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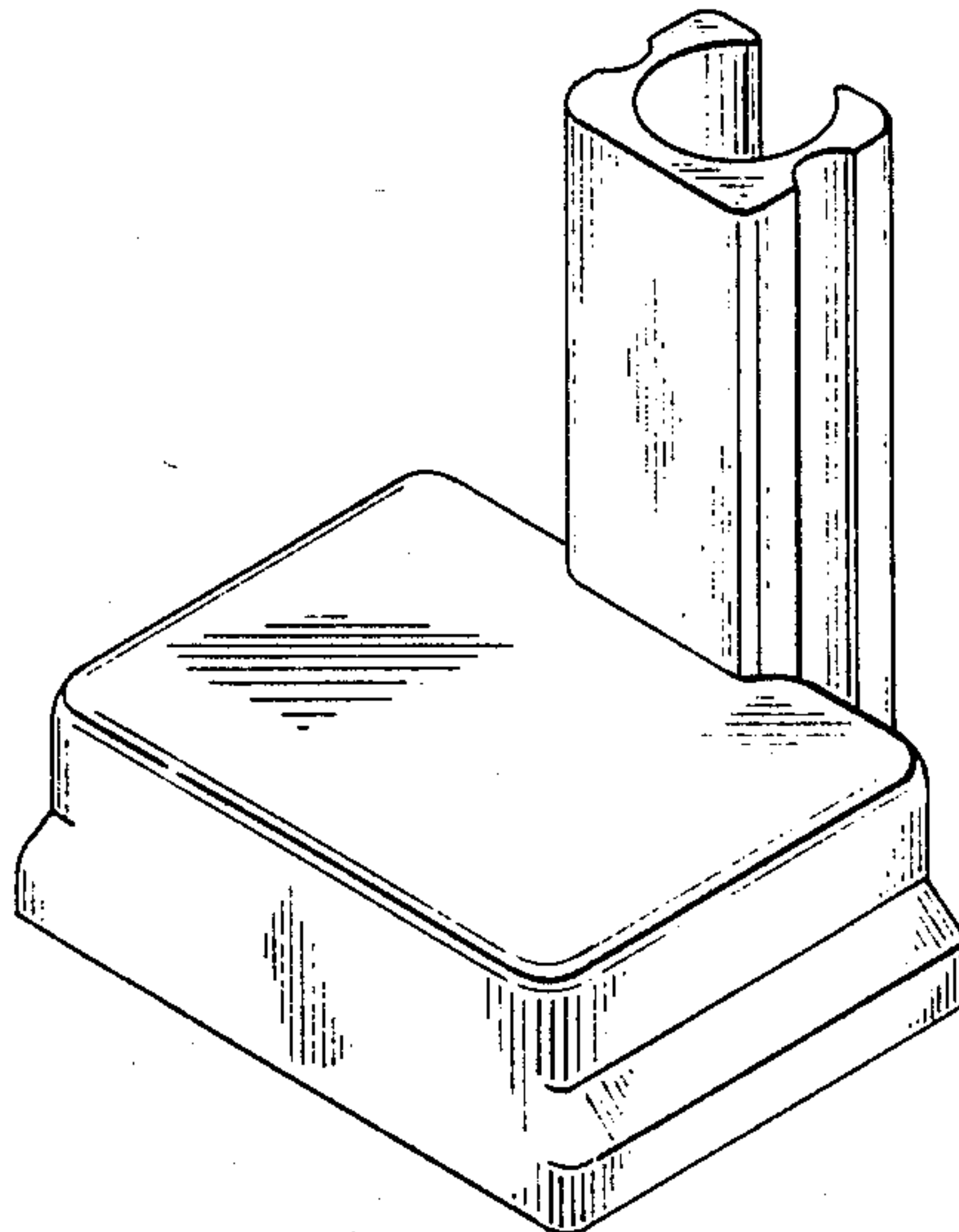
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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for protector for outboard
motor fuel hoses, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right perspective view of a protector for
outboard motor fuel hoses embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is an end elevational view thereof, the opposite
end being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a right perspective view of a modified form of
the protector for outboard motor fuel hoses shown in
FIGS. 1 thru 6; and,
FIG. 8 is a right perspective view of another modified
form of the protector for outboard motor fuel hoses,
shown in FIGS. 1 thru 6.



