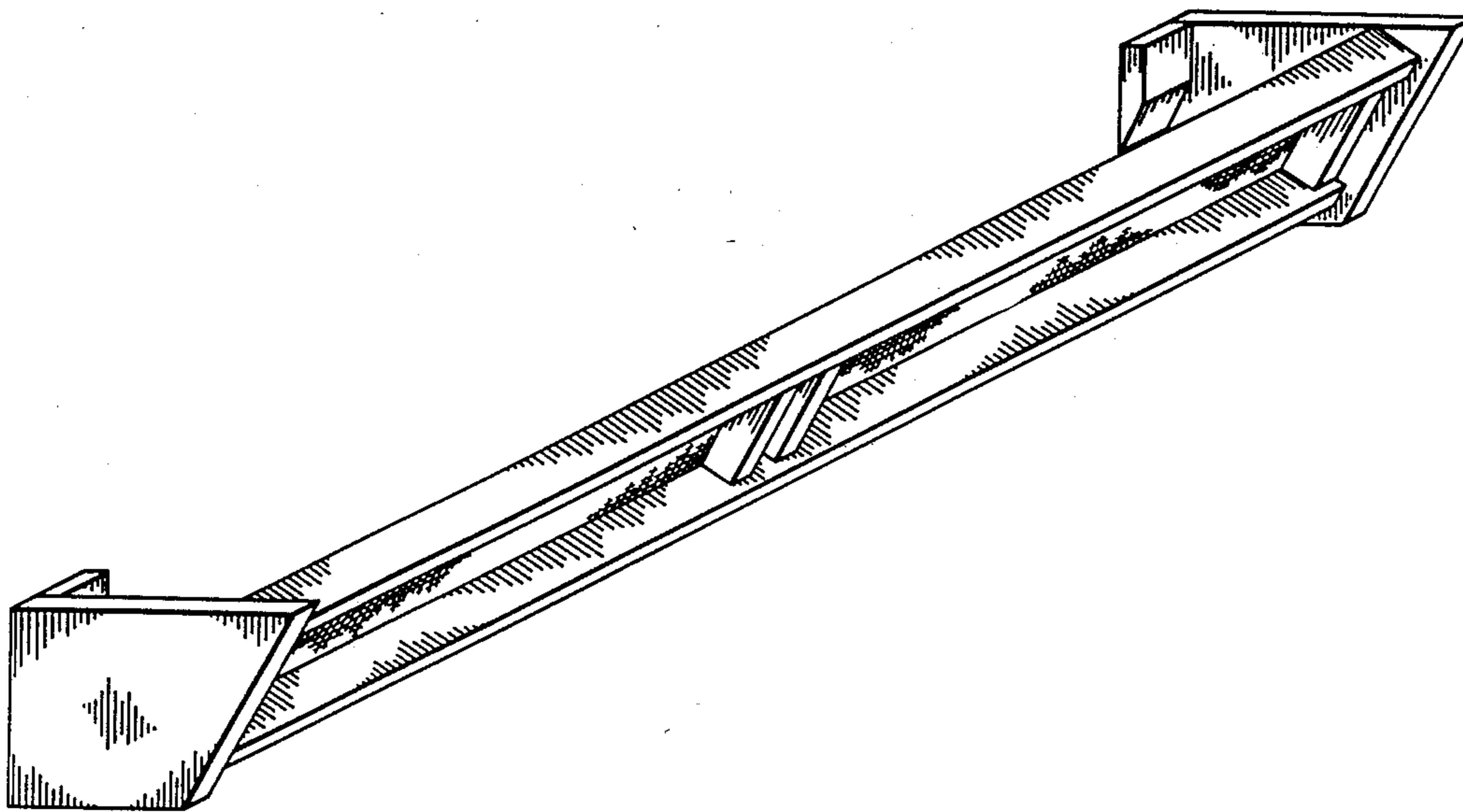

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a diffuser for a wall mounted light fixture, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shade for a light fixture showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;  
 FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view thereof, as taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 2;  
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.  
 The cross-hatching in the two rectangular light diffusing panels indicates canvas material.



