DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a powered post for automotive vehicle body and frame repairs, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a reduced right side elevational view thereof, the left side view being a mirror image of that shown; and

FIG. 4 is a reduced rear elevational view thereof.

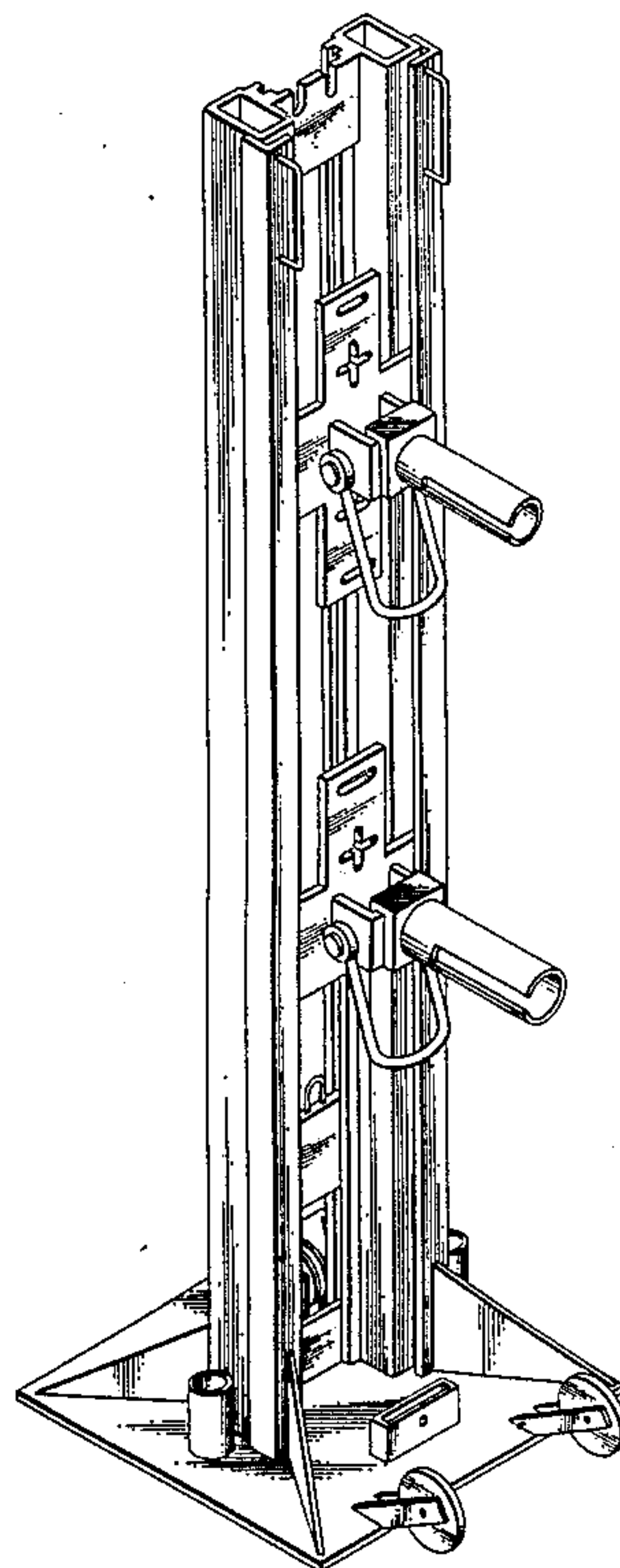

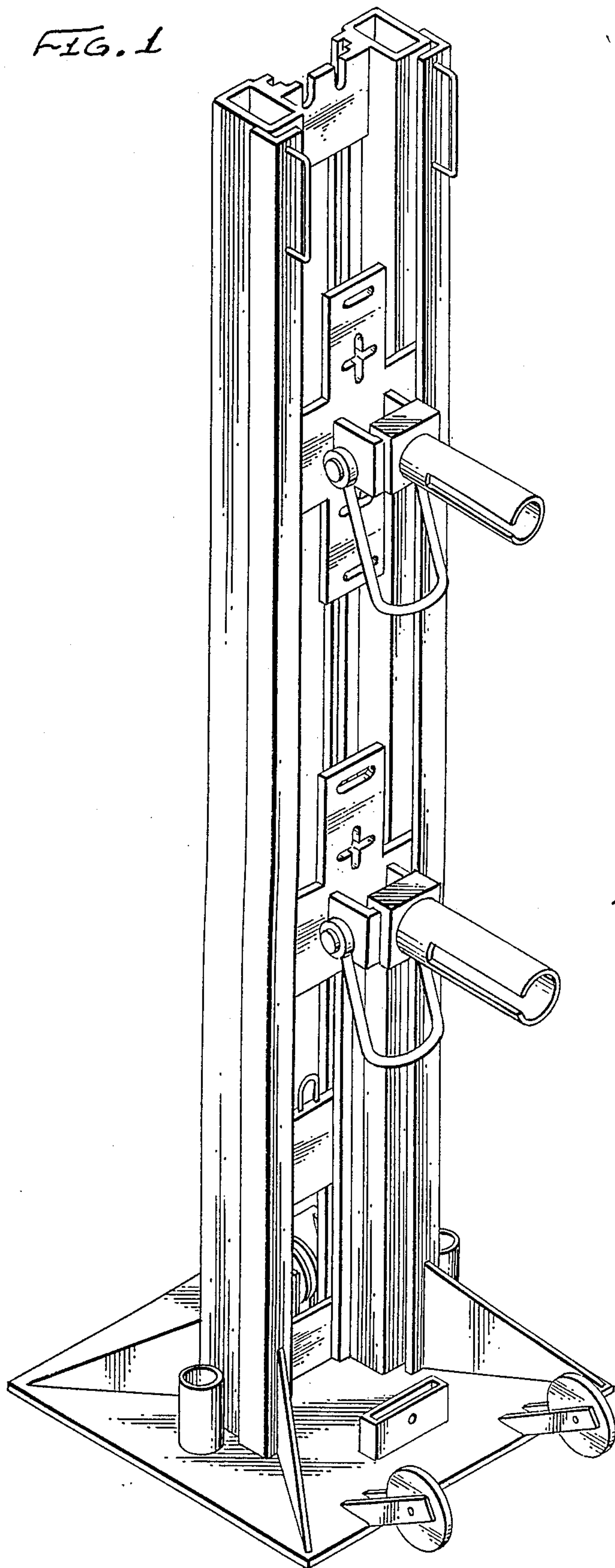

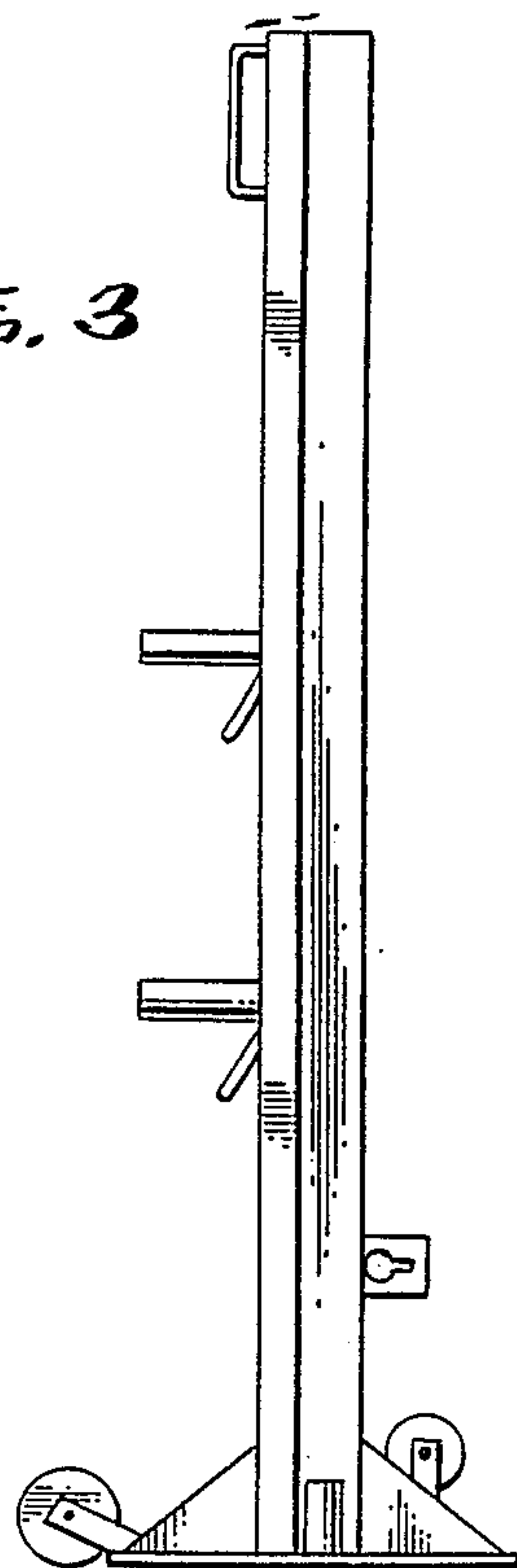
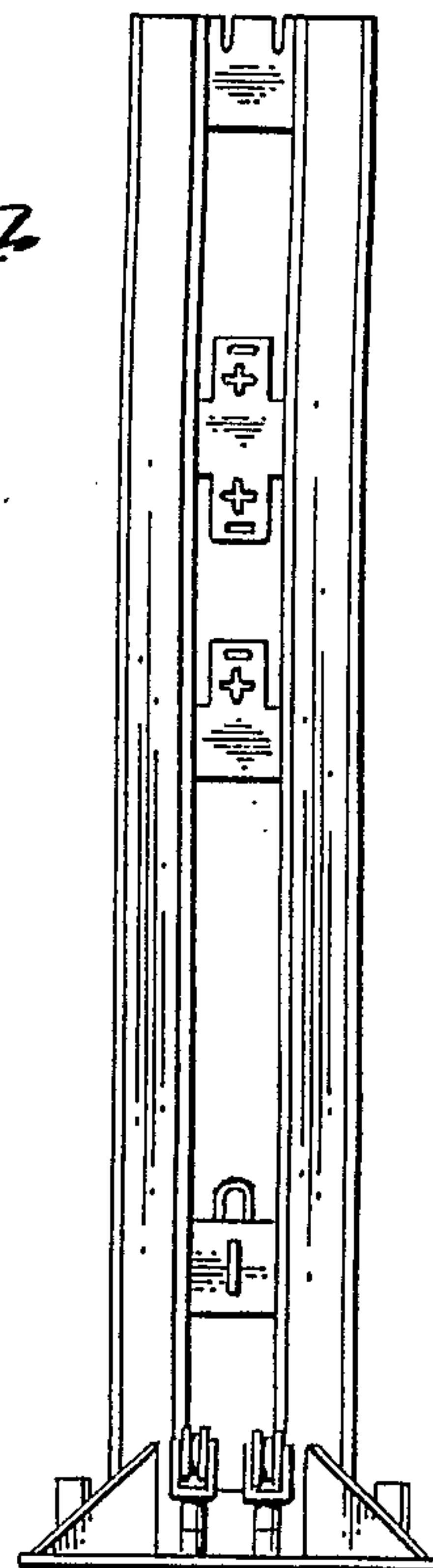