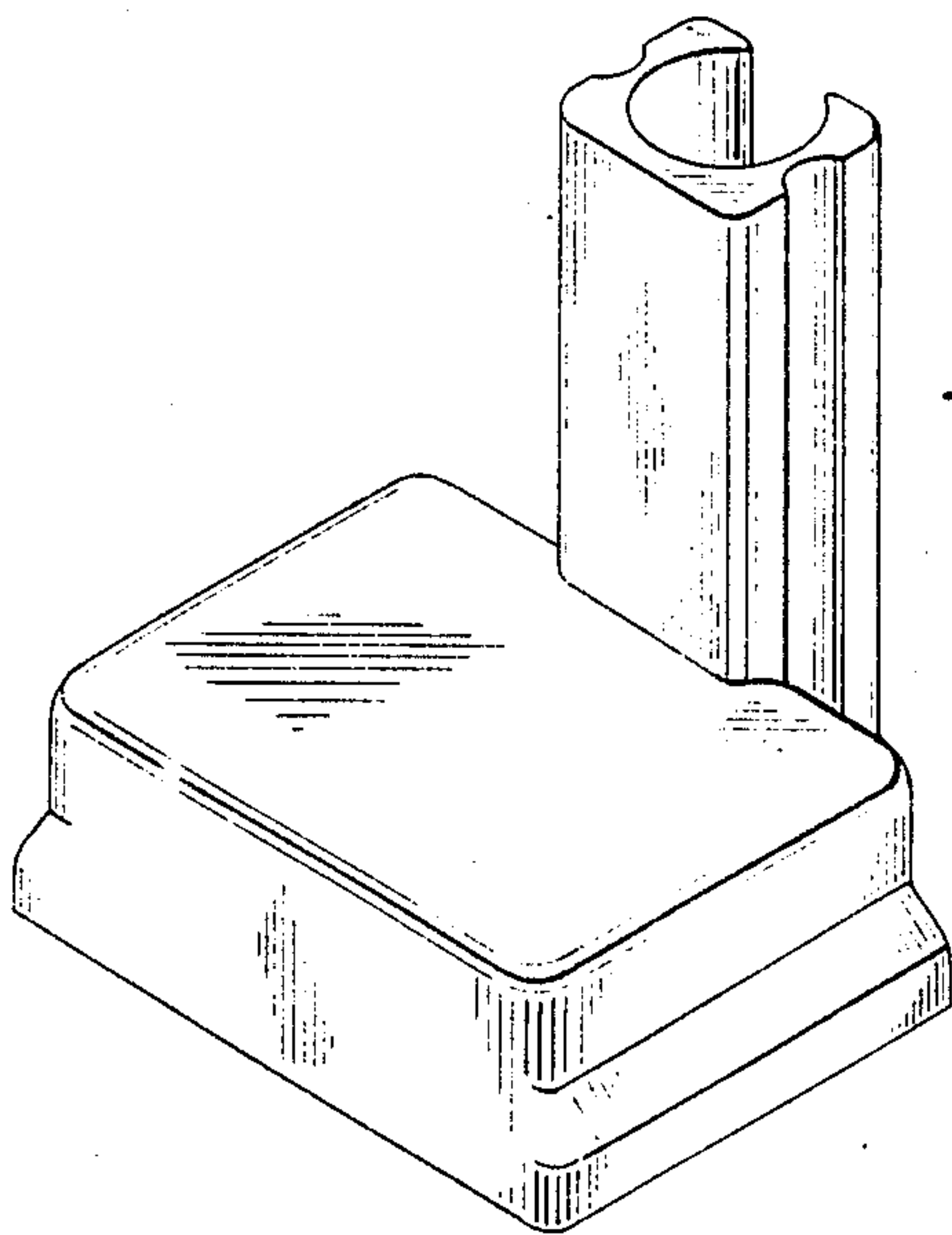

