DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a food scoop showing my new design;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged fragmentary view of the prong portion thereof.

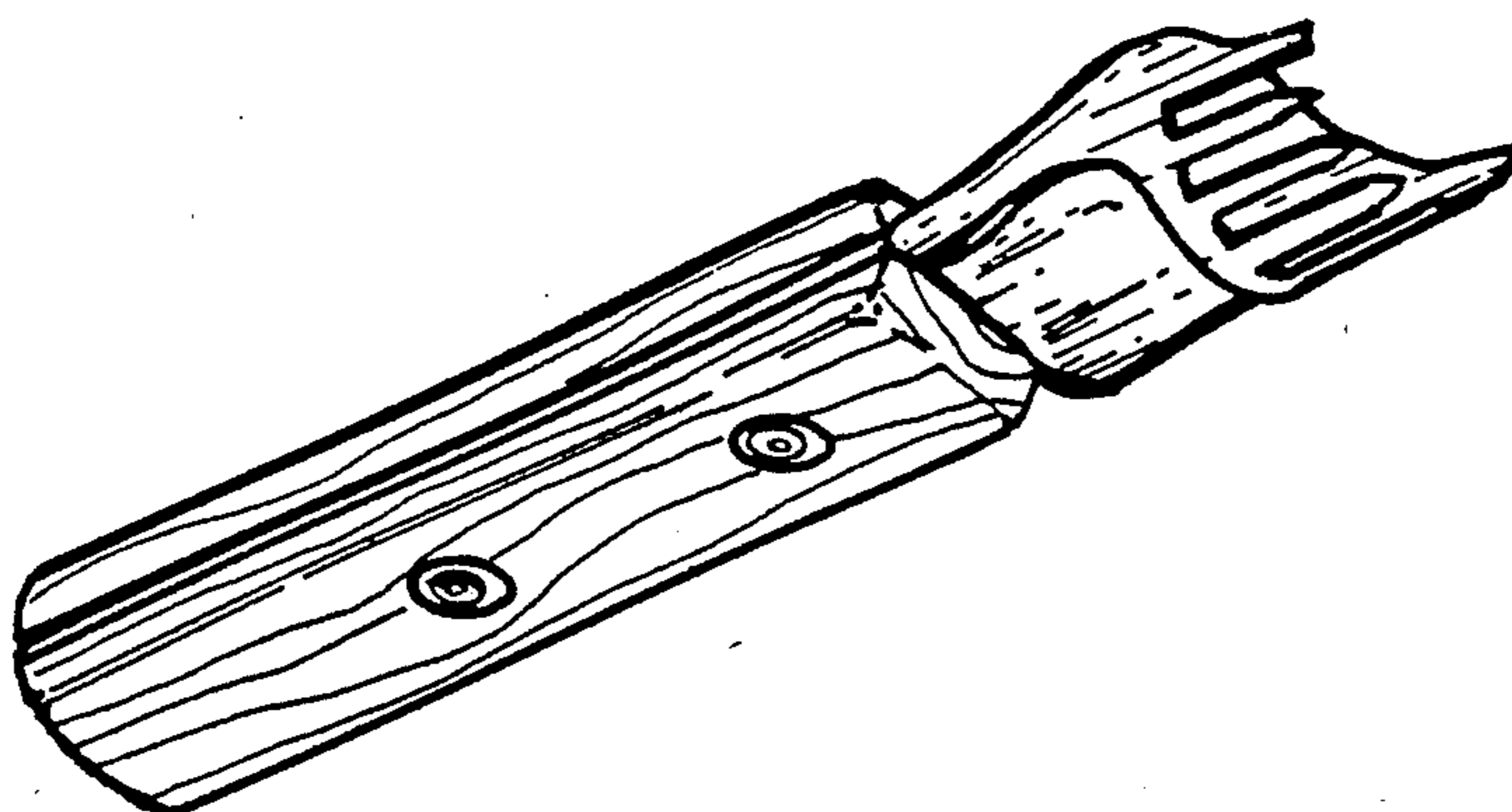

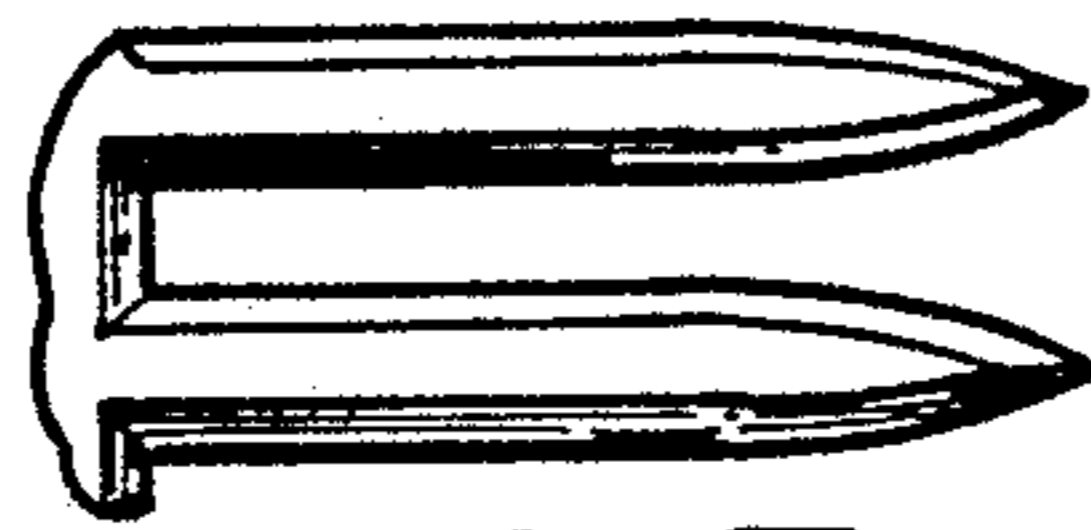
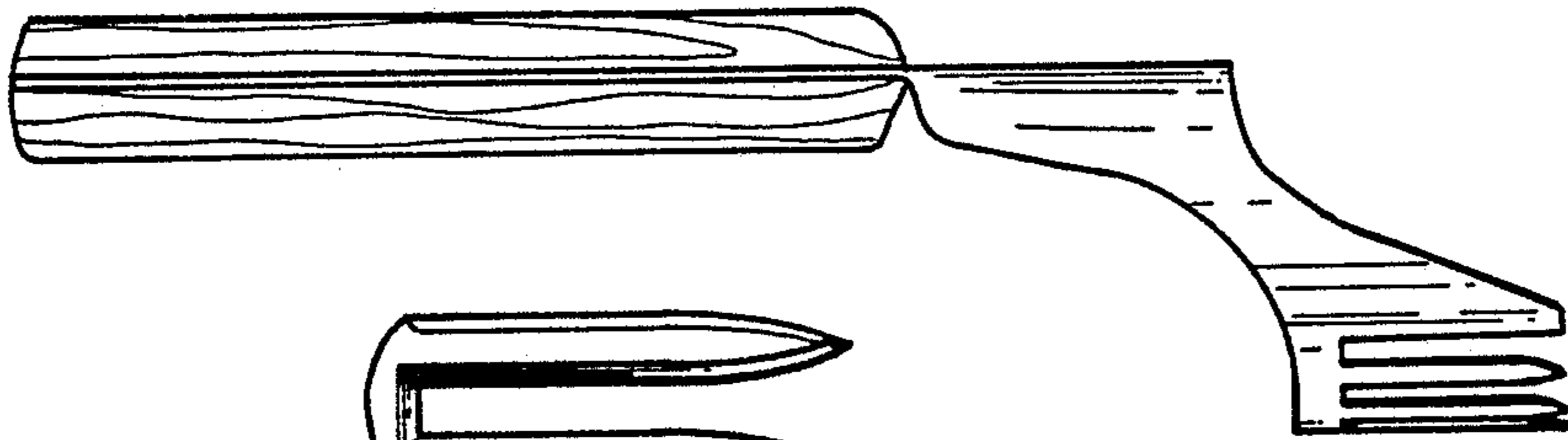