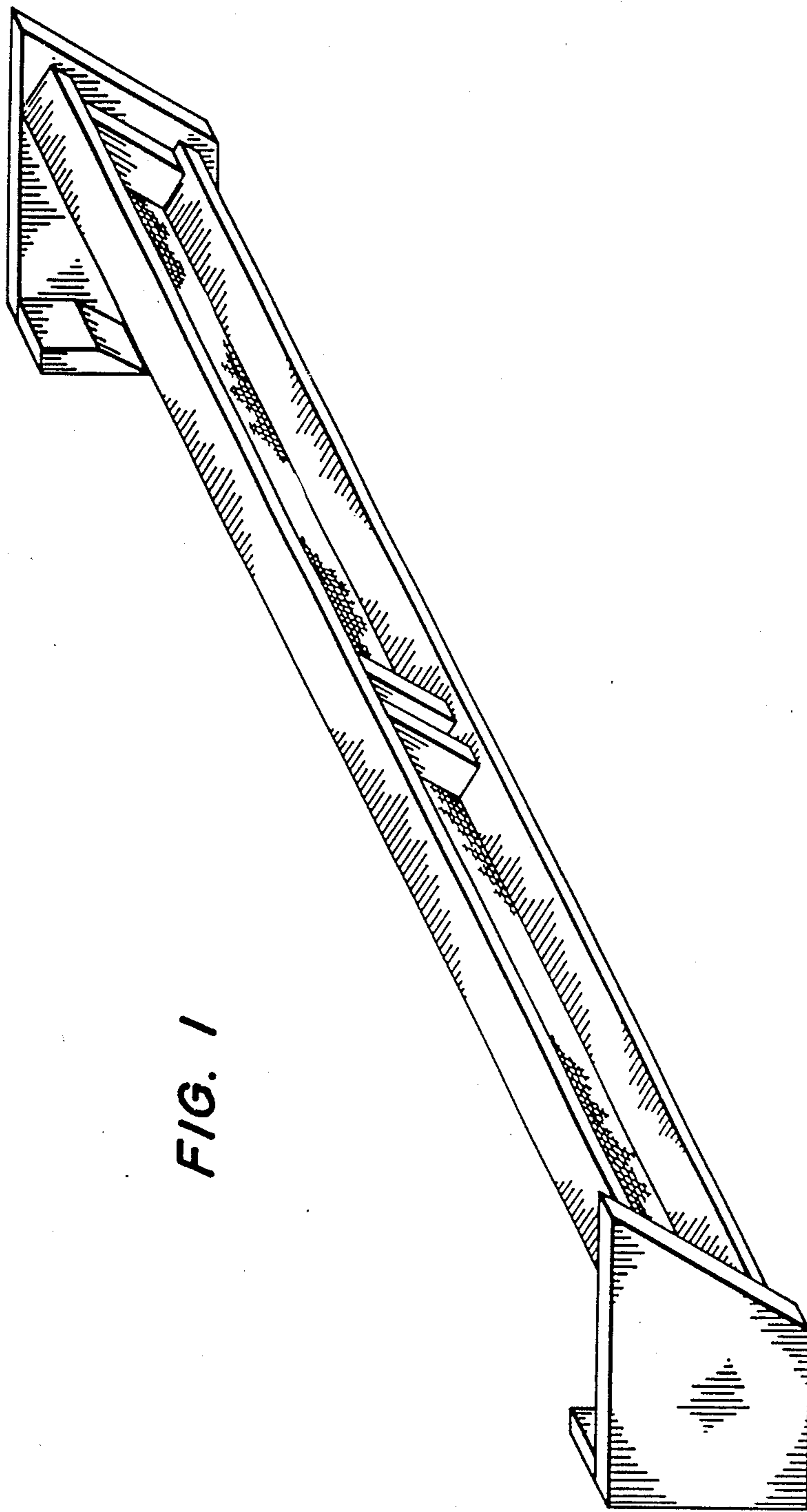

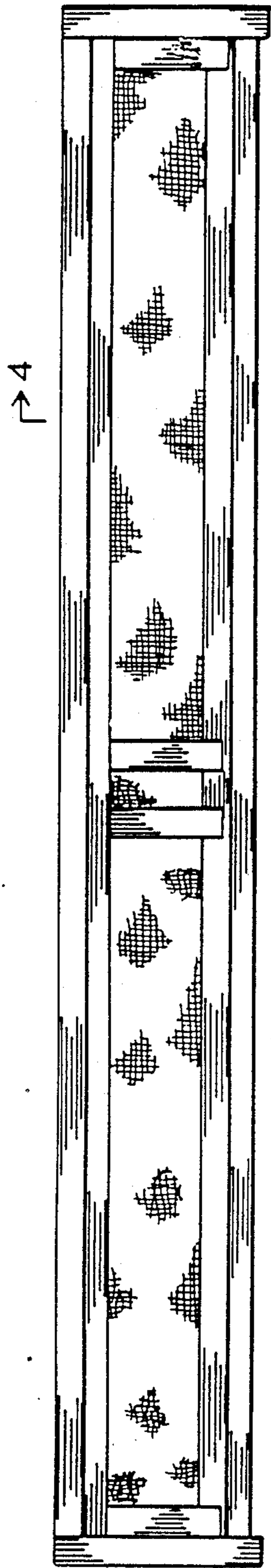

