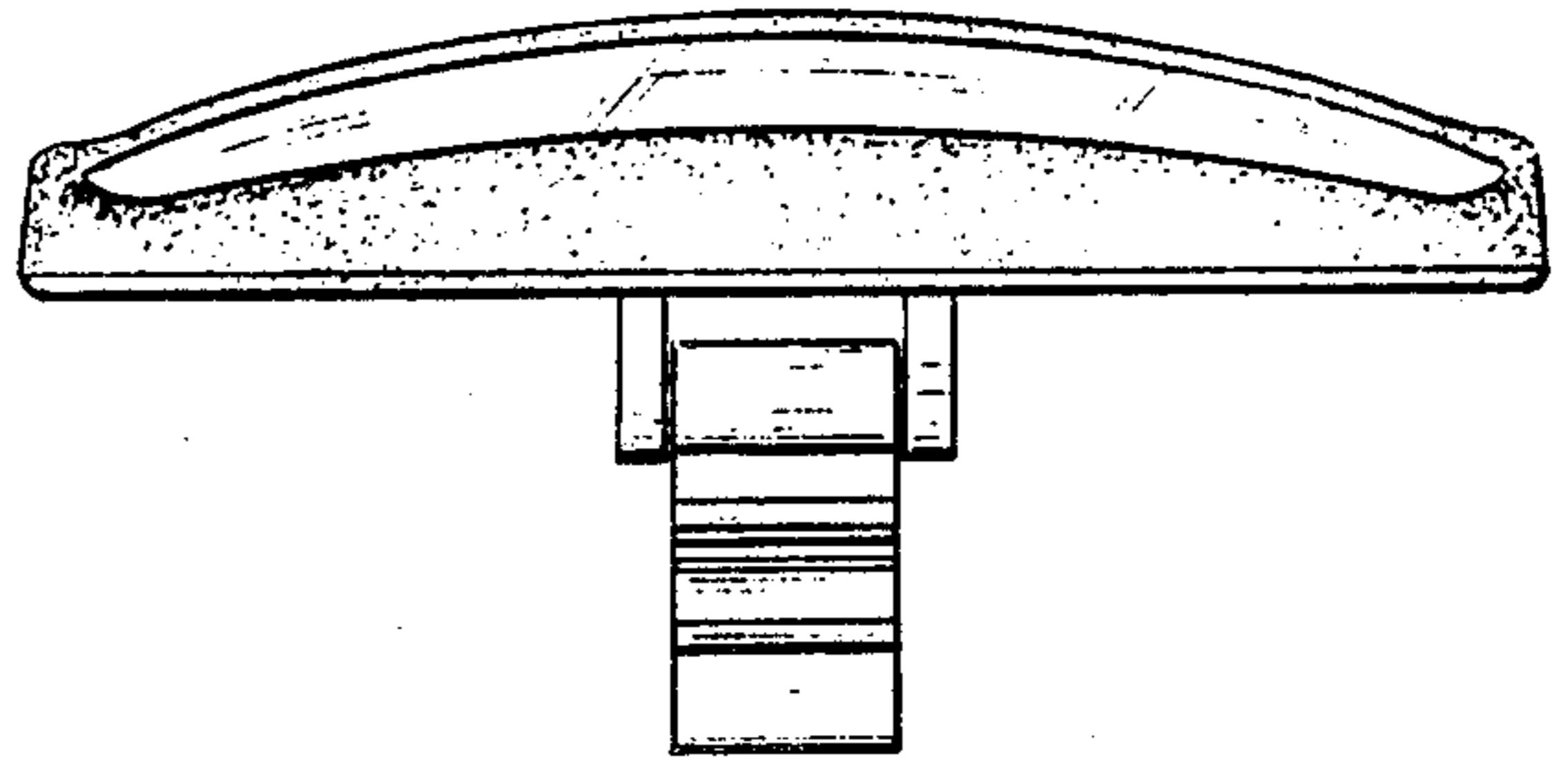

