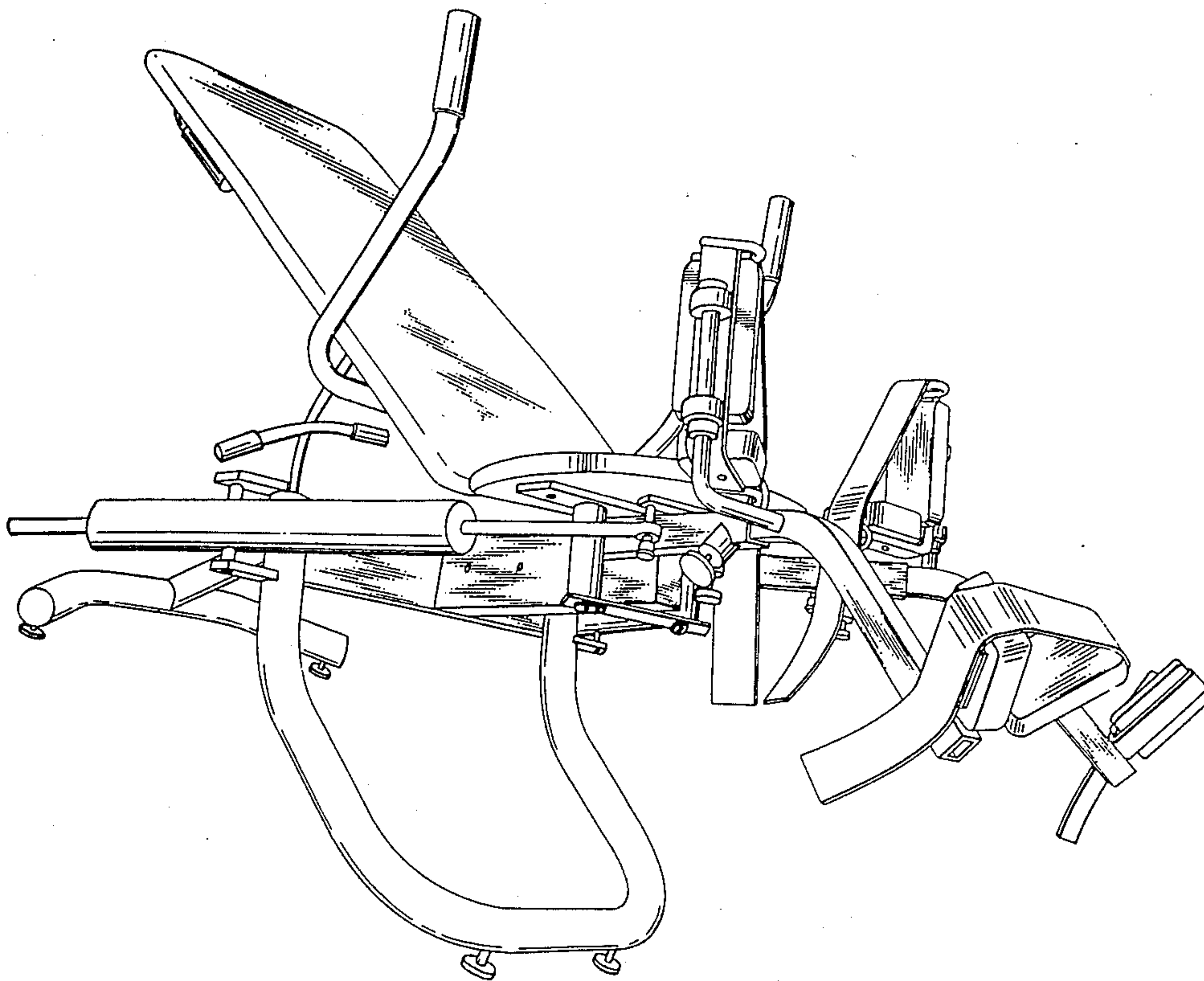

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an abduction-adduction hip exerciser showing my new design; and, FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof.



