[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an I.V. support stand for mounting upon a wheelchair or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an I.V. support stand for mounting upon a wheelchair or the like, showing my new design; the broken line showing of the arm rest of a wheelchair is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image;

FIG. 3 is a fragmentary left side elevational view of the upper end of the stand;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
