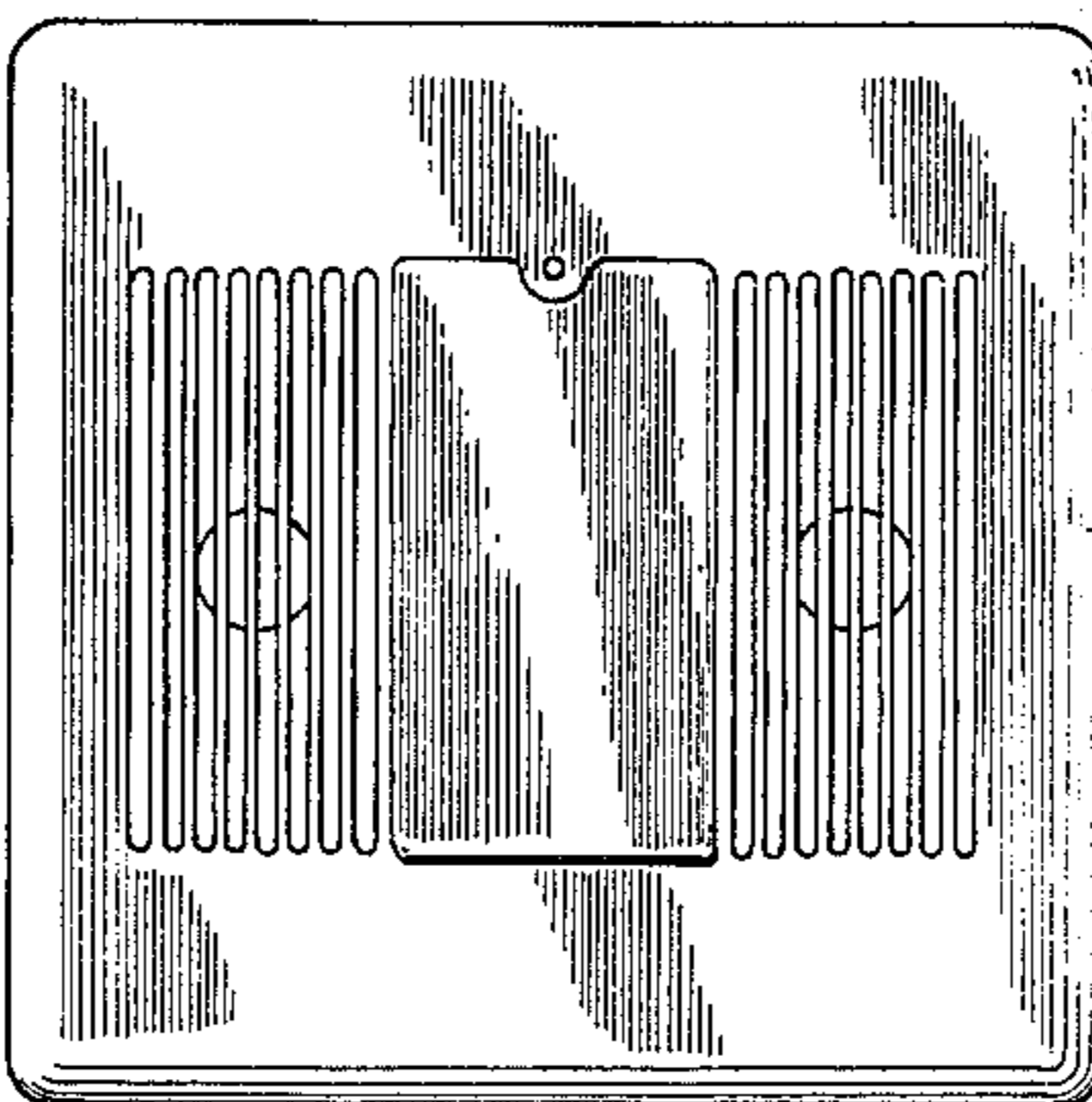
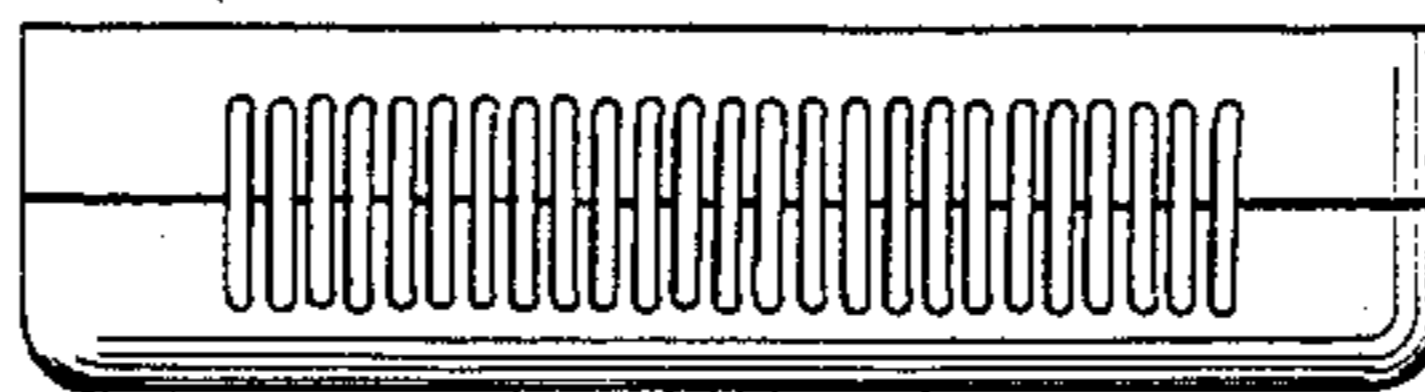

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a