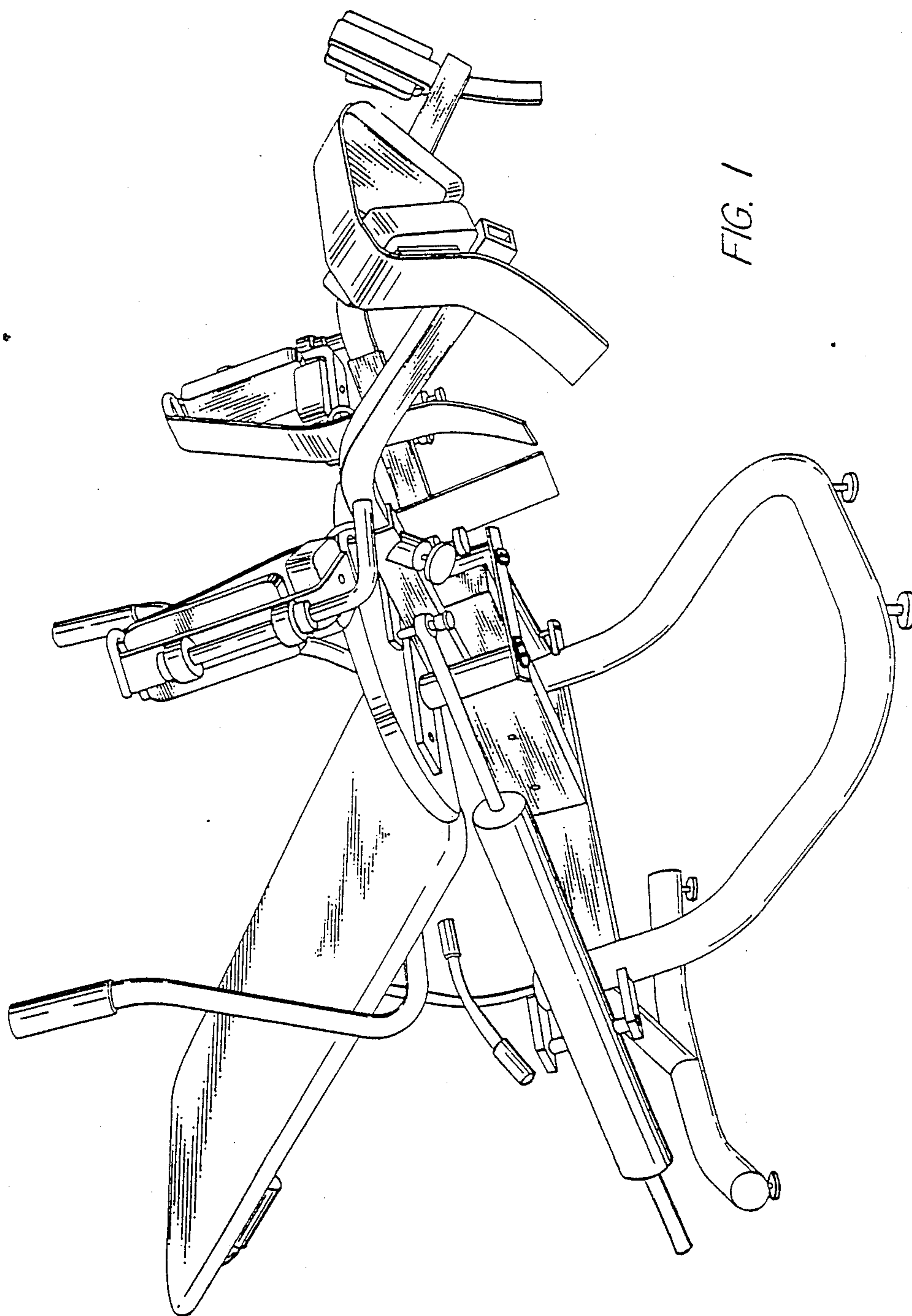