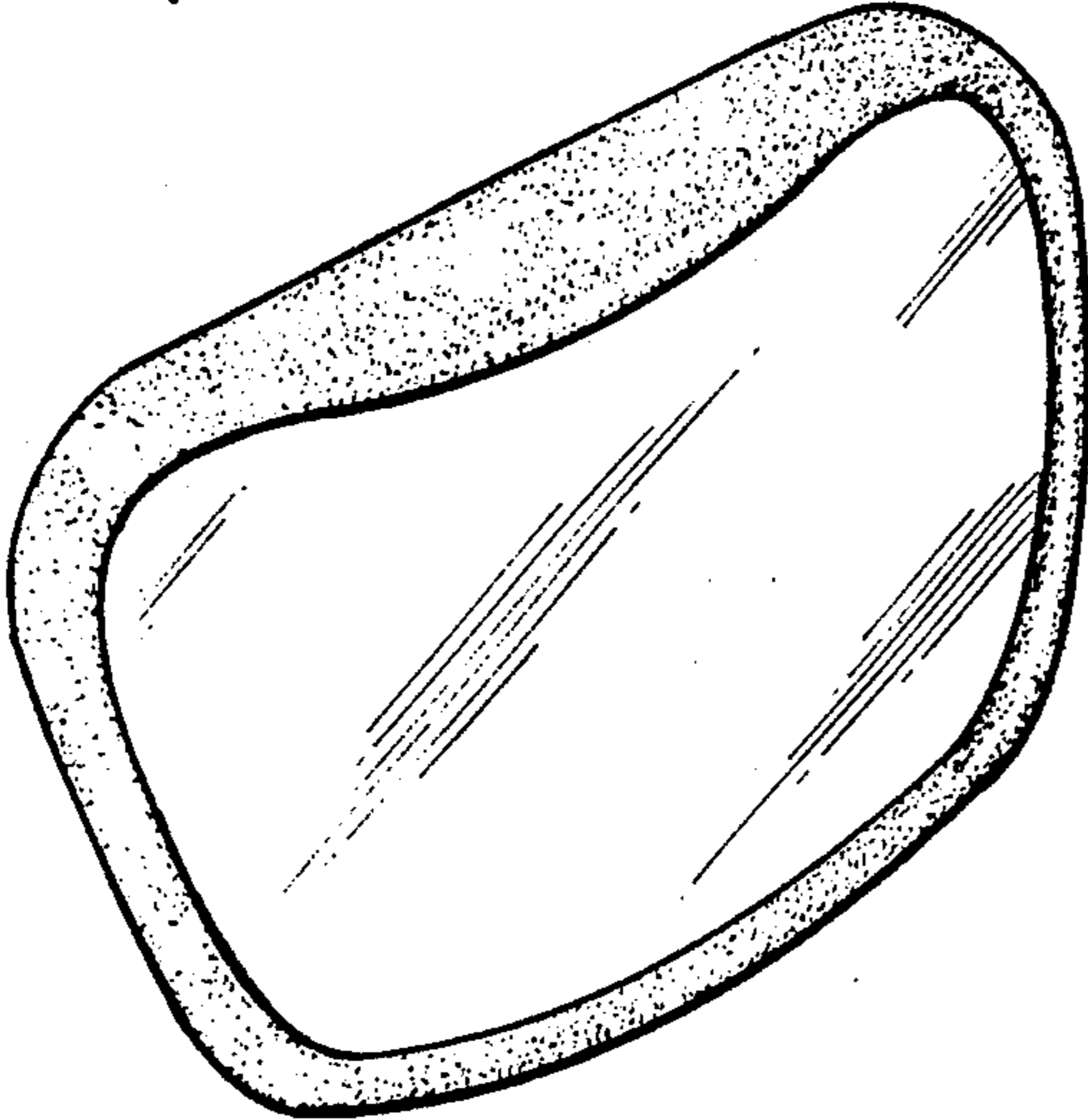

