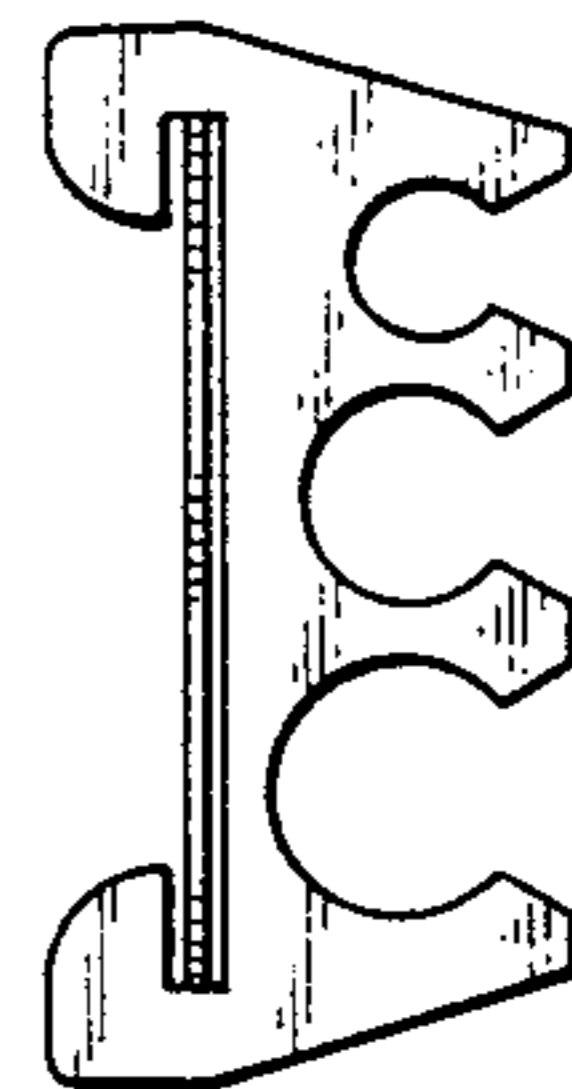
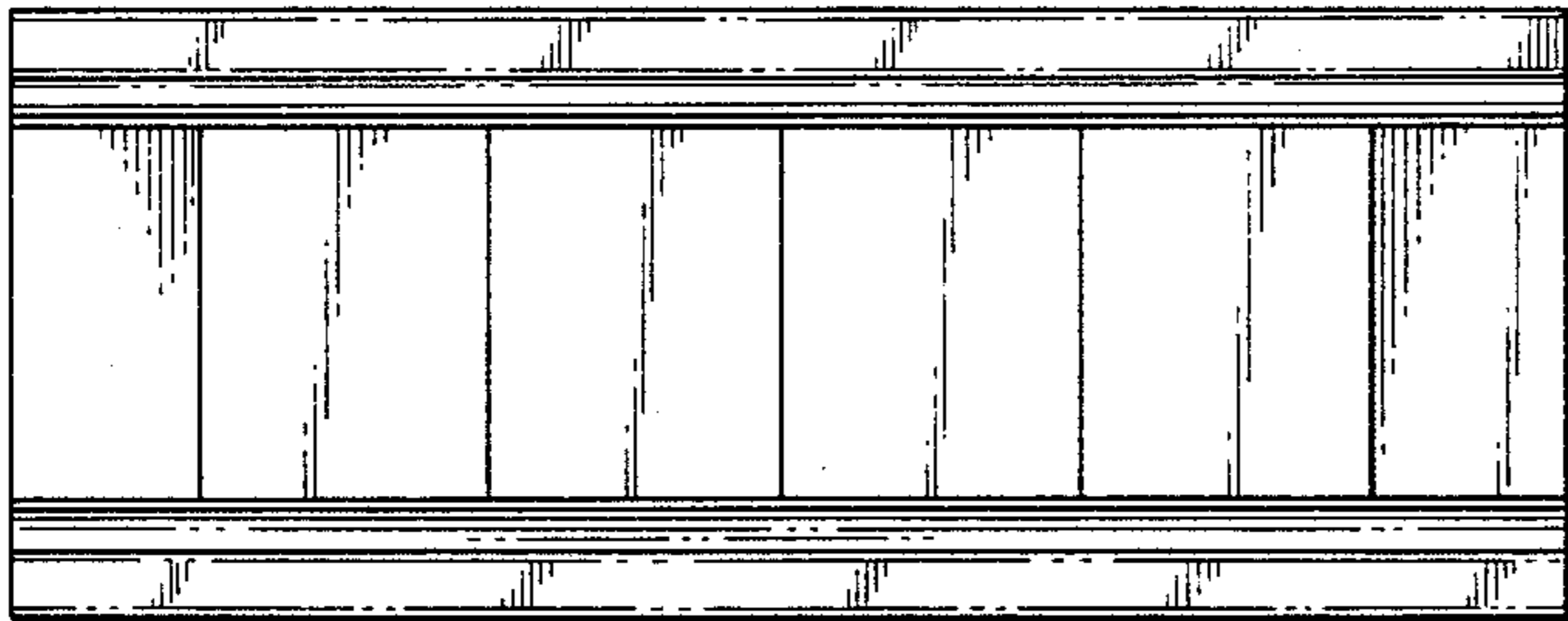

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tag holder for