FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a yellow jacket trap embodying my new design.

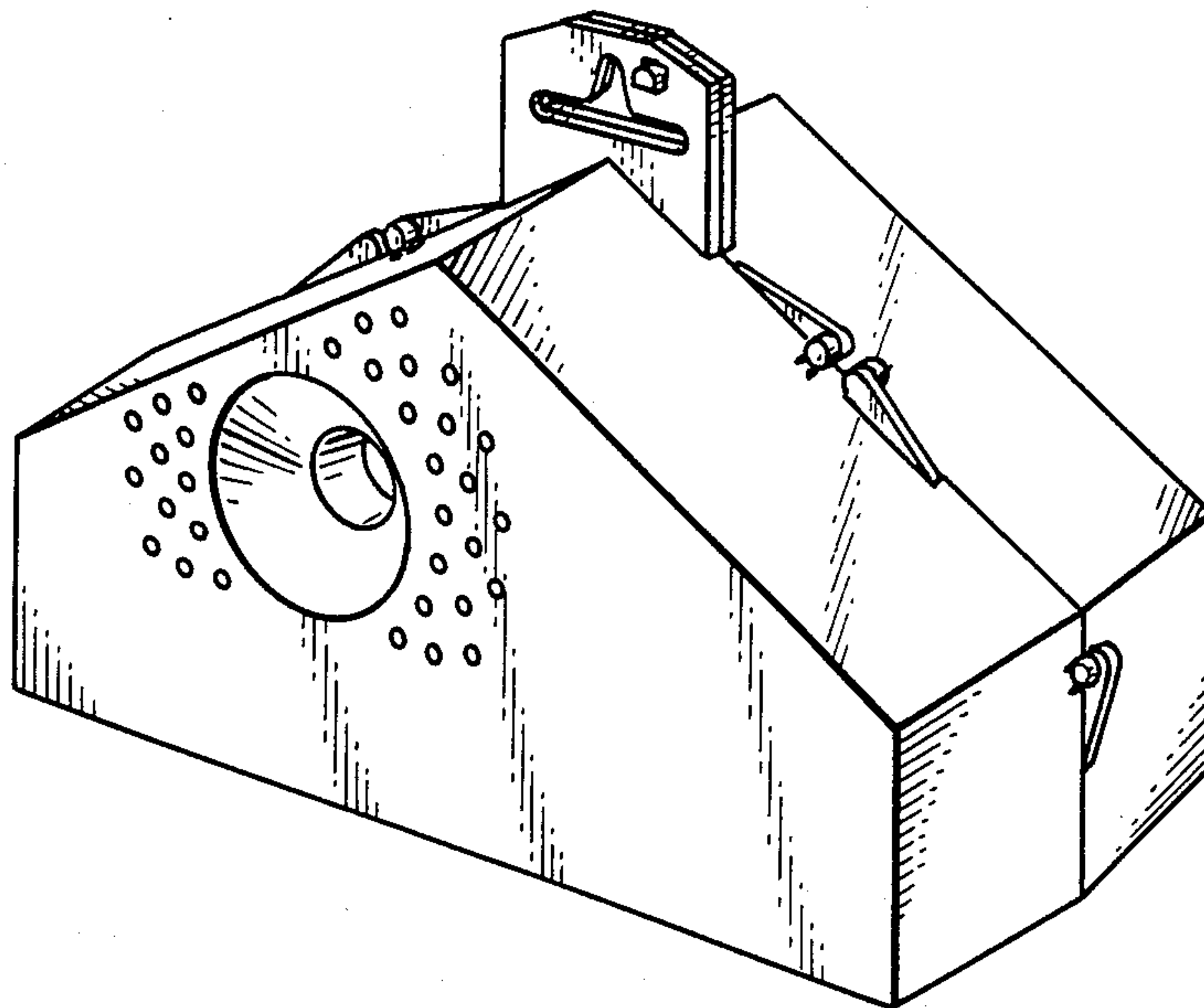
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the yellow jacket trap of FIG. 1.