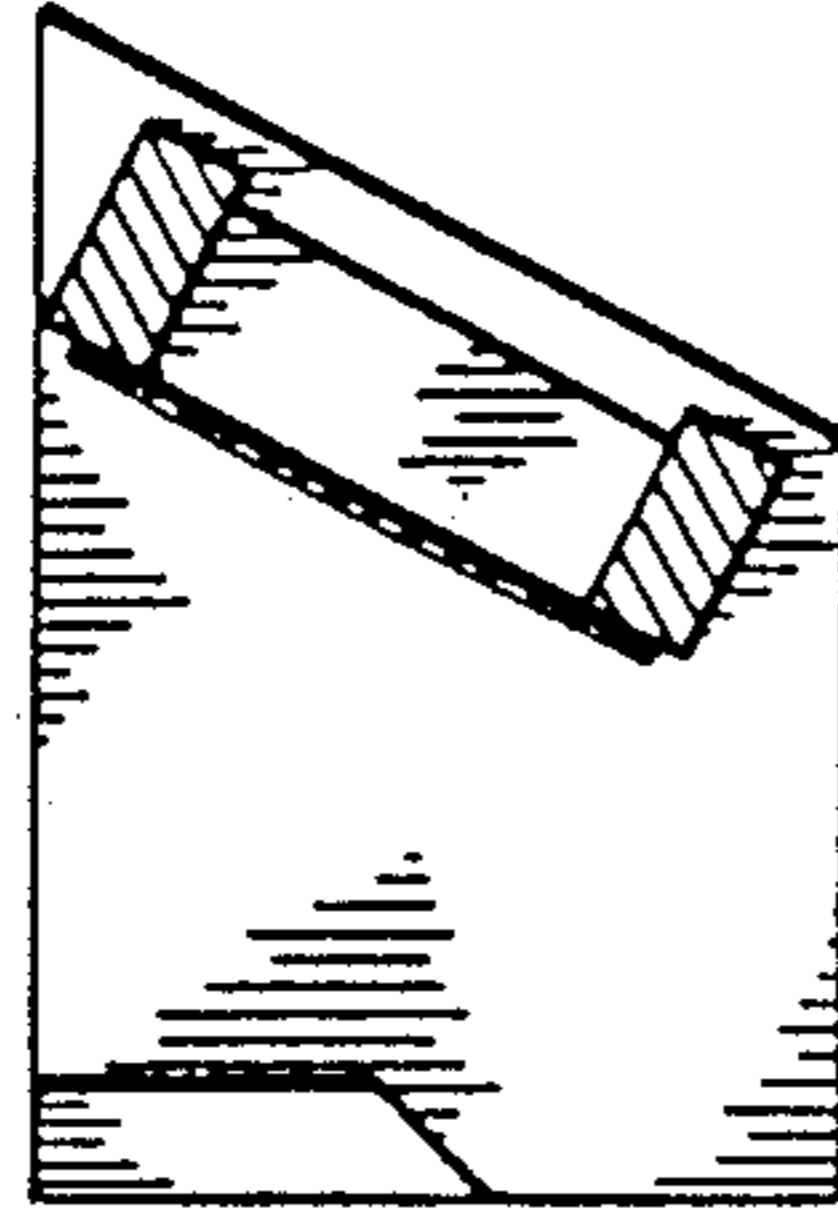

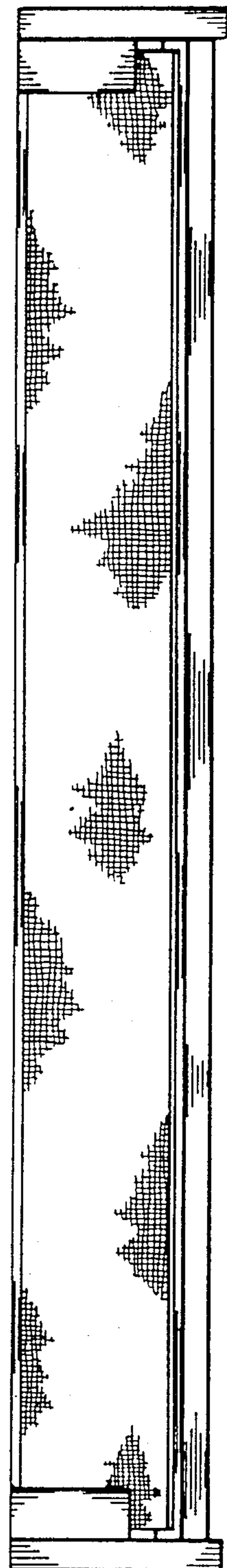