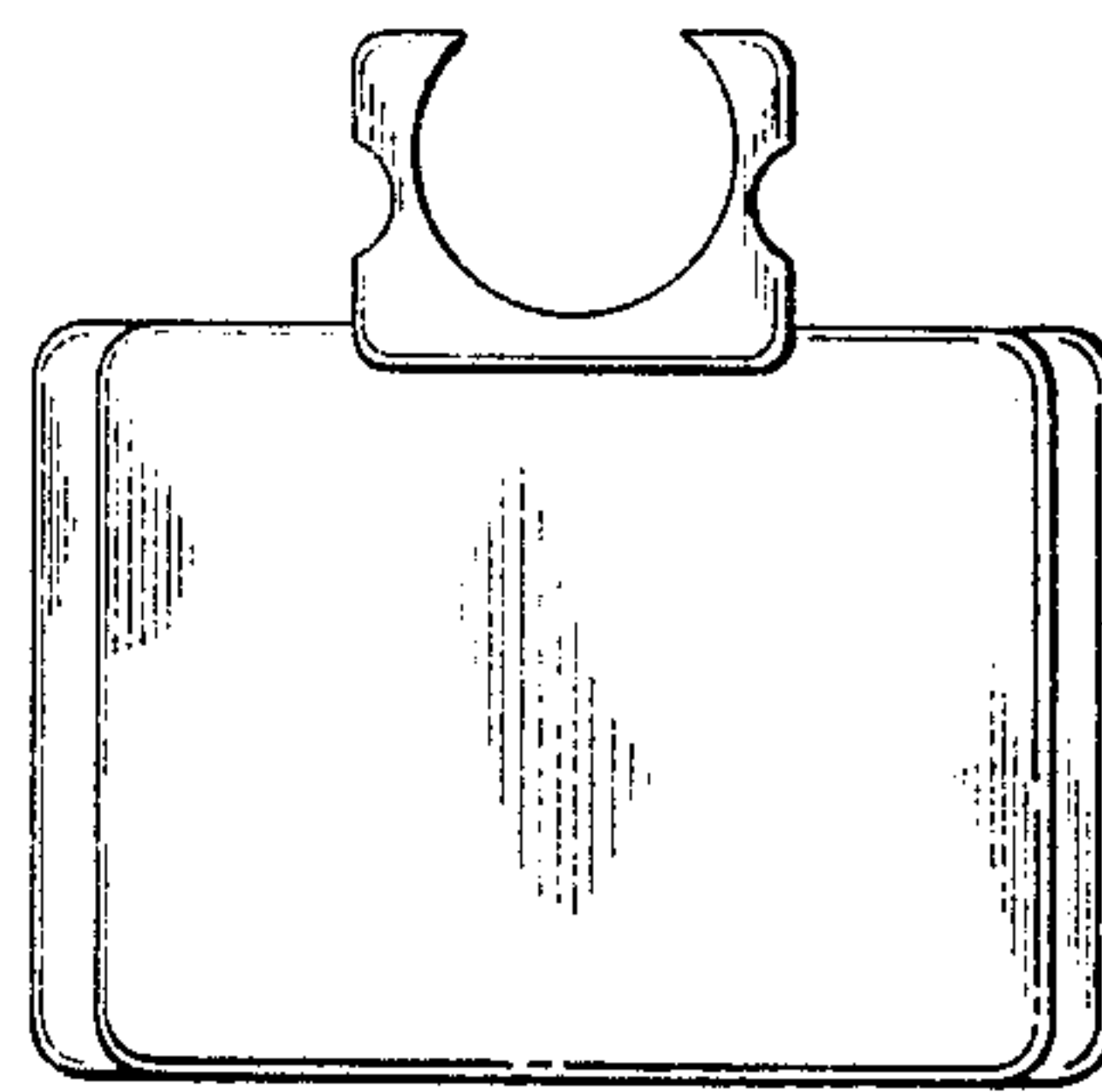