The front, not shown, is like the rear shown in FIGS. 1 and 3.



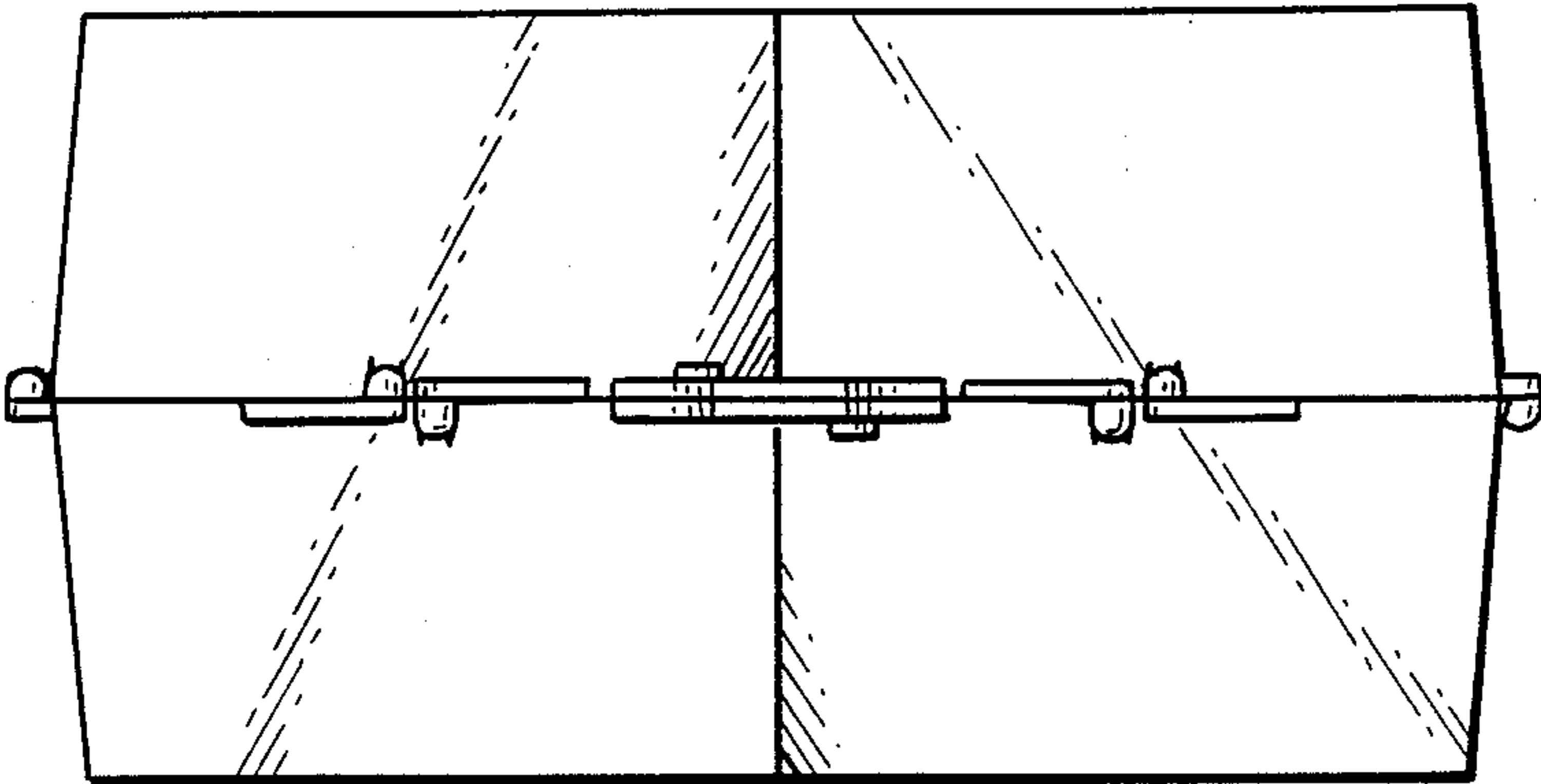