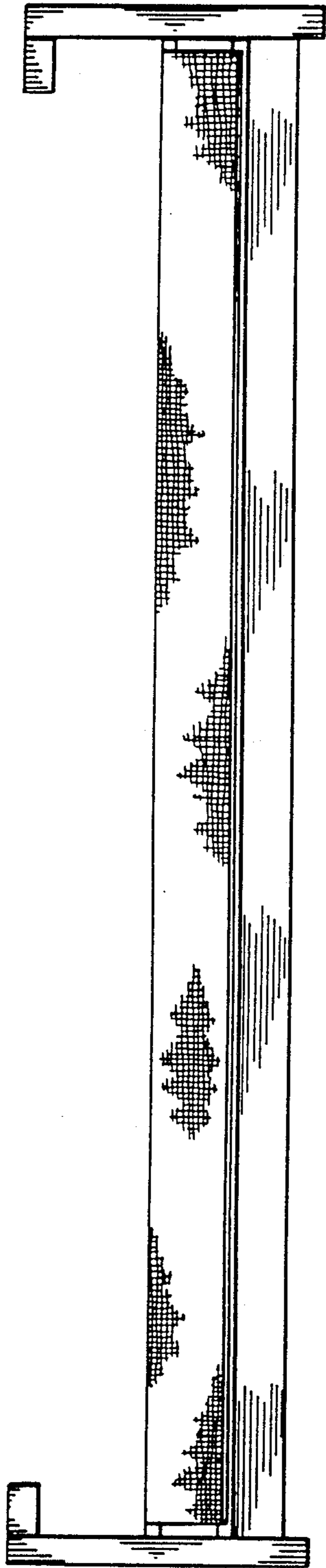

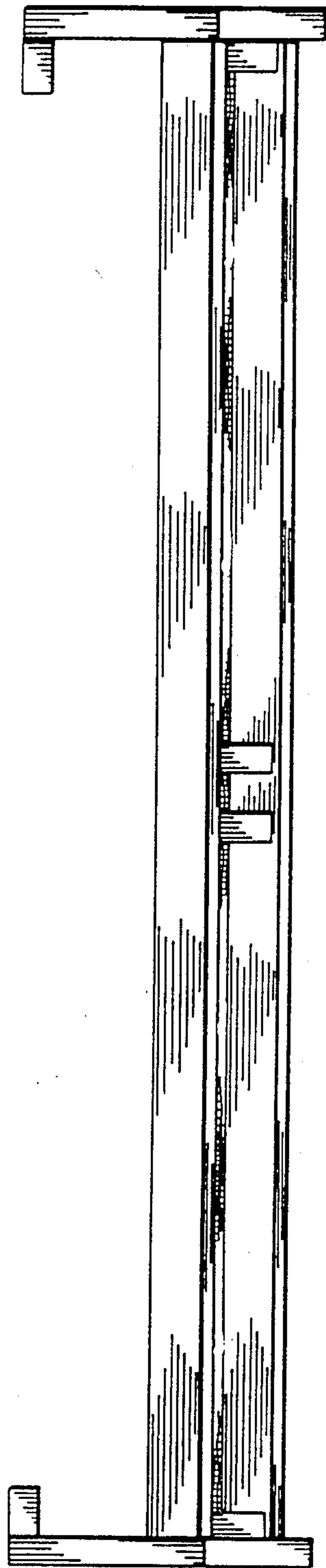