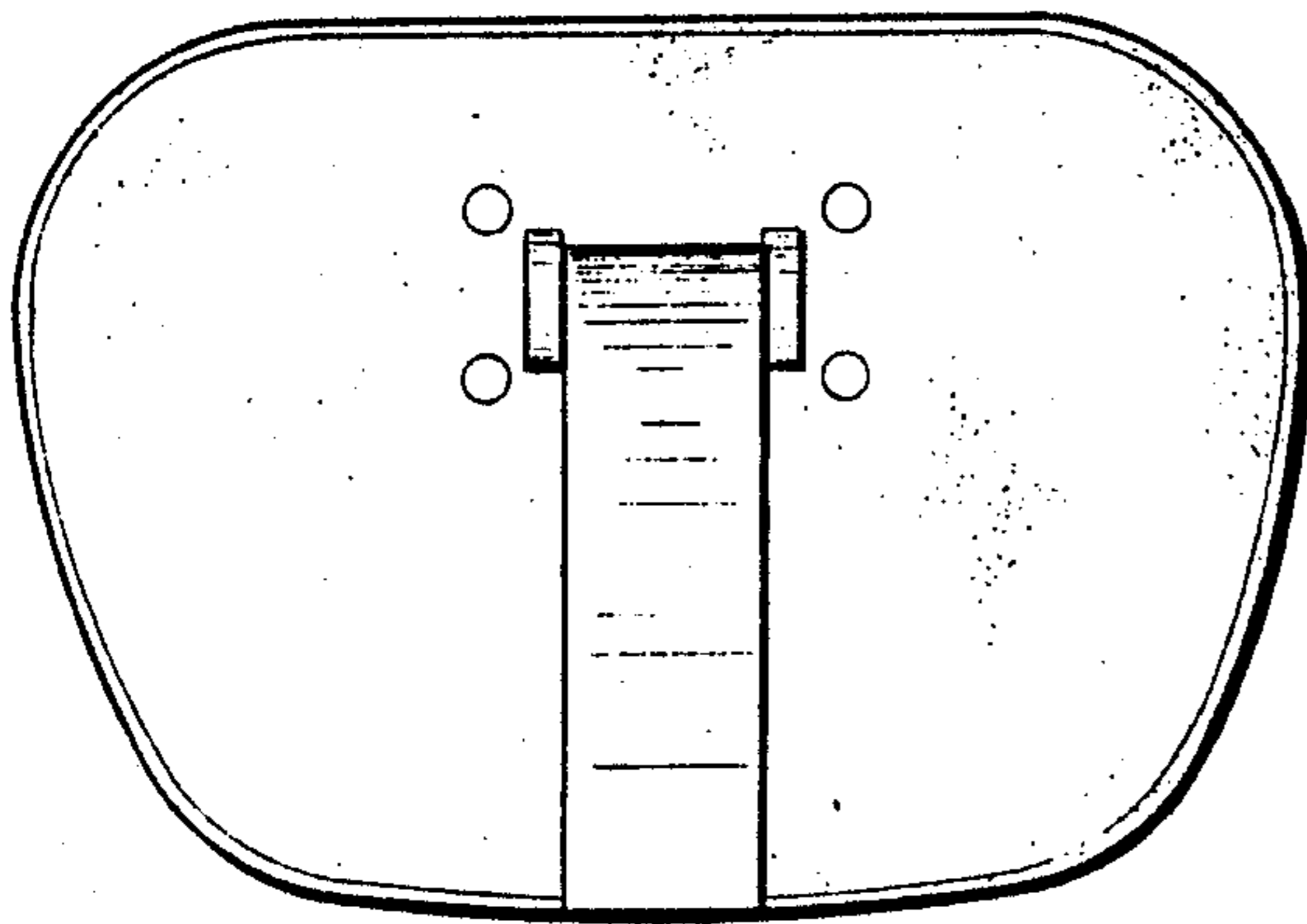