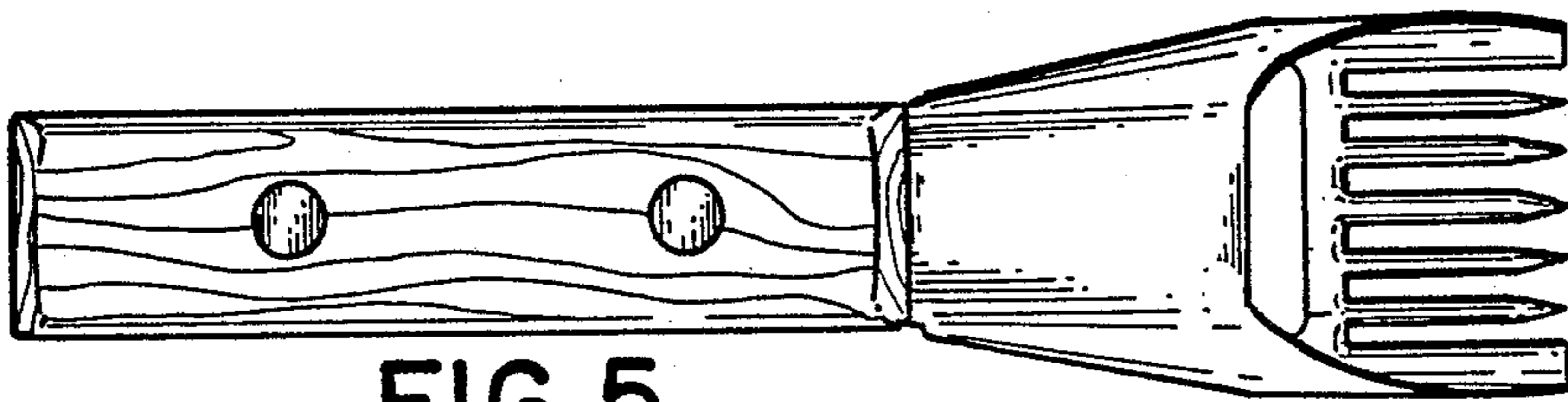

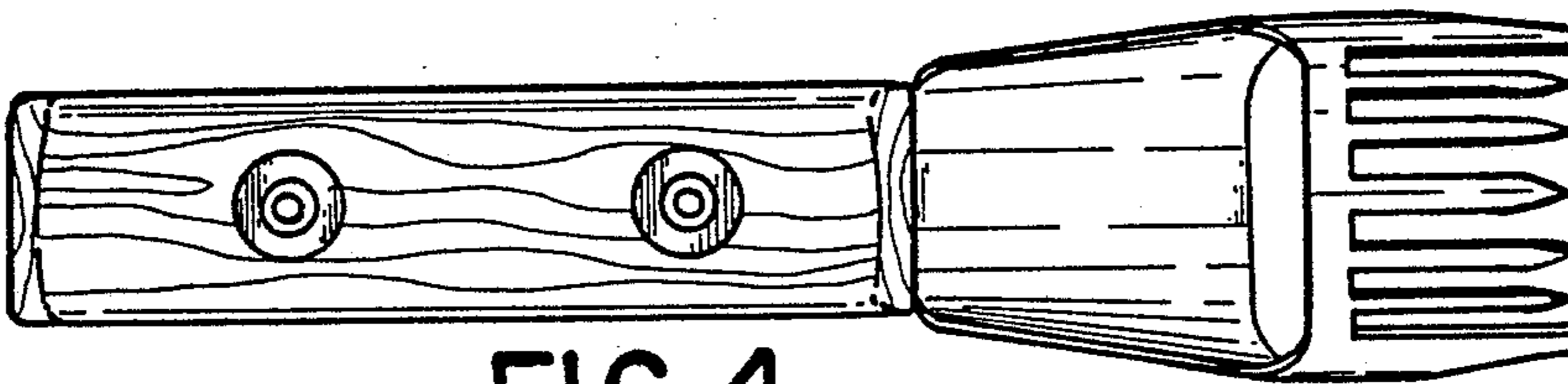