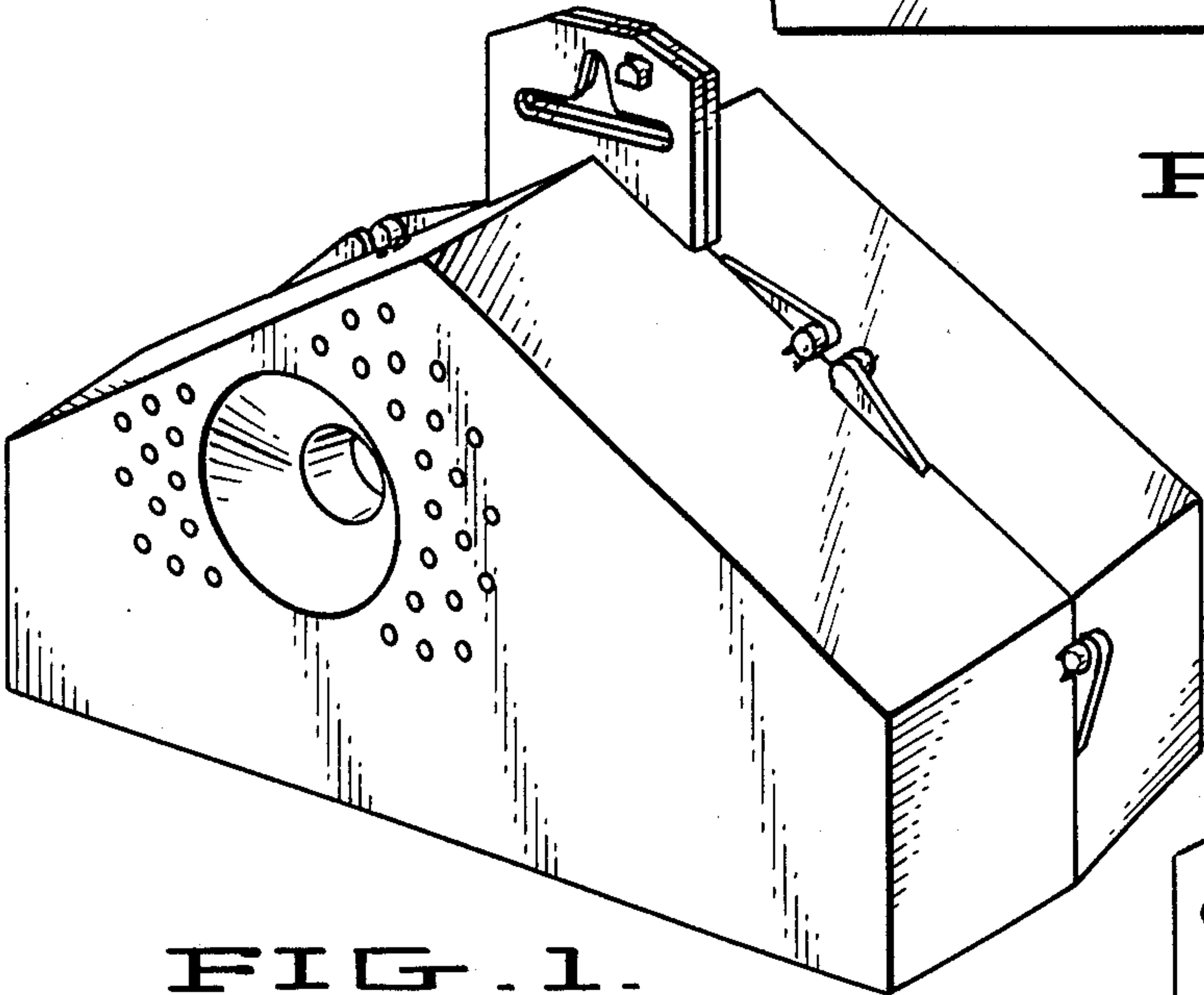