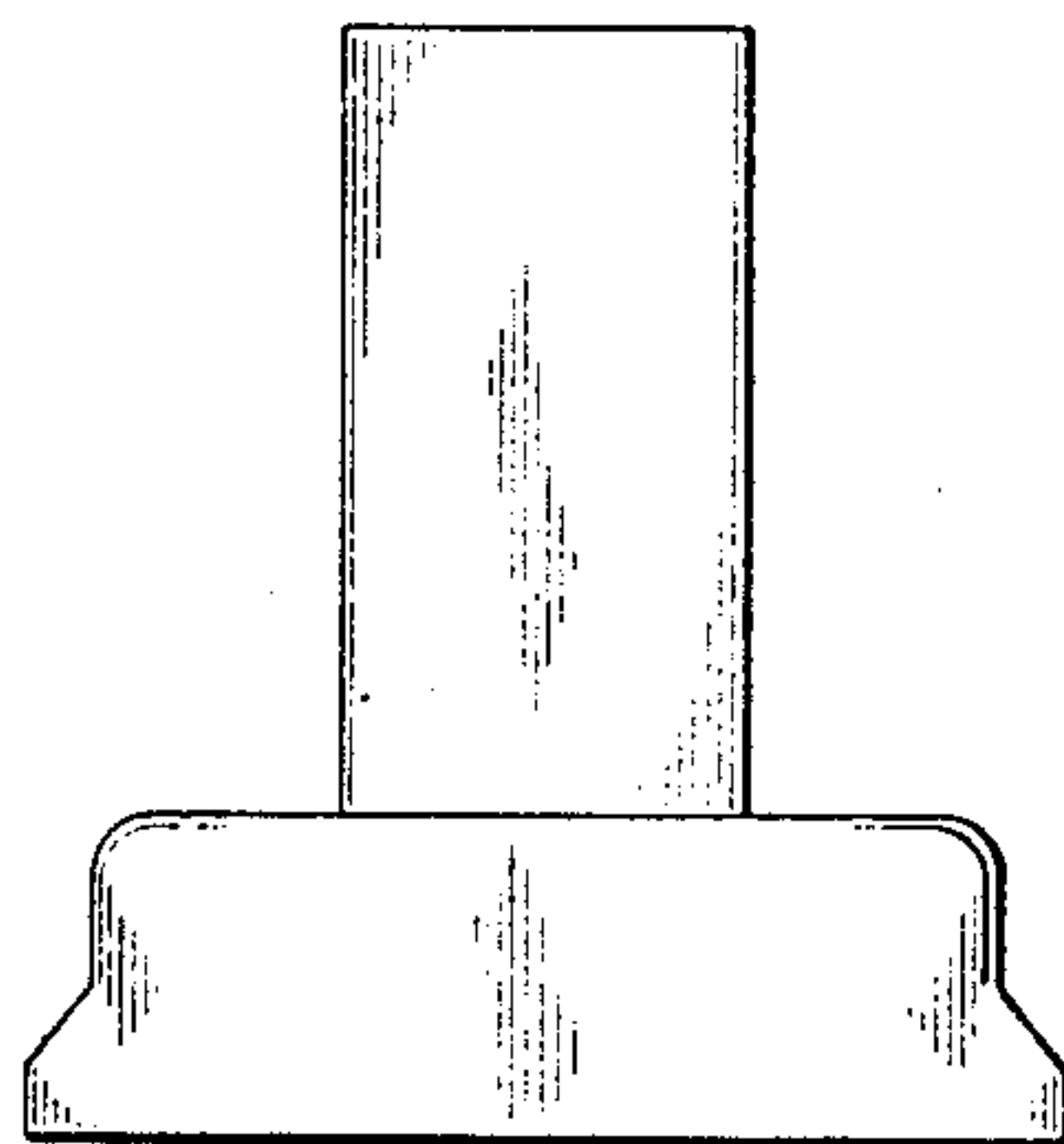