housing for occupancy-activated wall switch or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a housing for occupancy-activated wall switch or the like showing new design; FIG. 2 is a front view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof, the right side being a mirror image; FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof.



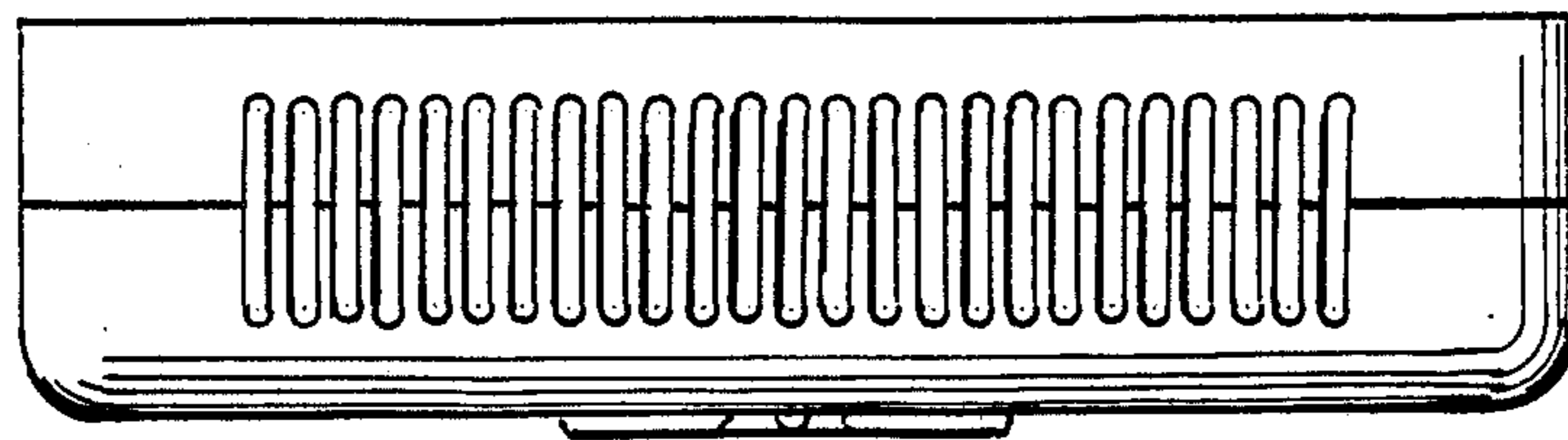

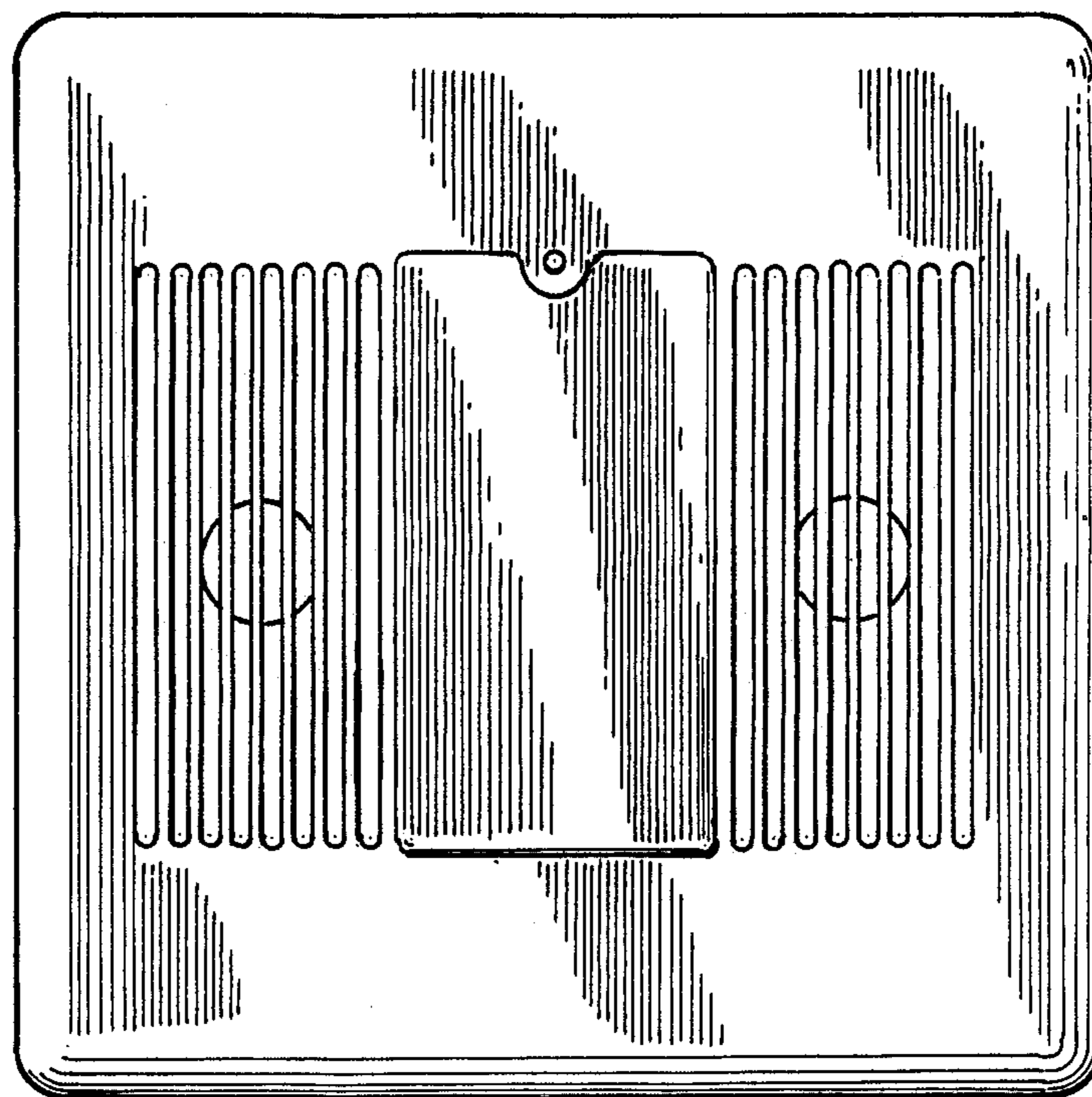