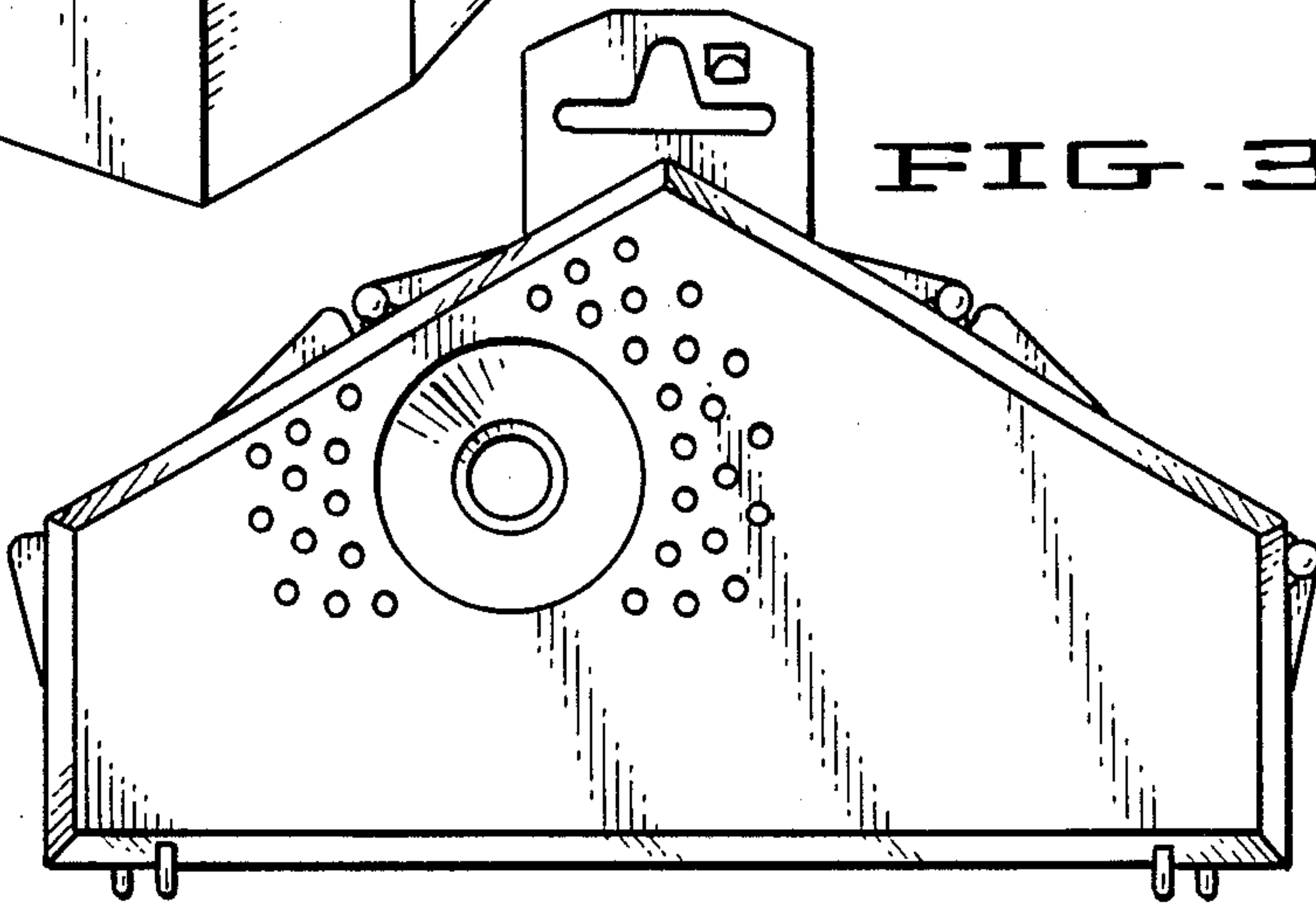

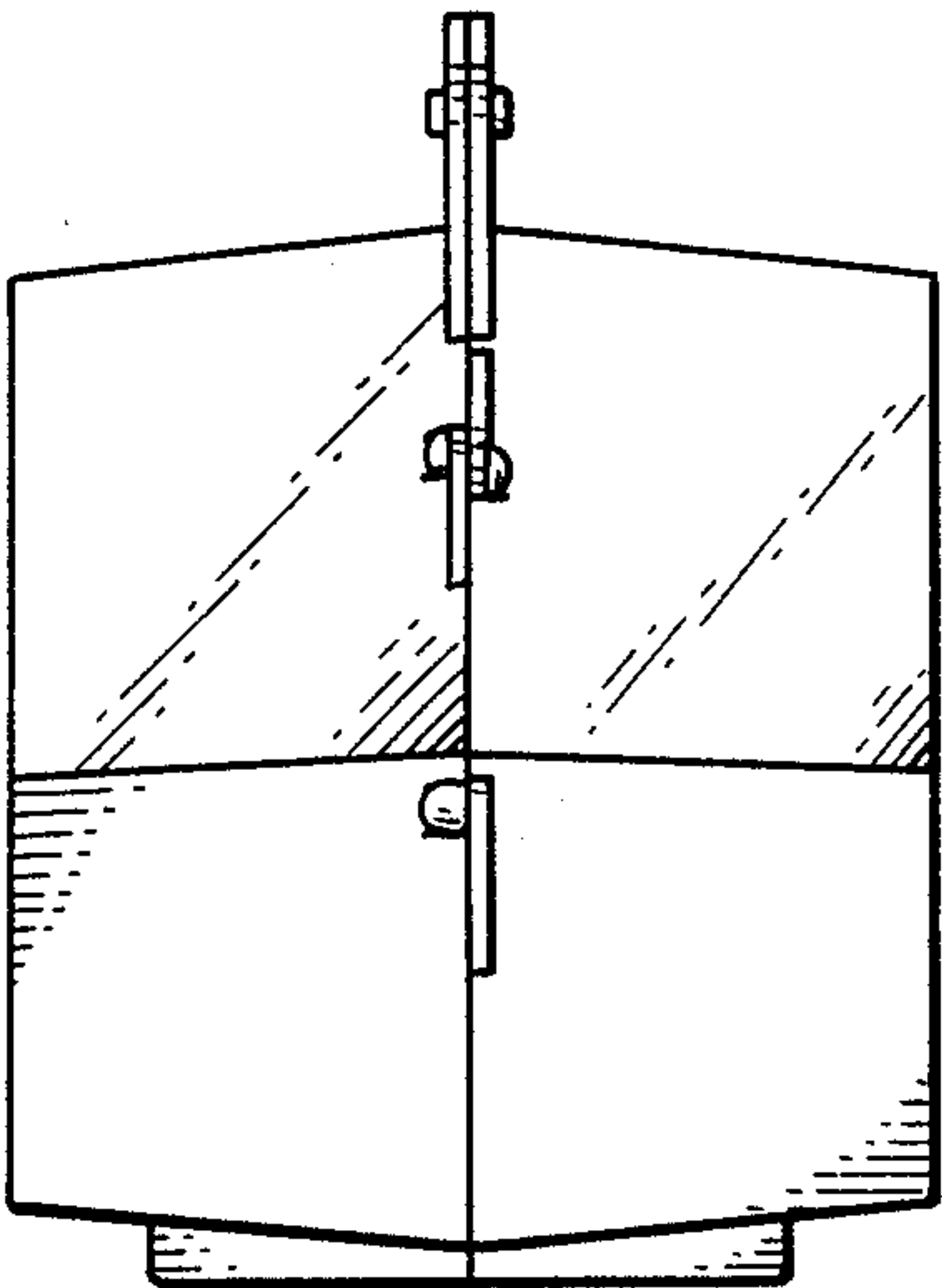