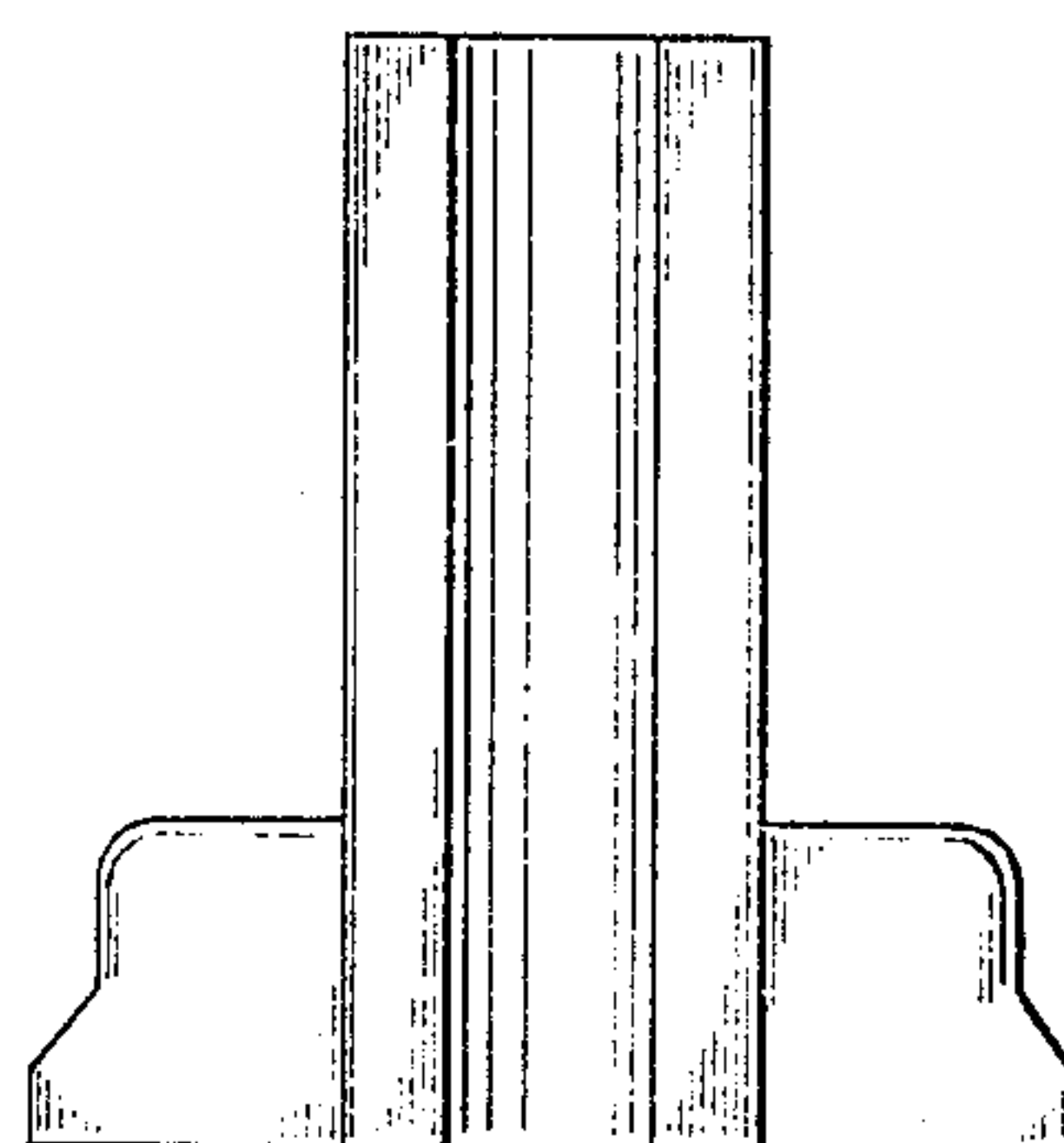

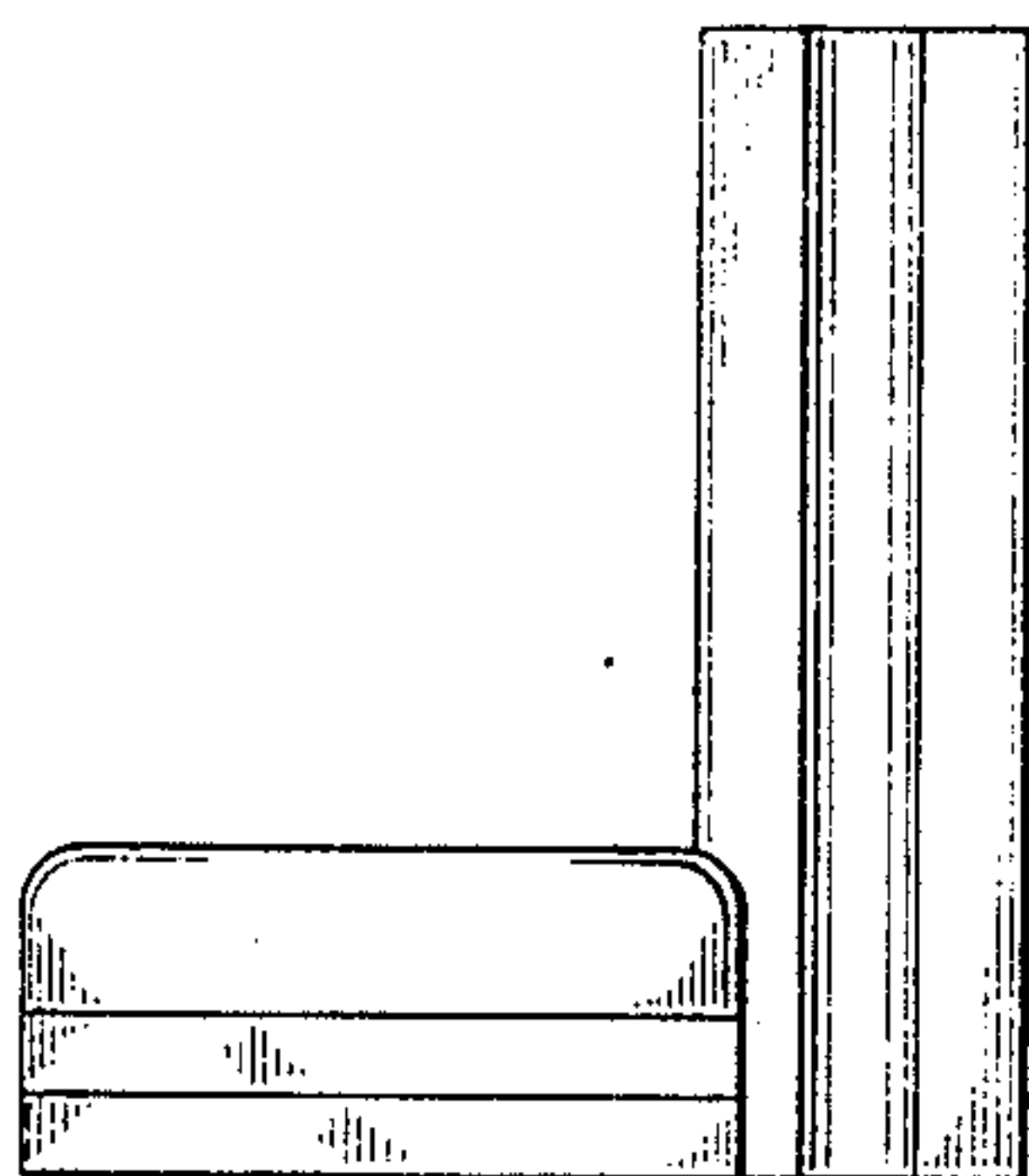