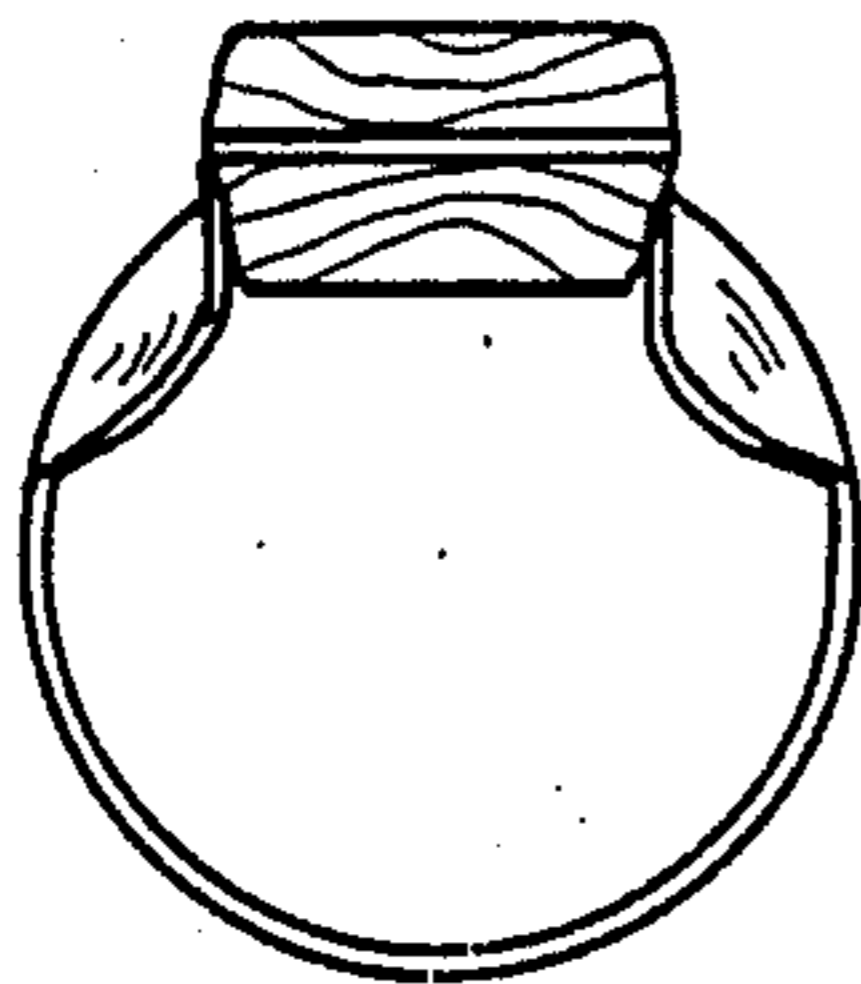

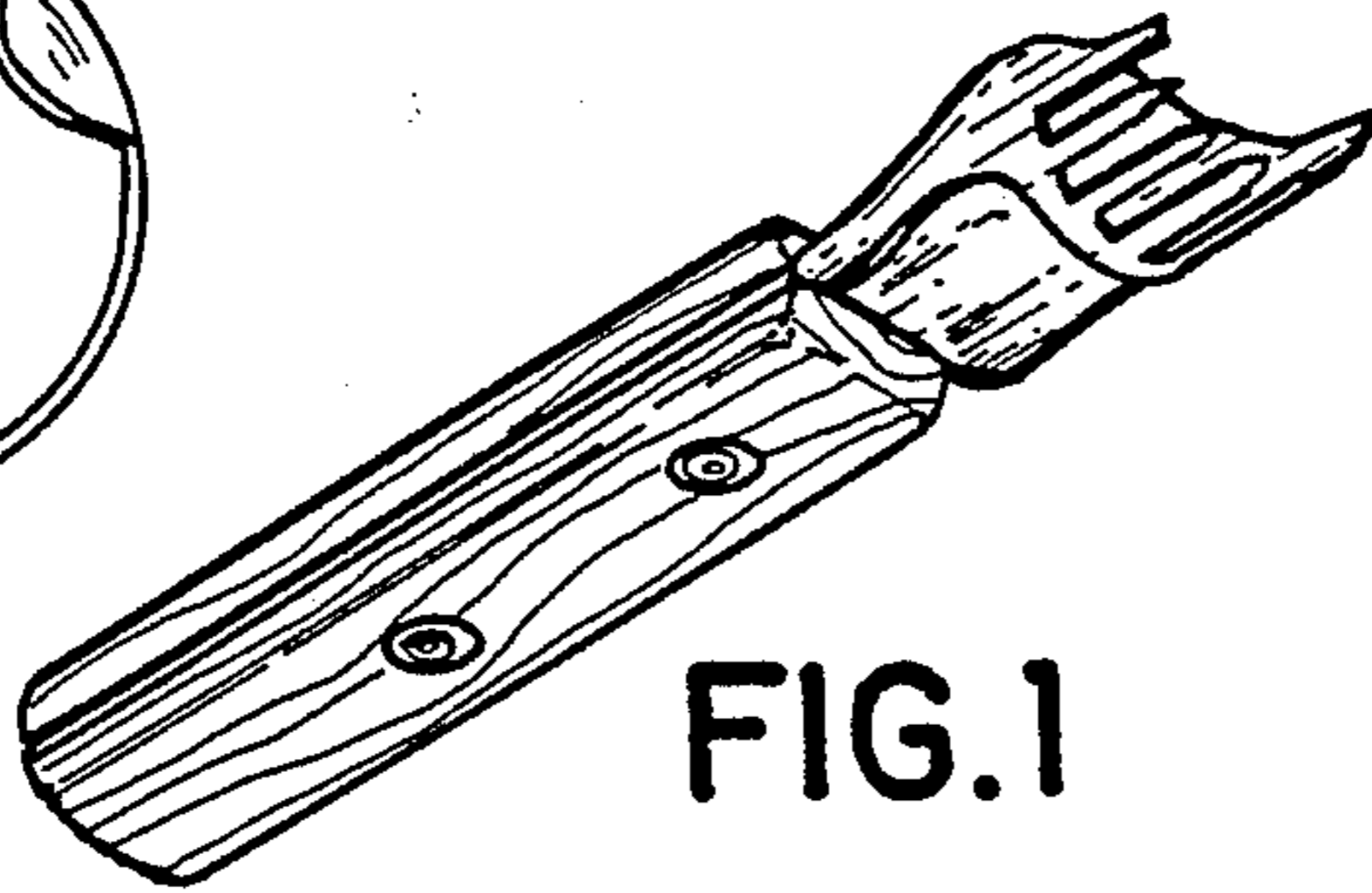

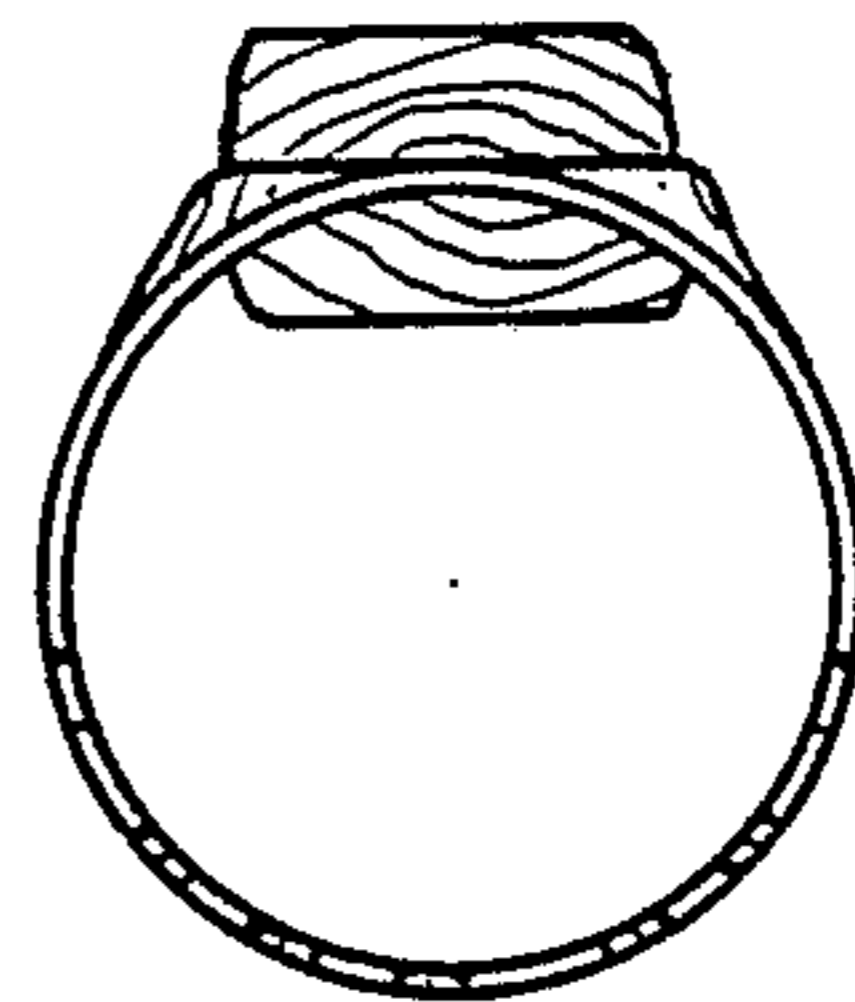