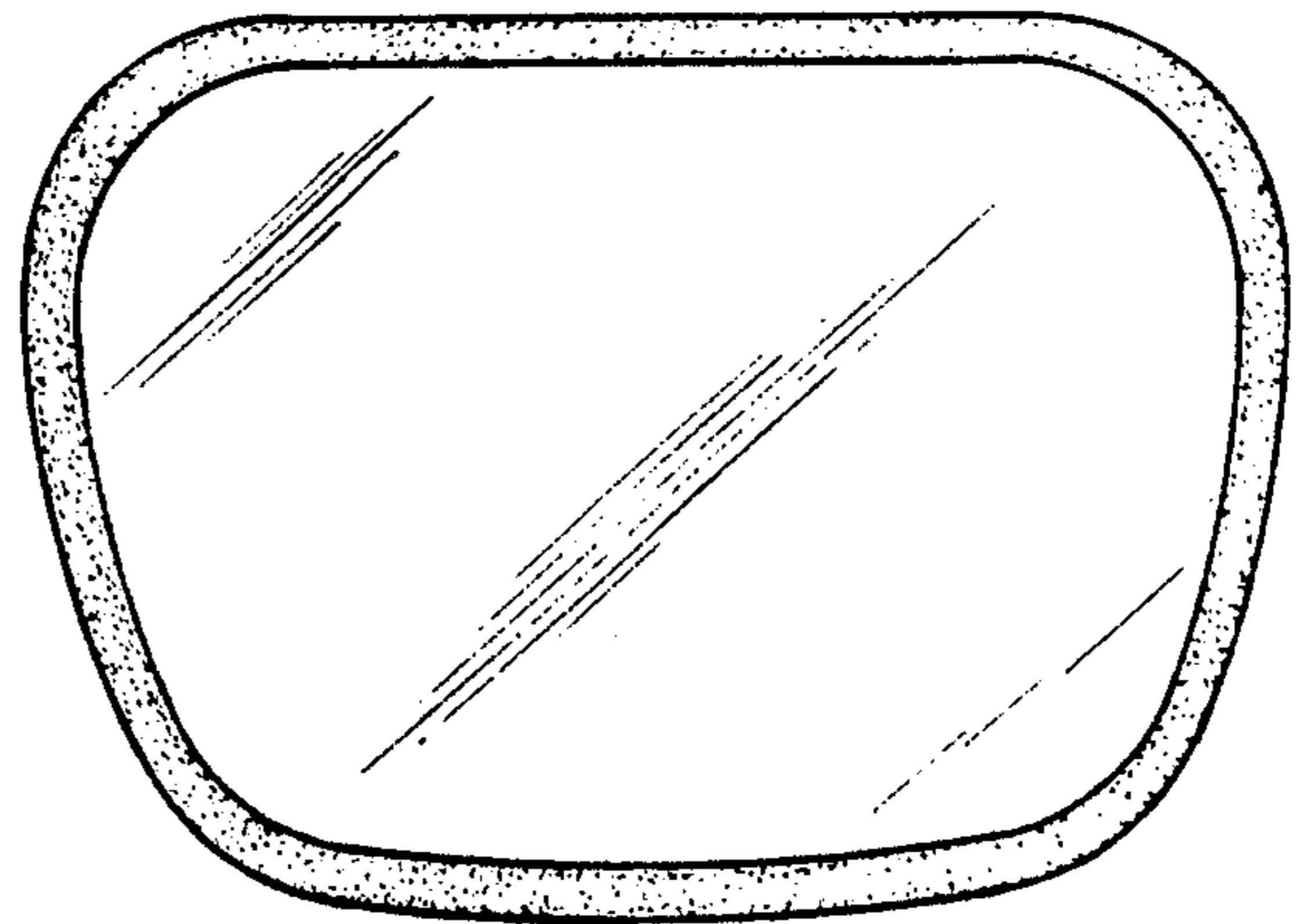