receiving information pieces, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a tag holder for receiving information pieces showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view, the left side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view, the top being a mirror image thereof.



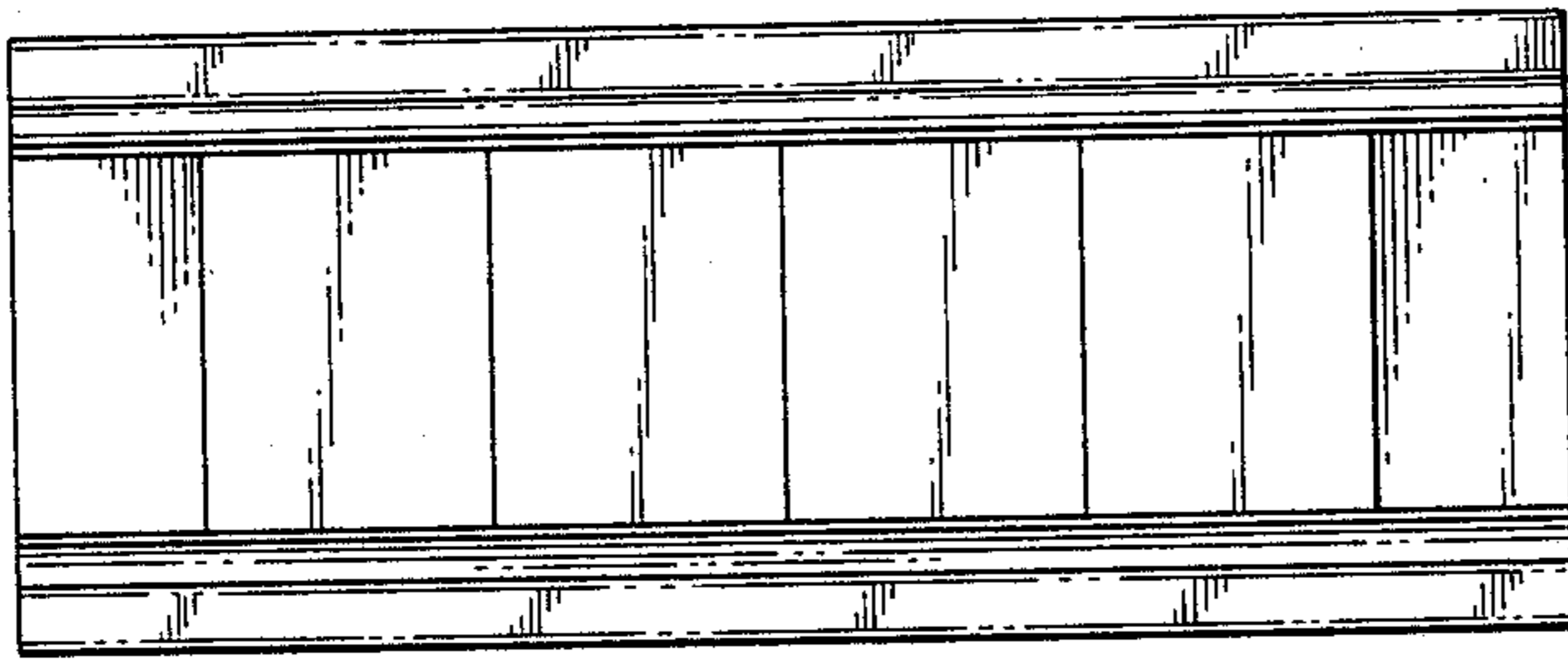

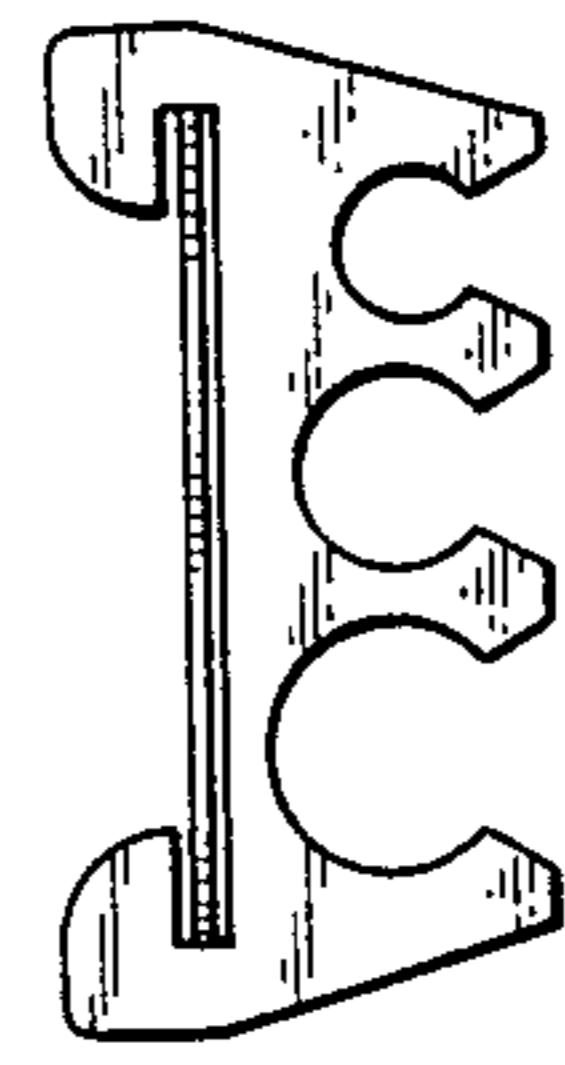

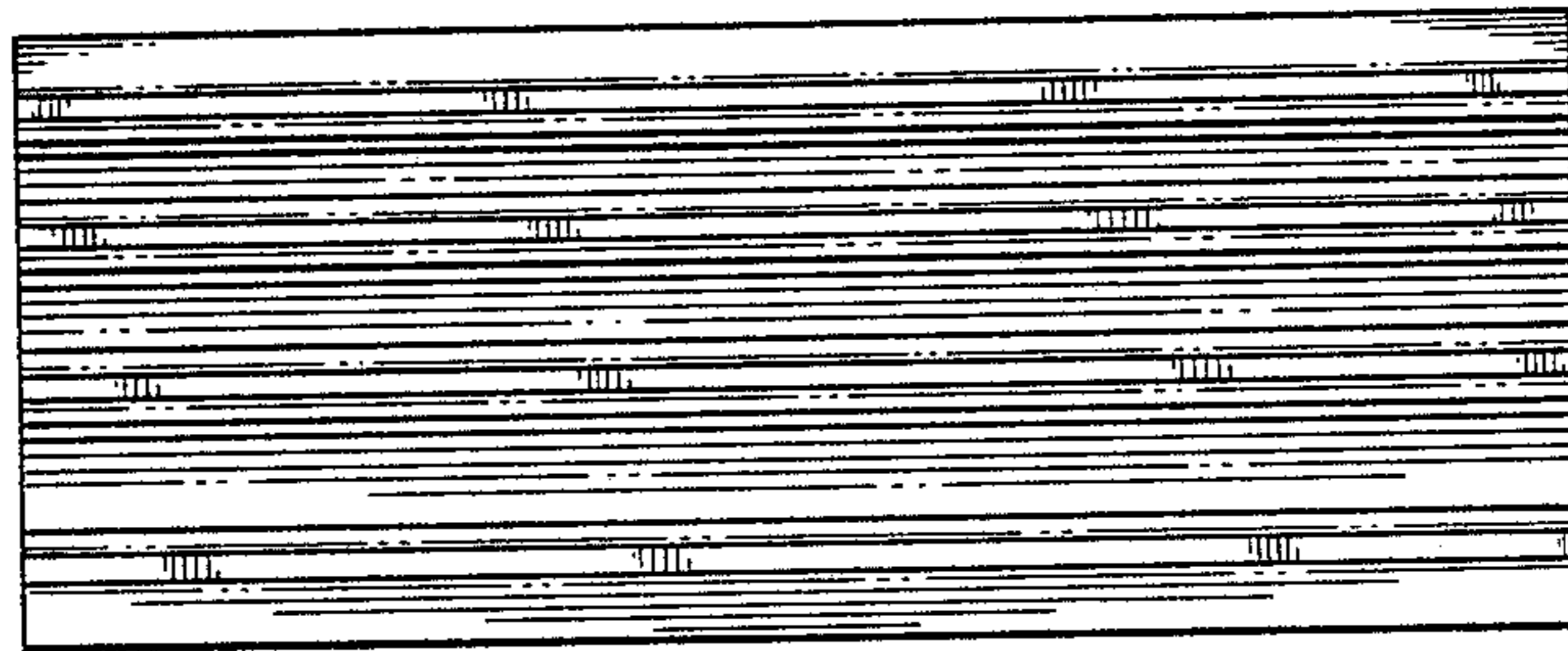

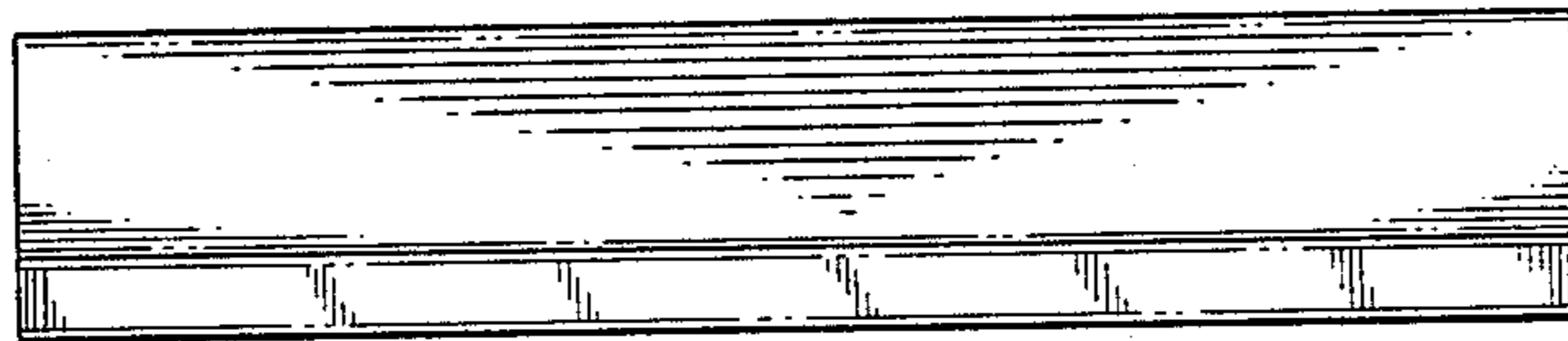