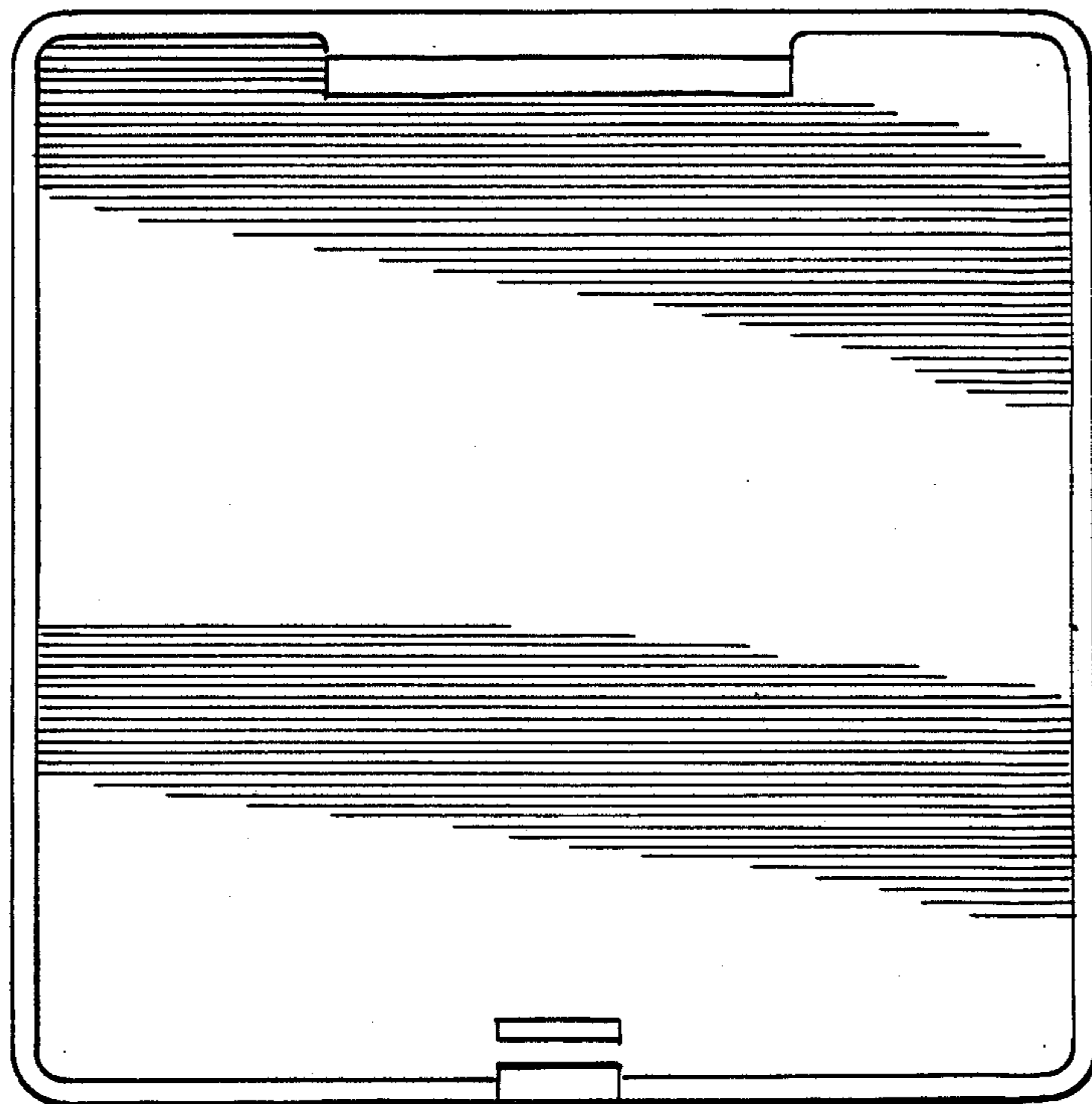

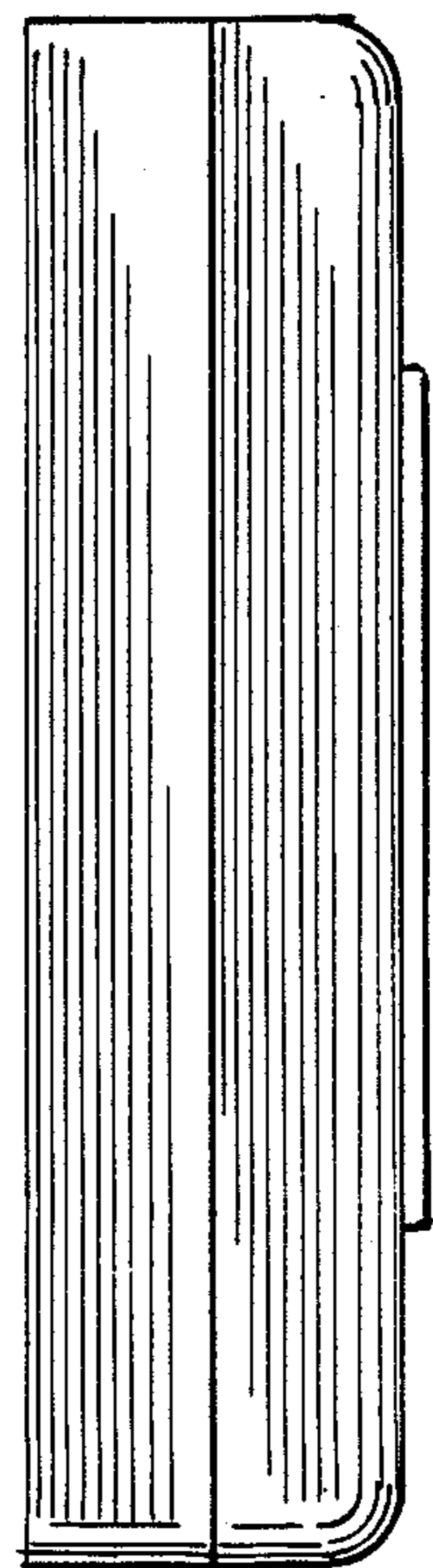

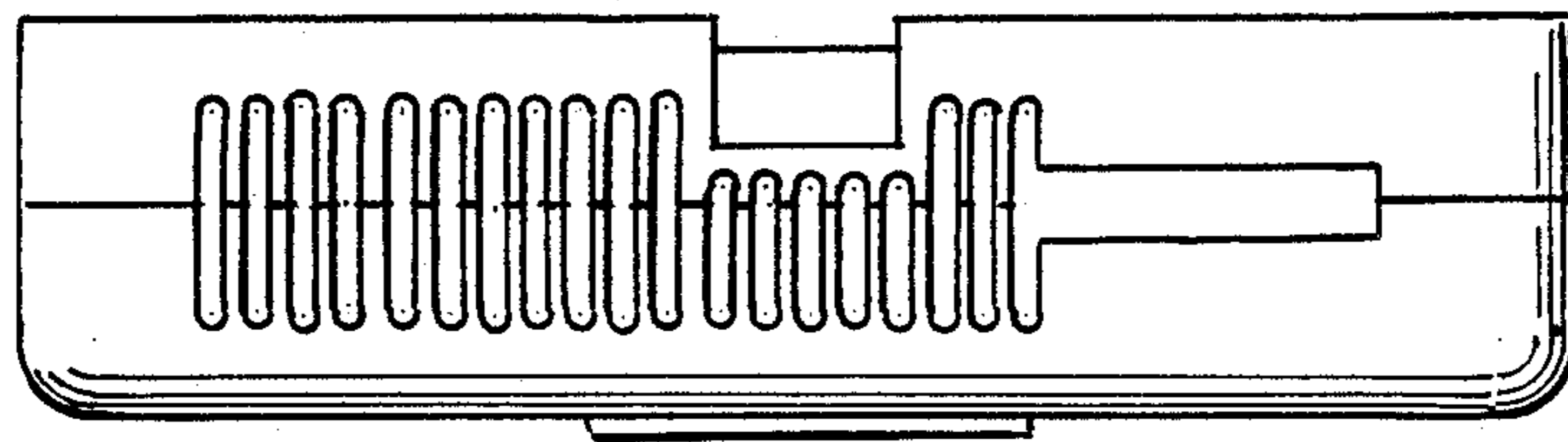