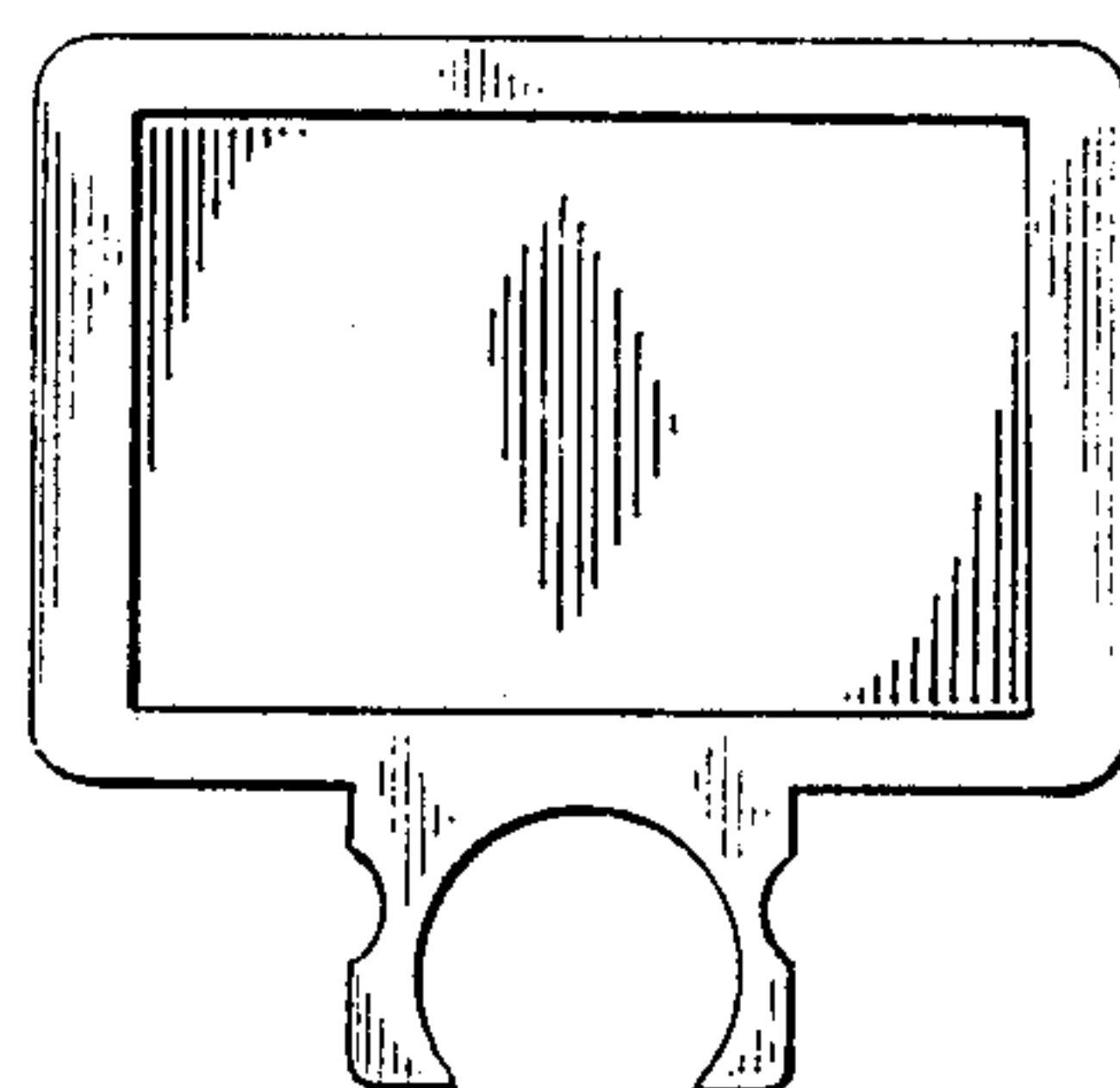