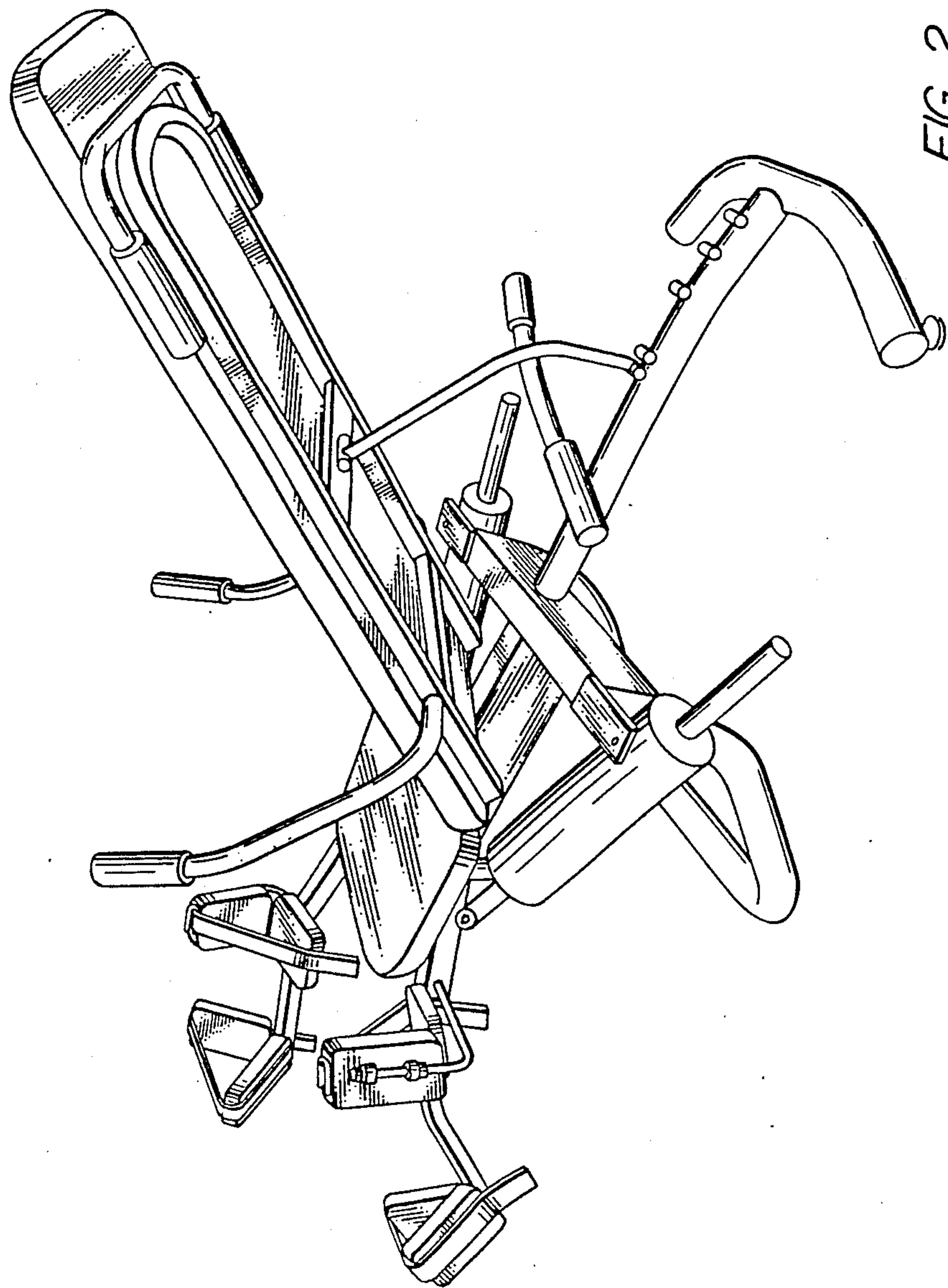
