[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a ball-point pen, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a ball point pen showing my new design, the rear being the same as the front shown;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being the same as the side shown;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view; and

FIG. 4 is a front perspective view thereof.

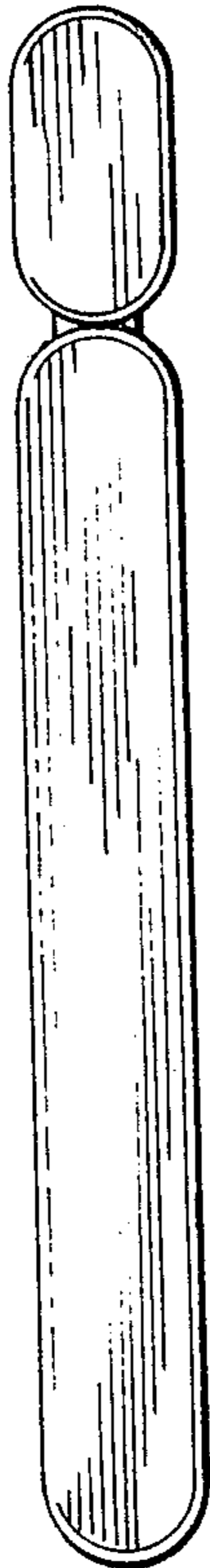