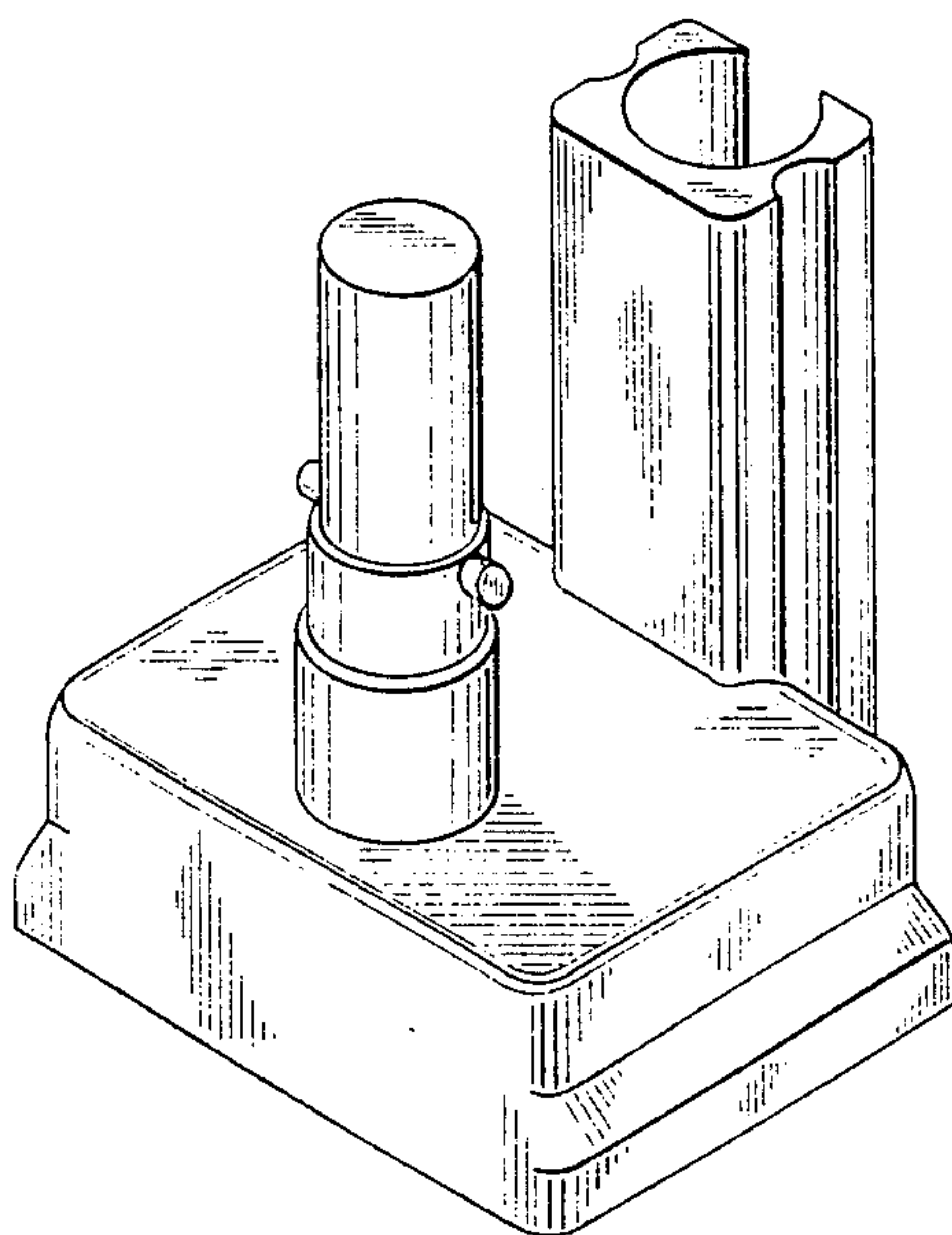