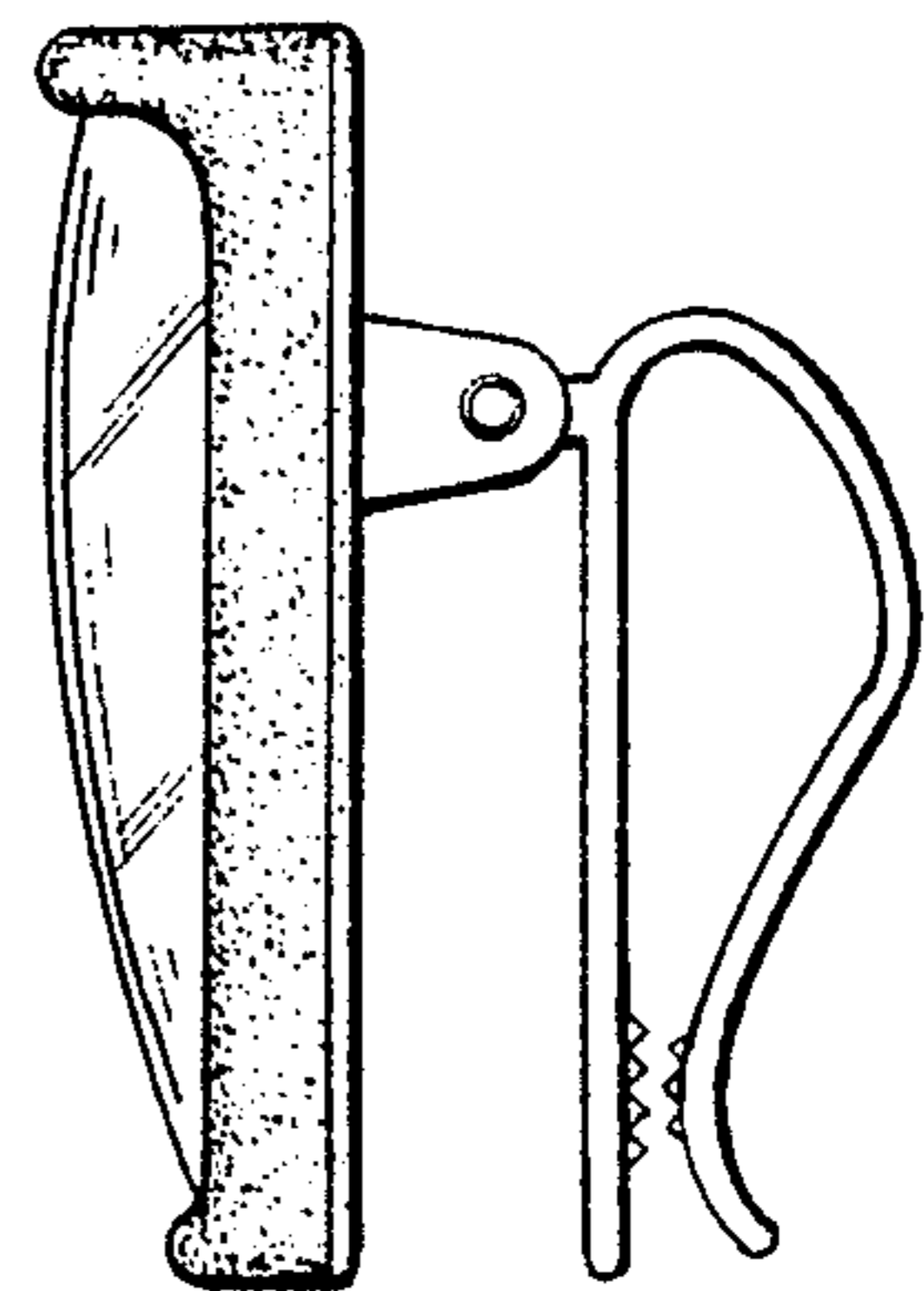