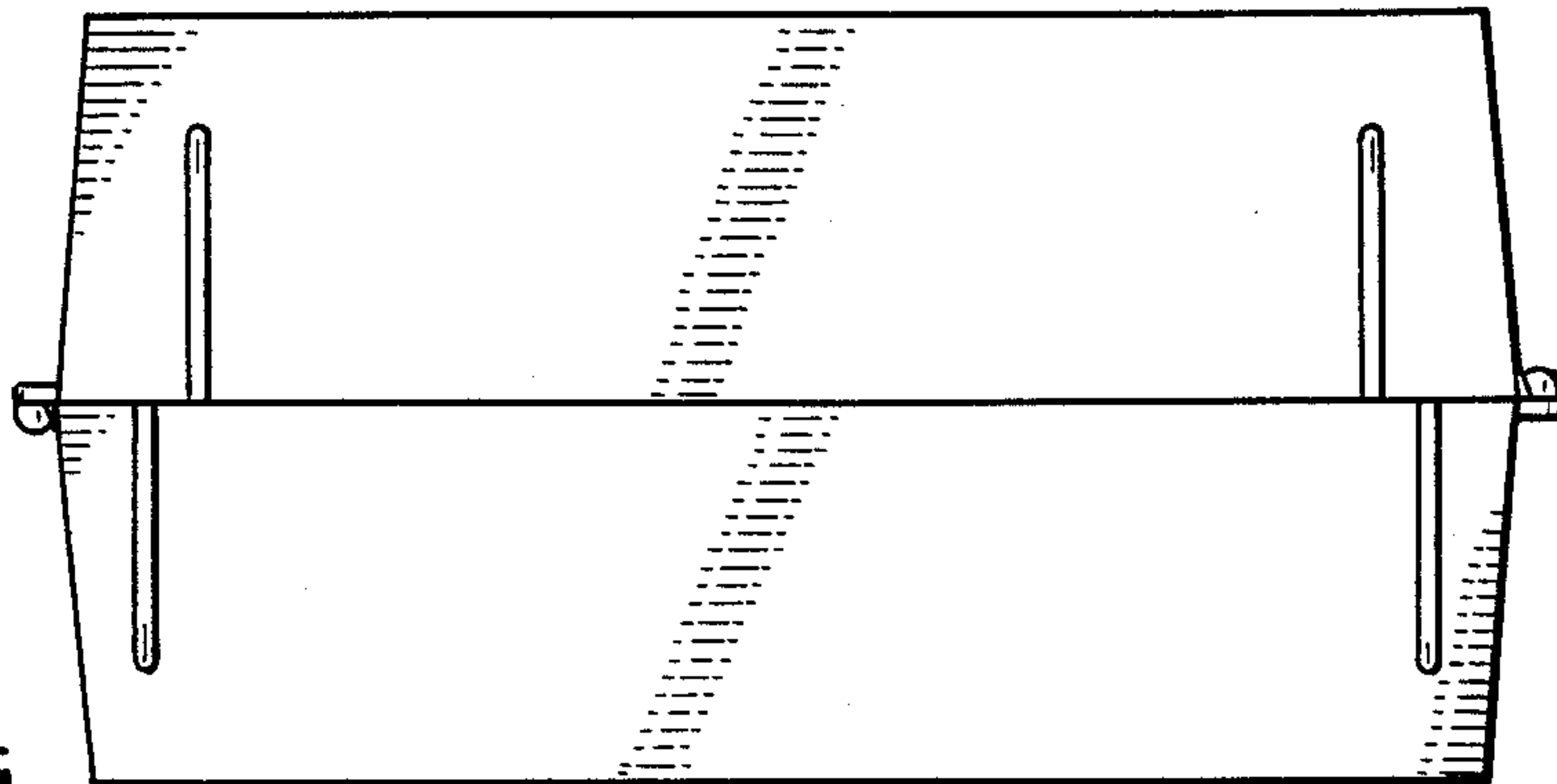