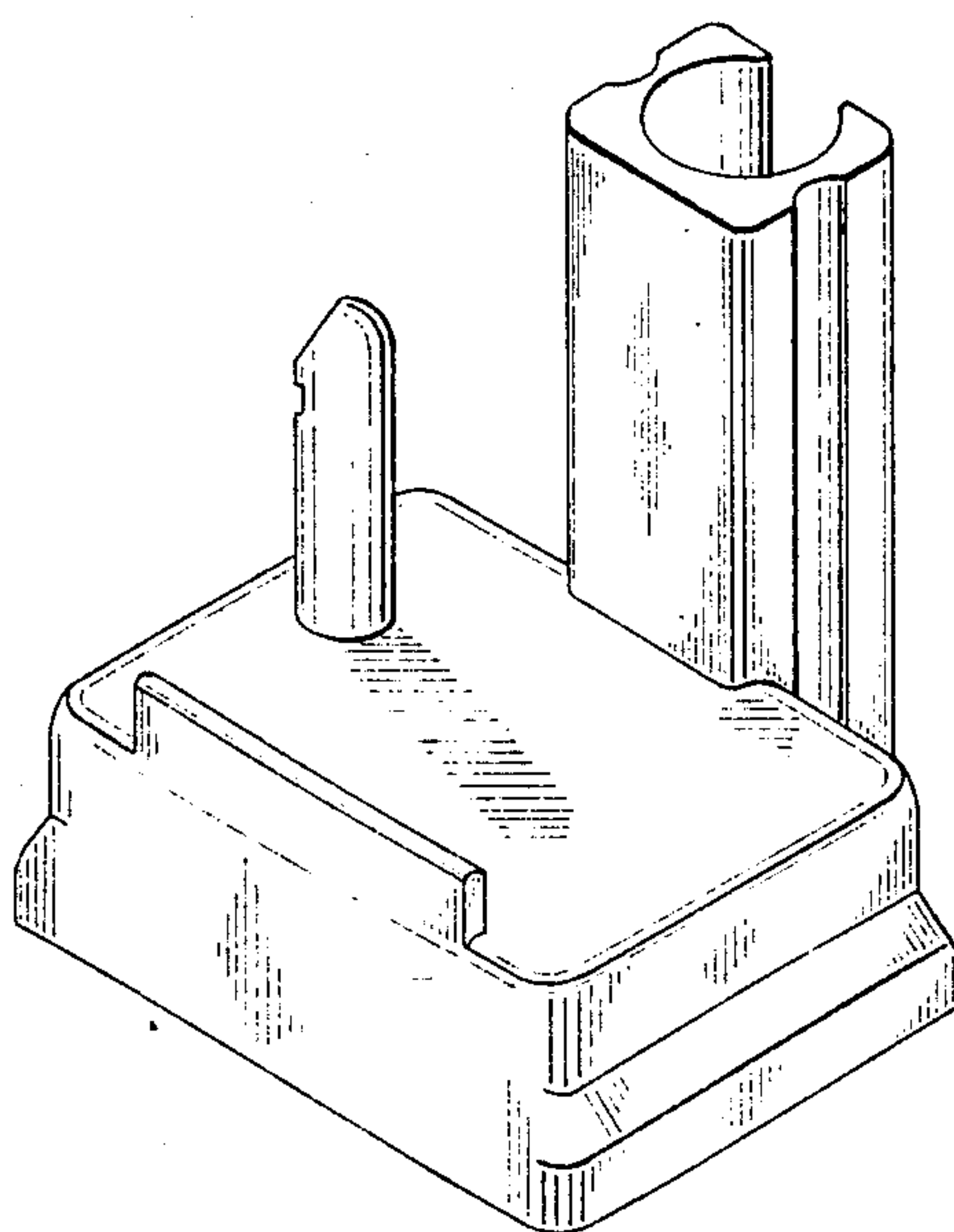