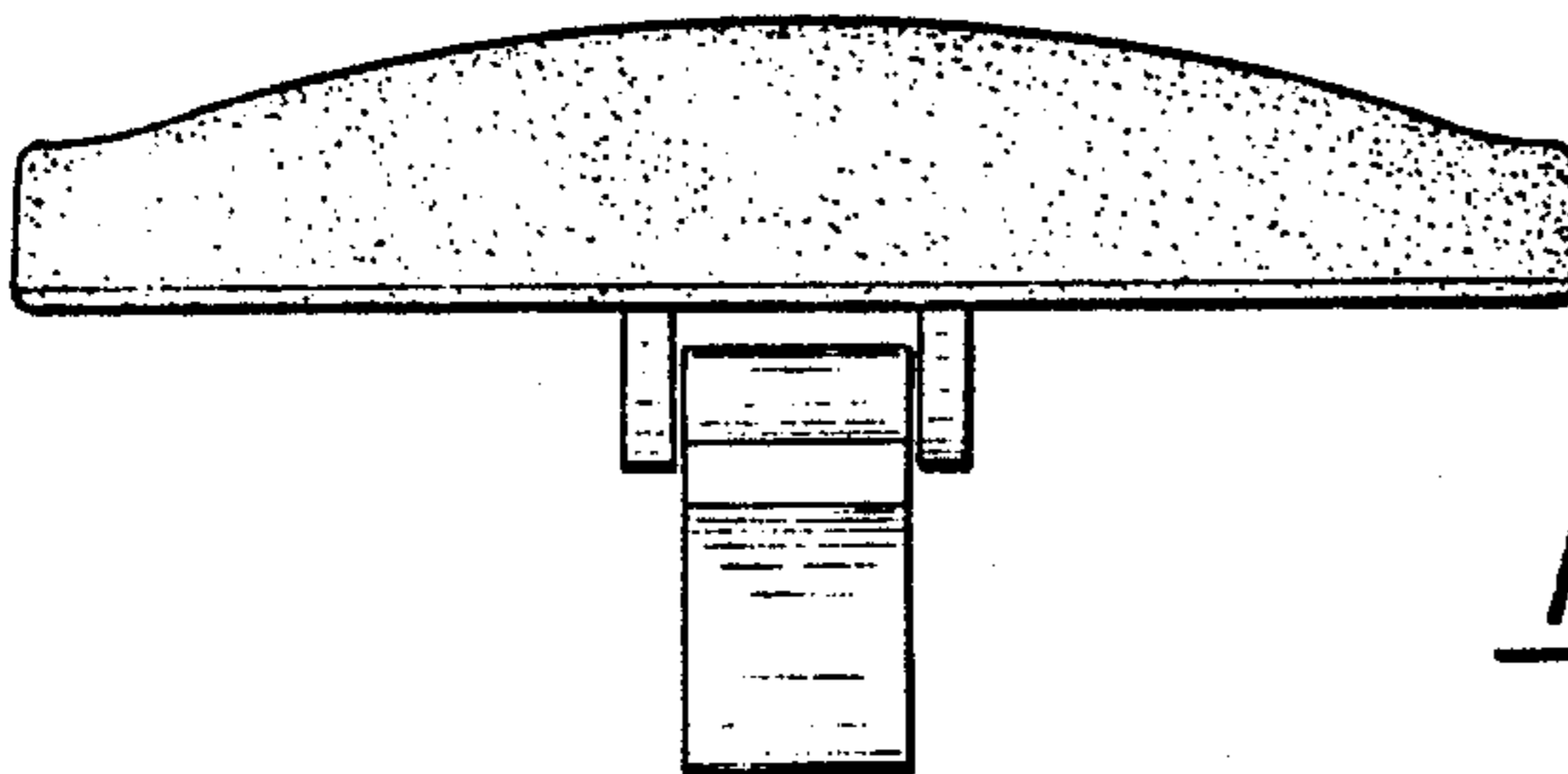