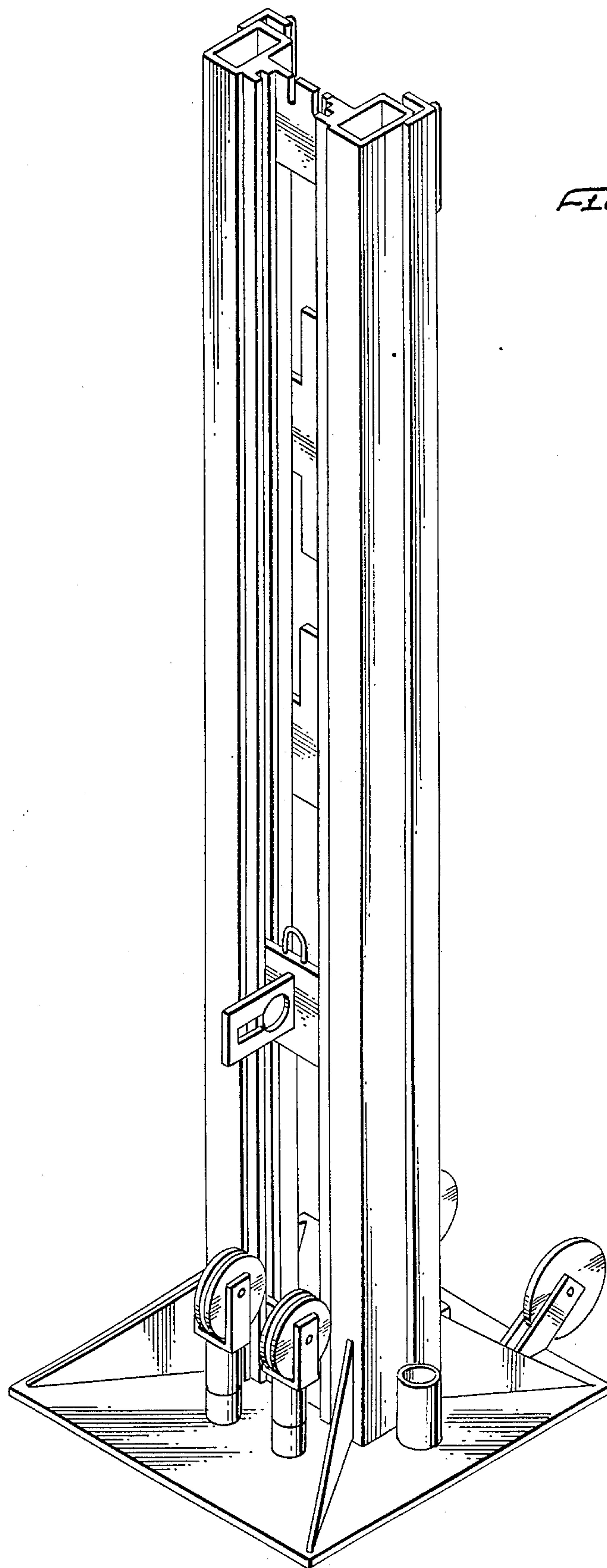
